21 |           DAVID: Okay. I'm sorry. What's your name,

23 |           HENRY: Henry.

24 |           DAVID: Henry, I'm sorry.

25 |           HENRY: That's okay, David.



1 arrange something to where we all come out.

2 HENRY: Okay. I will work on exactly that.

3 And you telling me, David, I'm trusting you. And I'm  
4 putting myself totally in your hands that if I can  
5 arrange to have you do that that everybody will come  
6 out.

7 DAVID: What I'm saying is is this. I'm  
8 saying that once I'm able to present this if you  
9 individuals, if you don't cut me off and don't, you  
10 know, don't do like what's been happening so far,  
11 right, where everyone cuts me off. You know, hitting  
12 me from the side with the questions that do not regard  
13 the points I'm trying to make then we'll come out.

14 HENRY: You're telling me --

15 DAVID: I'm telling you --

16 HENRY: You are telling me and you're -- and  
17 I'm holding you to your word that --

18 DAVID: Is that --

19 HENRY: -- if I can make arrangements to  
20 have you talk to the radio and what I will do is I  
21 will work on, on have you talking to, to a radio --  
22 I'll tell you what. We will -- what I'll do is I'll  
23 try to work on getting you something totally and  
24 completely different from anything that you've had  
25 before in such a fashion that, that we can present

1 this, and it will go out to a lot of radio stations.

2 How's that? Would you be willing to make a tape?

3 DAVID: A tape? It's better if I give it  
4 live. I mean, you know, I don't need to make a tape.

5 Because, you know, like I say I'd like to hear it.

6 HENRY: Okay.

7 DAVID: Make sure it's going, you know,  
8 nationwide or whatever.

9 HENRY: Okay. Could you come out and do  
10 that outside?

11 DAVID: I can't move.

12 HENRY: We'll --

13 DAVID: I can do it on the phone --

14 HENRY: -- we'll carry you out.

15 DAVID: No.

16 HENRY: I'm saying if, if you want to do it.

17 I'm --

18 DAVID: No, see, there again we can't do  
19 that.

20 HENRY: I'm, I'm -- I was just asking --

21 DAVID: On, on --

22 HENRY: -- if you wanted to do it that way.

23 If you don't, okay.

24 DAVID: On the telephone.

25 HENRY: On a telephone?

1                   DAVID: On the telephone.

2                   HENRY: Okay.

3                   DAVID: And you know --

4                   HENRY: Let me work on that.

5                   DAVID: Okay, then get back with me. Okay?

6                   HENRY: Okay.

7                   DAVID: Because I (indiscernible) I'm losing  
by --

8                   HENRY: Okay. Let me just ask you  
9 something. We were working on getting some more kids  
10 out. Are you ready to send a couple more kids out?

11                   DAVID: Well, let's, let's work on this now.  
12 And because this avenue like I told Jim, I said Jim,  
13 you know, because he's supposed to be still working  
with me. I -- what did he do now?

14                   HENRY: Well, he's, you know, he's been  
15 forever. We're going to have to give him a little bit  
16 of a break. You understand that?

17                   DAVID: Yeah.

18                   HENRY: Okay. And I'll -- and I promise to  
19 work with you in the same fashion that he has. Now  
20 let me, let me just propose a couple of things to you.  
You consider them, okay?

21                   DAVID: Okay.

22                   HENRY: One of the things that I want to  
23

1 propose is if we make a tape recording, one of the  
2 things that we ensure is that nobody is going to  
3 interrupt you with crazy questions or comments or  
4 anything like that.

5           DAVID: Okay. What we'll do then is we'll,  
6 we'll -- maybe we can make a tape and a video. And  
7 then maybe you can play that.

8           HENRY: Now do you have, do you have a  
9 video?

10          DAVID: Yes, we have high eight.

11          HENRY: Okay. Well, why don't you start  
12 working on that, and I will start working on it from  
13 this end.

14          DAVID: Okay. All right, then we'll do  
15 something.

16          HENRY: Okay. Now I'm going to a little --

17          DAVID: That way at least you'll know where  
18 I'm coming from.

19          HENRY: I'm going to need a little bit of  
20 time so that I can, so that I can work on this. In  
21 the meantime, can we get --

22          DAVID: Okay.

23          HENRY: -- some more children out or do  
24 you --

25          DAVID: Let's just hold off until we get



1 this spot figured out, all right?

2 HENRY: Okay.

3 DAVID: I need, I need some -- see, I gave,  
4 I gave Jim some money, right?

5 HENRY: Yes. We have the money here.

6 DAVID: And he was going to pick me up a  
7 phone, because our phone's really pretty bad. A lot  
8 of people use them and we needed, we needed a better  
9 line. Okay? Because you know we're -- I mean well, I  
10 can't move, so we're long extension.

11 HENRY: Okay.

12 DAVID: And so if we can get a new line and  
13 a phone from, you know, like I said I was going to pay  
14 for it.

15 HENRY: Okay.

16 DAVID: Then we'd have better reception.

17 HENRY: Okay. But do this for me, because I  
18 need to have these people, these bosses, you know,  
19 they're always real pushy. You understand that?

20 DAVID: I realize --

21 HENRY: Okay.

22 DAVID: -- you got a lot of chiefs there.

23 HENRY: Right. Send me two more kids while  
24 we're working on this so that they can, you know --

25 DAVID: I'll do that.

1 HENRY: Okay. Okay.

2 DAVID: Okay?

3 HENRY: So what I'll do is whenever you --

4 DAVID: I'm glad you have a concern for the  
5 children like I do because I have --

6 HENRY: Yes. Okay. What we will do is I  
7 will start working on this, okay. And it's either  
8 going to be a video and the audio, or at least we're  
9 going to get radio. But I'll get you something. Or  
10 I'll go to work on getting you something. Okay?

