1 (start Tape 14)

2 JIM: -- daughter. How old is she?

3 RACHEL: She's 5. They're both ready to
4 have a birthday pretty soon.

5 JIM: Oh, that's great. That's great. Star
6 and Cyrus. Okay.

7 RACHEL: Hold on a second.

8 JIM: Okay.

9 [gap]

10 RACHEL: Okay. I'm back.

11 JIM: Hey, listen. Let me tell you the rest
12 of this way this thing's going to go so you're clued
13 in. You know, I can tell David later. But what we're
14 going to do later is we're going to get -- we've got
15 buses, okay?

16 RACHEL: Um-hum.

17 JIM: We've got like four buses out on the
18 highway.

19 RACHEL: Um-hum.

20 JIM: And we're going to take those buses
21 and some of these, you know, bulletproof vehicles and
22 move them all together up so you, you can walk to
23 them.

24 RACHEL: And when are you going to do that?

25 JIM: Well, not now. Not until after the

1 broadcast.

2 RACHEL: Okay.

3 JIM: Or maybe during the broadcast. But
4 just -- I want to let you know that's going to happen.

5 RACHEL: Okay.

6 JIM: You know --

7 RACHEL: How many buses again?

8 JIM: I think we got four.

9 RACHEL: Four buses?

10 JIM: We're not sure about that. I mean
11 we're just, you know, trying to get the number of
12 people. From the number of people you just gave us,
13 we're trying to work out, you know, what size bus, how
14 many seats, you know.

15 RACHEL: And where are they going to move
16 them to? In front of the gate or --

17 UNIDENTIFIED MALE SPEAKER: We're not sure
18 exactly. But they just have to go over to the buses.

19 RACHEL: -- down the road in front of our
20 property or where?

21 JIM: Yeah. No, they won't be on your
22 property.

23 RACHEL: Somebody sitting in front of the
24 property on the road there or --

25 JIM: (Unidentified male voice in background

1 not discernible.) Well, what they'll probably be is a
2 little bit away. Like you'll come out your driveway
3 onto Double E Ranch Road.

4 RACHEL: Um-hum.

5 JIM: And then you'll, you'll walk left a
6 little while. Just walk to where you see them.
7 You'll see them as soon as you turn. But we're just
8 going to put them down the road a little bit.

9 RACHEL: Okay.

10 JIM: Okay? That's just for your safety,
11 our safety.

12 RACHEL: Okay.

13 JIM: And you just can walk right to where
14 those buses are.

15 RACHEL: Okay.

16 JIM: I'd say how far down the Double E
17 Road?

18 RACHEL: Uh-huh.

19 JIM: Probably you know, about as, little
20 longer than your driveway. It's not going to be that
21 bad.

22 RACHEL: Okay.

23 JIM: You know. That's a hard road anyway
24 so.

25 RACHEL: Yeah.

1 JIM: I think that will be the, the best way
2 to do it.

3 RACHEL: Okay.

4 JIM: If we try to do it with shuttling
5 cars, it's just too many folks.

6 RACHEL: It's -- yeah.

7 JIM: And it takes too long and --

8 RACHEL: Yeah, it does.

9 JIM: You know, between you and me, I mean
10 we'd, we'd like to do it as soon as we can for David.

11 RACHEL: Right.

12 JIM: And then also if we do it some other
13 technique, we get as many folks in the daylight, you
14 know. Of course, you guys we trust you. And I think
15 by now you trust that we're --

16 RACHEL: Yes.

17 JIM: -- we just want to get everybody out
18 of there.

19 RACHEL: Yeah. We appreciate what you're
20 doing for us. My son wants to talk to you.

21 JIM: Okay, sure. Put him on.

22 RACHEL: Okay.

23 CYRUS: Hi.

24 JIM: Cyrus?

25 CYRUS: Yeah.

1 JIM: This is Jim. How are you?

2 CYRUS: Fine.

3 JIM: Listen, you're going to come out of
4 there soon, aren't you, with your mom?

5 CYRUS: What?

6 JIM: You're -- how you doing?

7 CYRUS: Fine.

8 JIM: Yeah. What are you playing in there?

9 CYRUS: Yeah.

10 JIM: What are you doing? Tell me what
11 you're doing.

12 CYRUS: Nothing much.

13 JIM: Nothing much? Don't you have a game
14 you can play? Are you watching TV?

15 CYRUS: No.

16 JIM: No? You playing with your brothers
17 and sisters maybe, huh?

18 CYRUS: We don't have a movie.

19 JIM: You don't? Do you have your brothers
20 and sisters with you?

21 CYRUS: Yeah.

22 JIM: Is Star there with you?

23 CYRUS: Yeah.

24 JIM: Yeah. Is she, she playing with you?
25 What's your favorite thing to do? Huh? What's

1 your --

2 CYRUS: I don't know.

3 JIM: What's your very favorite thing to
4 eat?

5 CYRUS: Healthy fruit. Healthy, healthy
6 food.

7 JIM: Healthy food?

8 CYRUS: Yeah.

9 JIM: That's real good, healthy food.
10 You're going to be big and strong when you grow up.

12 CYRUS: What?

20 Yeah. Yeah. You're smart. You're smart. How old
21 are you?

22 CYRUS: Seven.

23 JIM: Seven. Oh, you must -- you sure
24 you're not older than that? You sound pretty smart
25 for that.

1 CYRUS: I know I'm 7.

2 JIM: Oh, you're 7, yeah. Yeah. Well,
3 that's great. So what else do you like? Tell me
4 something else you like. Do you like horses?

