1 (Start Tape 13.)

2 HENRY: Sure.

3 DAVID: I don't know, or I don't know if
4 what phone still works. Our -- I know, I know with
5 Jim, he could only call us.

6 HENRY: Well, I can --

7 DAVID: Well, call me back in about 15
8 minutes and --

9 HENRY: Okay. Now let me know what the
10 reading is. Because if it's starting to, to go down
11 we're, we're going to have to work quick, okay? You
12 know, I'm going to get this tape to these radio
13 stations no matter what. I'm giving you my word that
14 that's what I'm going to do, and that's exactly what I
15 want to do. But I want to, I want to see that you get
16 the proper medical attention.

17 DAVID: Okie doke.

18 HENRY: There's too many people that are
19 following you that, you know, they want to see the
20 right thing done here.

21 DAVID: Okie doke.

22 HENRY: Okay?

23 DAVID: All right.

24 HENRY: Okay. Well, I'll call you back in
25 about 15 minutes.

1 DAVID: Okay. Could you get one of the
2 nurses, Jeff?

3 HENRY: Okay. And are --

4 DAVID: And bring the blood pressure?

5 HENRY: Okay. And, and continue to, to as
6 best as you can to finish to your work on the tape.

7 DAVID: All right. Will do.

8 HENRY: Okay. I'll call you back in a
9 little bit.

10 DAVID: Thanks.

11 HENRY: Okay. Bye.

13 SCOTT: Hello?

14 HENRY: David?

15 SCOTT: No, this is Scott.

16 HENRY: Scott, is David there?

17 SCOTT: Yes, he is.

18 HENRY: May I speak to him, please?

19 SCOTT: Is this Henry?

20 HENRY: Yes.

21 SCOTT: Okay. Hold on.

22 HENRY: Thank you, Scott.

23 SCOTT: David, it's Henry. (Unidentified
24 male voices in background not discernible.)

25 [*gap*]

1 SCOTT: We're going to let you speak to the
2 nurse first, okay?

3 HENRY: Oh, okay, good.

4 [gap]

5 JILLIAN: Hello?

6 HENRY: Hello?

7 JILLIAN: Hello?

8 HENRY: Hello?

9 JILLIAN: You'd like to know Mr. Koresh's
10 feelings, his condition?

11 HENRY: Yes.

12 JILLIAN: Well, his blood pressure is to 85
13 over 40. His pulse is 60. Just a little irregular.

14 HENRY: Um-hum.

15 JILLIAN: And his temperature is normal.
16 His color -- he's drinking all right. He's passing
17 water all right. And his condition is just stable.

18 HENRY: Okay. Now is he bleeding a lot? Is
19 he losing a lot of blood?

20 JILLIAN: Well, he was losing a lot. But
21 now it has subsided.

22 HENRY: Okay.

23 JILLIAN: Yes. Only when, when on
24 movements.

25 HENRY: Okay. Do you know if any of the

1 major blood vessels were taken out?

2 JILLIAN: No. It doesn't seem likely.

3 HENRY: Okay. How about any vital organs?

4 JILLIAN: It doesn't seem as any vital
5 organs have been damaged.

6 HENRY: Okay. Okay. You would recommend
7 that he get medical attention, would you not?

8 JILLIAN: Well, just a minute please.
9 David?

10 UNIDENTIFIED MALE SPEAKER: David.

11 JILLIAN: David, I highly recommend medical
12 attention. What (indiscernible). What would I say?
13 He's asking me whether you need medical attention.
14 (Unidentified male voices in background not
15 discernible.) Yeah. Well, at the moment, we don't
16 think it's necessary.

17 HENRY: Okay. What time exactly did you
18 take the, the blood pressure?

19 JILLIAN: I've only just taken it about 3
20 minutes ago.

21 HENRY: Okay. And what is your name?

22 JILLIAN: My name is Jillian Matthew.

23 HENRY: Okay, Jillian. If you would, see 85
24 over 40 is a little bit, you know, is a little bit of
25 a concern. So I would like for you to take it like

1 maybe in another half hour or so.

2 JILLIAN: Um-hum. All right.

3 HENRY: Okay?

4 JILLIAN: Yes.

5 HENRY: Okay. May I speak to him?

6 JILLIAN: All right. You -- like to speak
7 to you.

8 DAVID: Yeah.

9 HENRY: You're holding up, huh?

10 DAVID: Yeah. But she said it was a
11 miracle.

12 HENRY: Yeah. Yeah.

13 DAVID: I got to -- like I said, you know,
14 you got a, got a strong will you got a strong will.

15 HENRY: Um-hum. Well, that's real good.
16 We're happy to hear that. I have a bit of a concern.

17 DAVID: Uh-huh.

18 HENRY: Okay? And the concern that I have
19 is, you know, when these children are coming out they
20 are all convinced that they're not going to see their,
21 their mamas again or their daddies. Okay? Now you
22 gave me your word --

23 DAVID: Now wait a minute. Now you're
24 making a statement, you're making a statement which is
25 totally contrary to everything those children with

1 reasoning powers have been taught. Scripturally
2 you're denying what they themselves have sit and heard
3 day by day.