11 DAVID: Yeah. Let's, let's -- like I say  
12 you'll, then you'll know, understand where I'm coming  
13 from.

14 HENRY: Okay. But I want you to understand,  
15 okay, I'm going to hold you this. You're telling me  
16 that --

17 DAVID: I --

18 HENRY: -- that you're going to send  
19 everybody out. I'm going to want everybody out.

20 DAVID: Okay.

21 HENRY: Okay.

22 DAVID: Do what you can though.

23 HENRY: Okay. But send me a couple of kids.  
24 I'm going to send a car to pick up the two kids.

25 DAVID: You got the van there now?

1 HENRY: I'll send it, I'll send the van out.  
2 Can we get the van over there?

3 DAVID: Yeah, well, give me a call or --

4 HENRY: Okay. The van is going there right  
5 now.

6 DAVID: Okay.

7 HENRY: And in the meantime, I'll work on  
8 this and I'll call you back in a little bit.

9 DAVID: Okay. Thanks.

10 HENRY: Thank you, David.

11 DAVID: Bye.

12 HENRY: Bye-bye.

15 UNIDENTIFIED MALE SPEAKER: Oh, good.

17 STEVE: Hello?

18 HENRY: Hello, David?

19 STEVE: This is Steve. Is this Henry?

20 HENRY: Yes, Steve.

21 STEVE: Henry -- do you want to talk here?

22 DAVID: Okay. You ready?

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1 HENRY: The car is ready to pick up the  
2 kids.  
3 DAVID: Okay.  
4 HENRY: Do you have the kids ready?  
5 DAVID: Yeah.  
6 HENRY: Okay.  
7 DAVID: Why don't -- (screaming in pain) --  
8 HENRY: Are you okay? Are you okay?  
9 DAVID: Oh, God. I'm back.  
10 HENRY: Are you okay?  
11 DAVID: I'm bleeding again.  
12 HENRY: Geez.  
13 DAVID: I coughed. Wait a minute.  
14 (Groaning.) Oh, boy. It got me by surprise.  
15 HENRY: Um.  
16 DAVID: Got the one hole in the front, one  
17 in the back. And when I -- if I laugh or if I cough  
18 it starts it up again.  
19 HENRY: Sure.  
20 DAVID: (Groaning.) Boy. Okay.  
21 HENRY: Which kids are you going --  
22 DAVID: When -- okay --  
23 HENRY: -- are you going to send down?  
24 Would you be interested in sending out --  
25 DAVID: Jamie. His name's Jamie and Joshua.

1 HENRY: Who's, who -- how old are they?

2 DAVID: Well, Jamie's an invalid. So you  
3 have to be -- you got a special chair and all that.

4 HENRY: Okay.

5 DAVID: The social workers here in town  
6 they -- oh, man. They know him. And Joshua, he's, I  
7 guess he's about -- how old's Joshua now, 6? How  
8 old's Joshy?

9 UNIDENTIFIED FEMALE SPEAKER: Seven.  
10 Joshua's 7.

11 DAVID: He's turned 6.

12 UNIDENTIFIED FEMALE SPEAKER: Joshua's 7.

13 DAVID: Oh, he's 7 now? Okay. He's 7.

14 HENRY: And Jamie?

15 DAVID: And Jamie he's --

16 UNIDENTIFIED FEMALE SPEAKER: Nine. Nine.

17 DAVID: He's 9 but he's like 3, you know, 4.

18 HENRY: Okay.

19 DAVID: Okay?

20 HENRY: Are they your kids?

21 DAVID: No.

22 HENRY: Okay.

23 DAVID: Okay. We'll send a little, little  
24 paper with them, you know, that tells you their  
25 closest to kin and, and all that stuff, okay?

1 HENRY: Okay.

2 DAVID: (Groaning.)

3 HENRY: I presented, I presented the idea.  
4 And, and so far it's looking, you know, pretty good.  
5 But we, we have a bit of a problem in terms of the  
6 time. Can you make a -- do you have something that  
7 you could work with so that you can make an audiotape?  
8 Do you have a recorder?

9 DAVID: Yeah, but I just can't get to it.  
10 And it's, it's sophisticated.

11 HENRY: They can't bring it over to you?

12 DAVID: We can't, we can't do a little  
13 video?

14 HENRY: Well, see, what we're hoping to do  
15 and, and because this is a serious situation, okay.

16 DAVID: Yeah, it's very serious.

17 HENRY: We're hoping to, to get this to a  
18 serious Christian broadcasting network type national,  
19 you know, broadcasting network that would, that would  
20 give us maybe, you know, nationwide coverage on this  
21 thing.

22 DAVID: Uh-huh.

23 HENRY: And if we talk in terms of a video,  
24 by the time we get it from here to, to --

25 DAVID: To have it edited, transferred over

1 to --

2 HENRY: Yeah.

3 DAVID: -- to 10 -- is it 10 -- I forgot  
4 what millimeter, 30, 33, 35 millimeter. Anyway, yeah.

5 HENRY: Um-hum. Um-hum.

6 DAVID: I know what you're saying.

7 HENRY: So if, if -- do you -- if we could,  
8 if we could --

9 DAVID: Steve, how many, how many -- do you  
10 know where -- do you think we could break down the  
11 studio and bring some, you know, take out of the rack  
12 and bring some (indiscernible) and stuff recorder in.  
13 Because we need to do an unedited, high fidelity  
14 tape. Okay.

15 STEVE: Get Greg.

16 DAVID: Okay.

17 STEVE: Greg would know how to do it,  
18 wouldn't he?

19 DAVID: Yeah. I can't get down there to it  
20 so. Yeah, that's what we'll do.

21 HENRY: Okay. And you know how everybody's  
22 concerned about money. And I mean everybody is, has a  
23 concern. Can you do me a favor, and can you make it,  
24 you know, like in such a fashion that, that in order  
25 to avoid their wanting to chop it up or to play part

1 of it or whatever --

2 DAVID: How much, how much does it cost  
3 their air time?

4 HENRY: Well, that's the whole thing.

5 DAVID: Per minute?

6 HENRY: That's the whole thing. You know,  
7 so keep --

8 DAVID: How much does it cost?

9 HENRY: I don't have any idea. But  
10 there's --

11 DAVID: Give me the price and I'll pay it.

12 HENRY: Oh, I don't have any idea. I have  
13 no idea. But what I'd like to do is I would like for  
14 you to make it as concise and as brief as you can make  
15 it so that we can be in a situation where your word  
16 will, will get out. Nothing will be chopped off.  
17 Your message will go out as you want it, you know.

