1 UNIDENTIFIED MALE SPEAKER #1: Okay. We
2 have any contact?

3 UNIDENTIFIED MALE SPEAKER #2: None at all.

4 UNIDENTIFIED MALE SPEAKER #1: This is
5 what --

6 UNIDENTIFIED MALE SPEAKER #2: Called
7 earlier.

8 (Phone ringing.)

9 JIM: No answer.

10 UNIDENTIFIED MALE SPEAKER #1: That's why
11 I'm wondering about their phone. You're absolutely
12 certain they didn't change the number?

13 UNIDENTIFIED MALE SPEAKER #2: Yeah, this --
14 well, this was our line, direct line into --

15 UNIDENTIFIED MALE SPEAKER #1: They were
16 going to change that.

17 UNIDENTIFIED MALE SPEAKER #2: They were
18 going to change the one that was Blaine's line over
19 there.

20 UNIDENTIFIED MALE SPEAKER #1: Try them
21 again in a minute.

22 UNIDENTIFIED MALE SPEAKER #2: -- they may
23 be able to turn that phone off.

24 UNIDENTIFIED MALE SPEAKER #1: Can check
25 with that tech --

1 UNIDENTIFIED MALE SPEAKER #2: Need Byron?
2 UNIDENTIFIED MALE SPEAKER #1: Yeah.
3 UNIDENTIFIED MALE SPEAKER #2: -- see if --
4 UNIDENTIFIED MALE SPEAKER #1: That did
5 something to it?

6 UNIDENTIFIED MALE SPEAKER #2: Yeah.
7 That's, that -- ring that long.

9 GREG: Hello?
10 JIM: Hello, this is Jim.
11 GREG: Jim.
12 JIM: Is this David?
13 GREG: No David. This is Greg. How you
14 doing?
15 JIM: Oh, hi, Greg.
16 GREG: Hold on a second would you?
17 JIM: Okay.
18 GREG: Thank you.
19 [gap]
20 GREG: There?
21 JIM: Yeah.
22 GREG: Okay. Go ahead.
23 JIM: David?
24 GREG: No, he's, he's not available right
25 now.

1 JIM: Oh, okay. Well, can you get him to
2 come over to the phone? I need to talk to him.

3 GREG: One second.

4 JIM: Um-hum.

5 [gap]

6 UNIDENTIFIED MALE SPEAKER: -- that number
7 would still be -- it should be. We're trying out --

8 UNIDENTIFIED MALE SPEAKER: Oh, you're just
9 trying the other number?

10 JIM: No. I tried -- this is the number
11 they gave me.

12 GREG: Jim?

13 JIM: Hey, yeah.

14 GREG: Hi, this is Greg again.

15 JIM: Hey, Greg.

16 GREG: Hey, Jim. I don't know -- first of
17 all, how, how did you get through to this? Because
18 this phone hasn't been working for a long, long time.

19 JIM: Oh, I don't know. We got, you know,
20 phone lines so we can get in there. We're trying to
21 get to David, you know.

22 GREG: Yeah. Okay, I just found out he's
23 out of it.

24 JIM: Asleep?

25 GREG: What's that?

1 JIM: Is he asleep?

2 GREG: Yeah.

3 JIM: Um-hum.

4 GREG: And that number is 5252.

5 JIM: Okay. Yeah. Okay. Was, was the
6 phone ringing up there?

7 GREG: I, I really have no idea. It
8 probably was.

9 JIM: Can you go up there and let me try to
10 call you up there?

11 UNIDENTIFIED MALE SPEAKER: Just to see if
12 it works.

13 JIM: Just to see if the phone works?

14 GREG: Yeah, sure. Hold on.

15 JIM: Okay.

16 GREG: Hang up here?

17 JIM: Yeah. Hang up there and then if, if I
18 don't get through call me back, or I'll call you back
19 at this number.

20 GREG: Okay.

21 JIM: Okay.

23 (Phone ringing. One side of phone
24 conversation in background.)

25 JOHN: Greg?

1 UNIDENTIFIED MALE SPEAKER: Greg.

2 JOHN: Okay, yeah, this is John. Hey Greg.
3 Okay, that's not ringing upstairs. Why don't I give
4 you, why don't you see if (indiscernible) call back in
5 about 4 or 5 minutes. Yeah, how's that? Okay, will
6 do. Bye-bye.

7 UNIDENTIFIED MALE SPEAKER: For 150 feet of
8 wire.

9 * * *

10 JIM: Hello? Hello?
11 RACHEL: Hello? Hello?
12 JIM: Hello?
13 RACHEL: Hello?
14 JIM: This is Jim.
15 RACHEL: Okay.
16 JIM: Who's this?
17 RACHEL: This is Rachel.
18 JIM: Oh, hi, Rachel.
19 RACHEL: Hello.
20 JIM: Is David there?
21 RACHEL: Yes, he is.
22 JIM: Can I talk to him?
23 RACHEL: Okay, I'll have to wake him up.
24 JIM: Okay. Go ahead.
25 RACHEL: Jim's on the phone. Jim.

1 DAVID: Jim.

2 JIM: Hey. David, how you doing?

3 DAVID: Oh, lots better.

4 JIM: Man, I know you got some rest. I'm,
5 I'm thrilled about that.

6 DAVID: Well, I'm getting some. I've been
7 waiting all this morning for the, for the, the message
8 to come across the air.

9 JIM: Right. Hey, we're getting that worked
10 out. And I think it's going to be a solid go.

11 DAVID: That will be great.

12 JIM: Yeah, it really is. I talked to Henry
13 and, and he told me what --

14 DAVID: He's another good guy, you know?

15 JIM: Yeah.

16 DAVID: He's got a good mind on him.

17 JIM: Yeah, he is a good guy. And we've,
18 we've been dealing with the Christian Broadcast
19 Network.

20 DAVID: Uh-huh.

21 JIM: And you know, we, we had some initial
22 difficulties about, you know, how long they would play
23 it. But we, we really hung in there and, and stood
24 up --

25 DAVID: Pushed it out.

1 JIM: We stood up and said listen, you know,
2 we want you to play his whole message.

3 DAVID: God bless you.

4 JIM: No editing. We, we really stood firm
5 for you. So I, I hope you realize that.

6 DAVID: Oh, God bless you.

7 JIM: But listen. I -- do you have a pencil
8 there?

9 DAVID: Pencil, Rach. Okay.

10 JIM: Okay. This is what we want to do.
11 We're -- the people at the network we -- like I say
12 we, we battled them to get the whole message. And,
13 and they, they said they will do it. And it's an
14 hour. It's a solid hour, David.