4 So I know point blank that, you know, you
5 have not asked them in regards to whether they're
6 going to see their parents again. Because the whole
7 doctrine revolves around, you know, Isaiah 49 where it
8 says I will save thy children referring to the
9 covenants. And you know, they, they know all of these
10 or at least are aware in conversational-wise children
11 that age usually do not have a conscience to discern
12 or understand, you know, the high points of doctrine
13 or philosophy.

14 But no, the thing of it is that, you know,
15 every one of these mothers tell them well, I'll see
16 you soon. So I don't know why you're saying that,
17 Henry.

18 HENRY: Well, I'm not, I'm not questioning,
19 you know, your word. You know, I just --

20 DAVID: Well, I mean how -- you know, by, by
21 your statement it implies that you're just making a
22 statement. But the question lies is did you really
23 ask them?

24 HENRY: Well, see, for example. One of the
25 kids, you know, came out with a note that says that,

1 that his name is Joshua and that he's 7 years old and,
2 you know, it lists all the different people that, you
3 know, I guess are relatives of --

4 DAVID: Relatives. Correct.

5 HENRY: Okay.

6 DAVID: And we've, and we asked, we asked
7 Jim originally. We said look, Jim. Because we --
8 first of all, our children don't eat pork.

9 HENRY: Okay.

10 DAVID: Okay? Now whether you all uphold
11 that or not we, we cannot really guarantee that. But
12 come to find out instead of calling the -- because I
13 understand it may take a day or two in some cases.
14 But instead of calling the present closest relative,
15 you all, you all have gone ahead and put them down at
16 the social place.

17 HENRY: Um-hum. Um-hum.

18 DAVID: You know, and which, you know, like
19 I say that's kind of really neither here nor there at
20 this point in time. You know, I've trusted Jim. I, I
21 would think that he would be smart enough not to
22 consider these children, you know, worthy of a foster
23 home or something like that. Because that would
24 strictly violate the reasons why that, you know, most
25 of these women and stuff would be coming out in the

1 first place.

2 HENRY: Okay.

3 DAVID: I mean they don't want to be judged
4 or considered that they're unworthy of motherhood.

5 HENRY: Um-hum.

6 DAVID: Or you know, having their children,
7 you know, because of an incident such as we're in at
8 the present time.

9 HENRY: Uh-huh.

10 DAVID: I mean that's another thing of trust
11 again. Because like I say, maybe that's what you're
12 going to do. Maybe that's not what you're going to
13 do. You know, we don't know as of yet. Like I say,
14 you know, in my case I realize that, you know, I'll,
15 I'll never see my children again, you know? Because,
16 you know, I understand through, through many, many
17 observations and through much history research, you
18 know, how the government works and stuff. Like I say,
19 I will dance to the music that I, I have played to.
20 You see what I'm saying?

21 HENRY: Um-hum.

22 DAVID: Okay. But the main thing is for me
23 to stand up in front of my Father, my God, and to
24 present a truth that he gave to me. Because there's
25 one reality that's above all realities. And that is

1 when the powers that control the universe, you know,
2 when those other worlds and those other beings out way
3 beyond, when they come and communicate to you, you
4 know.

5 HENRY: Um-hum.

6 DAVID: A lot of people have a very
7 Elizabethan ideal of God. You understand?

8 HENRY: Um-hum.

9 DAVID: They think God's got a beard and
10 wears a robe and, and not a very smart, you know, it's
11 kind of old, you know, traditional old English or, you
12 know. God is very high-tech. God's got computer
13 systems and technology above and beyond what this
14 world's ever seen.

15 HENRY: Um-hum.

16 DAVID: I know Harry, you see.

17 HENRY: Um-hum.

18 DAVID: In 1985 like I said I had a little
19 visit when I was in Israel. I've always been a
20 sincere guy like Randy will tell you, you know, if you
21 ever interview Randy. He knows I used to always tell
22 him as a kid that, you know, there's got to be a God.
23 And all my life I've, I've had this calling, this,
24 you know, these -- anyway. But never mind.

25 But the thing comes down to this. There's a

1 test in latter days. And it's a test of human
2 intelligence. And all that which is human that is not
3 going to use its intelligence. I don't mean in
4 regards to bureaucratic law.

5 HENRY: Um-hum.

6 DAVID: You see, remember that two
7 individuals that are into bureaucratic control --

8 HENRY: Um-hum.

9 DAVID: -- can cause millions of people to
10 go to war.

11 HENRY: Um-hum.

12 DAVID: A hothead like Hussein and a hothead
13 like -- oh, my mind, let's see here. The Cuban guy,
14 Castro.

15 HENRY: Uh-huh.

16 DAVID: See just their, their one decision
17 can cause many men to go and lose their lives, right?

18 HENRY: Right.

19 DAVID: Well, see you might call that a
20 political thing.

21 HENRY: Um-hum.

22 DAVID: But it really it's, it's, politics
23 is another form of religion.

24 HENRY: Um-hum.

25 DAVID: You see. It denies a deity, a

1 sovereignty. But still it has its principles --

2 HENRY: Um-hum.

3 DAVID: -- its philosophies and its -- well,
4 not theology. It's I guess humanology (sic). Its
5 Utopianistic views.

6 HENRY: Um-hum.

7 DAVID: Okay. So the point that we finally
8 come around to is this. If you were in Israel and you
9 was confronted with, you know, something from beyond
10 this world, something that, you know, confronted you
11 and communicated with you and told you what you must
12 do and showed you things such as you have never
13 dreamed. See I used to stutter all my life. I was a
14 stutterer.