18 DAVID: Well, like I say remember I'll even  
19 buy the time. You know?

20 HENRY: Well, you know, we don't need --

21 DAVID: We will fund it.

22 HENRY: -- we don't need that. We -- what  
23 we want is we want you to -- you were given your  
24 cooperation, and that's what we promised what we would  
25 do. So I want to live up to my part of it. Yeah, I



1 don't need your money. But I do need --

2 (Touch tone sounds.)

3 DAVID: Hello? Hello?

4 HENRY: Jesus.

5 DAVID: Hello?

6 HENRY: Hello.

7 DAVID: Hello. What's going on now?

8 HENRY: Who was that?

9 DAVID: Yeah. (Unidentified voice in  
background not discernible.)

10 HENRY: What -- you know, what I, what I  
11 would like to see is I would like for you to, to  
12 prepare yourself in such a fashion that you get your  
message out and --

13 DAVID: Okay, wait a second.

14 HENRY: Now, I'm a little bit confused about  
15 one thing. Okay? I, I know that you're, that you are  
16 a man of your word number one. And number two, I know  
17 that you know what you're talking about in terms of  
18 theology. I'm not as -- I'm not nearly versed as you  
19 are, okay? But one of the concerns that I have is I  
20 am taking you to your word and that is that you're  
21 going to come out and that everybody is going to come  
22 out and this thing is going to be resolved without  
anybody --

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1                   DAVID: Getting hurt.

2                   HENRY: Getting hurt. That includes you.

3                   DAVID: Except for what crimes we have to  
4 pay for what we've committed that is that. The world  
5 so speaks.

6                   HENRY: And that includes you. Am I correct  
7 in assuming that --

8                   DAVID: No, it's not an assumption. It's a  
9 fact.

10                   HENRY: Okay. Everybody's going to come  
11 out, and everybody's going to be fine, and there's  
12 going to be no shooting, and there's going to be  
13 nothing to, to cause anybody to do anything to hurt  
14 you. I don't want anybody to hurt you. Am I, am I  
15 correct in my assumption?

16                   DAVID: You're correct on that.

17                   HENRY: Okay.

18                   DAVID: So let's, let -- I got to start  
19 editing this and, and you got the van down there for  
20 the children, right?

21                   HENRY: Yes.

22                   DAVID: Okay. Be sure and tell them we're  
23 coming then, all right?

24                   HENRY: Okay. Now, now listen, listen to  
25 what I'm going to tell you. I don't know if this van

1 is going to stop in exactly the same place as the  
2 other van. It's going to be real close. The only  
3 reason that I'm telling you that is whoever's going to  
4 take the kids there, you know, these are two new  
5 people, because we've had a changing of a shift, okay?

6 So --

7 DAVID: Okay. But just at the water  
8 towers --

9 HENRY: Right. Right.

10 DAVID: -- like it was before.

11 HENRY: But, but I mean, you know, they may  
12 be 20 feet back or, or 5 feet forward from where they  
13 parked before. I don't want her to get a concern,  
14 whoever it is that's taking them there well, it's,  
15 they didn't park in exactly the same place.

16 Nothing's --

17 DAVID: Okay.

18 HENRY: -- going to happen other than what  
19 has happened before.

20 DAVID: You got a radio communication,  
21 right?

22 HENRY: Right.

23 DAVID: Okay. Like I say, we'll get the  
24 kids ready and --

25 HENRY: Right.

1                   DAVID: Are they down there now?

2                   HENRY: Yes. Now what, what we're going to  
3 need is I would like to try to start trying to find  
4 you medical help.

5                   DAVID: No, not yet.

6                   HENRY: Okay.

7                   DAVID: Let's get the other done.

8                   HENRY: Yes, we'll get -- no, I mean that's  
9 fine. And I understand that. And I'm not saying, you  
10 know, I'm going to send anybody in there. I want  
11 start preparing to have something ready for you after  
12 you do your tape and all of that. Okay?

13                   DAVID: Okie doke.

14                   HENRY: Okay.

15                   DAVID: Okay. Now I need to -- going to  
16 send the kids.

17                   HENRY: Okay.

18                   DAVID: He's going to get the equipment set  
19 up.

20                   HENRY: Okay.

21                   DAVID: I'm going to drink a little orange  
22 juice, get my breath up a bit. When I, when I cough,  
23 oh, man. I'll tell you. Anyway never mind.

24                   HENRY: How much time do you think you have?

25                   DAVID: Well, see it's, it's like I get, I

1 get renewed.

2 HENRY: Uh-huh.

3 DAVID: You know, and then, you know, the  
4 pain and all of a sudden I get where it's like  
5 something's developing in my chest. It's like -- I  
6 don't know. It's, it's kind of like a -- it's not a  
7 cold it's --

7 HENRY: Like an infection?

8 DAVID: I don't know if it's an infection or  
9 not. It's just -- I don't know. It's just a -- it's  
10 kind of like you know how you feel when you feel like  
11 you're fixing to get the flu?

11 HENRY: Yes.

12 DAVID: Something like that.

13 HENRY: Well, are you sure you, are you  
14 sure --

15 DAVID: You know, you go up and down.

16 HENRY: Are you sure you don't want us to  
17 send you some medical help?

18 DAVID: No, not yet. Let's, let's --

18 HENRY: Okay.

19 DAVID: -- we're on a good road right now.  
20 That's what I've been trying to --

21 HENRY: Okay.

22 DAVID: -- that's what I was trying to work  
23  
24  
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1 with Jim all along.

