1 (small child(ren) crying in background of most of
2 tape)

3 STEVE: Really, it is.

4 JIM: It is. It's going good and it's going
5 to go good.

6 STEVE: It feels like being on a -- up and
7 down on waves here, but --

8 JIM: Yeah, I know.

9 STEVE: Should I call you back then or are
10 you going to call me back or --

11 JIM: Tell you what I want to do is just
12 get --

13 STEVE: Pardon?

14 JIM: I want to just get the kids -- I want
15 to just tell you we got them safe.

16 STEVE TO UNIDENTIFIED PARTY: He's going to
17 work on that. He said he's going to work on getting a
18 line for you there, you know, with the radio station
19 or whatever.

20 JIM: Steve?

21 STEVE: You know there is one thing. A
22 couple of these guys that haven't made up their mind,
23 they're, they're saying there are guys in camouflage
24 that they, that they see them right now. They've got
25 like brush and stuff stuck in their helmets. They're

1 in camouflage, they're, they're positively on the
2 property. You know, we, we -- You know, you said
3 about those --

4 JIM: Okay.

5 STEVE: -- those kind of vehicles being
6 there?

7 JIM: Yeah.

8 STEVE: Well, that -- Okay, you, you said
9 it, we were going along and, you know, the, the --
10 we're moving with the kids. But who are they? I
11 mean, what are they doing there? You know, I really
12 thought you had control over these vehicles.

13 JIM: You know, there's a lot of perimeter
14 movement, I understand that.

15 STEVE: I mean that's the kind of thing that
16 makes some of these people nervous. They don't want
17 to be, you know, they're wondering what's going on and
18 they're afraid to move. A lot of them are sitting
19 here kind of like almost frozen.

20 JIM: Yeah, I know, but nobody's coming in.
21 You have my word. I know there's perimeter --

22 STEVE: Yeah.

23 JIM: -- people, Steve. I, I know there is.

24 STEVE: What are they doing on the property
25 and all that?

1 JIM: Yeah, I'm not making a secret of that.
2 But I guess we've got to, you know, we've got to kind
3 of, like I said earlier, you know, get more toward the
4 brass tacks, and that is --

5 STEVE: Well, that's what we want to do,
6 but, you know, I mean, you did tell us, you know, that
7 they wouldn't be on the property. And you mentioned
8 where the others would be and, and you told the truth.

9 JIM: Yeah.

10 STEVE: So I, I'm just wondering why those,
11 those guys are where they're at there.

12 JIM: Yeah. I'm going to have to get back
13 with those commanders.

14 STEVE: Can you?

15 JIM: Yeah, I will. I'm going to have to go
16 back --

17 STEVE: I, I really believe it'll make it
18 easier if you don't -- if there's no one like that.
19 There's going to be people here that are going to be
20 feeling much more safe and, and -- I mean, 'cause, you
21 know, it's night, they don't know what's going on,
22 they don't know where these people might end up being.
23 They're, they're scared.

24 JIM: I know. Look, here's what --

25 STEVE: Okay.

1 JIM: Here's what we're going to have to do.

2 STEVE: All right.

3 JIM: As soon as we get these kids hooked
4 up, I'm going to go back and talk to these commanders
5 --

6 STEVE: All right. Okay.

7 JIM: -- about that perimeter motion, okay?

8 STEVE: Right.

9 JIM: And, and some of these issues we've
10 discussed.

11 STEVE: Right, okay.

12 JIM: I've got to round them up. There's a
13 bunch of them in here.

14 STEVE: Okay.

15 JIM: And --

16 STEVE: And call me back then?

17 JIM: No, because I want to hook these kids
18 up, okay? And, and, and, and David said that he
19 wanted to keep the kids coming out.

20 STEVE: Right.

21 JIM: And you've got these other two,
22 Chrissy and -- You've got Brian and Jake are coming
23 out and you've got Chrissy and Scott.

24 STEVE: Yeah.

25 JIM: So what, what I want you to do, I've

1 got Henry here, okay?

2 STEVE: Okay.

3 JIM: He's been with me all through this.

4 STEVE: All right.

5 JIM: Okay? Helping me, setting up the car,
6 doing everything, okay?

7 STEVE: Yeah.

8 JIM: He's personal with me. I know the
9 guy, he's golden, okay? We've worked every --
10 Everything we've worked out stands.

11 STEVE: Okay.

12 JIM: Okay, he's not going to make any
13 changes to the, you know, he's going to try to work
14 with you. He knows all the agreements, he sat and
15 went through everything.

16 STEVE: Okay.

17 JIM: Okay?

18 STEVE: Yeah.

19 JIM: And he, he really is a good fellow,
20 okay? And I want you to just talk with him on the
21 mechanics of getting Chrissy and Scott out, okay? And
22 then, and then, you know, just to continue with it,
23 okay?

24 STEVE: Yeah.

25 JIM: While I go try to work on these

1 commanders. As long as we're doing this, I mean, it's
2 positive.

3 STEVE: Okay.

4 JIM: Okay?

5 STEVE: Is it okay if I get off the phone
6 here and talk with them then?

7 JIM: Okay, wait. There's a vehicle
8 approaching.

9 STEVE: Okay.

10 JIM: You know --

11 STEVE: I tell you, I'm so weak I'm standing
12 here and --

13 JIM: Just hang with me one second, Steve.

14 STEVE: Okay.

15 JIM: Listen --

16 STEVE: I'm tired.

17 JIM: -- what I want you -- After, after you
18 talk to Henry a while, and he'll give you a break,
19 but, you know, David can convince everyone to come out
20 if he has a mind to.