5 CYRUS: What?

6 JIM: You like horses?

7 CYRUS: Yeah.

8 JIM: Cowboys?

9 CYRUS: Yeah.

10 JIM: Yeah. Uh-huh. What else?
Spaceships?

11 CYRUS: Yeah, I love spaceships.

12 JIM: You love spaceships. You like to see
13 those guys that get shot to the moon, those astronauts
go to the moon?

14 CYRUS: Yeah.

15 JIM: You want to be one of those when you
16 grow up?

17 CYRUS: Yeah.

18 JIM: Yeah? An astronaut? That would be
fun, wouldn't it?

19 CYRUS: I wouldn't want to be one of them
20 though.

JIM: Okay. You got it. Okay --

DAVID: Because you know, you know, like I say they're, you know they're, they're jittery a little bit, you know. So let me just make sure they all know about it, all right?

JIM: Yeah. It's not coming -- just tell them this. It's got no gun on it. It's not coming in the driveway.

DAVID: Right. Well, we're, we're going to explain so --

1 JIM: Just going to drop the stretcher.
2 DAVID: Okay. So talk to my little boy
3 again.
4 JIM: Yeah, okay.
5 DAVID: I just want to make sure, you know,
6 before they come that we, we have --
7 JIM: Yeah, that --
8 DAVID: -- another 10 minutes or so so we
9 can --
10 JIM: Yeah, that's real smart.
11 DAVID: -- send it around.
12 JIM: That's real smart.
13 DAVID: Okay.
14 JIM: Let me talk to Cyrus.
15 DAVID: Thanks. (Unidentified voices in
16 background not discernible.)
17 JIM: He's going to go around telling
18 everybody. Cyrus?
19 [gap]
20 RACHEL: Hello?
21 JIM: Rachel?
22 RACHEL: Oh, I just want to make sure I
23 didn't get -- wait a minute.
24 JIM: You okay? How's that phone doing?
25 RACHEL: Yeah. It's, it's just that we're

1 kind of cramped up around here so --

2 JIM: Yeah.

3 RACHEL: -- sometimes it gets unhooked.

4 JIM: Yeah.

5 RACHEL: Now you -- nobody seems to be aware
6 that I have three children.

7 JIM: Oh. Cyrus, Star, and what's the other
8 one?

9 RACHEL: Bobbie.

10 JIM: Bobbie. Okay. How old is Bobbie?

11 RACHEL: She is -- March. She's 14 months
12 old.

13 JIM: Fourteen months. Okay. Good. That's
14 great. Okay. Well, you'll have to just carry her you
15 know.

16 RACHEL: Um-hum.

17 JIM: You just take them. You just tell the
18 mothers with the babies to just bring, take, carry
19 them themselves.

20 RACHEL: Okay.

21 JIM: And if you have, you know, some that
22 have two or small ones they, the other mothers can
23 help.

24 RACHEL: Okay.

25 JIM: And we'll try to arrange some kind of

1 car seat if we can.

2 RACHEL: Okay.

3 JIM: But Cyrus said he likes astronauts.

4 RACHEL: Oh, yeah. He -- yeah, he does.

5 JIM: That's neat.

6 RACHEL: Okay. He wanted to talk to you
7 some more.

8 JIM: Okay. Okay.

9 CYRUS: I'm here again.

10 JIM: Hey. What are you going to tell me
11 about those astronauts?

12 CYRUS: What?

13 JIM: What are you going to tell me about
14 those astronauts?

15 CYRUS: I don't know about them.

16 JIM: You don't?

17 CYRUS: No. I only have books, books of
18 them.

19 JIM: You do?

20 CYRUS: Yeah.

21 JIM: Do you have good pictures?

22 CYRUS: About the planets.

23 JIM: About the planets. Yeah.

24 CYRUS: Yeah. And outer space.

25 JIM: Oh, that's neat. You can get to see

1 those stars at night from your house?

2 CYRUS: Yeah.

3 JIM: You can? Do -- can you see them real
4 good?

5 CYRUS: Yeah.

6 JIM: Yeah. Did you ever see the moon?

7 CYRUS: Yeah.

8 JIM: You did? Yeah. Okay.

9 CYRUS: Where are you at?

10 JIM: I'm at -- I'm over here at the
11 airport.

12 CYRUS: Oh.

13 JIM: Yeah. It's about 8 miles from you.

14 CYRUS: How could I be able to go to you,
15 see you?

16 JIM: Well, you'll get to see us later.
17 Later on. You're going to come out later on. That's
18 what David and Rachel told me.