2 HENRY: Okay.

3 DAVID: You know, I was trying to get a  
4 trust in him to see if he would, you know, really let  
5 me get these kids out, you know, the way I wanted to  
6 get them out.

6 HENRY: Okay.

7 DAVID: And he's been very good to me.

8 HENRY: Okay. Well --

9 DAVID: And --

10 HENRY: -- we want to, we want to continue  
11 in that same vein. We don't want to change anything  
12 or, or make anything in such a fashion, you know. And  
13 when you kept telling me that there was somebody in  
14 that tower or in the roof, I knew that there wasn't  
15 anybody, you know, because --

15 DAVID: We found out what it was.

16 HENRY: Okay. Well, we appreciate, you  
17 know, we appreciate your trusting us. We continue to  
18 trust you.

18 DAVID: (Groaning.)

19 HENRY: We want to continue working in this  
20 fashion. I would like, I would for, you know, [gap] I  
21 would like for you to start working on that, that  
22 tape, and I will work with you, and I want you to work

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1 with me.

2           DAVID: Okie doke. Okay. Let me get off  
3 the phone then. And the kids will be down there in  
4 just a second, all right?

5           HENRY: Okay.

6           DAVID: Okie doke?

7           HENRY: Okay.

8           DAVID: Okay, thanks.

9           HENRY: Um-hum.

10          [gap]

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11          UNIDENTIFIED MALE SPEAKER: -- and I'm  
12 getting ready for that.

13          [gap]

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14          UNIDENTIFIED FEMALE SPEAKER: Hello?

15          HENRY: Hello?

16          UNIDENTIFIED FEMALE SPEAKER: Yeah.

17          HENRY: This is Henry?

18          UNIDENTIFIED FEMALE SPEAKER: This is Henry.  
19 Okay. Wait one moment. I'll give you to Steve.

20          HENRY: Okay.

21          UNIDENTIFIED FEMALE SPEAKER: Steve. Steve.  
22 Henry.

23          STEVE: Hello?

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1 HENRY: Hi, Steve. Steve?  
2 STEVE: Yes.  
3 HENRY: This is Henry.  
4 STEVE: Oh, hi, Henry.  
5 HENRY: How are you doing?  
6 STEVE: I'm on the tired side. Little  
7 bit --  
8 HENRY: Oh, I guess so.  
9 STEVE: -- little bit slow tonight.  
10 HENRY: Okay. Couple of things I wanted to  
11 bring up. David mentioned that he was going to try to  
12 do that audiotape. Is he working on that?  
13 STEVE: You know what, I, I just about 2  
14 minutes ago I was going to go lay down for a few  
15 minutes, and I went past him and he was almost  
16 snoring. He, he fell asleep.  
17 HENRY: Oh, he did?  
18 STEVE: Yeah.  
19 HENRY: Okay.  
20 STEVE: So are you working on that? Or I  
21 mean I -- or I mean have you checked or found out  
22 anything about it or --  
23 HENRY: Well, he said he was going to try  
24 to, to give us a, a tape. And he had asked somebody  
25 to try to go and get some equipment from --



1 STEVE: Okay. Yeah, I, I see --

2 HENRY: -- the recording studio.

3 STEVE: I see something is here right now.  
4 So that's apparently what it's part of.

5 HENRY: Okay. Is, is he -- I really have a  
6 concern because he was, you know, he was in, in great  
7 pain and agony, you know, when I was talking to him  
8 earlier.

8 STEVE: Uh-huh.

9 HENRY: And, but, you know, part of the  
10 problem is like he said every time that he coughs or  
11 laughs or something like that that he feels that he  
12 starts bleeding again.

12 STEVE: He said that?

13 HENRY: Yes, he, he did. And the problem is  
14 if he is feeling -- if there is internal bleeding,  
15 see, when, when that coagulates, that's going to cause  
16 him some serious problems. It's been a long time  
17 since, since he suffered that wound, and we need to  
18 try to get him some medical help.

18 STEVE: Well [gap] for, for what they're  
19 telling me I guess -- hello?

20 HENRY: Yes [gap].

21 STEVE: [gap] Oh, something -- I don't know  
22 what's -- what's happening I wonder?

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HENRY: Yeah.

STEVE: Is that at your end or --

HENRY: No, it's probably at your end.

STEVE: Well, there's nobody around the, the phone here. I don't get it.

HENRY: Uh-huh.

STEVE: I'm looking around here right now. Okay. It sounds actually better. I don't know what -- it kind of cleared up or something here.

HENRY: Um-hum.

STEVE: Okay. Okay, you were, you were saying, yeah. Oh, I tell you what. I'm just so worn out I'm having a hard time even talking here.

HENRY: Okay. Well, let me, let me say this. The, the two -- or the lady that brought the, the last two kids indicated that their car is almost out of gasoline.

STEVE: Oh, it is.

HENRY: So she said or she asked if we could bring some gasoline on the next, you know, when we do the next exchange. Can you get a couple of kids ready so we can pick them up and --

STEVE: Yeah, let, let me find out then. I guess I haven't been with it just too long here. I was starting to lay down there and I was -- let me

1 find out what they're doing, and I'll try to do that,  
2 okay?

3 HENRY: Okay.

4 STEVE: Just a minute.

5 HENRY: Okay.

6 [gap]

7 STEVE: Just a minute.

8 [gap]

9 STEVE: Henry?

10 HENRY: Yes.

11 STEVE: So have you made progress with doing  
12 the tape thing or --

13 HENRY: Yes. As a matter of fact, I mean  
14 we, we encountered some difficulty but, but --

15 STEVE: Yeah.

16 HENRY: What we're trying to do is because  
17 he is most serious about this --

18 STEVE: Uh-huh.

19 HENRY: -- we're trying to react in exactly  
20 the same fashion.

21 STEVE: Yeah.

22 HENRY: And what we're trying to work out is  
23 we're trying to get him some time on the National  
24 Christian Broadcasting Network.