21 STEVE: Well, you know, that's what he's
22 been saying to them. He again said to these people,
23 he said look, you know, he's already told them. And
24 like right now he's laying back because he's, he is,
25 you know, I'm telling you he can hardly talk.

1 JIM: Yeah.

2 STEVE: He mustered up what he could to talk
3 with you, but he is tired.

4 JIM: Well, you, you've got to work with
5 him, you've got to --

6 STEVE: Well, that's what I need to do now.
7 That's what I wanted to do.

8 JIM: Okay. Let me just tell you we've got
9 the kids --

10 STEVE: Okay.

11 JIM: -- and then you can work out with
12 Henry just a time to, you know, to keep bringing
13 people out and, you know, the kids anyway. Trust me,
14 Steve, Henry won't let you down now. I wouldn't give
15 you anybody that you couldn't trust.

16 STEVE: Right.

17 JIM: I mean, the guy's first-rate, okay?

18 STEVE: Okay.

19 JIM: Everything he says right down the
20 line, okay? Okay, the cars are there.

21 STEVE: Okay.

22 JIM: The commanders are telling me the cars
23 are there. You okay?

24 STEVE: Yeah. Oh, I'm getting tired.
25 There, there, you know, there's people all over the

1 place here and --

2 JIM: You know -- Okay, the kids are out?
3 You know, you guys talk about it. Nobody's coming in
4 there.

5 STEVE: Okay.

6 JIM: You've got my word, it's solid, it's
7 1,000 percent absolute, okay?

8 STEVE: Okay.

9 JIM: I know, I know that everybody's
10 skittish, but, you know, we've just got to work on the
11 kids and we've got to let -- What are they saying on
12 the radio, 10 kids?

13 STEVE: Yeah. Wait. (Indiscernible voice
14 in background) David, he believes that you're fixing
15 to hit us tonight, he says.

16 JIM: No, we are not fixing to hit you.
17 That is not true.

18 STEVE: I mean, here's, here's this crazy
19 radio again, you know. I mean, where, where are they
20 getting that information?

21 JIM: You know, that is baloney. It's
22 rubbish.

23 STEVE: The news media was told to get out
24 of the way and to back way off, much farther back than
25 what they are even now. Why is that?

1 JIM: Nobody's coming in there. A thousand
2 percent absolute guarantee. I'm promising you, it's
3 true, okay? Do we got those kids? Okay. Steve?

4 STEVE: Yeah.

5 JIM: Let me check here. Hold on a second.

6 STEVE: These guys are being told to move
7 back a half-mile more even for safety. Safety of
8 what?

9 JIM: Okay. I'm sorry, for what?

10 STEVE: We're listening -- Right now on the
11 news all the press is, is being told to move back a
12 half-mile more for their own safety. What are they
13 talking about?

14 JIM: Yeah. Oh, well, what they're doing is
15 they don't want them in any of the -- They've been
16 crawling down our backs, all those reporters.
17 Crawling down our backs.

18 STEVE: Well, their comments are, you know,
19 for safety, that they don't get hurt and so forth. I
20 mean, wow.

21 JIM: Oh, yeah, but that's not -- That's
22 normal. We don't want them there. I mean, they've
23 raced in real fast early and, you know, now we're just
24 trying to get them back and clear the road. It's
25 nothing, trust me. And it means nothing. I'd like

1 to -- Tell you what, I'd like to move them back to
2 Arkansas, they're such a pain in the neck.

3 STEVE: I suppose.

4 JIM: And the policemen are just glad, you
5 know, you go out and the lieutenant says get rid of
6 all the reporters. What do you think the policeman
7 does? Tries to kick their butt back a mile, so don't
8 -- it's no big thing. Okay, look --

8 STEVE: Yeah.

9 JIM: -- I've got -- Hold on.

10 UNIDENTIFIED MALE SPEAKER: We've got the
11 kids. They're on their way back. We have another car
12 in to pick up two more.

12 JIM: Okay, we've got the kids.

13 STEVE: Okay.

14 JIM: They're safe.

15 STEVE: Okay.

16 JIM: They're on the way back here.

17 STEVE: Can you -- Can I get off the phone
18 and then have them call again? And we're working on
19 the other two.

19 JIM: All right.

20 STEVE: I'm going to go talk -- try to talk
21 to these mothers.

22 JIM: Okay.

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1 STEVE: And try to get them going then right
2 away. 'Cause right now they're trying to decide. If
3 I could encourage them somehow.

4 Hello, Jim?

5 JIM: Hold on, hold on a minute.

6 STEVE: Okay.

7 JIM: Hold on. They're, they're going to
8 tell me something from the car.

9 STEVE: All right.

10 [gap]

11 JIM: Okay, I'm sorry. Okay, I'll tell you
12 what, let's --

13 STEVE: Okay.

14 JIM: -- can we take, take a break?

15 STEVE: Oh, thanks.

16 JIM: Can you --

17 STEVE: I'm going to actually kind of lay
18 down here --

19 JIM: Okay.

20 STEVE: -- in just a minute.

21 JIM: Take a break. Can you call me here?

22 STEVE: Yeah. Well, so far, I haven't been
23 able to. I tried to call you about 10 minutes ago and
24 I'm still not able to get out.