15 HENRY: Um-hum.

16 DAVID: I stammer all through school. Had a
17 speech problem. You know?

18 HENRY: Uh-huh.

19 DAVID: But after that event, I never
20 stuttered again.

21 HENRY: Uh-huh.

22 DAVID: But like I say, we have to, we have
23 to realize that, that in today's world with such
24 modern technology everywhere we, we have to look at
25 old truths of the Bible --

1 HENRY: Um-hum.

2 DAVID: -- in a modern way.

3 HENRY: Um-hum.

4 DAVID: And the modern way is, is
5 computerized technology. Seven seals, what is it?
6 You know, data program. In other words, what mind of
7 man can be able to categorize all the testaments of
8 the prophets and put it together into seven
9 categories. See now that's technology.

9 HENRY: Uh-huh.

10 DAVID: And the thing of it is it's called
11 wisdom.

12 HENRY: Um-hum.

13 DAVID: And scripture teaches us that if we
14 fail to be interested in this riddle, then the worlds
15 that are beyond our world are going to destroy all
16 those whose attitude have shown that they have not
17 chosen to increase and grow in wisdom.

17 HENRY: Um-hum.

18 DAVID: See, the prophecies themselves may
19 be allegorical.

19 HENRY: Um-hum.

20 DAVID: They may be just little stories.
21 But nonetheless, it still is a test.

22 HENRY: Um-hum.

1 DAVID: You know, when you're, when you're a
2 little kid and they send you to a psychiatrist don't
3 they put, tell you to put these little blocks in this
4 little block thing there? And you got to shape up,
5 match up the sizes?

6 HENRY: Right.

7 DAVID: Okay. Well, the same as this last
8 revelation. We have such pious and powerful men in
9 the world. Such power. Look at the Pontiff.

10 HENRY: Um-hum.

11 DAVID: You notice how powerful that
12 religious man is?

13 HENRY: Um-hum.

14 DAVID: I mean no one questions the, the
15 history and origin of the papacy.

16 HENRY: Um-hum.

17 DAVID: I mean it killed millions. The
18 Jesuit priesthood for those who went against its
19 infallible laws. The eucharist, the catechism. All
20 the, all the thousands and thousands of newborn babes
21 they found in the catacombs, you know, and under the,
22 the chapels and stuff that they put in the lime pits.
23 Of course, we always thought that the virgin and the
24 priest never did anything, right?

25 HENRY: Um-hum.

1 DAVID: Yeah, but we find out later that
2 there evil things were being done under a cloak.

3 HENRY: Um-hum.

4 DAVID: And Martin Luther rose up against
5 it. And how did he overthrow that system? With
6 truth.

7 HENRY: Um-hum.

8 DAVID: A Bible truth.

9 HENRY: Um-hum.

10 DAVID: So today we, we have a truth, a
11 Bible truth. But it's not going to overthrow just the
12 papacy.

13 HENRY: Um-hum.

14 DAVID: It's going to, you know, bring all
15 the world into a valley of decision. People are going
16 to have to hear it. They're going to have to say to
17 themselves well, you know, that's right. That is
18 right. That is exactly what is being said in harmony.
19 And that, that does agree.

20 HENRY: Um-hum.

21 DAVID: Then they're going to wonder, well,
22 I wonder who this guy really is?

23 HENRY: Um-hum.

24 DAVID: Well, the thing of it is is that I'm
25 going to let you in on a secret about Christ, okay?

1 HENRY: Okay.

2 DAVID: Anyone that God chooses to place his
3 power and spirit in no matter to what degree that
4 spirit is all have the same spirit of the one and only
5 living God.

6 HENRY: Um-hum.

7 DAVID: So what I'm saying is I'm saying
8 that the spirit of Elijah is no more different than
9 the spirit of Moses or the spirit of Daniel or the
10 spirit of Hosea. Because these men as men can do
11 nothing of themselves. Because all of these prophets
12 had the spirits of Christ.

13 HENRY: Um-hum.

14 DAVID: So Christ did not come in person
15 except he came in the person of his messengers.

16 HENRY: Um-hum.

17 DAVID: And the power of heaven strengthened
18 these men and enlightened these men and gave these men
19 gifts of knowledge and understanding to speak in
20 behalf of Christ.

21 HENRY: Um-hum.

22 DAVID: Which is the true living God, the
23 word of God. Otherwise, you know, you can't put 2
24 ounces of faith in man. It's impossible.

25 HENRY: Um-hum.

1 DAVID: So anyway.

2 HENRY: Okay.

3 DAVID: Okay. Let me get back to this tape.

4 And what was, what was the question again? You was
5 wanting, you was wanting to know something else.

6 HENRY: Well, one of the things that, that
7 we have a concern about, of course, is the kids.
8 We're hoping and we're, we're certain that we want
9 them to be reunited with their families. We can count
10 on that.

11 DAVID: Yeah, well, we realize also, and I
12 was discussing it with some of the people here that,
13 that, you know, once we go out there's going to be,
14 you know -- now we realize our butts are in trouble.
15 There is some extensive research that has to be done,
16 you know. Someone is responsible for the deacement
17 (sic) of law enforcement officers.