15 DAVID: Uh-huh.

16 JIM: And that's great. But they have some
17 legal and moral concerns, and they expressed these.
18 And what we want you to do is just add a sentence to
19 it, okay?

20 DAVID: Okay.

21 JIM: Now we want you to say something like
22 this. Now make a note of this, okay? And it's
23 nothing -- you'll, you'll understand what I mean.
24 Okay?

25 DAVID: Go ahead.

1 JIM: This is you, you, you're going to --
2 we'll tape this for you if, you know, once we, you
3 hear it. I agree that upon the broadcasting of my
4 tape --

5 DAVID: Oh, you want me to repeat that?

6 JIM: Okay. I agree --

7 DAVID: Yeah, well, go ahead. Let me hear
8 it.

9 JIM: Okay. I agree that upon the
10 broadcasting of my tape --

11 DAVID: Right.

12 JIM: -- I will immediately come out
13 peacefully with all my people.

14 DAVID: Right. That's the agreement we
15 made.

16 JIM: Okay.

17 DAVID: I said that on the tape.

18 JIM: Oh, I know.

19 DAVID: Already.

20 JIM: Oh, I know you did. And, and I heard
21 it. But we -- what we wanted --

22 DAVID: Yeah, that's the whole, that's the
23 whole thing of it. That's --

24 JIM: Well, what happened, Dave, though, is
25 the radio guys says, you know, they want to put it on

1 first. And you know, you had already --

2 DAVID: Oh, I see. Okay.

3 JIM: Yeah. But if you'll do that --

4 DAVID: Sure, okay. Well, you, well, you
5 want to record my voice here now or what? Because see
6 I put it on at the --

7 JIM: Okay. We'll --

8 DAVID: -- at the end of it.

9 JIM: Well, see we're -- hold on just a
10 second.

11 DAVID: Okay.

12 [gap]

13 JIM: David, the reason for this is the
14 people at the network are worried, you know, just the
15 way you phrased it, okay?

16 DAVID: Oh, how did I phrase it?

17 JIM: Well, you just said we will give
18 ourselves over to the world, give ourselves out to
19 you. And they were concerned and we're concerned that
20 there's going to be --

21 DAVID: Oh.

22 JIM: -- you know, some type of a suicide or
23 somebody hurt.

24 DAVID: Oh.

25 JIM: Okay. That's all. That's all our

1 concern is.

2 DAVID: Okay. So what, what do they want me
3 to say?

4 JIM: Okay, great.

5 DAVID: I want -- okay. I will --

6 JIM: Say -- let me read it to you again.

7 DAVID: All right.

8 JIM: I agree --

9 DAVID: I agree --

10 JIM: -- that upon the broadcasting of this
11 tape --

12 DAVID: -- that upon the broadcasting of
13 this tape --

14 JIM: -- I will immediately come out --

15 DAVID: -- I'll immediately come out --

16 JIM: -- peacefully --

17 DAVID: -- peacefully --

18 JIM: -- with all my people.

19 DAVID: -- with all the people.

20 JIM: Right. That -- and what they're going
21 to do, David, just going to play that first and then
22 your whole message.

23 DAVID: Okay. Have you recorded that?

24 JIM: No. I'm going to let you read it to
25 me in just a minute.

1 DAVID: Okay. Rach? I, I can remember
2 that.

3 JIM: Well, okay. Why don't you get Rachel
4 to write it down for you.

5 DAVID: Okay. Write this down. Upon the
6 broadcasting of this tape -- shouldn't I say I, David
7 Koresh, agree?

8 JIM: Yeah, sure. That's great.

9 DAVID: Say I, David Koresh, agree that upon
10 the broadcasting of this tape -- got that down? I --
11 okay. There's a big sentence. I and all the
12 people --

13 RACHEL: I and all the --

14 DAVID: I and all the people of this
15 association will come out peacefully.

16 JIM: And immediately.

17 DAVID: And immediately. And immediately.
18 Of course, we already made arrangements how to do
19 that, remember? I mean me and -- okay, read it back
20 to me, Rach.

21 JIM: Yeah, we'll -- hey, David, David, do
22 you mean it now? Are we going to do it?

23 DAVID: Yeah.

24 JIM: Okay, buddy.

25 DAVID: Okay --

1 JIM: Now, we'll -- you and me will work out
2 the details about, you know, walking out. Right now
3 we're more interested in getting your message out.

4 DAVID: Okay. Well, the things like I told
5 them, you know. Because the -- where's, where's Henry
6 at now? Has he gone to bed?

7 JIM: Yeah, he's gone to bed, yeah.

8 DAVID: Okay. Okay. So -- all right, then.
9 I guess (indiscernible).

10 JIM: Okay. Yeah. Did, did Rachel write it
11 down?

12 DAVID: Read it back to me, Rach.

13 RACHEL: I, David Koresh, agree upon the
14 broadcasting of this tape I and all the people in this
15 association will immediately, peacefully come out.

16 DAVID: Immediately --

17 JIM: Okay, wait a minute, Dave. Okay. Can
18 you get -- get it so you can read it, and I'll count
19 you down so we can record it, okay?

20 DAVID: Okay. Let me --

21 JIM: All right, practice it once. Just go
22 ahead and read it.

23 DAVID: Let me, let me see it, Rach. I,
24 David Koresh, agree upon the broadcasting of this tape
25 that I and all the people in this association will

1 immediately, peacefully come out. That don't sound
2 that good. I, David Koresh, agree upon the
3 broadcasting of this tape to immediately surrender?

4 JIM: Well, just come out.

5 DAVID: Okay. Okay, I, David Koresh, agree
6 upon the broadcasting of this tape to immediately come
7 out and all the people with me.

8 JIM: Peacefully.

9 DAVID: Okay, all the people peacefully.
10 Okay, got that?

11 JIM: Okay. Now you got it all like you
12 want it? You --

13 DAVID: Yeah. We'll give it a run. Okay.

14 JIM: Okay. I'll count you down, one, two,
15 three, and then you read it, okay?

16 DAVID: Okay.

17 JIM: Okay, you ready, buddy?

18 DAVID: All right.

19 JIM: Okay. One, two, three.

20 DAVID: I, David Koresh, agree upon the
21 broadcasting of this tape to come out peacefully with
22 all the people immediately.