25 JIM: Okay.

1 STEVE: What do you think? Is it -- Do you
2 think --
3 JIM: All right, hold on, let me check on
4 it.
5 STEVE: All right.
6 JIM: Okay.
7 STEVE: When, when should I call you?
8 JIM: Have you got that set up? (Talking to
9 someone else.) Okay, listen, Steve --
10 STEVE: Yeah.
11 JIM: -- you pick up the phone --
12 STEVE: Right.
13 JIM: -- and I'm going to have the
14 technician set it to ring my number.
15 STEVE: Okay. You mean like right now, just
16 to try it?
17 JIM: You want to try it right now?
18 STEVE: If you want.
19 JIM: Yeah.
20 STEVE: I mean, would that be the thing or -
21 - JIM: Yeah. Let's hang up, hang up.
22 STEVE: Okay.
23 JIM: Just leave it hang up for 15 seconds.
24 STEVE: All right.
25 JIM: And then pick it up and see if you get

1 me.

2 STEVE: Okay, I'll try.

3 * * * * *

4 STEVE: Hello?

5 HENRY: Steve?

6 STEVE: Yeah.

7 HENRY: This is Henry.

8 STEVE: Henry?

9 HENRY: Yeah.

10 STEVE: Oh, okay. Henry, it's not working.

11 HENRY: Did you dial?

12 STEVE: Yeah, I did.

13 HENRY: Don't dial. Just pick it up and --

14 STEVE: Oh, I see.

15 HENRY: -- just hold it.

16 STEVE: Just -- Okay.

17 HENRY: You don't have to dial at all, just
18 pick it up and just hold it.

19 STEVE: I see. Okay, let me try to -- Can I
20 try it again?

21 HENRY: Sure.

22 STEVE: Okay, thanks. I'll call you back.

23 * * * * *

24 STEVE: Hello?

25 HENRY: Hello, Steve?

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STEVE: Yes.

HENRY: This is Henry.

STEVE: Henry, how are you doing?

HENRY: Good. How are you doing?

STEVE: Well, I tried to call you back but I guess it didn't work.

HENRY: Okay. We have the kids here, but just before we get to the kids, we have the APC's that are going to be moving in.

STEVE: The, the which?

HENRY: The carriers that are moving into the general perimeter of the area. Remember, we talked about that earlier?

STEVE: Aren't there already three here or something?

HENRY: Well, those, those are the ones that we talked about, but they have never been -- they have never moved into position. They're going to be moving into position now. I want to let you know that so that --

STEVE: Okay.

HENRY: Okay?

STEVE: Yeah. They're moving three -- What are they called?

HENRY: APC's.

1 STEVE: -- APC's into position now that they
2 had mentioned, which they hadn't done yet. (Talking
3 to someone else.)

4 HENRY: But they have no -- Yeah, they don't
5 have the, they don't have the capability to shoot.

6 STEVE: Okay.

7 HENRY: Okay?

8 STEVE: Okay.

9 HENRY: The, the cannon and the muzzles were
10 removed, so everything should be fine.

11 STEVE: Okay. (Unidentified voice in
12 background not discernible.)

13 HENRY: Okay, and we have the kids --

14 STEVE: It's not Jim. Henry, what happened
15 to Jim then?

16 HENRY: He is working on -- I'm not sure
17 exactly what he's working on. He's working with the,
18 with the -- some of our brass on working out some of
19 the details. What we'd like to try to do is we'd like
20 to try to continue bringing kids out and any other
21 people that are ready to come out.

22 STEVE TO UNIDENTIFIED PARTY: Okay. So
23 they'd like to continue bringing the kids out and any
24 others that want to come out. He's talking to the
25 brass, I don't know about what. (Unidentified voice

1 in background not discernible.)

2 STEVE: He wants Jim to give him a call as
3 soon as the van is here, I guess.

4 HENRY: Okay. Is Jake -- I have Jake here,
5 or Jacob.

6 STEVE: Okay.

7 HENRY: Who would Jacob be talking to?

8 STEVE: Who would Jake be talking to? He
9 has Jake there, of course, and little Brian.

10 (Unidentified female voice in background not
11 discernible.)

12 [gap]

13 UNIDENTIFIED FEMALE SPEAKER: Jake?

14 HENRY: This is Henry. Who is this?

15 UNIDENTIFIED FEMALE SPEAKER: Can I have
16 Jake, please?

17 HENRY: Yes, you certainly may. Hold on
18 just a second.

19 JAKE: Hi.

20 UNIDENTIFIED FEMALE SPEAKER: Hi. I love
21 you. I love you. Tell Brian, okay? Tell Brian I
22 love him, okay? I've got to go. Put the other guy
23 back on the phone. I love you. Tell me, tell me you
24 love me.

25 JAKE: Bye.

1 UNIDENTIFIED FEMALE SPEAKER: Bye.

2 HENRY: Hello?

3 UNIDENTIFIED FEMALE SPEAKER: Put the guy
4 back on the phone.

5 HENRY: Huh?

6 UNIDENTIFIED FEMALE SPEAKER: Okay.

7 HENRY: Hello?
8 [gap]

9 HENRY: Hello?
10 [gap]

11 HENRY: Hello?
12 STEVE: Henry?

13 HENRY: Yes.
14 STEVE: So is Jim getting back on the phone
15 then or --

16 HENRY: Well, not just now. He's, you know,
17 he's talking to, to some of our --

18 STEVE: Well, can you have him call back as
19 soon as he's ready then, because the next two --

20 HENRY: We're ready now. If you're ready
21 to, to send two other people now, I'll, I'll work
22 those arrangements right now.