18 HENRY: Um-hum.

19 DAVID: You know. I'm, I'm hopefully they
20 say on the news that it shows clearly in regards to
21 when the officers first approached it shows, you know,
22 who fired first. Because I was standing right there
23 in the door. And I know, you know, that no fire came
24 from our side first.

25 HENRY: Okay.

1 DAVID: You see. But the thing of it is is
2 that my only hope would be for that is that, is that
3 those, those cameras actually were zooming in enough
4 on that front door.

5 HENRY: Um-hum.

6 DAVID: To show just exactly. Of course,
7 what I heard one guy comment was is that, you know,
8 somebody saw somebody there with a firearm. And so
9 once they saw the firearm that, that's a sign to go
after it, right?

10 HENRY: Um-hum.

11 DAVID: Isn't that, isn't that a ATF rule or
12 law? I mean if, if you all walked into a place, and a
13 guy's standing there with a gun, you know, I mean
14 that's, that's what you got to do. You got to draw
out, right?

15 HENRY: Well --

16 DAVID: So that's probably where our problem
17 came from.

18 HENRY: Um-hum.

19 DAVID: But you know, I had my head and part
20 of my body sticking out that door. I was actually
21 standing in the door there and I, I waved out. And
22 that's probably all on film too. And says, you know,
get out of here. There's women and children. Let's

1 talk. Let's go. Get out. You know so --

2 HENRY: Um-hum.

3 DAVID: -- you know I hope they --

4 HENRY: Well, one of the things that
5 concerned us was that one of the mothers said to one
6 of the kids I'll see you on the other side. So you
7 know, we were, we just wanted to make sure --

8 DAVID: Well, now remember too that, that
9 this was probably stated before we got this previous
10 arrangement going. Like I said before, nobody wants
11 to die.

12 Now but here's the thing. We cannot trust
13 you people. Nobody that has really had any experience
14 with the federal government can 100 percent trust the
15 federal government. Because like even with yourself
16 or with Jim, we see that you guys are not the boss.
17 You know, and the thing of it is is that there's just
18 too many voices and too much influence.

19 You know, I've -- let me back up and say one
20 thing. I've been very pleased thus far at how, you
21 know, Jim and yourself have, you know, guaranteed that
22 they haven't come in and punched us out yet.

23 HENRY: Um-hum.

24 DAVID: You see. I'm -- I respect that very
25 much. I, I appreciate that. You know, I thank God

1 for that that, you know, under the circumstances that
2 you have borne with me.

3 HENRY: Um-hum.

4 DAVID: You know. So this gives the
5 confidence, you know. Because this is a great nation,
6 America, and it should be, you know, more considerate
7 and more intelligent in regards to these things.

8 HENRY: Um-hum.

9 DAVID: Okay. So now this gives me more
10 liberty to entrust myself in the hands of this system,
11 you know, for you guys to be able to help drive this
12 situation out of the mud. You know, this is like a
13 four-wheeling truck. And we're all in it and we're
14 stuck. You know, and we all have to drive this thing
15 out.

16 HENRY: Okay.

17 DAVID: And that's what I'm saying. I'm
18 saying if you guys play right we're going to play
19 right.

20 HENRY: Okay.

21 DAVID: I do not believe that how this got
22 started was right. But I was not going to, you know,
23 allow after all the things have been said about me
24 allow myself to just stand back and sit back and allow
25 the system to come in and, you know, push, push me

1 around. I can't do that.

2 HENRY: Um-hum.

3 DAVID: You see, I cannot have the message
4 of truth to be stifled that, that easy.

5 HENRY: Um-hum.

6 DAVID: But you know, you guys, you and Jim
7 have been very, very considerate, very kind. Not at
8 all like, you know, the aftermath of -- there's,
9 there's a BATF video out on you guys. It's called
10 "Breaking the Law in the Name of the Law."

11 HENRY: Um-hum.

12 DAVID: I'm sure you've seen that. Of
13 course, like I say, you know, it's, it's not meant to
14 ultimately degradate you. But it's, it just simply
15 shows that people are human, okay?

16 HENRY: Um-hum.

17 DAVID: On both sides. So anyway. I guess
18 I've said enough. And no. You, you tell the children
19 that, you know, we've been letting them out little by
20 little to see what you all's reaction was going to be.
21 Because they've been saying on the radio all the time
22 that you all are fixing to hit us tonight. You know.

23 HENRY: Well, no, we --

24 DAVID: And Jim's been telling me that's not
25 true.

1 HENRY: We've never had that plan. You
2 know, we --

3 DAVID: So I've, I've been balancing it out
4 on both sides.

5 HENRY: Okay.

6 DAVID: Because like I say I have to stand
7 in a position to where if you do hit us tonight --

8 HENRY: No.

9 DAVID: -- you're going to, you're going to
10 be guilty of killing little children.

11 HENRY: Exactly.

12 DAVID: And the thing of it is is that
13 that's why in the beginning I made it very plain -- I
14 stood in the door there, you know. And that's not
15 very fun with a bunch of professionals, you know,
16 coming at you. And I tried to tell them, holler best
17 I can let's talk about this. I tried to talk to
18 Robert Gonzales first, you know.

