DAVID: -- Assyria, Nineveh, certain titles.

JIM: Uh-huh.

DAVID: But when you see the prophecies of Daniel, you see that Nebuchadnezzar is the first king that had an empire, world empire. He saw an image and this image was to depict every phase of human rulership down to the end of time. That's why the head was the head of -- Babylon, and the arms, which are part of the head, right --

JIM: Uh-huh.

DAVID: -- was made of Persia which meant that, meant that Persia was still Babylon, wasn't it?

JIM: Uh-huh.

DAVID: And Grecia was still made of Persia and Babylon, wasn't it?

JIM: Right.

DAVID: And Rome was still Greece, made of Persia and -- you know, when one nation rises up, I mean it incorporates all people, doesn't it?

JIM: Right.

1 DAVID: They're all mingled together, aren't
2 they?

3 JIM: Uh-huh.

4 DAVID: Well, that's what the whole image is
5 all about.

6 JIM: I see.

7 DAVID: It's about a nation or an empire of
8 all nations.

9 JIM: Uh-huh.

10 DAVID: Now, what nation do you know of in
11 the end of time, which will be a nation of nations?

12 JIM: Uh-huh.

13 DAVID: Do you know one?

14 JIM: A nation of nations?

15 DAVID: Yeah. Let me say a nation of
16 nationalities.

17 JIM: Israel?

18 DAVID: Nope.

19 JIM: I don't know.

20 DAVID: Well, what nation has more
21 nationalities than any other nation in one place?

22 JIM: America?

23 DAVID: Exactly. A nation that -- it comes
24 and it is built up from the nations. Daniel says, in
25 a nation where they'll mingle the seeds of men. And

1 from there, it spreads to all nations.

2 So, we have, like we say, red, black and
3 white, all aspects of every form of ancient political
4 government commingled into one network called the
5 United States of America.

6 JIM: Uh-huh.

7 DAVID: But the way Revelation 13 brings it
8 to view is that the prophet sees that although it's
9 powerful and dreadful, it still portrays the image of
10 a lamb, though it speaks as a dragon.

11 JIM: Uh-huh.

12 DAVID: And the Bible begins to explain to
13 us that there will come a time in the latter -- see,
14 we are subject to the laws of our nations.

15 JIM: Uh-huh.

16 DAVID: As God told Israel to Jeremiah that
17 when you go in amongst the heathen nations, you shall,
18 you know, you shall keep their laws and you shall
19 obey, you shall pray for the blessings of the city
20 where the Lord scatters you. Okay. So, you might
21 have peace.

22 JIM: Uh-huh.

23 DAVID: Okay. But there comes a time when
24 in the finality of all the empires a truth comes into
25 the world that determines or demands us to either keep

1 alliance to God and truth or to the dictates and laws
2 of man.

3 So, Jim, if you had a situation to where you
4 had to obey the laws of God or laws or man, which laws
5 would you keep?

6 JIM: Well, I'd try to keep both of them.

7 DAVID: Well, yeah, exactly, if they were in
8 harmony.

9 JIM: Uh-huh.

10 DAVID: 'Cause remember laws are really good
11 for us.

12 JIM: Uh-huh.

13 DAVID: You know.

14 JIM: Right. I understand.

15 DAVID: Yeah, but what if, what if one law
16 said -- what if the law of the State said you can't
17 keep the law of God?

18 JIM: All right. I understand.

19 DAVID: Which one -- what one would you have
20 to do?

21 JIM: Well, you have to do what's right by
22 your conscience.

23 DAVID: Yeah, okay. So, you'd probably keep
24 the law of God, if you understand, right?

25 JIM: Yeah, I would. Yeah.

1 DAVID: Okay, but you don't understand it,
2 though.

3 JIM: Right.

4 DAVID: Not the way we do.

5 JIM: Right, exactly.

6 DAVID: Okay. So, yeah, that's considered
7 in the judgment but these prophets are not Old
8 Testament. Remember, Revelation says that their
9 messages will be revealed when there's time no longer.
10 Their truth they were given are given for a time in
11 the end.

12 See, we hear about chariots with flaming
13 torches. We hear about people that are small. We
14 hear about a person that has good tidings, you know.

