Mrs. Beretta and Gentlemen:

I respectfully submit for your information and action the following data and recommendations:

I. Procurement of Housing

For some months I have been negotiating with the Army with reference to securing a portion of the San Marcos Navigation School for housing veterans. This field is located three miles from the campus and it is considered altogether possible and practical to house the students at the field and transport them to and from the campus. The following appears to be the situation at present:

1. Through our local Chamber of Commerce, the city of San Marcos and Congressman Johnson, we have secured tentative approval from the War Department to use as much of the housing at the Navigation School as is needed.

2. Congressman Johnson will be in San Marcos within the next ten days with a Committee from the War Department to make inspection and to give final approval. Mr. Amis of the Federal Housing Authority in Fort Worth has agreed to assist us in securing these facilities through the Federal Housing Authority. The major phases of our proposal are as follows:

- a. To secure the base hospital which will house 500 single men.
- b. To secure the Bachelor Officers Quarters which will be converted into apartments for married couples. This will house 192 married couples.
- c. To secure other buildings such as the Officers Club, the gymnasium and other buildings as needed.

The above proposal, if accepted, will require expense on our part to convert these buildings into use. We have already located some equipment which may be transferred to us without cost but it will be necessary to purchase buses and other equipment. We desire permission to make a loan of \$20,000 to defray the costs of the above transaction if and when it is consummated, the loan to be repaid from receipts within a four to six months period.

Election of Faculty for 1946-47

Your attention is called to the following adjustments in salary:

Item 3. I desire to make a local adjustment of \$300.00 in the salary of Dr. Bryan Wildenthal, Professor of Commerce and Business Manager.

Item 9. It is recommended that Dr. Claude Elliott, now Professor of History and Registrar, be assigned, in addition, the duties of Dean of graduate studies and an adjustment of \$300.00 be made.

Item 3b. I recommend the adjustment in salary of \$180.00 in the case of Mrs. Mary Buchanan.

Item 6b. It is recommended the salary of Dr. J. M. Roady be adjusted in the amount of \$180.00.

New Personnel

Item 6. I recommend the appointment of Dr. James Taylor as Professor of History and Director of the Department, succeeding Dr. Eugene Tanner, resigned. Dr. Taylor has, for the past few months, served in the Army as Historian and now holds the rank of Major. He was formerly Professor of History at the Texas State College for Women. He possesses an outstanding personality and professional record.

Positions to be Filled

Because of our favorable position in housing, we expect an unusually large increase in enrollment in June and September. This will mean an increase in the staff in some departments in order to take care of the teaching load. We know now that we shall need additional staff in Industrial Arts, Agriculture, Mathematics and in the Library, but are not in a position to make a recommendation at this time.

VII. Procurement of Surplus War Goods

Our college has been extremely fortunate during the past weeks in securing gifts from the Government. Our Industrial Arts Shop has just acquired by gift, tools and equipment for our wood work, sheet metal, drafting and machine shops, valued at approximately \$70,000.00 and it is expected additional equipment will be secured.

We have been able to purchase some materials and supplies at extremely low prices.

VIII. Alumni Association Campaign

A recent meeting of Alumni on our campus gave us great encouragement. The Association among many constructive activities planned a campaign to raise an additional \$25,000.00 for general college improvement.

The Alumni have already contributed about \$9,300.00 for the erection of a Memorial Organ to be dedicated to the men and women of the military services. Most of the remainder of this fund will be used to equip the Student Union.