19 HENRY: Um-hum.

20 DAVID: And you know. I saw him on news
21 here. But I think it's very cheesy in his behalf,
22 very, very cowardish (sic) to be staying out of the
23 light now. Because he could have -- and you tell him
24 this. He could have stopped all of this.

25 HENRY: Um-hum.

1 DAVID: You know, his conscience is probably
2 eating him up.

3 HENRY: Um-hum.

4 DAVID: So anyway.

5 HENRY: Okay.

6 DAVID: Okay. I'm sorry. So --

7 HENRY: That's okay. I just want -- yeah, I
8 just want to feel real good about this. And I want to
9 feel good that everybody is going to be coming out
10 alive.

11 DAVID: Well, that's what we want.

12 HENRY: Okay. Including you.

13 DAVID: Oh, I'm, I'm still here.

14 HENRY: Okay. Nobody's going to commit
15 suicide.

16 DAVID: No. I don't think anyone's going to
17 commit suicide.

18 HENRY: Nobody's going to be coming out with
19 guns so that somebody can shoot at them.

20 DAVID: Nobody's going to be coming out
21 playing John Wayne.

22 HENRY: Okay. Well --

23 DAVID: I mean have -- I mean are we letting
24 our children out? I mean, you know, are the children
25 gone -- do the children look like they've been abused

1 or neglected?

2 HENRY: No. No.

3 DAVID: Okay. So do they act abnormal
4 except the one child because it was born that way. It
5 was --

6 HENRY: Um-hum.

7 DAVID: -- a medical misinterpretation. You
8 know, the doctor didn't quite diagnose something
9 right --

10 HENRY: Um-hum. Um-hum.

11 DAVID: -- and it affected the child. But
12 are you happy with the children so far?

13 HENRY: Yes. Yes.

14 DAVID: Do they look like they're raised
15 strange, abnormal?

16 HENRY: No. No. They look just fine. I
17 just, you know, because of your concern and because
18 everybody's concerned that and, and primarily your
19 concern that you not be considered just another cult
20 leader. You know, and because of the sincerity that
21 you've expressed during our negotiations, you know, I
22 believe in, in the things that you've said. I believe
23 that when you've given me your word, you know, you've,
24 you've stuck to your word. And I want to feel good
25 about, about this situation. And I'm holding you to

1 your word.

2 DAVID: Well, just like Jim said that. And,
3 and like I say in our past experience together we've
4 seen it's been more shadowy on your side than it's
5 been on mine.

6 HENRY: I understand.

7 DAVID: I mean I've kept -- just like the
8 other night Jim told me not to deal with anybody else
9 but him. And we made an --

10 HENRY: Um-hum.

11 DAVID: -- an agreement. And then, you
12 know, another guy came along. And, and then all of a
13 sudden da, da, da, da, da. You know, he -- we, we --
14 he was very forceful and very strong. And when
15 someone's going to play forceful and strong to me,
16 then I'm going to play forceful and strong back.

17 HENRY: That makes sense.

18 DAVID: You see, but if someone's going to
19 sit down and say look, I'm willing to give you, you
20 know, 50 percent of the chips, and I'll take 50
21 percent of the chips, and we'll play this card game
22 fair.

23 HENRY: Um-hum.

24 DAVID: Then you know, when the chips are
25 all on your side then I'll, I'll fold up. You know,

1 it's a fair game.

2 HENRY: Okay.

3 DAVID: And that's, that's the way, that's
4 the way I've always been. It's the way I've always
5 taught the doctrine that was given to me.

6 HENRY: Okay.

7 DAVID: And this is the way the truth has to
8 be.

9 HENRY: Okay. One of the things that I, you
10 know, that I had a concern about, and you don't have
11 to give me the specifics on this. But you know, when
12 we've talked about the number of children that are
13 within the compound, we've never had a real good idea.
14 And you don't need to tell me that. But I feel --

15 DAVID: Well, ask the children that are
16 there, you know. Of course, like I say they don't
17 probably know either. But just ask them if there's a
18 lot more children. That's all you have to do.

19 HENRY: Yes. But that -- I'm -- that's,
20 that's not the point here. And, and the point is I
21 just want you to feel comfortable, you know. In terms
22 of if I ask you something I'm, you know, I'm asking
23 you man to man. And if you say this or that or the
24 other, that's fine. Or if you say look, I don't want
25 to tell you for this reason that's fine. I can accept

1 that --

2 DAVID: Right.

3 HENRY: That's --

4 DAVID: You're being very courteous. But
5 when it really comes down to it, you're talking to me
6 agent to criminal. That's what we're talking here,
7 okay?

8 HENRY: No. I'm not talking to you agent to
9 criminal.

10 DAVID: No. But realistically that's what
11 it is.

12 HENRY: What I'm --

13 DAVID: I have violated in all appearances
14 the codes of the United States of America's law.
15 That's why -- now your job is to, to deal with my mind
16 and to try in your best ability to come to some
17 feasible conclusion of how we can settle or resolve
18 our problems or differences. Now because of this
19 situation, you know, I am the one in trouble, you're
20 not. Okay.