15 JIM: Uh-huh.

16 DAVID: It's kind of like in Jeremiah 50 and
17 51. It seems like it -- the fall of Babylon takes
18 place, when in Jeremiah 50 God says, that I have laid
19 a snare for thee, Babylon, and you will be taken
20 unawares, for you will strive against the Lord.

21 That's just like Psalms 2 says. It says the
22 heathen rage -- and they got all these wild
23 imaginations, you know. Nahum says, why do you mad
24 against the Lord, oh wicked counsellor, you know.

25 JIM: Uh-huh.

1 DAVID: And it says that the heathen rage.
2 Let us break his bands asunder and cast his cords away
3 from us.

4 I mean they don't want to know the field.

5 JIM: Right.

6 DAVID: So, it, it comes down to the saddest
7 thing in the world. It comes down to where people
8 have been privileged with literature and ability to
9 read and see but now they're so full, that they don't
10 care to learn.

11 So, he that sits in the heavens, sad to say,
12 he laughs.

13 'Cause, Jim, let me tell you something about
14 my father.

15 JIM: Uh-huh.

16 DAVID: He wants your butt.

17 JIM: Uh-huh.

18 DAVID: He wants, he wants to wipe this
19 world out. It's vanity, it's proud, it's arrogant,
20 it's corrupt, it's rotten.

21 JIM: Uh-huh.

22 DAVID: Well, let me tell you something
23 about Christ. He lived here 2000 years ago with
24 humanity, and he saw that there was hope. Now, the
25 way it appears to you is our situation here is heavy

1 and tight and you're concerned, which this is good,
2 that you get all the people out that you can. And I
3 appreciate that. Especially the innocent and
4 everything.

5 JIM: We want everyone, uh-huh.

6 DAVID: Okay, now here's the deal.

7 JIM: Uh-huh.

8 DAVID: I feel the same way for you and this
9 world. I'm in my position because I know what's going
10 on upstairs, you know. I've done everything in the
11 world to avoid this. I've done everything in the
12 world with Robert to avoid this.

13 JIM: Okay.

14 DAVID: Now, I'm just trying to do my best
15 to get the innocent out, too.

16 JIM: Right.

17 DAVID: When you played that recording on
18 the, the radio, there may not be very many but there's
19 going to be someone out there that's going to say,
20 hey, wait a minute. He showed me point blank that
21 Psalms 45 is the first Seal.

22 JIM: There's a whole lot of people.

23 DAVID: Yeah, I know. And they're going to
24 say, but wait a minute. But he's a terrorist. But
25 wait a minute, he's this and he's that. He's a child

1 molester. He's blah, blah, blah.

2 JIM: But I didn't tell you this, Craig
3 Smith from the Christian Broadcast Network --

4 DAVID: Yeah.

5 JIM: -- exactly what you said, just there,
6 happened today. Exactly what you said there happened
7 today. He called us and said that the Christian
8 response in support of your message was overwhelming,
9 incredible. But, but the people were starting to
10 worry because you didn't come out. Other than that, I
11 mean he was getting calls -- he said, I can't handle
12 the calls. That's what he told me.

13 DAVID: Okay. But here's the thing. Did
14 they also inform them that I have a commander above
15 me? I only do --

16 JIM: Well, they're Christians, I'm sure
17 they know.

18 DAVID: Look, they don't know me, okay.
19 They are Christians according to what man has taught
20 them.

21 JIM: Uh-huh.

22 DAVID: But the honesty -- what is going to
23 be the saving grace for all who have heard that tape
24 is this. They're going to have to look at themselves
25 and say, irrespective of what we think of this man --

1 JIM: But they're starting to understand,
2 David. That's the feeling I got, you know.

3 DAVID: Well, look, let me explain.

4 JIM: Because you told me it takes a long
5 time to learn it.

6 DAVID: Well, here's the deal. The 45th
7 Psalm is a revelation of Jesus Christ, isn't it?

8 JIM: Okay.

9 DAVID: God said, my heart's -- God wrote a
10 book about me.

11 JIM: Uh-huh.

12 DAVID: And God has foretold me and called
13 me to be a warrior, a destroyer of the gentiles.

14 JIM: Uh-huh.

15 DAVID: But before this prophecy is to be
16 fulfilled, it's been God's purpose to allow mercy and
17 truth to go first. That's why before anybody gets
18 hurt in this world -- if you could understand who the
19 four angels were right now, the four corners of the
20 earth, right?