19 CYRUS: You'll come out what?

20 UNIDENTIFIED MALE SPEAKER: You'll come out
21 later on. He wants to know --

22 JIM: Yeah. Yeah. Cyrus?

23 CYRUS: Yeah?

24 JIM: Yeah. I'll come out later on. You --

25 CYRUS: Oh.

1 JIM: Okay?

2 CYRUS: Yeah.

3 JIM: Yeah. But did you have your lunch
4 today?

5 CYRUS: No, not yet.

6 JIM: Didn't have your lunch? Okay. What's
7 your favorite thing to have for lunch?

8 CYRUS: Sometimes we have salad and, and
9 beans and coleslaw and stuff like that.

10 JIM: Stuff like that.

11 CYRUS: And burritos.

12 JIM: Yeah --

13 CYRUS: We, we eat a lot of stuff.

14 JIM: Oh, you do?

15 CYRUS: Yeah.

16 JIM: Um-hum. Do you eat breakfast
17 sometimes?

18 CYRUS: Yeah, sometimes we eat chips and
19 Cheetos.

20 JIM: Um-hum. Did --

21 CYRUS: And chicken.

22 JIM: Well, that's good.

23 CYRUS: And hamburgers.

24 JIM: Hamburgers. Hey did, did you --

25 CYRUS: And ice cream and french fries.

1 JIM: Oh, that's good. I saw you had some
2 go-carts out there.

3 CYRUS: Yeah, we do have go-carts.

4 JIM: Yeah, did you ever ride on one of
5 them?

6 CYRUS: Yeah.

7 JIM: Are they fun?

8 CYRUS: We, we have motorcycles too.

9 JIM: Motorcycles too? That's pretty neat.

10 CYRUS: I have one too.

11 JIM: You do? What kind is it?

12 CYRUS: It's a -- what kind is it?

13 RACHEL: Is it a Yamaha?

14 JIM: A what? A big one?

15 CYRUS: Huh?

16 JIM: Is it a big one?

17 CYRUS: No, it's small.

18 JIM: Small for your size, huh? Yeah,
19 that's good.

20 RACHEL: Suzuki 50 ccs.

21 CYRUS: It's a Zuki -- it's a Suzuki what?

22 JIM: Suzuki.

23 CYRUS: It's a Suzuki 50 ccs.

24 JIM: Oh, that's really neat. What color is
25 it?

1 CYRUS: What color is it?
2 JIM: Yeah.
3 CYRUS: It's yellow.
4 JIM: Yellow Suzuki. Wow. You're a big guy
5 you can ride that.
6 CYRUS: I know.
7 JIM: That's really nice.
8 CYRUS: It's fun.
9 JIM: It's fun. I'll bet you go pretty
10 fast, don't you?
11 CYRUS: Yeah.
12 JIM: Yeah. But you don't want to get hurt
13 now. You got to be careful.
14 CYRUS: I know.
15 JIM: Right?
16 CYRUS: Yeah.
17 JIM: Because we don't want you to be hurt.
18 We want you to be safe. Okay?
19 CYRUS: Yeah.
20 JIM: Okay. And you know that. We, we want
21 you to be safe, okay?
22 CYRUS: Yeah.
23 JIM: Okay. Is your mom doing okay?
24 CYRUS: Yeah.
25 JIM: Okay.

1 [gap]

2 CYRUS: (Indiscernible.)

3 JIM: Huh? Where did David go?

4 CYRUS: David? He's over here.

5 JIM: Oh, is he, is he talking to everybody?

6 CYRUS: Huh?

7 JIM: Is he talking to everybody?

8 CYRUS: Who's talking to everybody?

9 JIM: David.

10 CYRUS: He's just laying there.

11 JIM: He's just laying there. Oh, Rachel's
talking to everybody. Yeah.

12 CYRUS: What?

13 JIM: Is your, your mom's not there, is she?

14 CYRUS: Yeah, my mom's here. My mom's here.

15 JIM: Oh, is she? Let me talk to her.

16 CYRUS: Okay. (Mimicking his mother.) Yes,
I'm here.

17 JIM: Rachel?

18 CYRUS: No, that was just me.

19 JIM: Oh. Is Rachel there?

20 RACHEL: He's a big joke.

21 JIM: (Laughing.)

22 RACHEL: He was laughing because he was
pretending to be me.

1 JIM: Oh. Yeah, I know. Is, is -- did
2 David go to tell everybody, or did you send somebody
3 to --

4 RACHEL: Yeah. They're -- they went to pass
5 it around to all the guys.

6 JIM: Okay, good.

7 RACHEL: To everybody.

8 JIM: Yeah. So once you tell me that
9 everybody's got the word, then we will send it, okay?

10 RACHEL: Okay.

11 JIM: But I won't send it until you tell me
12 that everybody knows.

13 RACHEL: Okay. Let me, let me see. We
14 don't know if they all know yet. Wants to know if
15 (indiscernible).

16 JIM: I'm going to tell them to turn that
17 radio on. It's 1.

18 UNIDENTIFIED MALE SPEAKER: I think they're
19 going out to get (indiscernible).

20 RACHEL: He says (indiscernible).

21 JIM: Yeah. Hey, Rachel?

22 RACHEL: Did you say something?

23 JIM: Yeah. Turn that radio on now, because
24 it's almost 1:06.

25 RACHEL: Okay.

1 JIM: That's 1010 AM.

2 RACHEL: Okay.

3 JIM: Go ahead. I'll hang on.

4 RACHEL: 1010. Channel 1010 they're going
5 to announce it. (Unidentified voices in background
6 not discernible.)

7 RADIO: -- through KRLD.

8 RACHEL: Can you hear it?

9 RADIO: Obviously our activities over the
10 last couple of days have been a question --

11 RACHEL: (indiscernible) were saying --

12 RADIO: -- and it has been a difficult time
13 for us. We're trying to make decisions oftentimes by
14 the seat of our pants --

15 JIM: You got a radio?

16 RADIO: We are --

17 JIM: At 1:06.

18 RADIO: -- in receipt of some material --
19 (Radio continues playing, intermittently discernible.)

20 RACHEL: I think they just -- did they just
21 announce it on KRLD?

22 JIM: I think they did.

23 RACHEL: When I turned it on they said from
24 David to the world or something.

25 JIM: Yeah. At 1:30, right?

1 RACHEL: I didn't hear the time, because I
2 just turned it on. I didn't hear them say the time.
3 I probably missed it.

4 JIM: Yeah. The, the two stations will do
5 it at the same time.

6 RACHEL: Okay.

7 JIM: At 1:30. But when you -- they may be
8 saying we're -- they should be saying we're going to
9 do it. And I think that's what they just said.

10 RACHEL: Um-hum. You already ate. See if
11 she wants some more. (Unidentified voices in
12 background not discernible.)

13 [*gap*]

14 RACHEL: It's really kind of hard to tell
15 where 1010 is. Because we haven't been listening to
16 it, and I don't have an exact dial on my --

17 JIM: Oh, really.

18 RACHEL: -- radio here. If I knew what
19 was --

20 JIM: Well, you could --

21 RACHEL: -- playing right now then I would
22 know.

23 JIM: What are they playing right now?

24 RACHEL: Yeah.

25 JIM: Can you get us a radio so we can --

1 she's having trouble tuning it in. If she knew what
2 they were playing now. This is Rachel. Okay, just a
3 minute. I'm going to see if I can get one. Maybe
4 I --

5 RACHEL: Okay. Watch your sister. You ate
6 already.

7 [gap]

8 JIM: Yeah, radio is what I need. No.
9 Okay. Just an AM radio. Rachel, I don't have a
10 radio. So I can't tell you what they're saying.