21 Now your courtesy I'm being very responsive
22 to, because I realize I am in trouble, and I realize
23 what the future holds for me even when I give myself
24 up to you. You know, I don't know to what degree is
25 going on my body right now, but nonetheless, I don't

1 think I have to really worry too much about that
2 because, you know, when I give myself over to you I
3 still have to keep my mind on God. Because, you know,
4 whatever I receive from the judicial system of
5 America, you know, that's what I receive.

6 HENRY: Okay. But --

7 DAVID: And if God doesn't deliver me out of
8 it then that's what I get.

9 HENRY: Um-hum.

10 DAVID: And it's to the Lord's great wishes.

11 HENRY: Um-hum.

12 DAVID: But like I say the point is this.
13 Everybody's going to know the importance of the seals
14 then, aren't they?

15 HENRY: Exactly.

16 DAVID: Thanks to you.

17 HENRY: Well --

18 DAVID: And that's very commendable.

19 HENRY: And thanks to you, too. But I want
20 you to -- I don't want you to look at me as just
21 somebody that's looking to you as a criminal. I'm
22 looking to, to ensure as best as I can that you and
23 everybody that's within the compound gets out alive.
24 And that these --

25 DAVID: Right.

1 HENRY: -- children have an opportunity and
2 that your mission and your cause because you're so
3 devoted to it if you tell me look, this is what I want
4 to do to guarantee all of these people's lives, then
5 I'm with you. I'll work with you as hard as I can.

6 DAVID: Right. Well, that's what, that's
7 what I was telling Jim earlier. I was telling look,
8 Jim, I've got a plan.

9 HENRY: Okay.

10 DAVID: And the first thing I told him was
11 is this. I said Jim, I said look. I've been hit, and
12 I get -- I've been getting weak. I says I'll tell you
13 what. You let me just lay here and let me die. I
14 says and give these people time to think.

15 HENRY: Um-hum.

16 DAVID: Because I won't influence them.

17 HENRY: Right. I remember that.

18 DAVID: And I says and once I'm dead, then
19 they're going to be sitting around here, and they're
20 going to be thinking, you see, and I'll be gone.
21 There will be no more influence. And that way they
22 can make decisions on their own. See, that's what I
23 was first telling Jim.

24 HENRY: Um-hum.

25 DAVID: You know. And Jim says no, no, no.

1 Of course, the other option is, is that if, if they
2 don't give us time for the people to make these
3 decisions, you know, then it's always going to stay in
4 the light that well, as long as I'm the leader they're
5 going to do what I say. But that's not the way this
6 program is operated.

6 HENRY: Uh-huh.

7 DAVID: That's the way it appears, you know.
8 And it's true on that tape I did scream and I did
9 call some people some stupid idiots. But if you do
10 the whole story --

11 HENRY: Um-hum.

12 DAVID: -- of what somebody had done.

12 HENRY: Um-hum.

13 DAVID: You don't mingle this truth with
14 people that do perverse sins.

15 HENRY: Um-hum.

16 DAVID: Now there's a reason why somebody
17 just like Christ -- anyway, Christ called the
18 disciples fools, didn't he?

18 HENRY: Um-hum.

19 DAVID: Not that he was hating them, but
20 because they had done some foolish things.

21 HENRY: Exactly.

22 DAVID: But the point is this. What I need
23

1 to do now is I need to buckle down and I need to, you
2 know, I had some, just a little bit of chicken soup
3 here. And --

4 HENRY: Okay. Have you had any?

5 DAVID: Oh, yeah. I had a little bit and --

6 HENRY: Okay.

7 DAVID: And I need to readjust myself here
8 and start doing this tape.

9 HENRY: Okay.

10 DAVID: I've been going through these
11 different tape machines. The, the big tape machine
12 we, we have some trouble with, because it uses a AKG
13 phantom powered mike.

14 HENRY: Um-hum.

15 DAVID: And we haven't been able to find it.
16 And the guys are kind of worried about turning on the
17 lights in the building in case, you know, somebody --
18 you know how it is. You know?

19 HENRY: If you tell me that you're going to
20 turn the lights on, you can go ahead and turn the
21 lights on. Nothing's going to happen. You know.

22 DAVID: Yeah, because --

23 HENRY: I can advise the people that the
24 lights are going to go on because we're working on
25 something.

1 HENRY: Hello. This is Henry Garcia. Who
2 is this?
3 RITA: This is Rita.
4 HENRY: I'm sorry?
5 RITA: Rita.
6 HENRY: Rita?
7 RITA: Uh-huh.
8 HENRY: Is David around?
9 RITA: Yes, he is. One moment, please.
10 HENRY: Thank you, Rita.
11 [gap]
12 DAVID: Oh, wait.
13 HENRY: I'm sorry?
14 DAVID: Had earplugs in.
15 HENRY: How you doing?
16 DAVID: Oh, we're, we're getting this thing
17 done.
18 HENRY: Okay. Great. How far along are
19 you?
20 DAVID: I should, I should have it
21 completely done by 6 o'clock.
22 HENRY: Okay. How's your -- did anybody
23 take your blood pressure again?
24 DAVID: The, the -- she said the doctor was
25 supposed to, to call up again. I don't remember.

1 Did, did she take my blood pressure again?

2 HENRY: Well, I asked her to.

3 DAVID: Oh, yeah. Okay. Yeah, that's
4 right. I'm sorry. I got my mind involved on this --
5 where did she -- oh, that's -- where did she go? I
6 guess she went to bed.