25 STEVE: The National Christian Broadcasting

1 Network?

2 HENRY: Yes, which has several thousand  
3 radio stations throughout the country.

4 STEVE: Okay.

5 HENRY: Now that is, is based in Phoenix,  
6 Arizona.

7 STEVE: In Phoenix, Arizona.

8 HENRY: But, you know, their headquarters.  
9 But when we called out there, there's nobody there, so  
10 we sent agents out to go to the people's house and get  
11 them out of bed or wherever they're at --

12 STEVE: Uh-huh.

13 HENRY: -- so that we can initiate this.

14 STEVE: I see. So was he wanting to do that  
15 yet tonight or --

16 HENRY: Well, he wanted to -- he was going  
17 to record the, the cassette for us.

18 STEVE: Uh-huh.

19 HENRY: And then he assured me.

20 STEVE: Yeah.

21 HENRY: And I told him I was going to hold  
22 him to his word, but he assured me not once but at  
23 least four times --

24 STEVE: Uh-huh.

25 HENRY: -- that, that once we did that,

1 everybody was coming out.

2           STEVE: I see. Could you be careful of the  
3 cord there? I think that's maybe what the problem is.

4           Someone was bumping into this -- the cord in the  
5 phone is bad.

6           HENRY: Oh, okay.

7           STEVE: Okay. Yeah. Careful. Careful  
8 there. Hello?

9           HENRY: Yes.

10           STEVE: Okay. Okay. Let me see. And then  
11 we're -- right now, he's fallen asleep. I see they  
12 brought a couple of the things. Is there any way I  
13 could leave him maybe sleep for 1 hour?

14           HENRY: Okay. But, but I have a concern,  
15 Steve. And the --

16           STEVE: Yeah.

17           HENRY: -- concern that I have, you know, is  
18 that, you know, his health may be deteriorating.  
19 Okay, so --

20           STEVE: There's, there's -- right now  
21 there's a nurse over here. And she says leave him  
22 sleep for the moment --

23           HENRY: Okay.

24           STEVE: -- just to regain, regain at least a  
25 little strength here.

1                   HENRY: Okay. That's --

2                   STEVE: And then she said she wants there  
3 herself asking if, if they can't do something in that  
4 area. She was just whispering over here to me. So I,  
5 I think between her and I we're going to ask them  
6 about that, you know, getting that kind of attention  
7 or something, or see if there's more that could be  
8 done to help out there.

9                   HENRY: Okay. Okay. And we are ready to  
10 provide that, but --

11                   STEVE: Okay.

12                   HENRY: -- we're going to have to take him  
13 out of there.

14                   STEVE: Uh-huh.

15                   HENRY: Okay? And I want you to be thinking  
16 in terms because at some point the responsibility, you  
17 know, for the entire group is probably going to shift  
18 to your shoulders, Steve.

19                   STEVE: I see.

20                   HENRY: And, and, you know, I know there's  
21 an awful lot of people there. A lot of children.

22                   STEVE: Right.

23                   HENRY: We want to between you and us,  
24 between you and me, we need to try to coordinate this  
25 so that we can effect what --

1                   STEVE: Right.

2                   HENRY: -- David and I initiated and that is  
3 everybody's coming out.

4                   STEVE: Okay. Is there any way then -- can,  
5 can you call me back in an hour?

6                   HENRY: Sure.

7                   STEVE: Oh, that would be great. Because I  
8 think what I'm going to do is even lay down here, and  
9 I'm going to have somebody here wake me up then. Or  
10 if, if the phone rings, I'm just going to make sure  
11 that I hear it just so I don't fall off too deeply in  
12 sleep or something.

13                   HENRY: Okay.

14                   STEVE: Okay.

15                   HENRY: Now let me just ask you this. Can  
16 we get a couple of kids so that we can go ahead and,  
17 and give you the gasoline for that car that, that that  
18 lady was asking about?

19                   STEVE: Well, she said he never -- he passed  
20 out before he gave the next couple that were to be  
21 going. So I don't know what to really do right now.  
22 Can, can we just wait for 1 hour?

23                   HENRY: Okay. Does --

24                   STEVE: And then, and call me and I'm going  
25 to have them at least have, you know, a number of them

1 ready so that he can just say well, you know, these  
2 two are going next then.

3 HENRY: Okay.

4 STEVE: Yeah. I'm -- oh, I tell you what.  
5 I mean I'm, I'm so tired. Last night I went through  
6 the whole night. And I, I never got to sleep at all.  
7 I laid down --

8 HENRY: You must be exhausted.

9 STEVE: Oh, I am.

10 HENRY: Okay.

11 STEVE: Henry, thanks much.

12 HENRY: Okay.

13 STEVE: I, I mean I know you're really  
14 trying there. I, I can tell. And I really do  
15 appreciate it.

16 HENRY: Um-hum.

17 STEVE: So I'm going to conk out here for  
18 about an hour. And please call me back.

19 HENRY: Okay. One other thing.

20 STEVE: Okay.

21 HENRY: Did you need a phone cord?

22 STEVE: I -- yeah. When you call me back,  
23 then I'll mention that again. I guess we -- I think  
24 he said that, didn't he?

25 HENRY: Yeah, but I'm not sure what kind of



1 a cord it is that he wants.