23 JIM: Okay. We got it.

24 DAVID: Okay.

25 JIM: Okay. Now let's see if there's any

1 other issues we got to talk about just now. Yeah.

2 We --

3 DAVID: This is supposed to be nationwide.

4 JIM: Hey, Dave?

5 DAVID: Yeah.

6 JIM: One thing the commanders -- we're
7 going to get that to the radio people.

8 DAVID: Okay, excuse me. Can someone give
9 me a Kleenex? All right. Like I say (indiscernible)
10 and on these? (Unidentified male voice in background
11 not discernible.) The main thing is the truth. Okay.

12 JIM: Hey, David?

13 DAVID: So what happened with the KRLD
14 broadcast of it?

15 JIM: The KRLD?

16 DAVID: Yeah.

17 JIM: Oh, broadcast of the tape?

18 DAVID: Yeah.

19 JIM: Oh, I don't know. I thought we --
20 well, we're going to go on nationwide. That's part of
21 the network, you know, how it goes on.

22 DAVID: Oh, I see.

23 JIM: Yeah, it will all be on. It will be
24 on like -- I mean this is the biggest Christian
25 broadcasting network in the world. And the guy

1 they're dealing with is Craig Smith.

2 DAVID: Yeah.

3 JIM: Out of Phoenix. And he's going to do
4 it.

5 DAVID: Yeah.

6 JIM: Yeah.

7 DAVID: It's just --

8 JIM: You'll be able to hear it. I'm going
9 to call you when, when it's happening.

10 DAVID: And it will be on KRLD?

11 JIM: It's going to be on 1010 AM. Write
12 this down.

13 DAVID: 1010 AM.

14 JIM: And it's KBBW.

15 UNIDENTIFIED MALE SPEAKER: Waco.

16 JIM: Waco.

17 DAVID: Yeah.

18 JIM: That's just the one in Waco. It's
19 everywhere. It's a network.

20 DAVID: All right.

21 JIM: Okay. Now listen, here's a couple of
22 things we need to get from you in the meantime. We're
23 trying to work out, you know, the -- get all the folks
24 out quietly and you know, anybody who's injured. And
25 the commanders want to know the number of the injured.

1 In other words, how many do you have that can't walk,
2 can walk, and a count. Numbers. You know, I've got
3 10 women. I've got, you know, 30 women. I've got 10
4 men. You know --

5 DAVID: Well, as soon as, as soon as this is
6 all done that's when I told him that, that, you know,
7 I would, I would give all that information out.

8 JIM: Well, okay.

9 DAVID: That's what we originally worked
10 out.

11 JIM: Okay. Well --

12 DAVID: Is that the women and children would
13 come. And then, and then the guys would come one by
14 one with, you know, because it's not that cold now
15 anyway.

16 JIM: Okay.

17 DAVID: Without any bulky jackets or
18 anything with their hands up. Because that way, you
19 know, it would be seen that there's no hanky-panky or
20 anything like that on the guys' parts.

21 JIM: Okay. Well, what we're -- oh, I
22 understand that. And, and we trust you. And we just
23 want to kind of prepare in advance, you know, to have
24 some buses out there so we can take you together and,
25 you know, you know, we -- instead of a bunch of cars.

1 And we were kind of hoping that, you know,
2 you would lead the way. You know, some of the folks
3 might be scared and --

4 DAVID: Well, I don't know if I can lead the
5 way. I mean --

6 JIM: Well, you can be part of the group.

7 DAVID: Yeah.

8 JIM: You know, if you can't walk, we'd
9 provide you with a stretcher, and two of your able-
10 bodied men can, you know, carry you out. And you
11 know, you'd be a intrical part of the group, you know
12 what I'm saying?

13 DAVID: Right.

14 JIM: Maybe you want to be in the center of
15 your group and two of your men carrying you out. But
16 I mean you're there with them.

17 DAVID: Yeah.

18 JIM: You know, you're the leader and, you
19 know, we're relying on you. The only reason I'm
20 asking --

21 DAVID: Well, what we can do is we can send
22 our guy up to the gate.

23 JIM: Okay.

24 DAVID: And if you all will -- or, or a
25 couple of guys at the gate. If you all will hand him,

1 you know, get him, give him a stretcher.

2 JIM: Um-hum.

3 DAVID: Then they, then they can, they can
4 bring me out then.

5 JIM: Okay. David, it's the right thing to
6 do.

7 DAVID: Well, I, I told you, Jim, I would
8 work something out with you, remember?

9 JIM: I, I know you did.

10 DAVID: And I told you, you know, that we'd,
11 we'd do this -- getting the children out first.

12 JIM: Right.

13 DAVID: Right? Then we'd negotiate.

14 JIM: Right.

15 DAVID: And you know, like I said,
16 everything that I try to do is I try to emphasize that
17 the people that stay with me don't stay with me
18 because of me.

19 JIM: Um-hum.

20 DAVID: They stay with me because of the
21 truth. And unless you know where the truth begins,
22 you see.

23 JIM: Yeah.

24 DAVID: Or unless it can be tested by being
25 out and being around, that's one of the only two ways

1 people can see why people stand for what they stand
2 for.

3 JIM: That's right.

4 DAVID: So you know.

5 JIM: Well, David, you've kept your word and
6 so have we.

7 DAVID: Well, you've been -- you all been a
8 lot better than I ever see in the other cases.

9 JIM: And I'll tell you our only reason for
10 these questions about the people is just logistical,
11 you know.

12 DAVID: Uh-huh.

13 JIM: So we can call ahead to the hospital
14 to say look, we have a man who has an arm wound. We
15 have a -- you know, David has a wound in his lower
16 abdomen. You know, so they can prepare to treat you.

17 DAVID: Right.

18 JIM: That's the only reason. I mean I'm
19 not -- I mean there's no secret behind it. And then
20 just to have the number of vehicles there. You
21 remember the glitches we had the other day when the
22 car wasn't ready. And then the people at the
23 Christian Broadcast Network, you know, their, their
24 position and, and you understand the news, okay.