21 JIM: Uh-huh.

22 DAVID: (Indiscernible) says, hurt not until
23 we've sealed the servants of our God. And their
24 foreheads, right?

25 JIM: Uh-huh.

1 DAVID: You know what they're sealed with,
2 don't you?

3 JIM: What?

4 DAVID: The seal of the living God. They're
5 sealed unto God by accepting and receiving the
6 knowledge of God's truth. In other words, their mind
7 is enlightened with the light that comes from God's
8 word.

9 JIM: Uh-huh.

10 DAVID: That's given to them by Christ.

11 JIM: Uh-huh.

12 DAVID: I come, my reward is with me. You
13 know all that stuff already.

14 JIM: Right. I understand.

15 DAVID: Okay. Now, so, because there is
16 such a power of unbelief in the world today, due to
17 the adversary who rules men by their passions and
18 feelings and emotions, what takes place is there
19 has to be another judiciary. Angels of God, powerful
20 angels, are in continual communication, going back and
21 forth. And decisions are being made on every
22 individual that's involved in observing this activity.

23 JIM: Uh-huh.

24 DAVID: Like I said and Habakkuk said -- I
25 didn't say it, Habakkuk said it, regard you amongst

1 the heathen. There will come a time --

2 JIM: We'll all be judged? At some point,
3 won't we, David, all be judged?

4 DAVID: We're being judged now.

5 JIM: Yeah.

6 DAVID: The truth is what's judging us.

7 JIM: Uh-huh.

8 DAVID: You see, now, if Psalm 45 is the
9 first seal, well, then what we got to look at, we got
10 to look at, well, what's the lesson there? Well, the
11 lesson is that Christ is going to destroy his enemies.
12 But that's not what we want to worry about.

13 JIM: Right.

14 DAVID: You see, it's just like you guys.
15 There's tanks out here and everything. Well, you
16 know, that, that could destroy your enemies, right?

17 JIM: Uh-huh.

18 DAVID: But you're telling me, you're saying
19 to me, you're saying, but, Dave, they're out there.
20 That's a show of arms but they're not there to destroy
21 you.

22 JIM: Uh-huh.

23 DAVID: They're just there to, to kind of
24 emphasize that I want you to come my way.

25 JIM: Uh-huh.

1 DAVID: You see?

2 JIM: Uh-huh.

3 DAVID: Okay. But you don't realize that
4 there is guns a billion times bigger than yours
5 pointed at you.

6 JIM: Uh-huh.

7 DAVID: You see. Bigger than you, bigger,
8 and more accurate. And the thing of it is, you can't
9 see them. You've got guys out here trying to
10 camouflage themselves, trying to hide, but you don't
11 see the camouflage that's hurled all around you guys.
12 You don't know what's fixing to happen to you.

13 Okay. Now, here's the deal. The only way
14 you can learn what's fixing to happen is if you give
15 this fool -- well, like you're doing now, you know --
16 an opportunity to emphasize one thing, that in the
17 first seal Christ goes forth conquering in the
18 conquer. You know that, Jim.

19 JIM: Right.

20 DAVID: And for your lack of knowledge, you
21 don't have that much fear of God. I realize that.
22 But the thing of it is is Psalm 45. That threat
23 should scare you.

24 JIM: Uh-huh.

25 DAVID: Because the reason being is that the

1 real purpose of that is an invitation to the marriage
2 of the Lamb, Revelation 19. So, instead of the truth
3 coming to destroy you -- which, oh, yes, if you reject
4 it, it will destroy you. But the point is is that you
5 might look at it, judge for yourself. And it says,
6 blessed are those which are called unto the marriage
7 of the Lamb. You know, Revelation 19 -- and the
8 heaven parts and there's the man on the red -- on the
9 white horse again, right?

9 JIM: Uh-huh.

10 DAVID: And he has a crown, many crowns. He
11 has a name that no one knows but he himself.

12 JIM: Right.

13 DAVID: And no scholar can tell you what the
14 name Koresh means. No one knows except one person.
15 He has a name that no one knows but he himself, but
16 his name is the word of God.