23 STEVE: Well, that's what David is hoping,
24 that, you know, to try --

25 HENRY: Okay, that's fine. We'll work it

1 right now.

2 STEVE: All right.

3 HENRY: Are you, are you ready to send them
4 right now?

5 STEVE: Well, he mentioned -- What, did you
6 want to talk to Jim about the next two that you have
7 or -- Yeah, he says him and Jim's got the deal going
8 and he wants to keep on talking with Jim, I guess.

9 HENRY: Well, I'd like to -- Can I talk to
10 him for just a second?

11 STEVE: Okay. He wants to talk to you.

12 MR. KORESH: Hello?

13 HENRY: How are you doing?

14 MR. KORESH: Kind of weak. How are you boys
15 doing.

16 HENRY: How do you feel now?

17 MR. KORESH: How do I feel now?

18 HENRY: Um-hum.

19 MR. KORESH: Just a little pain.

20 HENRY: Okay. What we'd like to do, David,
21 is we'd like to continue working as we were before.
22 We'd like to continue bringing out additional
23 children, as best as we can, with the same agreement
24 that we had before. And we'd like to work, if
25 possible, you know, everybody has a concern here about

1 you. We feel that, you know, that you're not really
2 taking care of yourself. We don't want anything to
3 happen to you. We'd like for you to consider coming
4 out yourself.

5 We want everybody to come out, we want
6 everybody to come out of this alive. We don't want
7 you to give up, and we feel that you are. That's a
8 great concern to, to all of us.

9 MR. KORESH: Well, like I was telling Jim,
10 you know, I told Jim to, to look into that Bible. I
11 told him to look into Revelation 4 and 5. I told him
12 to look into those seals. Now, if you look at the,
13 the fifth seal, if you look at the sixth seal, if you
14 look into Isaiah 13, if you look in Joel 2, if you
15 look into the back of Nahum, what's fixing to happen
16 has already been foretold. I teach seven seals.

17 Now, whatever that means, you know, I'd like
18 to talk with you guys in full. I'd like you to grab a
19 Bible, sit down and follow me word by word, see what
20 the ancients have foresaw. And that way we'd have a
21 better understanding. But I realize that, you know,
22 most of you are not ready for that. You've got your
23 own way of doing things.

24 HENRY: Well, one of the concerns that we
25 have, you know, that I feel that you may have is you

1 mentioned earlier that you felt that people were
2 calling you a cult leader, okay? If you give up, that
3 may in fact be the impression that everybody has,
4 whereas if you continue to fight in terms of trying to
5 save your life and continue to lead your people,
6 that's not the impression that will be created.

6 MR. KORESH: Look --

7 HENRY: You've been a family person, okay?
8 And your family --

9 MR. KORESH: Oh, I'm definitely a family
10 person.

11 HENRY: And your family needs you. And
12 everybody wants to see you come out of this alive.

12 MR. KORESH: Look, Henry --

13 HENRY: Everybody needs you. These people
14 need you, the kids need you.

15 MR. KORESH: You're not going to listen to
16 me, are you?

17 HENRY: I will listen to you.

18 MR. KORESH: Okay, you're listening now?

18 HENRY: Yes, I am.

19 MR. KORESH: Okay. The event that you're
20 now fixing to witness is you're fixing to see a
21 government, a government that's been blessed -- See,
22 there was an ancient empire called Babylon.

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1 HENRY: Um-hum.

2 MR. KORESH: Land of the Chaldeans. And
3 before Babylon ruled the then-known world, God had a
4 people that he brought out of Egypt and God had given
5 them laws and statutes and God had stated unto Israel,
6 which was a cult because they had one leader, Moses,
7 and one right-hand man, Aaron, and God says and
8 promised that if they will keep his laws he'll make
9 them the head of all nations. If they break his laws,
10 he'll scatter them amongst the nations and the nations
of the heathens will rule over them.

11 So for many, many hundreds of years God
12 forebores his people. But, finally, the days came
13 when Israel became worse than the heathens. So God
14 arose prophets such as Isaiah, Hosea, Obadiah,
15 Malachi, Zephaniah, Habakkuk, you know, these
16 prophets, Nahum. And God foretold in these prophets
17 how that they'd be scattered amongst the nations. In
18 the Book of Daniel, Daniel was shown, while under the
19 Chaldean captivity, he was shown that the nations of
20 the earth that shall rule over God's people will be
21 symbolized as one great image, and the image will be
head of gold, arms of silver, belly of brass, legs of
iron, feet part of iron and part of clay.

22 And Daniel says to the king, Nebuchadnezzar,

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1 the highest ruling position of the land in that day,
2 Daniel says thou oh, King, of this head of gold, and
3 after thee shall arise another kingdom inferior to
4 thee, and yet a third kingdom of brass. And then a
5 fourth kingdom, dreadful and terrible, it shall cometh
6 the whole world.

6 HENRY: Um-hum.

7 MR. KORESH: And then there shall be a
8 kingdom that shall be at the ten toes, partly strong
9 and partly broken. So when Rome split up under the
10 nomadic kingdoms, it fell into many different
11 kingdoms.