11 RACHEL: Oh, you don't? Okay.

12 JIM: But it is a Craig Smith show.

13 RACHEL: Sorry?

14 JIM: Craig Smith. He's the guy on the
15 Christian Broadcast Network. It's his program.

16 RACHEL: Uh-huh. Okay.

17 JIM: That's on. So you might see if you
18 could pick that up. They should be just talking now,
19 so it wouldn't be music.

20 [gap]

21 RACHEL: Oh, yes. I'll see if someone else
22 can get it. Can you get it? Can you get it?

23 JIM: Yeah, I wanted --

24 RACHEL: No, but (indiscernible).

25 (Unidentified male voices in background not

1 discernible.) Well, I guess he wants to listen to it
2 on KRLD anyway.

3 JIM: Yeah, it's the same --

4 RACHEL: It's the same thing.

5 JIM: The same thing, yeah.

6 RACHEL: One, one person has it on 1010.

7 JIM: Okay, good. So now you --

8 RACHEL: We've got a few radios around here.

9 JIM: Okay, good. They got one person --
10 hold on. (Unidentified voices in background not
discernible.)

11 [gap]

12 RACHEL: What's she doing?

13 [gap]

14 JIM: I can hear some radio back there,
Rachel. Is that KRLD?

15 RACHEL: Hello? What?

16 JIM: Is that KRLD I'm hearing?

17 RACHEL: Oh, from here?

18 JIM: Yeah.

19 RACHEL: Yes.

20 JIM: Yeah. Okay. Are, are you guys, are
21 you guys upstairs or downstairs? Are we going to have
trouble getting David down these stairs or anything?
22 Rachel?

1 RACHEL: Hello?

2 JIM: All right. Is David upstairs or down?
3 I mean are you going to have trouble getting him
4 downstairs or anything?

5 RACHEL: No, it shouldn't be a problem.

6 JIM: Okay. Bet you guys are tired, aren't
7 you?

8 [gap]

9 RACHEL: Do all the guys know
10 (indiscernible)? Does every know? (Unidentified
11 voices in background not discernible.) So everyone
12 knows? (Unidentified voices in background not
13 discernible.) Make sure everyone knows.

14 They say everyone knows, but we're going to
15 double check on that.

16 JIM: That's real smart. That's --

17 RACHEL: Just make sure everybody does know.

18 JIM: That's real smart. That's real good.
19 Yeah, go ahead and do it. I don't want anybody to
20 not understand, you know?

21 RACHEL: Just a minute. Someone else wants
22 to talk to you.

23 JIM: Okay.

24 DAYLAND: Hello?

25 JIM: Hello? Is this Star?

1 DAYLAND: Yeah.

2 JIM: How are you?

3 DAYLAND: How are you?

4 JIM: Well, I'm doing real good. Are you
5 feeling okay?

6 DAYLAND: Yeah.

7 JIM: Oh, good. I'm glad. You going to
8 come out soon --

9 DAYLAND: Yeah.

10 JIM: -- with your mommy, aren't you?

11 DAYLAND: Yeah.

12 JIM: Good. We'll get to see you when you
13 come out, okay? You be good for your mom, now, and
14 you help her.

15 DAYLAND: Yeah.

16 JIM: Okay? You promise me?

17 DAYLAND: What?

18 [gap]

19 JIM: I want you to help your mom, okay?
20 Will you do that?

21 DAYLAND: Yeah.

22 JIM: Okay. You be good.

23 DAYLAND: Okay.

24 JIM: All right. See you later.

25 DAYLAND: Yeah.

1 JIM: Okay, bye.
2 DAYLAND: Bye.
3 NICOLE: Hello?
4 JIM: Hey.
5 NICOLE: Hello?
6 JIM: Is that Star?
7 NICOLE: No. This is Dayland's mother.
8 JIM: Oh, whose mother?
9 NICOLE: Dayland's mother.
10 JIM: Oh, Damon.
11 NICOLE: You just spoke to Dayland on the
12 phone.
13 JIM: Yeah. How are you doing?
14 NICOLE: Sorry?
15 JIM: What's your name?
16 NICOLE: Nicole.
17 JIM: Okay. Are you doing okay?
18 NICOLE: Yeah. Fine.
19 JIM: All right. Good. Has Rachel told you
20 what's going on?
21 NICOLE: Yeah.
22 JIM: Okay. Just hang in there and trust
23 us, and everybody's going to be fine, okay?
24 NICOLE: We really appreciate what you're
25 doing.

1 JIM: Well, that's all right. We appreciate
2 you guys working with us, and we'll just settle this
3 all real quiet and peacefully, you know, for the kids
4 and you guys, okay? So that's --

5 NICOLE: Okay.

6 JIM: -- what we're going to work out. So I
7 just want you to hang with us, and don't get upset
8 when you see any of these vehicles. We've got --
9 one's got to bring a stretcher for David and, you
10 know.