17 Have you ever heard about the word of God
18 being made flesh? It's a serious thing, very serious.

19 So, people are being judged right now, just like
20 we're being judged. And, you know, our T.V. doesn't
21 work too good. We'll hear on the radio. People are
22 calling up and they're like, blah, blah, blah, blah,
23 you know, you know, cult leader, whatever. Some are
24 saying, well, you know, he's got his weird beliefs.
25

1 Some are being merciful, some are not being so
2 merciful, whatever. And, you know, cases are being
3 decided right now in regards to this -- hey, is Psalm
4 45 the first seal? Is that truth a truth? And then I
5 mentioned the Psalm 1, you know.

6 JIM: Uh-huh.

7 DAVID: Are we to sit in the seat of the
8 scornful or the steps of the ungodly or are we
9 meditating on the law of God right now? What is God's
10 law? Right now, God's law is not Ten Commandments.
11 God's law to judge the world is Seven Seals, right?

12 JIM: Uh-huh.

13 DAVID: That law is Christ, isn't it?

14 JIM: Uh-huh.

15 DAVID: Revelation of Christ, something
16 that's extra. And this is where in the New Testament,
17 Jim, Christ explains about how the kingdom of heaven
18 will be like ten virgins. Five are wise and five are
19 foolish. They were all waiting for the marriage,
20 weren't they?

21 JIM: Uh-huh.

22 DAVID: The five wise got extra oil, though,
23 didn't they?

24 JIM: Right.

25 DAVID: And the five foolish didn't get

1 extra oil, did they?

2 JIM: Un-ah.

3 DAVID: Well, what do you think that extra
4 oil is? The oil is what gives us light in our
5 lanterns, right?

6 JIM: Uh-huh.

7 DAVID: What do you think that extra oil is
8 that they didn't get, that they weren't interested in?

9 JIM: I don't know.

10 DAVID: Well, what's the last revelation of
11 Jesus Christ that's important for us to know? I mean
12 you've already got the revelation of Jesus according
13 to Matthew, don't you?

14 JIM: Uh-huh.

15 DAVID: According to Mark, Luke and John?

16 JIM: Uh-huh.

17 DAVID: Aren't all these men laboring with
18 pen to reveal Jesus to you?

19 JIM: Uh-huh, that's right.

20 DAVID: Well, what's the revelation that we
21 need to find then? What's the last part? What's
22 extra? That won't be known until there's time no
23 longer.

24 JIM: Is that the Seals?

25 DAVID: Well, is it?

1 JIM: I don't know.

2 DAVID: John says something must be
3 hereafter, didn't he? What must be hereafter? Must
4 God sit on a throne hereafter?

5 JIM: Uh-huh.

6 DAVID: Must he have a rainbow above his
7 throne? Must he have a book in his right hand?

8 JIM: Uh-huh.

9 DAVID: Must it be sealed? Must Christ open
10 it?

11 JIM: Uh-huh.

12 DAVID: And then after he opens it in
13 heaven, must he come and bring it? I think so. And
14 must we make a decision for life or death? I don't
15 want to talk about your, your personal life. I don't
16 want to talk about things you've done and haven't
17 done.

18 JIM: Right, I understand.

19 DAVID: I want to talk about if the truth
20 came, would you want to know it.

21 JIM: Uh-huh.

22 DAVID: That's what I care about, Jim.

23 JIM: Uh-huh.

24 DAVID: I mean I care about my children,
25 too.

1 JIM: I understand. Well, I think I
2 understand it better now that you've explained it to
3 me.

4 DAVID: But -- are you there, Jim?

5 JIM: Yeah, I'm sorry, I just bumped the
6 phone. I think I --

7 DAVID: You're starting to catch it a little
8 bit.

9 JIM: Yeah. I think, I think maybe these --
10 I think I am getting a feel for it. It is -- it's
11 really a little clearer to me.

12 DAVID: It's a message of life and death.

13 JIM: I think these people that were calling
14 into the Christian Broadcast Network, David, were
15 really receiving their message. Now, you know, there
16 are so many call-ins and people wanting to hear more
17 about it and --

18 DAVID: Well, see, so now what happens then,
19 if you understood more about all the prophets, you
20 would understand.

21 JIM: Uh-huh.

22 DAVID: That Isaiah says, for they --
23 talking about the enemy -- shall surely gather
24 together but not by me. In other words, God's not
25 backing these guys.