25 DAVID: Uh-huh.

1 JIM: Their position is that when the
2 broadcast is over you come out.

3 DAVID: Right.

4 JIM: Because they -- they're trying to do
5 that to help. And if you wait hours after that or
6 something --

6 DAVID: No, we're going --

7 JIM: -- other people will say, you know, it
8 wasn't because of the broadcast. See that's why I'm
9 trying to make the plans, you know.

10 DAVID: Yeah, I see.

11 JIM: And then also I don't want it to get
12 dark on us. And that many people getting ready, you
13 know, with the children, the mothers would take a
14 little while.

14 DAVID: Right.

15 JIM: You know. So I'll tell you what. We,
16 we if -- why don't you do this for me. Go ahead and
17 get a head count. It's not going to hurt nothing.
18 And we'll, we'll get in contact with Craig Smith.

18 DAVID: Well, let me, let me give you an
19 approximate head count on the remaining children, all
20 right?

21 JIM: Okay.

22 DAVID: Okay, let's see, 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6,

1 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17, 18, 19 --
2 there's over 20 children remaining.
3 JIM: Okay, 20 children.
4 DAVID: Yeah.
5 JIM: How about women?
6 DAVID: And I have -- to be honest with you,
7 I have to really count.
8 JIM: Okay.
9 DAVID: I don't know.
10 JIM: Okay. Well, give me --
11 DAVID: There's a lot.
12 JIM: -- give me, give me a ballpark. Just
13 give me an idea. I can -- so I can --
14 DAVID: Forty? Fifty?
15 JIM: Forty women? Okay. Forty to fifty,
16 okay.
17 DAVID: Forty, fifty women. Maybe how many
18 men approximately?
19 UNIDENTIFIED FEMALE SPEAKER: Forty-five --
20 DAVID: Forty-five, fifty? Forty-five,
21 fifty.
22 JIM: Okay. Forty-five, fifty men?
23 DAVID: Yeah.
24 JIM: Okay. Now how about --
25 DAVID: I mean, you know, like there's,

1 | there's over 150 people.

2 | JIM: Okay. I understand. Maybe you could
3 | get Rachel to just go around and get a count.

4 | DAVID: Okay.

5 | JIM: You know. You know, just get a head
6 | count. Tell her to take a piece of paper, just count
7 | everybody. And that will help us with the buses. And
8 | then the, the other thing is especially important is,
9 | you know, people who can't walk, yourself and any
10 | others, can we --

11 | DAVID: Well, I'm the only one that, that
12 | can't walk so --

13 | JIM: Okay. Okay. Well, do -- we can get a
14 | stretcher in there to you, okay? And I --

15 | DAVID: Oh, well let, let two guys bring the
16 | stretchers in.

17 | JIM: Well, maybe we'll have Sita meet them
18 | or something?

19 | DAVID: Have what?

20 | JIM: You know, have Sita meet them at the
21 | gate. Or we'll bring it in to you.

22 | DAVID: Yeah.

23 | JIM: We'll work it out.

24 | DAVID: Yeah, okay. You can just meet them
25 | down at the road.

1 JIM: Well, okay. We can get them to the
2 gate maybe. And then you could have two guys walk
3 down and get them or something.

4 DAVID: Yeah. And then, and then they can,
5 they can bring me out.

6 JIM: Yeah. Okay.

7 DAVID: Because like I said, we've got two
8 nurses here anyway.

9 JIM: Yeah, okay. We can work that out.

10 DAVID: Two like RNs, and one of them's just
11 like a helper nurse.

12 JIM: Okay. I'll, I'll get something so we
13 can get that to you so you can get out on that.

14 DAVID: When was my last blood pressure
15 check? Does anybody remember? (Unidentified female
16 voice in background not discernible.) Yeah.

17 JIM: How is it?

18 DAVID: Could you, could you get her to get
19 that, that lady and, and see how my blood pressure was
20 when she last checked it?

21 UNIDENTIFIED MALE SPEAKER: Ninety over --

22 UNIDENTIFIED FEMALE SPEAKER: It was 90 over
23 40 (indiscernible).

24 DAVID: Ninety over forty. Okay. Ninety,
25 something like ninety over forty. I guess I should

1 have it taken again.

2 JIM: Well, that's, that's another reason
3 for us to make these preparations, David. You know
4 what I mean?

5 DAVID: Yeah.

6 JIM: I mean --

7 DAVID: Well, I started, I started, you
8 know, we started cleaning the wounds and everything
9 too.

10 JIM: Okay.

11 DAVID: And yeah, I heard on the radio the
12 police officer said that he, he shot me twice in the
13 stomach.

14 JIM: Um-hum.

15 DAVID: He must have recognized me or
16 something.

17 JIM: I don't know. I don't know. That's
18 another reason not to delay. Because we're going to
19 get the message on. And, and once it is, you know,
20 there's no reason for you not to get that medical care
21 just as quick as we can.

22 DAVID: Yeah.

23 JIM: And, and --

24 DAVID: So is KRLD going to be able to --
25 are they going to, are they going to connect with this

1 too or --

2 JIM: Yeah. The tapes are going to KRLD.

3 Both. KRLD is going to play it.

4 DAVID: Uh-huh.

5 JIM: And the Christian Broadcast Network,
6 KBBW.

7 DAVID: All right.

8 JIM: So you can get two radios, two into
9 each one. And they'll both play them.

10 DAVID: Oh, I see. Okay.

11 JIM: And I'll alert you ahead of time.
12 Okay?

13 DAVID: All right.

14 JIM: Now we -- we'll keep every one of our
15 agreements, you know, that we made.

16 DAVID: And when's this going to start?

17 JIM: Well, it won't be yet. What happens
18 is they have to listen to the tape at KRLD, you know,
19 is not finished listening to it. The Christian
20 Broadcast Network listened to it.