11 NICOLE: Um-hum.

12 JIM: Don't be upset or anything, okay?
13 We're -- just trust us and we'll, we'll all get out of
14 this together.

15 NICOLE: Um-hum.

16 JIM: Okay?

17 NICOLE: Okay.

18 JIM: Do you have any other children?

19 NICOLE: Yes. I have a --

20 JIM: How old --

21 NICOLE: -- I have a little girl.

22 JIM: How old is she?

23 NICOLE: She's 1.

24 JIM: One. What's her name?

25 NICOLE: Pagis (phonetic sp.).

1 JIM: Pagis. Okay. And how old's Damon?

2 NICOLE: Dayland is 3.

3 JIM: Three. Okay.

4 NICOLE: You've probably heard about them
5 anyway. My parents have flown in from Australia.

6 JIM: Oh, yeah. That's right.

7 NICOLE: Bruce and Lisa Gent (phonetic sp.).

8 JIM: Yeah.

9 NICOLE: Lisa's not my real mother. But my
10 dad, Bruce Gent.

11 JIM: Yeah. Okay. They're coming in.
12 Well, you'll want to be reunited with them. That will
13 be great.

14 NICOLE: Sorry?

15 JIM: That, that's a long flight. When will
16 they get here?

17 NICOLE: They're already here.

18 JIM: Oh, they are? Okay.

19 NICOLE: Yeah.

20 JIM: Well, that's good.

21 NICOLE: I've heard that they're concerned
22 from the radio. We listen to the radio.

23 JIM: Oh, well, that's great. That's super.
24 I'm glad. That's, that's great.

25 NICOLE: Okay.

1 JIM: When was the last time you were in
2 Australia?
3 NICOLE: The last time?
4 JIM: Yeah.
5 NICOLE: Let me think. Probably 4 years ago
6 now.
7 JIM: Oh, I'll bet you miss seeing it, don't
8 you?
9 NICOLE: Australia?
10 JIM: Yeah.
11 NICOLE: Well, I got a book that's got
12 better things to see in it, and I'm holding on to
13 that.
14 JIM: That's good. I've never been to
15 Australia.
16 NICOLE: You haven't?
17 JIM: Been to London a couple of times
18 and --
19 NICOLE: Nah.
20 JIM: But it's not the same, is it?
21 NICOLE: No.
22 JIM: (Laughing.)
23 NICOLE: No.
24 JIM: Not quite the same.
25 NICOLE: No.

1 JIM: London's too crowded.

2 NICOLE: That's what I've heard.

3 JIM: It's --

4 NICOLE: Have some English people here.

5 JIM: Yeah.

6 NICOLE: Yeah.

7 JIM: It's, it's different, you know.

8 NICOLE: Yeah.

9 JIM: I knew a girl that was from Australia
10 and she just, she just loved it.

11 NICOLE: Yeah.

12 JIM: All the wide open space and all those
13 beaches and --

14 NICOLE: Oh, it's not that good.

15 JIM: No?

16 NICOLE: No. There's a lot of desert there
17 now.

18 JIM: Oh, the outback?

19 NICOLE: Yeah, center the coastal -- it's
20 only around the edges of coastal. The center is very
21 dead and arid and dry and hot. It's not that good.

22 JIM: Do you ever see any of those kangaroos
23 down there?

24 NICOLE: Oh, yeah. The big reds, yeah.

25 JIM: Do you really?

1 NICOLE: Yeah.

2 JIM: Yeah.

3 NICOLE: They're -- yeah. I've seen them in
4 jumping, you know. You drive through the country and
5 you see them.

6 JIM: Oh, that's neat.

7 NICOLE: Yeah.

8 JIM: Koala bears and wallabies and all that
9 stuff?

10 NICOLE: Yeah, I've seen all them. I've
11 held a koala bear.

12 JIM: You have?

13 NICOLE: They've got sharp claws.

14 JIM: You mean they're, they'll, they'll
15 actually hold you?

16 NICOLE: Well, this was when I was about 10
17 years old at a park up in Queensland. I was with my
18 grandfather, and they gave me a koala bear to hold
19 with my brother.

20 JIM: Well, that's kind of neat.

21 NICOLE: So.

22 JIM: You're the first person I ever talked
23 to that held a koala bear.

24 NICOLE: (Laughing.)

25 JIM: I think that's neat. Don't they have

1 big claws on them or something?

2 NICOLE: Yeah. Very big claws. Big black
3 claws.

4 JIM: But they won't scratch you, will they?

5 NICOLE: You got to be careful.

6 JIM: Really.

7 NICOLE: This one was pretty tame. But they
8 can get pretty wild.

9 JIM: Yeah. Wow, that's -- yeah. Hold on a
10 minute. Hold on a minute, Nicole.

11 NICOLE: Okay. (Unidentified male voice in
12 background not discernible.)

13 [gap]

14 JIM: You okay?

15 NICOLE: Yeah.

16 JIM: How you feeling? Are you, are you in
17 pretty good spirits?

18 NICOLE: Yeah.

19 JIM: You sound okay.

20 NICOLE: Yeah. I'm okay. I'm fine.

21 JIM: Good. Well, just --

22 NICOLE: Feeling a bit shaky, you know.

23 JIM: I know. And listen.

24 NICOLE: Their coming in like that, you
25 know? They just came in. I mean there was no warning

1 or anything. I look out my window. I see them coming
2 in. I look out my window again, they jump out, and
3 they just started shooting.

4 JIM: Oh, I know. Well, listen. That's,
5 that's the past. And now we're dealing with --

6 NICOLE: That was scary.

7 JIM: -- the future.

8 NICOLE: (Shuddering.)

9 JIM: I know. But we're just concerned
10 about you. And, and we're going to work this all out.
11 And I'm just concerned how you're feeling now?

12 NICOLE: Now, yeah. I'm fine now. Then.

13 JIM: Yeah. And you know, just keep that
14 good attitude and be positive. Because we're going to
15 all walk through this. And Damon and Pagis and you
16 together, okay?

17 NICOLE: Yeah.

18 JIM: And, and everybody in there.

19 NICOLE: Yeah.

20 JIM: Everybody in there. And all together
21 with David. And we're going to all work this out.
22 And we've all made those agreements. And --

23 NICOLE: Yeah.

24 JIM: -- we're all going to stick by it,
25 okay?

1 NICOLE: Well, I hope so, you know.

2 JIM: Now you know you can trust me.

3 NICOLE: Well, yeah.

4 JIM: Well, you ask David or Steve or
5 Rachel.

6 NICOLE: No, I know you -- I've been
7 observing. I've been here listening and seeing, and
8 David's happy to deal with you.

9 JIM: Yeah. Well, we're just being straight
10 with each other.

11 NICOLE: Yeah. You've been good.

12 JIM: Yeah. And so that's what I'm saying.
13 Just, just stick with me.

14 NICOLE: Okay.

15 JIM: And if you have any worry, just know
16 Jim's telling you the way, the right way. And I'm,
17 I'm -- there's no tricks, okay?