11 HENRY: Um-hum.

12 MR. KORESH: We know it as Europe. Now,
13 Daniel goes on to explain that while Europe is still
14 in existence, he goes on to say (indiscernible) behold
15 a stone, came and smote the image in the feet and they
16 had gold and silver and brass and iron, was all made
17 as the chaff of the summer threshing floors. Well,
18 this stone is the subject of which the Book of
19 Revelation talks about. It talks about that which
20 must be hereafter, that God will one day in the
21 future, in the end of the world, shall come and sit on
22 his throne in heaven, and there'll be one question
23 asked in heaven.
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1 The question is who is worthy to open this
2 book? The book is in the right hand of God. And to
3 lose these seven seals thereof, scripture clearly
4 teaches Christendom, that no man in heaven nor on
5 earth neither under earth was able to open and he
6 looked thereon.

6 HENRY: Um-hum.

7 MR. KORESH: But the lamb, the lamb is
8 symbolized as a lamb with seven eyes and seven horns.
9 You know, God creates things in seven days, doesn't
10 he?

11 HENRY: Um-hum.

12 MR. KORESH: Okay. There's only one many
13 who knows what that book teaches. But for the sake of
14 humanity, the acid test revolving around the subjects
15 in this book revolve around Christ in heaven, opening
16 the seals, and what is witnessed is a man on a white
17 horse, a man on a red horse, black and pale. Dead
18 souls under the altar described to God because of
19 their blood that's been shed, and then the time when
20 the sun and moon and stars will be darkened, the
21 heavens will part as a scroll and the great man,
22 mighty men, free men, bonded men shall cry to the
23 rocks and mountains to fall on them and hide them from
24 the face of him that sits on the throne and from the

1 | wrath of the lamb, but the great David's wrath has
2 | come.

3 | HENRY: Um-hum.

4 | MR. KORESH: So these subjects are
5 | mysteries, 'cause nobody really has a real thorough
6 | opinion to really know the real meanings of these
7 | things. But in Chapter 10, after the student of
8 | scripture is read and become familiar with the
9 | symbols, in Chapter 10, after talking about an army of
10 | 200 million that overthrow the world, it talks about a
11 | mighty angel coming down from heaven. And he has in
12 | his hand a little book and it's opened and seven
13 | thunders are uttered, seven thunders. And John was
14 | told that when there's time no longer this mystery of
15 | God, this revelation of Jesus Christ, the seven seals
16 | will be finished, as God has declared to his servants
17 | the prophets.

16 | HENRY: Um-hum.

17 | MR. KORESH: So in this 22nd chapter, after
18 | a person takes the time to read these things, it's
19 | very clear, the statement, Christ says I Jesus have
20 | sent my angel to testify to these things in the
21 | churches. I am the root and the offspring of David.
22 | Now, Ancient David was a great king, wasn't he?

22 | HENRY: Um-hum.

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1 MR. KORESH: He's the one that took his
2 little sling stone and slew the great giant Goliath.

3 HENRY: Right.

4 MR. KORESH: Yeah, okay. So what happened
5 was he says behold, I come quickly. My reward is with
6 me, to give it to every man according as his work
7 shall be.

8 HENRY: Um-hum.

9 MR. KORESH: Now, when Christ comes, the
10 question is going to be what did the father give him
11 that no other man in heaven was worthy to receive? No
12 man was worthy. A book, right?

13 HENRY: Um-hum.

14 MR. KORESH: God gave him a book, a
15 revelation of himself that the father claims he's the
16 author of this book. And when the lamb comes, he's
17 going to bring this book and mankind is supposed to
18 find out that it is the Bible, the Bible which the
19 prophets of God having spoken by the spirit that God
20 gave them, having volumed a testament in regards to
21 those events that must be fulfilled in the latter
22 days. Now, in Revelation 13, John witnesses in
23 regards to the seventh seal, John sees a beast.

24 This beast has a head like a lion, a body
25 like a leopard, feet of a bear. In Daniel 7, Daniel

1 foretold that the empires of Babylon -- Persia, Greece
2 and Rome would be symbolized, Babylon as a lion, --
3 Persia as a bear, Greece as a leopard. And the fourth
4 beast, he said, would devour all the three beasts
5 before it and conquer the world. Now, that was Rome.

6 Daniel also says in the days of this kingdom they
7 will kill the prince of the covenant. They could
8 change God's times and God's laws and place
9 abomination to make desolate false religion. We know
10 the only true religion is the religion of God.

11 HENRY: Um-hum.

12 MR. KORESH: Now, Christ died during the
13 times of Rome and on the cross. Very clearly, it's
14 written in the gospel records. He said father,
15 forgive them for they know not what they do.

16 HENRY: Um-hum.

17 MR. KORESH: And then he said into thy hand
18 I commit my spirit. And the hand of God has a book,
19 the word. By the word of God, God made heaven and
20 earth. And by his word, there was prophets. The
21 events that you're now witnessing are taking place.
22 Now, what is taking place? Well, in the Book of
23 Micah, it says in that day they shall gather together
24 and they shall say let thine be defiled that they know
25 not the thoughts of the Lord, neither do they

1 understand his counsel.

2 All of the prophets through the Book of
3 Nahum, it talks about Messiah, it talks about, well,
4 for instance, to make it real simple, Christ says he
5 has the key of David in revelation. So in the Book of
6 the Psalms, for instance Psalms 2, David sees a vision
7 of the future, of a confrontation between man and
8 man's law --

8 HENRY: Um-hum.

9 MR. KORESH: -- and God and God's law.

10 HENRY: Um-hum.

11 MR. KORESH: Now, Revelation 13 tells us
12 that there's a lamb-like beast that'll rise up, having
13 two horns, and it'll speak as a dragon. Now, we've
14 got to identify what great empire arose up after
15 Europe that's a great empire that's lamb-like or
16 Christian, but yet doesn't really tell the truth.
17 Well, the only great empire we've known is the United
18 States of America. Now, back to Psalms 2, the psalm
19 says why do the heathen rage? You know, the heathen
20 don't know God.