2 STEVE: I'm not certain either to be honest  
3 with you.

4 HENRY: Okay. Okay. Well, check on those  
5 things.

6 STEVE: Okay.

7 HENRY: You know, in about an hour I'll be  
8 back to you.

9 STEVE: Thank you much.

10 HENRY: Thank you, Steve.

11 STEVE: Okay. Yeah. Bye.

12 HENRY: Bye-bye.

13 \* \* \*

14 RACHEL: Hello?

15 HENRY: Hello?

16 RACHEL: Hello?

17 HENRY: This is Henry. Who's this?

18 RACHEL: Just a minute. Steve. Steve. Who  
19 am I talking to?

20 HENRY: This is Henry. Who's this.

21 RACHEL: I'm sorry. I couldn't understand  
22 you.

23 HENRY: Henry.

24 RACHEL: Henry.

25 HENRY: Who's this?

1 RACHEL: Oh, it's Rachel.  
2 HENRY: Hi, Rachel. How you doing?  
3 RACHEL: Okay.  
4 HENRY: How's everybody doing in there?  
5 RACHEL: I guess okay.  
6 HENRY: How's David?  
7 RACHEL: Well, he looks okay. Looks like  
8 he's --  
9 HENRY: He looks okay?  
10 RACHEL: Looks like he's sleeping.  
11 HENRY: Okay. Who is the nurse in there  
12 that's, that's taking care of him?  
13 RACHEL: Which nurse is it?  
14 HENRY: Yeah.  
15 RACHEL: I don't know.  
16 HENRY: Are you a nurse?  
17 RACHEL: No.  
18 HENRY: Okay. Is there more than one nurse  
19 in there?  
20 RACHEL: I think there's a few, but I don't  
21 know who, which one is which.  
22 HENRY: Uh-huh. Well, you know, we have a  
23 concern. And we wanted to see if we could talk to her  
24 so that --  
25 RACHEL: Looks like she's waking up.

1 HENRY: Oh, okay.

2 RACHEL: Here.

3 [gap]

4 DAVID: This Harry?

5 HENRY: David?

6 DAVID: Yeah. Is this Harry?

7 HENRY: This is Henry.

8 DAVID: Henry. Oh -- sorry.

9 HENRY: How are you doing?

10 DAVID: Okay.

11 HENRY: Are you in pain?

12 DAVID: (Gasping.) Oh, it's almost a funny  
question. But, oh, wait a second. Let me look --

13 okay. All right. Are the children there yet?

14 HENRY: Yes, they are. You want to talk to  
them?

15 DAVID: Yeah. See. Rachel? Could you,  
could you get Larry? Is Larry asleep or -- could you  
16 get Rachel, Larry and --

17 RACHEL: -- asleep.

18 DAVID: Course, little Jamie can't talk so.

19 HENRY: Um-hum. We want to confirm that  
20 you're going to be making that tape, okay?

21 DAVID: Yeah. I was just trying to get some  
22 rest --

23

1 HENRY: Yeah.

2 DAVID: -- to get my strength up.

3 HENRY: Okay. Okay. I can understand that.

4 Do you -- I don't know if Steve had a chance to, to  
5 talk to you. But, you know, we're working something  
6 out. And because, because you are serious, very  
7 serious about this, we want to approach it from the  
8 same, you know, with that same seriousness. Okay?

8 DAVID: Oh, yeah.

9 HENRY: And what we'd like to do is we are  
10 trying to not present this to somebody that's, that's  
11 going to take it lightly but rather whom we are trying  
12 to contact as a matter of fact as we speak is the  
13 National Christian Broadcasting Network. Okay?

13 DAVID: All right.

14 HENRY: Okay.

15 DAVID: All right. Okay. Where's,  
16 where's -- which -- where is that located at?

17 HENRY: They're based out of Arizona. I  
18 think it's in, I think it's in Phoenix. And they  
19 have --

19 DAVID: What's the subsidiary station here  
20 locally?

21 HENRY: That I don't know. I know that they  
22 have several thousand radio stations throughout the

23

24

1 country. But, you know --

2 DAVID: The station everybody's listening to  
3 right now is KRLD, right?

4 HENRY: Yeah. But that's, that's local.

5 DAVID: I know --

6 HENRY: We're trying to get you something  
7 number one that's religious.

8 DAVID: Exactly.

9 HENRY: That's, that's serious.

10 DAVID: Exactly.

11 HENRY: Number two that has national  
12 exposure.

13 DAVID: Okay.

14 HENRY: Now the -- you know, as you know,  
15 that one of, one of the concerns that I have is here  
16 you are very serious, okay. And some of these people  
17 are calling you -- I don't even want to tell you what  
18 they're calling you. Okay? I mean it's something  
19 that you don't like. Okay? So I thought it would  
20 be --

21 DAVID: No, okay. I just -- I got what  
22 you're saying just --

23 HENRY: Okay. So we want to have something  
24 that, you know, that you're going to be pleased with.  
25 Because it's considered a serious religious network.

1     Okay?  So we -- I mean, we called this national  
2 network in Arizona, and we couldn't get a hold of  
3 anybody.  So what we did is we called our FBI office  
4 in Phoenix, and as we speak they're waking up the  
5 people that are in charge of this.

6             DAVID:  It's not a 24-hour radio station?

7             HENRY:  Well, I'm not sure about that.  I'm  
8 sure that it is.

9             DAVID:  What, what --

10            HENRY:  I shouldn't say I'm sure that it is.  
11 But, but the people that we were trying to contact,  
12 the head people, weren't around.  So --

13            DAVID:  Oh, I see.  Yeah.

14            HENRY:  -- so they, they sent people out to  
15 the home.  Okay?

16            DAVID:  Right.

17            HENRY:  And when I was talking to Steve, he  
18 was a little bit confused about what you wanted.  
19 So --

20            DAVID:  Okay.  We're going to make this  
21 tape.  It's not going to be a long one.

22            HENRY:  Okay.

23            DAVID:  And we're going to put something  
24 together very tangible, very simple, very even and  
25 begin to show the difference between the way I

1 perceive the seals and what, in, in difference to what  
2 we've heard the seals being presented thus far by all  
3 so-called teachers and religious leaders that have  
4 been calling the radio stations.

5 HENRY: Uh-huh.

6 DAVID: So that way people will be able to  
7 honestly listen and read their Bibles as they're  
8 listening and see that I know what I'm talking about.

9 HENRY: Exactly.

10 DAVID: And then they'll make a decision  
11 from what they themselves have seen and heard from  
12 their own Bible. And then like I say, then I'm in  
13 your hands.