6 HENRY: Oh, okay.

7 DAVID: Could you, could you check down
8 there and see what she said? Stable?

9 UNIDENTIFIED MALE SPEAKER: Stable, yes.

10 DAVID: What's that? Oh, stable. She said
11 stable.

12 HENRY: Okay. So it's pretty much what it
13 was before.

14 DAVID: It was pretty much where it was
15 before? (Unidentified voice in background not
16 discernible.) Okay. Yeah.

16 HENRY: What --

17 DAVID: She said yeah.

18 HENRY: What about your temperature?

19 DAVID: We didn't, we didn't check my
20 temperature. It's pretty chilly here, though. I
21 don't, I don't --

21 HENRY: Okay.

22 DAVID: Yeah.

1 HENRY: What about your color, skin color?

2 DAVID: Hey, Scott, what do I look like?

3 SCOTT: You look fine.

4 DAVID: I don't look pale or anything?

5 SCOTT: No.

6 DAVID: Can you see? It's kind of dark in
7 here. Oh, don't make me laugh. Let's see. Well, I,
8 you know, like I say she didn't tell me that, you
9 know, what my skin color looks like.

9 HENRY: Okay.

10 DAVID: I look at my arm. It don't look too
11 bad.

12 HENRY: Okay. And, and your breathing is
13 normal?

14 DAVID: Well, I mean -- well, I can't take
15 very deep breaths because --

16 HENRY: Okay.

17 DAVID: -- you know, it gets down into the
18 area that kind of very sensitive.

19 HENRY: Okay.

20 DAVID: Okay? So okay now. Matter of fact,
21 I was recording when the phone rang, so I have to back
22 up a bit and kind of delete that out. Also I had, you
23 know, a couple or three babies crying. I had to re-
24 edit over that too.

1 HENRY: Okay.

2 DAVID: So you know it's -- don't want to
3 get too much, I don't want to get that in the tape.

4 HENRY: Okay.

5 DAVID: Okay?

6 HENRY: You mentioned that it's a little bit
7 colder, that you're a little bit cold.

8 DAVID: Well, all our windows are gone right
9 now.

10 HENRY: Oh, okay. But you don't feel like
11 your, like your skin is clammy or anything like that.

12 DAVID: No. It's -- I'm under, I've got
13 about, about three or four blankets on me.

14 HENRY: Oh, okay.

15 DAVID: From my, basically from my chest
16 down. And plus I got that big sheet tied in a knot
17 and, you know, around the wounded areas.

18 HENRY: Okay.

19 DAVID: So --

20 HENRY: Okay.

21 DAVID: What, what happened?

22 HENRY: No, I was clearing my throat.

23 DAVID: That was a, was a gunshot? What?

24 (Unidentified voices in background not discernible.)

25 HENRY: No, I was --

1 DAVID: Oh, something dropped. Okay.

2 HENRY: Oh, okay. We want to ensure, you
3 know, that, that you get what, what we say that, that
4 you're going to get and that we get what, what you say
5 we're going to get so --

6 DAVID: Right.

7 HENRY: Could we have you dictate or, or
8 just give us a preamble indicating what you hope is
9 going to happen with the tape and, and then say
10 that --

11 DAVID: Well, I can put that on the tape too
12 if you want.

13 HENRY: Okay. And then --

14 DAVID: Okay. And that way everybody hear
15 it.

16 HENRY: Okay, good. And then say that, that
17 after the, after the, after you finish the tape that,
18 that we've agreed, you know, to have the --

19 DAVID: Everybody comes out.

20 HENRY: Yes. And then that you agree that
21 everybody's going to come out.

22 DAVID: Right.

23 HENRY: Okay. Now --

24 DAVID: But you're going to -- like I say
25 when, when you bring the guys up here remember -- I

1 know, I know they're paramedics. I know they're
2 really good. But like I say I, I don't -- I haven't
3 taken no, no alcohol, no drugs, no aspirin. Nothing.
4 You know, I don't, I don't really believe in that
5 unless it's extreme emergency and, and it's just this
6 state that I'm in right now under the conditions I
7 haven't taken any of those things.

7 HENRY: Okay.

8 DAVID: So I mean I've been sitting in this
9 one position and it's everything I, I can do just to,
10 to like every once in a while I got to like just move
11 my legs like an inch this way, inch that way. My, my
12 toe bone is like (groaning). I, I can't describe it.
13 It's, it's like it's numb.

13 HENRY: Now are you perspiring?

14 DAVID: No, I'm not perspiring.

15 HENRY: Okay.

16 DAVID: No, because it's like I say. Rita,
17 how cold do you think it is right now? (Unidentified
18 voices in background not discernible.)

18 HENRY: See, one of the things is if with
19 all the blankets that you have you should be
20 perspiring a little bit under the blankets, you know?

21 DAVID: Well, no, I, I -- as far as the
22 blankets are concerned it's I just, I feel warm.

1 HENRY: Okay.

2 DAVID: And I'm not perspiring.

3 HENRY: Okay.

4 DAVID: And besides my, from my around my
5 waist and my, my rear end and my tailbone all that's,
6 it's basically numb except for the pain of trying to
7 move. And then, you know, the gut's kind of numb.