21 HENRY: Um-hum.

22 MR. KORESH: They don't know his word.

23 HENRY: Um-hum.

24 MR. KORESH: And they get angry.

25

1 HENRY: Um-hum.

2 MR. KORESH: It says, and the people imagine
3 vain things, for the leaders of the earth and the
4 rulers take counsel together against the Lord --

5 HENRY: Um-hum.

6 MR. KORESH: -- and against his anointed.

7 HENRY: Um-hum.

8 MR. KORESH: That's Christ, you see?

9 HENRY: Um-hum.

10 MR. KORESH: Saying let us break his bands
11 asunder. Now, what are the seven bands that Christ
12 promises to bring when he comes again? The seven
13 seals, right?

14 HENRY: Um-hum.

15 MR. KORESH: But Zachariah and the other
16 prophets say that the world will not regard these
17 messages of mercy. They have no interest in being
18 instructed by anyone but themselves. Now, they say
19 let us break his bands asunder, let us cast his cords
20 away from us. But scripture says, which is taking
21 place right now, it says that he that sits in the
22 heavens -- That's the father, you see?

23 HENRY: Um-hum.

24 MR. KORESH: -- shall laugh, for the Lord
25 shall have them, the heathen, in confusion. See, the

1 heathen don't know what they're doing. And this time
2 they can't be forgiven because this time they
3 willfully reject the subject which so plainly has been
4 laid in the Book of Revelation, a subject which
5 everyone is to be very familiarized with for the
6 latter days. And yet, they're to understand by
7 earnest study that these things will remain a mystery
8 until Christ comes again.

8 HENRY: Um-hum.

9 MR. KORESH: To reveal these mysteries.

10 HENRY: Um-hum.

11 MR. KORESH: So the heathen and their
12 tactics in dealing with a person based upon rumors and
13 based upon their laws, they fail to understand that
14 God also has a law and God also has a kingdom and God
15 also has a key. So what takes place, it says, then
16 shall the Lord speak unto them in his wrath. That's
17 what happens during the sixth seal.

17 HENRY: Um-hum.

18 MR. KORESH: The sun and moon and stars is
19 darkened, the heaven departs as a scroll, and the
20 great men of the earth cry to the rocks and mountains
21 to hide them from the face of the reality that they
22 would not know aforetime what God said will be. So
23 they end up fulfilling prophecy, not knowing what side
24

1 they're doing. But to the wise, when God speaks in
2 his wrath, they already know of the events. And it
3 says yet have I set my king up on my holy hill of
4 Zion.

5 So irrespective of what attitude the heathen
6 may take against the truth of the seven seals or the
7 man that is trying to teach the seven seals,
8 irrespective, God's kingdom, the stone, God himself is
9 going to intervene and he's going to hit the image in
10 the feet and it's all going to blow away, and God's
11 going to take the jurisdiction and power from all the
12 great men of the earth and all that the prophets have
13 spoken is to be fulfilled.

14 HENRY: Um-hum.

15 MR. KORESH: Now, the psalm continues to say
16 I will declare the decree, the Lord has said unto me,
17 thou art my son, this day have I begotten thee. So we
18 know the anointed one is Christ, don't we? Christ is
19 the Son of God in Psalms 2, right?

20 HENRY: Um-hum.

21 MR. KORESH: And it says the father says to
22 the son ask of me and I will give thee the heathen for
23 thine inheritance and the other most parts of the
24 earth for thy possession, for thou shalt dash the
25 heathen to pieces with a rod of iron and shall break

1 | them as a potter's vessel. Now, that's pretty bad,
2 | isn't it?

3 | HENRY: Um-hum.

4 | MR. KORESH: I mean, nobody wants to be
5 | hurt, do they?

6 | HENRY: No, really.

7 | MR. KORESH: So that's why in Psalms 2 the
8 | subject is clear, the mission of the lamb, the
9 | anointed one, is to teach the seals, okay?

10 | HENRY: Um-hum.

11 | MR. KORESH: Now, the reason why the
12 | prophecy is written is because it continues to say
13 | now, therefore, be wise, ye rulers of the world, be
14 | instructed, ye judges of the earth. Serve the Lord
15 | with fear and rejoice with trembling. Kiss the son,
16 | least he be angry, and ye perish in the way when his
17 | wrath is kindled but a little. Now, I'm not mad at
18 | you guys, you know.

19 | HENRY: Well, and we're not mad at you,
20 | either.

21 | MR. KORESH: Well, but your show of arms is
22 | definitely bigger than my show of arms. So in Psalms
23 | 18, the psalm has made very plain when it says I will
24 | love the Lord for he is my rock and my salvation, my
25 | buckler and the horn of my salvation. It says I will

1 call upon him so shall I be delivered from my enemies,
2 for they were too strong for me. And the day of my
3 calamity, and this is a calamity, really, they
4 prevented me. And then it goes on to talk about a
5 terrible event that takes place afterwards, because,
6 you know, you all guys are too big for me.

7 You know, your laws are more numerous than
8 the Ten Commandments, you know, your weapons are
9 bigger, your forces are stronger.