18 NICOLE: No.

19 JIM: Okay. I'm just going to, you know,
20 just want everybody to walk out quietly and
21 peacefully. I hope it stopped raining. I --

22 NICOLE: Oh, it's nice here.

23 JIM: Is it nice? Oh, good. I'm in a room
24 with no windows.

25 NICOLE: Sorry?

1 JIM: I said I'm inside a room --

2 NICOLE: Oh, you, oh, you --

3 JIM: -- an office that doesn't have any
4 windows.

5 NICOLE: Oh, it's very -- it's sunny
6 outside.

7 JIM: Oh, good.

8 NICOLE: I don't know if it's hot or cool or
9 whatever. It was cold last night. But it's -- it is
10 very sunny outside.

11 JIM: Oh, well, that will be good. That
12 will be a good day. That's great.

13 NICOLE: David was just showing Dayland his
14 bullet hole in his, in his side part near his hip.

15 JIM: Yeah, it's near his hip, isn't it?

16 NICOLE: Yeah. It's in his hip.

17 JIM: Yeah. I know -- he told me he was
18 bleeding real bad out the, out the back.

19 NICOLE: It's, it's stopped -- it's in his
20 stomach. It's, it's in his stomach. It, it isn't
21 bleeding right now.

22 JIM: It isn't? Okay. You got some
23 bandages on the back?

24 NICOLE: He hasn't got anything on it.

25 JIM: Oh, really?

1 NICOLE: It's totally opened. And it's gone
2 straight through out the back.

3 JIM: Yeah.

4 NICOLE: Oh, he's got something on the back,
5 but not on the front.

6 JIM: Oh, I see. Yeah.

7 NICOLE: So --

8 JIM: The front's not bleeding then?

9 NICOLE: Well, he said it's bleeding
10 through. It's like, you know, draining out.

11 JIM: Out the back?

12 NICOLE: Out the back.

13 JIM: Yeah. And he got hit in the wrist too
14 he told me.

15 NICOLE: Yeah, he did.

16 JIM: Yeah. Okay.

17 NICOLE: It's --

18 JIM: Well, that should be okay.

19 NICOLE: It's got plenty of dry -- he's got
20 plenty of blood on him.

21 JIM: Yeah.

22 NICOLE: Dry -- everywhere.

23 JIM: Yeah. Well, that's okay. You know,
24 if his blood pressure holds. That's why where we --
25 that's, that's one of the reasons we want to move up

1 the stretcher now and, you know, do some preliminary
2 things.

3 NICOLE: Preliminary? What do you mean?

4 JIM: Well, because the message has got to
5 be played at 1:30. See and it, it lasts for an hour.

6 NICOLE: Uh-huh.

7 JIM: And then after that, you know,
8 everybody's going to start coming out. We're going to
9 make those arrangements.

10 NICOLE: So you got --

11 JIM: Well, I'm just trying -- I don't want
12 David to have to lay there any longer than, you know,
13 until after the message is played.

14 NICOLE: Uh-huh. So it's for an hour, huh?

15 JIM: Yeah. His message is an hour, yeah.
16 We're going to play it all.

17 NICOLE: Okay.

18 JIM: And then we want to start facilitating
19 everybody to come out, and we want him to get some
20 treatment.

21 NICOLE: Um-hum.

22 JIM: He needs to see a doctor with those
23 wounds. And everybody who has any.

24 NICOLE: They've got some pretty big tanks
25 out there.

1 JIM: Yeah. Oh, yeah. That's, that's not a
2 tank. It doesn't have any guns on it. It's just --

3 NICOLE: It's -- it looks like it's got a
4 gun part out the front of it.

5 JIM: No, it's -- but there -- we took the
6 gun off it.

7 NICOLE: Sorry?

8 JIM: We took the gun off it.

9 NICOLE: You took the gun off it?

10 JIM: Yeah. Um-hum. There's no gun on it.

11 NICOLE: Oh. Well, when I looked through, I
12 could see that the big barrel thing out the front of
13 it. And there's like six of them. I'm like whoa.

14 JIM: Oh, yeah. No, hey, Nicole. It's no
15 problem. It's -- don't worry about it. It's just,
16 just so they don't get shot. That's all it is.

17 NICOLE: Yeah. Okay. How are the other
18 kids doing?

19 JIM: They're doing good. I've been talking
20 with them and of course let them talk to their moms.
21 And these people here, ladies at Health Services have
22 been treating them like they're their own kids, you
23 know.

24 NICOLE: That's good. That's good.

25 JIM: And they're just real gentle with them

1 and giving them food and keeping them warm. And
2 they're doing great. All the kids are in great
3 spirits. I mean just super.

4 NICOLE: They're great kids. Our kids are
5 great, you know.

6 JIM: Oh, they are. They're well behaved.
7 And every one of them just as polite as they could be.
8 And none of them, not any of them were upset. I was
9 concerned that, you know, when they saw a few
10 policemen and agents they would get scared, you know?
11 But they didn't. And the agents made sure they were
12 real gentle. And then of course we gave them to the,
13 the ladies at the Health Services, you know?

14 NICOLE: They're special kids, you know.

15 JIM: Yeah, they're good kids. I'm telling
16 you. Good kids.

17 NICOLE: Well, David makes the most
18 beautiful babies in the world.

19 JIM: Yeah. That's right. Fourteen months
20 Bobbie, huh? What color hair does she have?

21 NICOLE: She's got blonde.

22 JIM: Oh. Is that like you too?

23 NICOLE: Sorry?

24 JIM: Do you have blonde hair too?

25 NICOLE: I don't, I don't have blonde hair.

1 JIM: No, you don't. She got it though,
2 huh?
3 NICOLE: Sorry?
4 JIM: What? Something happened to my line
5 there.
6 NICOLE: What happened?
7 JIM: I don't know. Somebody must --
8 NICOLE: What's going on with the line?
9 JIM: We've had trouble --
10 NICOLE: Is that your line? Oh, there it
11 goes.
12 JIM: Yeah, there it is. Okay.
13 NICOLE: It's okay. Yeah.
14 JIM: I got phone wire going along the floor
15 here. And I must have kicked it. I got a, you
16 know --
17 NICOLE: You know Dayland is David's?
18 JIM: Damon is David's child?
19 NICOLE: My son and my daughter belong to
20 David.
21 JIM: Oh --
22 NICOLE: They're David's children.
23 JIM: Your son and your daughter are David's
24 children.
25 NICOLE: Yeah.