21 DAVID: Right.

22 JIM: Okay. Now we're -- now have
23 dispatched your preamble, okay? You know --

24 DAVID: Uh-huh.

25 JIM: -- the message we just made, okay?

1 DAVID: Right.

2 JIM: And then Craig Smith's show doesn't
3 start until a little after 1.

4 DAVID: Okay.

5 JIM: Okay, so I mean he's the guy we're
6 dealing with. So his show's a little after 1.

6 DAVID: Okay.

7 JIM: Yeah. Yeah. The -- and the reason
8 they got to listen, you know, so they make sure
9 there's no obscenities on there --

10 DAVID: Oh, yeah, definitely.

11 JIM: The FCC rules, you know, say that,
12 that, you know what I mean.

12 DAVID: Exactly. Well, I'm not -- I mean --

13 JIM: That's okay. I understand. I'm just,
14 I'm just telling you the reason.

15 DAVID: I mean I tried to make it as, as
16 simple and as compact --

17 JIM: We heard it. We heard it. It's
18 great.

19 DAVID: As much as I -- but you know, I just
20 said, I told you it's very limited on that tape.

21 JIM: I understand.

22 DAVID: The wealth of information is really
23 a thousandfold over that.

24

1 JIM: Well, listen. After you walk out of
2 there and your, your word's going to get out even
3 more. I'm telling you it's going to get out even
4 more.

5 DAVID: The truth.

6 JIM: The truth will get out. When, when
7 you come out of there even more. So just remember
8 that, okay?

9 DAVID: All right.

10 JIM: And what we have to do now is -- why
11 don't you go ask Rachel if she'll make us a head
12 count?

13 DAVID: Okay. Rach? Go and, and -- it's
14 going to take her a while. It's a big place here.

15 JIM: Oh, I understand.

16 DAVID: And go get a, all a head count of,
17 of all the women and, and the guys too, right?

18 JIM: Yeah, the guys. And, and tell her
19 especially if she can tell us about the wounds.
20 Because we'll alert to, to trauma center, you know?

21 DAVID: Okay. The two wounds is a guy got a
22 braise wound on the leg.

23 JIM: Okay.

24 DAVID: And, and one guy got a braise wound
25 in the, in the arm.

1 JIM: Okay.

2 DAVID: I mean it's kind of like in the
3 wrist like kind of like what mine is. I got one on
4 the wrist too.

5 JIM: Okay. You got the wrist, the lower
6 abdomen.

7 DAVID: Right. It's -- but see like I say,
8 it went, it went, it went kind of towards the side.

9 JIM: Yeah.

10 DAVID: And like I said I think it broke
11 my --

12 JIM: Pelvis?

13 DAVID: -- pelvic bone, yeah.

14 JIM: David, do all the people agree to come
15 out with your, with your --

16 DAVID: I, I explained it to them. That's
17 why, you know, two ladies already came out.

18 JIM: Yeah. Well, we knew that --

19 DAVID: I told them I said look, we've
20 got -- there's one thing above all and that is the
21 truth.

22 JIM: Right.

23 DAVID: You when Isaiah said, you know, lift
24 up the voice with the voice. Together shall they
25 sing. They shall see eye to eye. See, everyone

1 already knows all those prophecies.

2 JIM: Um-hum.

3 DAVID: There's seven eyes of the lamb,
4 right?

5 JIM: Right.

6 DAVID: And so there's just, you know, one
7 complete truth that all the prophets have been
8 foreseeing, and Ezra didn't want this truth.

9 JIM: Um-hum.

10 DAVID: So --

11 JIM: Well, I was -- I know, I know you
12 arranged that. And I was, what I was concerned about
13 that, you know, the place is so --

14 DAVID: Well, most of, most of like the,
15 most of the girls, the young girls, you know, they do
16 not trust they system, you know.

17 JIM: Oh, sure.

18 DAVID: So that's why they said, you know,
19 no, we don't want to go out.

20 JIM: Um-hum.

21 DAVID: You know until, until we see it.

22 JIM: I understand it.

23 DAVID: Yeah.

24 JIM: Well, it's a big place, and we were
25 concerned that everybody in the inside got the word,

1 you know, and that there wasn't somebody off in a room
2 that, that didn't get the word, you know.

3 DAVID: No.

4 JIM: Okay. That, that was our --

5 DAVID: Like I say we'll go, we'll go around
6 the head count to and --

7 JIM: Yeah.

8 DAVID: -- and, and get this all totally
9 resolved.

10 JIM: Hey, that --

11 DAVID: I mean like, like for instance we
12 just, we just heard a shot a few minutes ago, right?

13 JIM: You heard a shot?

14 DAVID: Yeah. But what happened was -- who
15 was that? (Unidentified voices in background not
16 discernible.) It was a, it was a guy that he was --
17 he grabbed a pistol and it didn't have no clip or
18 nothing in it.

19 JIM: Oh, it was an accident.

20 DAVID: And yeah, but you know it's -- I
21 thought oh, no. I mean last thing in the world we
22 need --

23 JIM: Well, listen you --

24 DAVID: And he had pulled the trigger. It
25 didn't have a clip in it, but it had a round in a

1 chamber.

2 JIM: Okay. Well, listen, I think that's
3 something you can look at us. We didn't -- we heard
4 the shot out there. We didn't do anything.

5 DAVID: Yeah. Yeah.

6 JIM: You know? And I mean, right?

7 DAVID: Kind of got a lot of things to tell
8 you, you know --

9 JIM: I mean that's how much we trust you.

10 DAVID: Right.

11 JIM: That we, we hear a shot. The, the
12 agents, the FBI, the ATF are out there. They're not
13 reacting to that, because we told them not to.

14 DAVID: Well, you're some good guys.

15 JIM: All right. And I trust you and you
16 trust me.

17 DAVID: Right.

18 JIM: And I want --

19 DAVID: I told you, Jim --

20 JIM: -- all the trust, I want all the trust
21 of everyone in there. Do you --

22 DAVID: Well, like I say these aren't crazy
23 people.

24 JIM: Oh, I know it. We know that.

25 DAVID: You know, there -- these are people

1 that have had high paying jobs that are very highly
2 intellectual. They --

3 JIM: Hey, we know that.

4 DAVID: -- so they're reasoning people. You
5 know, you might think that the original settlers of
6 this country were, you know, people that were trying
7 to obtain freedom because of European oppression,
8 right?

8 JIM: Um-hum.

9 DAVID: Remember how this government did to
10 the Indians?

11 JIM: Right.

12 DAVID: You know I mean it's -- sometimes
13 it's really a real picture of attitude to really
14 identify what is really right and what's really wrong.
15 But that's where the point of reasoning comes in.

15 JIM: Right.

16 DAVID: And that's what we try to establish
17 here is --

18 JIM: Hey, you've been --

19 DAVID: -- let us reason together the
20 scripture says.

21 JIM: That's right. You are on the level.
22 And you are on the level. That's the kind of guy you
23 are.

23

24

1 DAVID: Well, this is the way I always try
2 to teach the scriptures too. Then people jump around
3 and say that I'm crazy. Now in that tape that I made
4 over for the Australians which it was actually a tape
5 over here, the subject it was actually revolvant (sic)
6 which says, you know, they, they play half of it on
7 the tape. And it says, you know, God says, I'm
8 screaming, right?