10 HENRY: Um-hum.

11 MR. KORESH: You know? But not really. You
12 see, not really. You know, Elijah in his day, the
13 king of Israel was having to face the Moabites and the
14 Hittites and they were outnumbered. But what Elijah
15 said was they that be with us are more than they that
16 be with them because unbeknown to the forces of the
17 heathen who were so boistering of their superior power
18 they did not see the invisible forces of God, the
19 angels of God, you know, just like in the days of
20 ancient Hezekiah.

21 HENRY: Um-hum.

22 MR. KORESH: When the Assyrian armies came
23 into Judea, they kept saying to Hezekiah now do not
24 deceive your people, but have all of them come out to
25 me and we'll take you to a land likened to your own

1 and the land flow with milk and honey. Don't let
2 Hezekiah deceive you saying that your God will deliver
3 you. Anyway, what happened was as Hezekiah had
4 listened to the Prophet Isaiah, Hezekiah had repented
5 his sins, asking God for forgiveness. And Hezekiah
6 prayed to God, saying Lord God of heaven, thou art the
7 only true and living God and all the gods of the earth
8 are idols and they are no gods.

9 Now, we've come to the birth and there's no
10 strength to bring forth, so please save us and deliver
11 us that all the world may know that there is a true
12 and living God is Israel. So what took place was, is
13 that that night the angel of the Lord went forth and
14 smote 185,000 of their warriors and they perished.
15 You see, we all know Christ is coming soon.

16 HENRY: Um-hum.

17 MR. KORESH: That gospel's been preached for
18 a long time, hasn't it?

19 HENRY: Um-hum. It certainly has.

20 MR. KORESH: Yes. And everyone is supposed
21 to be like Christ, aren't they?

22 HENRY: Right.

23 MR. KORESH: Okay. But the question is is
24 the world ready for the coming of Christ in glory?
25 Well, God never said he would come in glory the second

1 time. The scriptures tell us, as the Gospel of Peter
2 tells us, look for the salvation that shall be brought
3 to you in the end of the world at the revelation of
4 Jesus Christ. We find in Hebrews Paul tries to
5 explain to the Christian church that we who are of the
6 spirit dwell in the heavenly sanctuary, a sanctuary
7 where the man of this world can never contaminate,
8 they cannot pollute it, they cannot contaminate it,
9 because it revolves around God who speaks through his
word, the seven seals.

10 And, you know, like I say, unless we fear
11 God, unless we fear his word --

12 HENRY: Um-hum.

13 MR. KORESH: -- you know, the appearance of
14 the thing, just like 2,000 years ago, who really
believed that Christ was Messiah?

15 HENRY: That's right.

16 MR. KORESH: You know?

17 HENRY: That's right.

18 MR. KORESH: And why did he have to die? He
19 says father, I pleadeth that thy remove this cup from
20 me. But if it be not removed except I drink it, not
21 my will but they will be done. Taken from Psalm 60,
22 where it says Lord, thou has shown thy people hard
things. Well, the seven seals are pretty hard things.

1 Thou has made us to drink the wine of astonishment.
2 Psalm 75, Messiah is talking to the, to the heathen
3 and he says I said to the fools do not foolishly, and
4 to the wicked lift not up your horn on high, speak not
5 with a stiff neck, for know that promotion comes
6 neither from the east nor the west nor the south, by
7 the north in Orion -- past Orion in heaven in the
8 northern part of the universe, the father has exalted
9 and promoted Christ above all heaven, hasn't he?

9 HENRY: Um-hum.

10 MR. KORESH: Right? Okay. It says in Psalm
11 75 -- We're having a lot of babies crying around here
12 now.

12 HENRY: Are they okay?

13 MR. KORESH: I guess they're -- Why are the
14 babies crying so much? (Unidentified female voice in
15 background not discernible.) Yeah, can you give them
16 some bottle or some, some breast or something?
17 (Unidentified female voice in background not
18 discernible.) Please? Yeah, she wants some milk.
19 Okay. Anyway, so we're stuck in a corner right now,
20 my friend.

20 HENRY: How do you feel right now?

21 MR. KORESH: Well --

22 HENRY: Physically?

23

1 MR. KORESH: In Psalms -- I don't know, it's
2 like this. Christ says he has the key of David,
3 right?

4 HENRY: Um-hum.

5 MR. KORESH: He can open and no one can
6 shut?

7 HENRY: Um-hum.

8 MR. KORESH: It's taken from the prophecy of
9 Isaiah 22, for God promises to overthrow the ungodly
10 of his land. He's going to take away the power of the
11 ungodly and reestablish his kingdom.

12 HENRY: Uh-huh.

13 MR. KORESH: He says in that day I'll rise
14 up my servant -- Yeah, he says Eliakim, which means
15 God'll raise up Eliakim. It says on that day I'll lay
16 upon his shoulder the key of David and he shall open
17 and none shall shut, and he shall shut and none shall
18 open. And it says they shall lay upon him all the
19 glory of his father's house. Now, unless you know who
20 Eliakim is, you won't know who his father is. But it
21 says you shall lay upon him the offspring and the
22 issue.

23 But, you know what that is. That's
24 children, isn't it? Offspring?

25 HENRY: Um-hum.

1 ropes.