JIM: Okay. It's, it's not there yet. Okay. I just thought it might have got there but --

NICOLE: Someone just looked, and they said it's not there yet.

JIM: Okay. Well, we'll wait until David checks with everybody.

NICOLE: Sorry?

1 JIM: I said David's going to check to
2 make -- you guy were double telling everybody, right?

3 NICOLE: We're triple, quadruple told
4 everybody.

5 JIM: Triple, quadruple. That's good.

6 NICOLE: Yeah. So --

7 JIM: So is it -- are we ready? Should we
8 send it or?

9 NICOLE: Should we, should we -- he's asked
10 should we send it? The stretcher.

11 DAVID: Yeah, if we could have it. And that
12 way I can, I can be sitting in it, you know, while I'm
13 listening.

14 NICOLE: He said --

15 DAVID: It's going to take a while to move
16 me.

17 NICOLE: He said yeah. And he can be put in
18 it while he's listening, you know, listening to the
19 tape.

20 JIM: Okay. That's, that's perfect. That's
21 great.

22 NICOLE: Because he said it will take a
23 while to get into it.

24 DAVID: (Indiscernible.)

25 NICOLE: Okay. I'm going to go. David

1 would like to speak to you.

2 JIM: Who would?

3 NICOLE: David.

4 JIM: Yeah, sure.

5 NICOLE: Okay?

6 JIM: Okay. Now tell everybody, pass the
7 word, we're sending the vehicle with the stretcher.

8 NICOLE: Okay.

9 JIM: And the vehicle will stay up you --
10 north of the driveway where you, on the road. It
11 won't be on your driveway. It will be on the road.

12 NICOLE: Behind the road?

13 JIM: No. It will be on the road.

14 NICOLE: On the road.

15 JIM: Where you can see it.

16 NICOLE: Okay.

17 JIM: But away from the -- you know, a
18 little north of the driveway.

19 NICOLE: A little more on the driveway.

20 JIM: Well, what they're going to -- never
21 mind. But it will be right at the driveway. It will,
22 it will move away.

23 NICOLE: Okay. We'll, we'll see it. I'm
24 sure we'll see it.

25 JIM: You'll see it. You'll see it. Okay.

1 NICOLE: Okay. We'll see you later.

2 JIM: Okay, Nicole.

3 NICOLE: Bye.

4 DAVID: Jim?

5 JIM: Hey, David.

6 DAVID: Yeah, like I say. When it's like,
7 you know, if we can get that thing here. Because like
8 it takes me a long -- I mean this thing like I said
9 went in through my --

10 JIM: It's coming right now, buddy. I just
11 sent it.

12 DAVID: Okay, stomach. But what it is I
13 think it fractured or busted into my hip bone.

14 JIM: Right.

15 DAVID: So when I move just a little bit
16 it's like, you know, painful. So and you know, the
17 better, the sooner we have that there it would give us
18 more time to --

19 JIM: You bet.

20 DAVID: -- you know, kind of inch by inch
21 into it.

22 JIM: Absolutely.

23 DAVID: Because I haven't taken no pain
24 pills or nothing.

25 JIM: Okay. Well, it's --

1 DAVID: So.

2 JIM: -- it's coming right now. It ought to
3 be there in just a few minutes.

4 DAVID: Okie doke. Thanks.

5 JIM: And then you tell one of your guys to
6 tell me when they see it and, and just tell me when,
7 you know, they'll -- it will move a little bit away
8 from the driveway up there to park.

8 DAVID: Okay.

9 JIM: It's just going to sit there and it
10 won't move.

11 DAVID: All right.

12 JIM: And, and nobody will come out of it.
13 And then you tell me and, you know, you can send two
14 guys to the driveway to get the stretcher.

14 DAVID: Okie doke.

15 JIM: Bring it back. And then in 5 minutes
16 your message is coming on.

17 DAVID: Okie doke.

18 JIM: In both channels so, you know, keep
19 that on.

19 DAVID: Oh, God bless you, Jim.

20 JIM: Are you, are you holding on for me.

21 DAVID: Oh, yeah.

22 JIM: Yeah. I talked to Nicole.

2 again that nobody on this side does anything stupid,
3 okay?

4 JIM: Okay. That's good. Real good.

5 DAVID: So let me -- I mean I'm, you know,
6 like I say -- what?

7 JIM: Yeah.

8 DAVID: Well, where's Neil at?

9 (Unidentified male voice in background not
10 discernible.) Okay. Here, talk to Rachel a minute,
11 okay, please?

10 STAR: Huh?

11 JIM: What's your name?

12 STAR: What?

5 Remember the Cookie Monster?

6 JIM: Do you have any cartoon books?
7 Picture books?

8 STAR: Ernie and Cookie Monster.

9 UNIDENTIFIED FEMALE SPEAKER: No. But it's
10 on that program. Big Bird. It's on the same show.
11 Ernie and the Cookie Monster. Remember?

12 STAR: Yeah. (Unidentified voices in
13 background not discernible.)

14 [gap]

15 JIM: Hey, J.D., can you switch to this
16 thing without cutting off?

17 J.D.: How about (indiscernible).
18 (Unidentified male voices in background not
19 discernible.)

20 STAR: I hear him talking off of the phone.

21 JIM: I think I have it. Hey.

22 STAR: Huh?

23 JIM: You still there?

24 STAR: Yeah.

25 JIM: Okay.

1 STAR: My mommy said are you gone?
2 RACHEL: No, I said (indiscernible).
3 JIM: No. No, tell her I'm here. Tell her

21 STAR: Yeah. (Giggling.)

1 checking with everybody.