9 JIM: Um-hum.

10 DAVID: You know. He's got a boogie, he's
11 a, lamb. And I says you idiots, right?

12 JIM: Um-hum.

13 DAVID: Okay? You -- people don't know what
14 had just happened. You know, you know people in the
15 organization in this message are supposed to walk in
16 the light of the truth, see. Now if we don't know
17 what's totally involved in that truth, you know, then
18 we don't understand why a presentation or an anger can
19 be made that way.

20 JIM: Um-hum.

21 DAVID: But, but there are certain sins that
22 just should not be done --

23 JIM: Um-hum.

24 DAVID: -- with the kind of information that
25 we give.

1 JIM: Um-hum. Um-hum.

2 DAVID: I mean, you know, you want to talk
3 about Christ.

4 JIM: Um-hum.

5 DAVID: Lifting up his voice 2,000 years
6 ago. Read the scriptures. You know, and the
7 prophets. They didn't talk, they didn't talk, you
8 know, but this --

8 JIM: Hey, David?

9 DAVID: Go ahead.

10 JIM: I want to tell you something. I
11 listened to your message on that tape. And I just
12 want to tell you that I think you did a great job.

12 DAVID: Well --

13 JIM: I, I mean it now. I'm being sincere.

14 DAVID: It's a small portioning. We'll hear
15 a lot more afterwards.

16 JIM: That's right.

17 DAVID: So --

18 JIM: Hey, listen. The, the commanders are
19 asking for me out there for the transportation
20 arrangements.

20 DAVID: Okay.

21 JIM: So let's do this if it's okay. Let's
22 take a break so I can get with them. And, and when

23

1 you get the head count from Rachel, will you call me
2 back?

3 DAVID: Okay. You got the number, Steve?

4 JIM: Yeah.

5 DAVID: Jim's number.

6 JIM: Here, let me give that to you, David.

7 DAVID: Okay.

8 JIM: 799- --

9 DAVID: 799 Rach.

10 JIM: 05 --

11 DAVID: Wait. She's, she's writing it down.

12 JIM: Okay.

13 DAVID: I got to move real quick, Jim, wait.

14 JIM: Okay. All right.

15 DAVID: (Groaning.) Takes a lot of effort
16 just to gain an inch. Okay, 799 --

17 JIM: 0545.

18 DAVID: 0545.

19 JIM: Okay. After you get the head count
20 call me.

21 DAVID: Okie doke.

22 JIM: Okay. And make those arrangements,
23 because we, we want to get you out right after your
24 message is played.

25 DAVID: Okie doke.

1 JIM: So you can get some treatment.
2 DAVID: All right.
3 JIM: Okay, David.
4 DAVID: Okay, we'll talk to you in a little
5 bit.
6 JIM: I'll see you, buddy. All right.
7 DAVID: Okay, thanks --
8 JIM: Okay, bye.
9 DAVID: -- bye.
10 UNIDENTIFIED MALE SPEAKER: Great.
11 * * *
12 JIM: David?
13 RACHEL: This is Rachel.
14 JIM: Oh, hey, Rachel. This is Jim.
15 RACHEL: Oh, okay. David's napping at the
16 moment. So I just called to give you a head count.
17 JIM: Okay, great.
18 RACHEL: Okay. Can you hear that loud noise
19 over the phone I hear?
20 JIM: Oh, wait a minute. Let me fix it.
21 Hold on just a minute.
22 RACHEL: Okay.
23 [gap]
24 JIM: That's feedback in my circuit. I can
25 hear it.

1 RACHEL: Um-hum.

2 JIM: Okay. Go ahead and give me the head
3 count.

4 RACHEL: Okay. There, it's cleared it now.

5 JIM: Okay.

6 RACHEL: The men, 43.

7 JIM: Okay.

8 RACHEL: Women, 47.

9 JIM: Okay.

10 RACHEL: And the children that are left
11 still --

12 JIM: Um-hum.

13 RACHEL: -- is 20.

14 JIM: Okay. All right, now David's asleep.

15 RACHEL: Um-hum.

16 JIM: Okay. What we're going to do is we're
17 going to have everybody walk out.

18 RACHEL: Uh-huh.

19 JIM: Not now. You know, I'm going to get
20 back with you.

21 UNIDENTIFIED MALE SPEAKER: How many cannot
22 walk?

23 JIM: Yeah, how many cannot walk? Just
24 David or --

25 RACHEL: As far as I know at this moment.

1 RACHEL: Okay.

2 JIM: After the message is played. So
3 here's what we're going to do.

4 RACHEL: Okay.

5 JIM: Okay? We're going to send one of
6 these big armored police vehicles, okay?

7 RACHEL: Okay.

8 JIM: That you know, so the men won't get
9 shot in it, you know. Has no gun on it. They're just
10 going to drive it up and drop the stretcher in the, by
11 the driveway.

12 RACHEL: At the driveway, that's at the, the
13 gate.

14 JIM: Right, right. That's where David
15 wanted.

16 RACHEL: Okay.

17 JIM: Okay. Then we've told them to move
18 the vehicle up the road, okay.

19 RACHEL: Uh-huh.

20 JIM: Where you'll be able to see it.

21 RACHEL: Okay. Who's going to -- you're
22 going to move it up the road.

23 JIM: Yeah. We're going to take care of it.
24 We're going to have it moved away from the stretcher.

25 RACHEL: Okay.

1 JIM: Up the road. But I told them to put
2 it where you could see it, okay? You know, so you
3 know it's there. I mean I'm not trying to hide it
4 from you. Okay?

5 RACHEL: Just a minute. Just a minute.
6 (Unidentified voices in background not discernible.)

7 UNIDENTIFIED MALE SPEAKER: What happened?

8 RACHEL: What was that?

9 UNIDENTIFIED MALE SPEAKER: They're dropping
10 it off.

11 UNIDENTIFIED MALE SPEAKER: What are you
12 doing?

13 RACHEL: Oh, they had an accident here. I
14 couldn't hear what you were saying.

15 JIM: What happened?

16 RACHEL: I don't know.

17 JIM: Okay. So anyway, let me tell you
18 what's going to happen.

19 RACHEL: Okay.

20 JIM: So this, this vehicle's going to drop
21 the stretcher at the driveway.

22 RACHEL: Okay.

23 JIM: And it's going to go on up. And I
24 want you to alert everybody it's a non-threatening
25 thing. It's, it's just the mechanics of getting it

1 | there.