2 HENRY: No. No. That's not possible.

3 MR. KORESH: They're right up there.

4 HENRY: We made an agreement. They can't --
5 Nobody can be there. Make sure. Ask again.

6 MR. KORESH: Steve? Like I say, I feel so
7 sorry for you guys.

8 HENRY: What we want, what we're hoping to
9 do --

10 MR. KORESH: I know what you want, but you
11 don't understand. Look at how much -- Look, did Jim
12 Jones ever get this kind of slander? Look --

13 HENRY: We don't want anybody -- We
14 certainly don't want you to be slandered.

15 MR. KORESH: Listen, let me explain again.

16 HENRY: Okay.

17 MR. KORESH: Okay, look, in Psalms 45, God's
18 the one speaking. And when you come up hither to my
19 church -- See, it's the spirit and the world, the
20 world is bad. There is no temple on God, to be
21 honest. The temple of God must be in you and it must
22 be in truth. Spirit and in truth, okay? When you
23 come up hither, you'll see God on a throne. That's
24 what's written, isn't it? When you read things, you
25 don't really see it, you just see it in your mind,

1 don't you?

2 HENRY: Um-hum.

3 MR. KORESH: And our mind must be renewed
4 with the knowledge of God, correct?

5 HENRY: Um-hum.

6 MR. KORESH: That's why God has chosen to
7 use scripture as a means for men to see his mind.

8 HENRY: Um-hum.

9 MR. KORESH: So in the 45th Psalm, when you
10 come up hither and you can look at the father
11 spiritually and you hear the 45th Psalm speak, it says
12 my heart -- See, the father gives me the book, right,
13 and opens the first seal about the white horse?

14 HENRY: Um-hum.

15 MR. KORESH: So then I show you Psalms 45.
16 It says my heart is indicting a good manner. I speak
17 of things which I have made touching my king. You
18 know who the father's king is, don't you? It's
19 Christ.

20 HENRY: Um-hum.

21 MR. KORESH: It says my tongue is the pen of
22 a ready writer.

23 HENRY: Uh-huh.

24 MR. KORESH: Now, how does God want to
25 speak? He wrote a book, didn't he?

1 HENRY: Um-hum.

2 MR. KORESH: That's why his tongue is the
3 pen of a ready writer.

4 HENRY: Um-hum.

5 MR. KORESH: He says to the son, he says
6 thou are fairer than the children of men. So that's
7 his opinion isn't it?

8 HENRY: Yes.

9 MR. KORESH: He says grace is poured into
10 thy lips. Now, how are men required to be saved in
11 the latter days? Who's going to come? And what's he
12 going to teach? The seven seals, right?

13 HENRY: Um-hum.

14 MR. KORESH: And who gave him the seven
15 seals to teach? The father, right?

16 HENRY: Um-hum.

17 MR. KORESH: And all that receive his
18 testimony will learn the prophets and all the books
19 pertaining to these seals and they'll receive grace --

20 HENRY: Um-hum.

21 MR. KORESH: -- unmerited favor for
22 salvation.

23 HENRY: Um-hum.

24 MR. KORESH: So, therefore, have God blessed
25 thee forever. But then it says gird thy sword upon

1 thy thigh, O most mighty, with thy glory and thy
2 majesty. And in that majesty ride prosperously
3 because of truth. Now, what did he ride? What does
4 the king ride? In the first seal what does he ride?

5 HENRY: The white horse?

6 MR. KORESH: He rides the white horse.

7 HENRY: Um-hum.

8 MR. KORESH: So they're on the roof for sure
9 now, right?

10 HENRY: No, they are not on the roof.
11 Nobody is even close. Listen, the agreements that we
12 made, David, the agreements that Jim made with you all
13 stand. We are not --

14 MR. KORESH: Well, why, why are people
15 jumping all around on the roof?

16 HENRY: There is nobody on your roof. There
17 is nobody -- There is --

18 MR. KORESH: Let's get back to the psalm
19 then, so you can get a better picture of the way I
20 think, okay? So in Psalms 45, it says with thy glory
21 and majesty, ride prosperously because of truth. Now,
22 what is the truth that the father gave him that says
23 he's going to ride prosperously? The seven seals,
24 right?

25 HENRY: Um-hum.

1 MR. KORESH: Okay. Meekness and
2 righteousness, it says thy right hand shall teach thee
3 terrible things. Why? Because the father gave me
4 this book.

5 HENRY: Um-hum.

6 MR. KORESH: The father gave me the book and
7 it talks terrible things, what's going to happen to
8 the heathen that resist, resist against the will of
9 God, the word of God.

10 HENRY: Um-hum.

11 MR. KORESH: Okay. Finally, it says thy
12 arrows are sharp in the heart of the king's enemies.
13 I mean, you know, what arrows? Does he have a bow in
14 the first seal? He does, doesn't he?

15 HENRY: Um-hum.

16 MR. KORESH: Okay. Whereby the people fall
17 under thee. This says thy throne O God is forever and
18 forever. The (indiscernible) is a right scepter. Thy
19 love is righteousness and hate is wickedness.
20 Therefore, God, thy God have anointed you with the oil
21 gladness above thy fellows. So is Christ the son of
22 God?

23 HENRY: Yes.

24 MR. KORESH: And he's God, isn't he?

25 HENRY: Um-hum.

1 MR. KORESH: Okay. Now, it goes on to talk
2 about his marriage. It says upon my right hand is
3 stand the queen in gold of Ophir.

4 [gap]

5 MR. KORESH: They're coming in on us.

6 HENRY: No, nobody is there. I promise you
7 nobody is there. We -- Every agreement that we made
8 before stands.

9 MR. KORESH: Go up and see.

10 HENRY: Go ahead and send somebody, because
11 there's going to be nobody there. There's going to be
12 nobody there. I can promise you that. Like, you
13 know, just like you, we're also servants of the Lord.
14 We're not your enemies. We're not.

15 MR. KORESH: Well, if you --