8 HENRY: Um-hum.

9 DAVID: Except if I try to make any
10 immediate moves.

11 HENRY: Um-hum.

12 DAVID: So you know, it's just -- now as far
13 as my hands and all that I can feel that they're cold.
14 I have the wound on my left hand which the bullet,
15 you know, kind of chopped me in the left of my wrist.

16 HENRY: Um-hum.

17 DAVID: And my thumb is dead. You know,
18 it's just like it don't, it's not there.

19 HENRY: Uh-huh.

20 DAVID: Of course, I'm looking now I, I
21 let -- the bullet just took a clean, just a real clean
22 gash right out of it. You know, just like -- it's
23 weird. Just, just passed right, just took skin and
24 it's neat and everything just right out. So I, I just
25 left it kind of open, you know. And it didn't --

1 HENRY: Um-hum.

2 DAVID: And it bled for a long time. My, my
3 whole left side of my shirt's all blooded. But it
4 finally stopped bleeding then it --

5 HENRY: Um-hum.

6 DAVID: -- it's just like a big old crevice
7 there, you know?

8 HENRY: Yeah. But you still have a good
9 mental outlook. You can concentrate and --

10 DAVID: Oh, yeah. This, this truth is
11 everything. I mean --

12 HENRY: Okay.

13 DAVID: Like I say, when you hear this tape
14 you'll realize that --

15 HENRY: How, how much of the tape do you
16 have going?

17 DAVID: Oh, we've got, we've got more than
18 half of it.

19 HENRY: Okay.

20 DAVID: Like I said I've had -- first of
21 all, we had trouble getting the tape machine going.
22 You know how it is. And then I've, I'm trying to keep
23 the thing right up to my mouth.

24 HENRY: Um-hum.

25 DAVID: We had to -- we're using a high bias

1 tape. But we had to go down to like a more of a mid-
2 range compact Panasonic.

3 HENRY: Okay.

4 DAVID: Which the heads are good heads on
5 it. You know, it still, it can be quite legible for,
6 you know, a radio.

6 HENRY: Okay.

7 DAVID: Of course, they can also mix it too.

8 HENRY: Um-hum. Can you play a little bit
9 just so I can see how it sounds?

10 DAVID: Yeah, let me back up here.

11 [gap]

12 DAVID: Sounds a little higher than what my
13 voice is but --

13 HENRY: Okay.

14 DAVID: This is a small speaker. Can you
15 hear that?

16 (Playing following from tape.)

17 ...last living disciples on the Isle of
18 Patmos being a prisoner for the word of God and for
19 the testimony of Jesus Christ which no doubt are the
20 things Jesus has to say which would probably be quite
21 controversial to the things that the Pharisees and
22 Sanhedrin of the day had to say we're sure. He being
23 on this Isle of Patmos, a prisoner on a Lord's day had

22 space them at a long enough distance to where and you

2 guys will come out, and I'll have them hold their
3 hands up.

4 HENRY: Okay. And single file.

7 HENRY: Um-hum.

8 DAVID: Their hands up. And, and -- well,
9 do you have like --

10 HENRY: We can turn --

11 DAVID: -- warm vehicles and stuff like
12 that?

13 HENRY: What we'll do is we'll, we'll turn
14 on the lights, and they can walk towards the lights.
15 And then we'll have people, you know, ready to, to
16 assist them once they get to, to the cars.

17 DAVID: All right. Now when's this, now
18 when's this tape going to be played again?

19 HENRY: As soon as you, as soon as you send
20 it out we're going to, you know. Now do you want to

22 we get --

25 HENRY: Okay.

1 DAVID: Because you said I could also, you
2 know, decide what time that I want this thing played.

5 HENRY: -- we want to play it as soon as we
6 can so we can get everybody out.

7 DAVID: Well, the thing of it is though is
8 that I want to make sure it's played during prime
9 time.

10 HENRY: Well, we --

11 DAVID: So people can hear it.

12 HENRY: -- we can do that. And absolutely
13 we will do that.

14 DAVID: Okay then. All right then. But
15 we --

16 HENRY: But we want, but we want, we want to
17 start getting this thing, you know, we want to try to
18 bring this --

19 DAVID: I'm aware. I realize.

20 HENRY: Okay. So as soon as -- what we'd
21 like to do is we'd like to get everybody out as soon
22 as possible. So --

23 DAVID: Well, now see there again is where
24 you're, you know, you're, you're coming up over on top
25 of me --

1 HENRY: I'm not -- no.

2 DAVID: -- and you're saying, you're saying
3 all right now, Dave. We're going to do this, this and
4 this. But we want you to, to, you know, in other
5 words, you know, this is like commercialization. It's
6 like well, I paid \$3 wholesale for this thing. And
7 you paid \$2 wholesale for that thing. And I want to
8 sell this thing to you at more profit than what I want
9 to get for yours. I mean --

9 HENRY: No. I want this to, I want --

10 DAVID: -- what I'm, what I'm saying is, is
11 that -- like today they were broadcasting all over TV.
12 And since the FBI is involved, you know, when they
13 cut our lines. But they started saying all kinds of
14 things on the radio that was not true. You know. And
15 the deal of it was --