15 kept saying what, what, what. I can't hear because
16 the telephone too -- the tape is too loud.

17 JIM: Oh, okay. Is Rachel there?

18 STAR: What?

19 JIM: Is, is your mommy there?

20 STAR: Yeah.

21 JIM: Let me talk to her.

22 STAR: Huh?

23 JIM: Let me talk to your mom.

24 STAR: Yeah. Mommy.

25 RACHEL: Hello?

1 JIM: Rachel?

2 RACHEL: Yes.

3 JIM: Are they playing the message?

4 RACHEL: They're -- yeah. Kind of like the
5 prefix so to speak.

6 JIM: Okay.

7 RACHEL: They're just saying that they have
8 the tape there, and I turned it down though, because
9 she said she couldn't hear you so.

10 JIM: Oh, okay. Well, you can turn it up.
11 Just turn it up and I'll hear it.

12 RACHEL: Okay.

13 RADIO (RICK): -- the compound. The FBI
14 agents then added onto the front of it 8 to 10 seconds
15 in which David Koresh agrees upon the broadcast of
16 this tape to come out peacefully with all persons
17 inside. And then there's a 4 second pause. And then
18 we get into the body of the 58-minute tape that was
19 sent out to the FBI agents. And Charlie, I guess if
20 you'll just tell me the, the, what the time looks like
21 and, and when it's time to roll the tape, we'll be
22 ready to go.

23 RADIO (CHARLIE): We've got a minute and 15
24 seconds by the, our studio clock here. And we'll go
25 by that. So if you can stand by, we'll give you a

1 | countdown as we get closer to it. Again, Rick, I want
2 | to thank you. I know it's been an incredibly
3 | stressful time for you there. And not knowing what
4 | was around the corner and having to face up to it in
5 | an incredibly professional manner. And I thank you
6 | for all your service. And, and you can have a couple
7 | of days off when we get out of this so you can catch
8 | up on your sleep. Because I plan to do the same. Can
9 | we ask one more question?

9 | RADIO (RICK): Sure.

10 | RADIO (CHARLIE): With the agreement that
11 | they will peacefully leave the compound, is it your
12 | understanding, Rick, that will be after the broadcast
13 | or during the broadcast when it begins?

14 | RADIO (RICK): I don't know, Bob. That's
15 | between the FBI negotiators and David Koresh. From
16 | the listening to the first few seconds of it I get the
17 | impression that once the broadcast starts, the
18 | peaceful surrender will begin. But that's just based
19 | on the words I heard.

20 | RADIO (CHARLIE): Okay.

21 | RADIO (RICK): Time will tell. It will,
22 | we'll have to depend on our reporters, and we'll have
23 | to qualify that so that people don't have
24 | expectations. That's an assumption on our part. We
25 |

1 really don't know. Having not been a party to the
2 negotiations, we cannot give you any certainty to the,
3 the contents of the tape. We need to do a legal ID
4 here, Bob. This is KRLD, Dallas-Fort Worth. It is
5 1:30.

6 RADIO: The tape you're about to hear was
7 given to KRLD news 42 minutes ago by two FBI agents
8 who came from the command post at the PSPI, the old
9 Connolly (phonetic sp.) Air Force Base
10 (indiscernible). (Radio continues playing,
intermittently discernible.)

11 RACHEL: Is someone confirming to them that
12 it's after the tape or --

13 JIM: The, the --

14 RACHEL: Because they think that it's, it's
15 going to begin after they start the tape not at the
end of the tape.

16 JIM: Well, no, it's after the end. Don't
17 worry about that. You and I work that out.

18 RACHEL: Okay.

19 JIM: Yeah.

20 RADIO: -- by the request of the FBI and
David Koresh at 1:30.

21 (Following is the tape being played over the
22 radio.)

1 TAPÉ: I, David Koresh, agree upon the
2 broadcasting of this tape to come out peacefully with
3 all the people immediately.

4 RADIO: Now we will have a few seconds
5 before the beginning of the 58 minute --

6 TAPÉ: March 2nd, 1993. My name is Dave
7 Koresh. I'm speaking to you from Mt. Carmel Center.

8 The first thing that I would like to
9 introduce in our subject is the reasons for the
10 revelation of Jesus Christ. In the Book of
11 Revelations, commentary states that what John has
12 written in scripture is nothing other than the
13 revelation of Jesus Christ which God gave to him to
14 show to his servants things which much shortly come to
15 pass. And he signified it, signified it by his angel
16 into service John. Now --

17 JIM: Rachel?

18 TAPÉ: John (indiscernible) --

19 JIM: Hello? Rachel?

20 TAPÉ: -- the record of God and the word of
21 Christ and of all things that he saw. In the first
22 chapter of Revelation, it says blessed is the man,
23 blessed is he readeth, and they that hear the words of
24 this prophecy, and those who keep the things that are
25 written therein: for the time is at hand.

1 (Indiscernible) John writes this to the
2 seven churches which are in Asia.
3 JIM: Rachel?
4 TAPE: Emphasis --
5 RACHEL: Yes.
6 JIM: Oh, I can hear him playing it. Can
7 you hear it?
8 RACHEL: Just a minute.
9 JIM: Right.
10 RACHEL: (Turns radio down.) Say that
11 again?
12 JIM: Can you hear the radio good?
13 RACHEL: Yes.
14 JIM: Okay.
15 RACHEL: Uh-huh.
16 JIM: When David comes back, put him on
17 right away.
18 RACHEL: Sorry?
19 JIM: When David comes back --
20 RACHEL: Uh-huh.
21 JIM: Or where is David, right there?
22 RACHEL: Yeah. He can't -- he's not
23 walking.
24 JIM: Yeah, all right.
25 RACHEL: Why, you want to talk to him?