2 | RACHEL: Uh-huh.

3 | JIM: It's nothing to worry about. It's
4 | strictly so the, the agents don't get hurt.

5 | RACHEL: Okay.

6 | JIM: It's for their protection only, okay?

7 | RACHEL: Okay.

8 | JIM: And then they're going to just sit up
9 | there, okay?

10 | RACHEL: Okay. And they don't have any
11 | weapons either, is that what you said?

12 | JIM: Right. I mean there's no gun on that
13 | thing.

14 | RACHEL: Okay.

15 | JIM: Okay? But you got to let the people
16 | know.

17 | RACHEL: Okay.

18 | JIM: They're not coming out of it.

19 | RACHEL: Okay.

20 | JIM: Nobody will come out of it.

21 | RACHEL: They're just going to let the
22 | stretcher off at the gate.

23 | JIM: Yeah. Right. Okay?

24 | RACHEL: And then our guys will go up there
25 | and get it.

1 JIM: Yeah. I will call you.

2 RACHEL: Oh, you're going to call after
3 that?

4 JIM: Well, I'll tell you what. When you
5 see it, you call me.

6 RACHEL: Okay.

7 JIM: When you see it, you call me.

8 RACHEL: Okay.

9 JIM: But don't get out. I mean you
10 don't -- when you see it you just call me.

11 RACHEL: Okay.

12 JIM: And then, you know, we'll tell them
13 that, you know, you're going to send a man or two
14 out --

15 RACHEL: Okay.

16 JIM: -- to get it. I don't want you to be
17 surprised or them to be surprised. Everybody knows
18 what everybody's doing.

19 RACHEL: All right.

20 JIM: Okay? How you holding up?

21 RACHEL: Okay. We're doing all right.

22 JIM: Okay. Is David sleeping?

23 RACHEL: Yes.

24 JIM: Okay. Hold on. Let me see if I need
25 anything else. Are you sure this is going to be okay

1 with everybody?

2 RACHEL: As far as I know, that's the way it
3 was planned out before.

4 JIM: Oh, good. Well, look, reinforce it
5 with them.

6 RACHEL: Okay.

7 JIM: Because we're all concerned for your
8 safety.

9 RACHEL: Okay. I'll, I'll tell them about
10 it after I get off the phone.

11 JIM: Okay. And, and --

12 UNIDENTIFIED MALE SPEAKER: Let's ask her to
13 do it right now.

14 JIM: Yeah. Can you tell everybody while
15 we're holding on or --

16 RACHEL: Okay.

17 JIM: Okay.

18 RACHEL: Just a minute.

19 [gap]

20 RACHEL: Is everybody listening? He wants
21 me to reiterate (indiscernible). Okay, they're going
22 to send a big armored -- be quiet.

23 UNIDENTIFIED MALE SPEAKER: Quiet.

24 RACHEL: Everybody listen.

25 UNIDENTIFIED FEMALE SPEAKER: Quiet.

1 RACHEL: They're going to send a big armored
2 vehicle up to the gate. There's not going to be any
3 weapons in the vehicle. And they're not going to get
4 out. They're just going to drive up to the gate, let
5 the stretcher out the gate, and then they're going to
6 drive a little bit past the gate. And then when we
7 see the stretcher up there, we give Jim a call.

