Employment of Building Inspector.

It is obvious that we need a resident inspector on all this construction, and after making thorough investigation, I should like to recommend the following person:

Mr. O. L. Edwards, at \$100.00 per week.

Mr. Edwards has had considerable architectural and engineering training, although not registered. He has served as resident inspector on a number of large construction jobs in central and south Texas. His credentials are good and the reports I have had about him are quite satisfactory.