14 HENRY: Okay. One of the concerns that I  
15 have, okay, is I'm talking to some people, some  
16 medical people. And what -- I don't like what I'm  
17 hearing. And what I'm hearing is that, you know,  
18 remember when we were talking earlier and you coughed,  
19 okay. You told me that you thought that you might be  
20 bleeding. If you --

21 DAVID: Yeah, when I cough I bleed.

22 HENRY: Okay. Now do you, do you think that  
23 you're bleeding internally? Probably, right?

24 DAVID: Well, the hole is right here next to  
25 the belly. And it, it hit me in the, the pelvic, and

1 then it somehow traced around and went out kind of  
2 towards my back. There was a hole in the back --

3 HENRY: (Whispering.) My God.

4 DAVID: -- that was bigger than the hole in  
5 the front.

6 HENRY: Yeah. Well, see --

7 DAVID: And then the --

8 HENRY: What, what I'm, what I'm being told  
9 is that when you're hemorrhaging and then you're blood  
10 clots, okay, it creates a problem, because internally  
11 somebody's going to have to deal with it. You've  
12 been -- this is a long time ago that this occurred.  
13 We need to try to move things along so that you can  
14 get some medical assistance before you start having a  
15 lot of difficulty, you know, and, and you start going  
16 into shock or something like that.

17 DAVID: Well, I was in shock when I first  
18 got hit I thought.

19 HENRY: Okay.

20 DAVID: But like I say when -- I'm going to  
21 make this tape and, and I'm going to -- when we send  
22 the kids out to you I'm going to send that tape with  
23 them. And you'll just have to -- this will play, this  
24 will play tomorrow sometimes, right?

25 HENRY: Well, we can play it whenever you



1 want. If you want we can play it now. Or we can, we  
2 can go --

3 DAVID: Well --

4 HENRY: -- you know, we can play it  
5 tomorrow. Tomorrow will be fine. Now, you know, if  
6 you have a problem, if you have -- or if you're not  
7 happy with the National Christian Broadcasting  
8 Network, we can go to KRLD. I mean I don't have any  
9 problems going with whomever you want.

10 DAVID: Well, that's like I say if it's a  
11 national coverage then other stations will pick it up.

12 HENRY: Sure.

13 DAVID: And KRLD will probably more than  
14 happy want to play it. Because they've, they've been  
15 wondering what's happened to me anyway.

16 HENRY: Okay. Well, I don't have any  
17 problems making them a copy and giving them a copy or  
18 whatever you'd like.

19 DAVID: Would you, would you make a  
20 correction for KRLD and then those things for me?

21 HENRY: Okay.

22 DAVID: Let's see. They keep saying we have  
23 eight kids out. Let's see, we got 1, 2, 4, 6, 8, 10,  
24 12, 14, 16 children. And they need to, they need to  
25 understand we got 16 children out.

1 HENRY: Okay.

2 DAVID: And there's a whole lot more as  
3 you'll find out. And your all's records were really  
4 wrong when you numbered the amount of people here and  
5 stuff. And, and, you know, I'd like to hear that on  
6 the radio that there was 18 of them gotten out so far.

7 That's Lahara, Renee, Angelica, Crystal, Camaray  
8 (phonetic sp.), Landon, Jake, let's see, my eyes are  
9 kind of blurry.

9 SHERRY: Ryan.

10 DAVID: Ryan, yeah.

11 HENRY: Okay. Give me the names again.

12 DAVID: Let me, let me get this --

13 HENRY: Lahara.

14 DAVID: -- closer to, to me. Just read it  
15 off to me there, Sherry, would you? The, the ones  
16 that we've sent out so far. Okay. (Unidentified  
17 voices in background not discernible.) Okay, wait a  
18 second. Slow down, all right? Okay. Lahara.

18 HENRY: Lahara.

19 DAVID: Okay. You already got that down?

20 HENRY: Um-hum.

21 DAVID: Renee.

22 HENRY: Renee.

23 DAVID: Okay. Angelica.

24

1 HENRY: Angelica.  
2 DAVID: Go ahead.  
3 UNIDENTIFIED MALE SPEAKER: Crystal.  
4 DAVID: Crystal.  
5 HENRY: Crystal.  
6 UNIDENTIFIED MALE SPEAKER: Camaray.  
7 DAVID: Camaray.  
8 HENRY: Camaray.  
9 UNIDENTIFIED MALE SPEAKER: Landon.  
10 DAVID: Landon.  
11 HENRY: Landon.  
12 DAVID: Yeah. The next one's Jake.  
13 HENRY: Jake.  
14 UNIDENTIFIED MALE SPEAKER: Ryan.  
15 DAVID: Ryan.  
16 HENRY: Brian.  
17 UNIDENTIFIED MALE SPEAKER: Joshua.  
18 DAVID: Joshua.  
19 HENRY: Joshua.  
20 UNIDENTIFIED MALE SPEAKER: Jamie.  
21 DAVID: Jamie.  
22 HENRY: Jamie.

24 DAVID: No. The other ones -- all the ones  
25 that are marked off. (Unidentified female voice in

1 background not discernible.) Those others on the  
2 other side.

3 UNIDENTIFIED MALE SPEAKER: Oh, Janessa.

4 DAVID: Okay. Janessa.

5 HENRY: Janessa.

6 DAVID: Patron.

7 HENRY: Patron.

8 DAVID: Yeah. Keep going. (Unidentified  
9 voices in background not discernible.) Let me see.  
10 Let me see that list. (Groaning.) Okay. Oh, are you  
11 saying these here are listed twice?

12 UNIDENTIFIED FEMALE SPEAKER: Yeah.

13 DAVID: No, they're not. No, these are the  
14 first ones we sent out. That's why they wrote the

2 Jamie. So that's -- (unidentified female voice in  
3 background not discernible) -- 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, --  
4 okay, 6, 7, 8, 9 -- all we've been saying anyway how  
5 many --

6                   HENRY: I, I think we only have 14. I think  
7 you said 16, but I think we have 14.

8                   DAVID: Oh, boy. I tell you. I mean, I may  
9 be corrected on them. But like I say, I got a big  
10 long list here and --

11                   HENRY: Okay.

12                   DAVID: -- we're marking them off little by  
13 little and -- okay. All right. So -- (groaning) --  
14 all right, then so I'm going to start -- where's,  
15 where's Greg and them? They still -- where's Steve?