8 RACHEL: Okay.

9 JIM: Okay. And they're passing the word?

10 RACHEL: Yeah.

11 JIM: Okay. Any of the -- any other
12 children that need special care?

13 RACHEL: No.

14 JIM: Injured, diapers, bottles, anything?

15 RACHEL: No. We have plenty of diapers.

16 JIM: Nothing? You got all that stuff?

17 RACHEL: Yeah. We have, we have lots of
18 diapers, plenty of food.

19 JIM: Okay. Do -- are we talking about any
20 infants here?

21 RACHEL: Sorry?

22 JIM: Any infants in the children?

23 RACHEL: I'm sorry. I don't understand
24 the --

25 JIM: You know, babies.

1 RACHEL: Oh, infants. I thought you said
2 incense.

3 JIM: Yeah --

4 RACHEL: Yes. We have infants. So we'll
5 need some car seats.

6 JIM: Some car seats. Okay. How about a
7 number? Any idea?

8 RACHEL: I'll have to find that out how many
9 car seats.

10 JIM: Okay. Well, we can see what we can do
11 on that.

12 RACHEL: Okay.

13 JIM: If not, you know, their moms can be
14 holding them and stuff.

15 RACHEL: Okay.

16 JIM: Yeah, we'll -- if we have the car
17 seats by -- we'll let, you know, the mother can hold
18 them.

19 RACHEL: Okay.

20 JIM: And what you need -- David was going
21 to do and be concerned with was getting everybody to
22 have a coat.

23 RACHEL: Um-hum.

24 JIM: You know, with that many people,
25 Rachel, it takes a while.

1 RACHEL: Well, I think a lot of people, I
2 don't know if they have those on already or not.
3 Because --

4 JIM: Okay. Well, you know, David's health
5 is another time factor.

6 RACHEL: Um-hum.

7 JIM: And his blood pressure's down.

8 RACHEL: Um-hum.

9 JIM: He's bled a lot.

10 RACHEL: Um-hum.

11 JIM: And we talked with him about this, so
12 after we play the radio broadcast --

13 RACHEL: What time will that be?

14 JIM: Well, we're, we're probably going to
15 do it at -- as soon as possible but sometime after 1.

16 RACHEL: Okay.

17 JIM: I will alert you when it's going to
18 play so you can turn your radio on.

19 RACHEL: Okay.

20 JIM: And then after it's over, you know,
21 our agreement is that everybody's immediately going to
22 come out.

23 RACHEL: Um-hum.

24 JIM: But I'll have to work the mechanics
25 out of the actual like how many people at a time.

1 RACHEL: Um-hum.

2 JIM: You know, with David so we don't --

3 RACHEL: So you're going to call after the
4 program is over? Is that what you're saying?

5 JIM: Yes. Yes. Okay, no -- we don't want
6 anybody come out --

7 RACHEL: Okay.

8 JIM: -- unless we're talking on the phone.

9 RACHEL: Okay.

10 JIM: Because I don't -- I, I want you all
11 to be safe.

12 RACHEL: Okay.

13 JIM: Okay. You can trust me now. You know
14 that.

15 RACHEL: All right.

16 JIM: I'm hoping that they'll -- is it
17 raining out there?

18 RACHEL: Just a minute. Is it raining
19 outside? No.

20 JIM: Okay. All right. I'd say do this for
21 me. Just --

22 UNIDENTIFIED MALE SPEAKER: Time they're
23 supposed to wake --

24 JIM: Yeah. Did you have a time that you
25 were going to supposed to wake David up or --

1 RACHEL: No. He comes, you know, he comes
2 in and out of it so.

3 JIM: Yeah. Is he in a bed or on the floor
4 or what?

5 RACHEL: No. He's just laying on the floor.

6 JIM: Oh, shoot. I'll bet he's hurt.

7 RACHEL: We didn't have time for that, you
8 know?

9 JIM: Yeah. Um-hum. I understand. I
10 understand. And he --

11 RACHEL: And then after that he couldn't
12 move. He's in too much pain so.

13 JIM: Right.

14 RACHEL: So, he's got plenty of pillows and
15 blankets. He's laying on, you know, some padding.

16 JIM: Yeah.

17 RACHEL: So.

18 JIM: Will your guys be able to get him on a
19 stretcher?

20 RACHEL: Yeah, they should be able to just
21 fine.

22 JIM: Okay. (Unidentified male voice in
23 background not discernible.) Yeah. When we hear what
24 time the radio is going to play it, you know, we'll
25 call you.

1 RACHEL: Okay.

2 JIM: And then you can wake him then.

3 RACHEL: Okay.

4 JIM: But that will be a while.

5 RACHEL: All right.

6 JIM: Okay. So maybe he'll get a little
7 good rest and, and get his strength back.

8 RACHEL: Okay.

9 JIM: And so forth. Hold on. Let me check
10 on one other thing on that stretcher, okay?

11 (Pause)

12 JIM: We're shooting for 1:30 on the
13 broadcast, Rachel.

14 RACHEL: Okay. 1:30

15 JIM: Now we're going to have to confirm
16 that. That's what we're shooting for.

17 RACHEL: All right.

18 JIM: Now the two channels it's going to be
19 played on.

20 RACHEL: Two channels?

21 JIM: It's going to be played on two
22 channels.

23 RACHEL: Okay.

24 JIM: Okay? Let me give them to you so you
25 know.

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RACHEL: Okay.

JIM: Okay? It's KBBW.

RACHEL: Oh, yes.

JIM: On 1010 AM.

RACHEL: Okay.

JIM: Christian Broadcast Network. And that's going, you know, like I don't -- hundreds of stations they have. Okay?

RACHEL: But that's not national.

JIM: Yes, it's national.

RACHEL: Oh, is it?

JIM: Oh, yeah. Uh-huh. Absolutely. We checked.

RACHEL: Oh, I guess the one on FM is the one that's not national.

JIM: Yeah, the FM. This, this is the big one.

RACHEL: Okay.

JIM: Okay? And then they're also going to do it on KRLD which is 1080.

RACHEL: KRLT.

JIM: D as in David.

RACHEL: Oh. I'm sorry.

JIM: Yeah. And that's 1080.

RACHEL: Okay.

1 JIM: Now you know, if you got two radios
2 you'll hear it on both.

3 RACHEL: Yeah, we, we have both.

4 JIM: Okay. And we're shooting for 1:30.

5 RACHEL: Okay.

6 JIM: So you got to kind of just hang in
7 there and --

8 RACHEL: Okay.

9 JIM: -- you know, be good for everybody.
10 Because you know, we can't talk to everyone.

11 RACHEL: Okay.

12 JIM: So we can only talk to a few, you and
13 David, you know, and --

14 RACHEL: Um-hum. All right.

15 JIM: You guys got to kind of help us
16 facilitate it.

17 RACHEL: Okay. I'll let everybody know.

18 JIM: Yeah. And I was hoping they'd move
19 that truck up there while we were on the phone so you
20 could tell me you saw it. But --

21 RACHEL: Oh, you mean on your end?

22 JIM: Yeah. I mean I was hoping they'd
23 drive it up there. I passed the word down for them
24 to, to bring that stretcher up.

25 RACHEL: Um-hum.

1 JIM: And so, so we could get it in there.

2 But --

3 RACHEL: Oh, you mean ahead of time.

4 JIM: Yeah, you know.

5 RACHEL: Uh-huh.

6 JIM: Because, because I'm just worried
7 about his blood pressure.

8 RACHEL: Um-hum.

9 JIM: You know, if we have it already in
10 there, and then we play the message, then it's time to
11 come out we don't have to, you know, deal with it
12 then.

13 RACHEL: Oh, I see. Um-hum.

14 JIM: Yeah. Yeah, 1:30 is when we're
15 playing the message. (Unidentified male voice in
16 background not discernible.) Hold on a second,
17 Rachel.

18 RACHEL: All right. They're going to try
19 for 1:30. But he's going to call us.

20 JIM: Okay, Rachel?

21 RACHEL: Yes.

22 JIM: The program on the Christian Broadcast
23 radio, okay?

24 RACHEL: Um-hum.

25 JIM: Starts at 1:06.

1 RACHEL: 1:06, okay.

2 JIM: Now that's when they're going to
3 announce that they'll be playing it at 1:30.

4 RACHEL: Okay.

5 JIM: So you might turn it on at 1:06.

6 RACHEL: All right.

7 JIM: And, and the reason they're doing that
8 they said is to get a wider audience.

9 RACHEL: Okay.

10 JIM: So in other words, instead of just
11 starting it they're telling everybody this is going to
12 be on so they can get as many listeners as possible.

13 RACHEL: All right.

14 JIM: Yeah. Do you -- can you see out the
15 front window?

16 RACHEL: Yeah, if I get up.

17 JIM: Okay. Well, I want you to keep an eye
18 to see if that truck comes up with the stretcher.

19 RACHEL: Okay.

20 JIM: Okay. They, they told me it should be
21 up there momentarily.

22 RACHEL: All right.