16                   UNIDENTIFIED FEMALE SPEAKER: Sleeping.

17                   DAVID: Is he sleeping around the corner?  
18 Oh, anyway. Here, here Larry. Here's -- this guy  
19 will let you talk to Josh.

20                   LORRAINE: Hello?

21                   HENRY: Hello?

22                   LORRAINE: Hello? This is Joshua's mother.

23                   HENRY: Oh, okay. Hold on a second. Let me  
24 get --

25                   LORRAINE: Okay. Thank you.

1 HENRY: What's your name?  
2 LORRAINE: Lorraine.  
3 HENRY: Lorraine? Okay. Hold on, Lorraine.  
4 Let me get the -- Joshua. How are you doing?  
5 LORRAINE: I'm doing fine. Thank you.  
6 HENRY: Good.  
7 [gap]  
8 HENRY: He's coming right up, Lorraine.  
9 Hold on just a second.  
10 LORRAINE: Okay.  
11 HENRY: (Whispering.) Say hi.  
12 JOSHUA: Hi.  
13 LORRAINE: Hi, honey. You doing okay?  
14 JOSHUA: Yeah.  
15 LORRAINE: Okay. You be a good soldier, all  
16 right?  
17 JOSHUA: Okay.  
18 LORRAINE: Okay. I love you, honey.  
19 JOSHUA: Okay.  
20 LORRAINE: Okay, sweetheart.

1 HENRY: Oh, okay.

2 LORRAINE: Okay, I'm going to put David back  
3 on, okay?

4 HENRY: That's fine.

5 LORRAINE: Okay. Thank you.

6 HENRY: Thank you. (Unidentified female  
7 voice in background not discernible.)

8 DAVID: Okay. All right, thanks. Okay.

9 HENRY: David, one of the things that we  
10 need to work out if, if we can is we have -- when we  
11 made that last exchange the ladies that brought the,  
12 the kids over said that their car was running out of  
13 gasoline, and they wondered if we could get them some  
14 gasoline.

15 DAVID: Wait a second.

16 HENRY: Okay.

17 DAVID: Said something about their car being  
18 out of gasoline? Oh, it is? (Unidentified voices in  
19 background not discernible.) Oh that, that little  
20 car, you know, it goes a long ways just on a -- well,  
21 we -- she said --

22 HENRY: So what --

23 DAVID: -- that she talked to the girl,  
24 Mary. But the thing of it is, is that -- how low is,  
25 how close to empty is it? (Unidentified female voice



1 in background not discernible.)

2 HENRY: David?

3 DAVID: Yes.

4 HENRY: What, what we've done is we've  
5 gotten a, you know, 5, 5 gallons worth of gasoline.  
6 We got a gas tank full of --

6 DAVID: Oh.

7 HENRY: And when they, we make the next  
8 exchange we'll just fill it up. We'll, we'll pour the  
9 5 gallons of gasoline in the car. Okay?

10 DAVID: Okay. All right. Thanks. I  
11 appreciate that.

12 HENRY: Okay.

13 DAVID: I don't -- well, it's too late to  
14 get a phone now so.

14 HENRY: What?

15 DAVID: Oh, we -- see we have a lot of --  
16 what we had to do is because I couldn't move and our  
17 phone was, was way down in a different part of the  
18 building, we had to scrounge up all kinds of phone  
19 cords and piece them together to stretch them across  
20 the building to, to get to where I am.

20 HENRY: Uh-huh.

21 DAVID: So we could have a phone here.

22 HENRY: Oh, okay, so you need a --

23

1                   DAVID: So I had asked, I had, you know, I  
2 had sent some money to Jim, and I'd asked him, you  
3 know, to, you know, take care of the kids with that.  
4 But --

5                   HENRY: Um-hum.

6                   DAVID: -- I'd also asked him to if he could  
7 if he could just like have someone pick up, you know,  
8 half, you know, nothing real fancy, just a straight  
9 phone from Radio Shack or something with approximately  
10 150 feet or so of, of telephone cable.

11                   HENRY: Okay. Well, that's -- you know, I,  
12 I have a note here to get, to get a telephone cord. I  
13 didn't know what exactly that was.

14                   DAVID: Yeah.

15                   HENRY: Okay. That's what you need. You,  
16 you need --

17                   DAVID: Yeah. Not the, the kind that twist  
18 around and around, you know, the, the straight stuff,  
19 you know. I need a lot of it. And the longer pieces  
20 we can get the better, because then we don't have so  
21 many connections we have to make.

22                   HENRY: Okay. Now you want that -- that's  
23 like, like an inside cord, right?

24                   DAVID: Yes, sir.

25                   HENRY: Okay. Let me work on that. I'll

1 probably get that as soon as, as --

2           DAVID: They've got it at Radio Shack.  
3 They've got like, you know, they even got like 50 feet  
4 sections, you know. So --

5           HENRY: Okay. Let me ask you this. When I  
6 spoke to Steve he was, he was concerned, you know,  
7 about your health as we all are, okay? But he's -- he  
8 has a concern about making any decisions. Are you  
9 trying to prepare him -- do you think it might be wise  
10 to, to -- is somebody calling? Hello?

11           DAVID: Hello?

12           HENRY: Yeah. That is Steve -- are you  
13 working towards preparing Steve to take over some of  
14 the responsibility? Because I feel that you're  
15 getting weaker, okay? And, and you have a lot of  
16 responsibility on your shoulders, okay?

17           DAVID: Well, that's what I was telling Jim.  
18 I was telling Jim, I said look, Jim, I teach my  
19 students from the very first day that they meet me I  
20 tell them, I say hey, look, do you want to learn the  
21 seals? And they don't even know what that is at  
22 first, most of them. So I tell them look, would you  
23 like to learn something about Jesus Christ --

24                   (End of tape.)  
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