1 JIM: Right.

2 DAVID: And all that gather together against
3 thee shall fall for thy sake, my namesake.

4 JIM: Uh-huh.

5 DAVID: Okay. This is what happens is when
6 these guys if, if they don't, if they don't listen to
7 me.

8 JIM: Right.

9 DAVID: You know, and they make hasty
10 decisions like an eagle that hastens to eat. See, the
11 eagle is a symbol of your currency, too, you know?

12 JIM: Uh-huh.

13 DAVID: It's the national seal.

14 JIM: Right.

15 DAVID: Okay. He claims the wheat and the
16 barley, doesn't it?

17 JIM: Right.

18 DAVID: Okay. Now, the prophecy also
19 projects these things. Isaiah says, woe to the nation
20 overshadowing with wings which is beyond the rivers of
21 Ethiopia. In other words, this nation is way on the
22 other side of the world, right?

23 JIM: Right.

24 DAVID: And what happens is is that the
25 prophecy says that, you know, they sent ambassadors to

1 a people scattered and (indiscernible) beginning, you
2 know. And it says their ambassage is not going to
3 work but they, themselves, are to be instructed, you
4 know.

5 JIM: Right.

6 DAVID: And it says if they're not
7 instructed, then God's going to use them as an example
8 for everyone else in the world who has had a chance to
9 hear the first point, is Psalm 45 the first seal?

10 DAVID: Now, notice, Jim, this is personal
11 now, just between me and you.

12 JIM: Okay.

13 DAVID: When, when we first -- when you
14 first said over the radio -- you asked people to call
15 in, you know, the teachers or scholars or whatever --

16 JIM: Uh-huh.

17 DAVID: -- to call in and start, you know,
18 explaining the Seals, remember?

19 JIM: Yeah, but that's what you wanted,
20 David. You asked for that, remember?

21 DAVID: Yeah, okay. Well, and you heard
22 what they were saying, right?

23 JIM: Right.

24 DAVID: The Apocalypse and --

25 JIM: Yeah.

1 DAVID: -- you know, metaphor, parabolic.

2 JIM: Yeah.

3 DAVID: Well, you notice how they just
4 started like yak, yak, yak, yak, yak, right?

5 JIM: Right.

6 DAVID: But you notice how they didn't go
7 according to the prophets?

8 JIM: Uh-huh.

9 DAVID: But, you know, was not King David a
10 prophet?

11 JIM: Yeah.

12 DAVID: I mean he prophesized a lot of
13 Messiah, didn't he?

14 JIM: Yeah.

15 DAVID: Well, then Psalm 45 point blank
16 tells you the details. It's like the Seven Seals are
17 like a movie preview, you know. The prophecies give
18 you the details --

19 JIM: Right.

20 DAVID: -- but the Seven Seals in the first
21 picture just give you a small picture preview of what
22 the event relates to.

23 JIM: Uh-huh.

24 DAVID: So, that's why in Israel -- that's,
25 that's how in Israel we get the rabbi stumped.

1 JIM: Right.

2 DAVID: Because what we show him is this.
3 We say, now, look, how can the Christians be wrong
4 when they say that what must be hereafter are these
5 Seals. You see?

6 JIM: Uh-huh.

7 DAVID: When you show them from the prophets
8 what the Seals are --

9 JIM: Right.

10 DAVID: -- then that's what they believe in.

11 JIM: Right.

12 DAVID: This is where Paul says, Paul says,
13 that God would have all Israel -- Jew and gentile come
14 into harmony, you see. And it's got to be through one
15 truth.

16 JIM: Uh-huh.

17 DAVID: Now, if the Christians are saying
18 that the prophecies of the prophets are to be
19 fulfilled in the end of the world, then the Jews can't
20 say the Christians are wrong, can they?

21 JIM: No.

22 DAVID: Okay. So vice versa. If the Jews
23 are believing today that the prophecies are going to
24 fulfilled by Messiah, then the Christians have to say
25 the Jews aren't wrong.

1 JIM: Uh-huh.

2 DAVID: To bring in perfect harmony between
3 all people. But, of course, it just seems like today
4 the gentiles do not really even care to know about
5 these Seals. And this is what's going to judge them.

6 JIM: Uh-huh.

7 DAVID: Anyway, you got those, those puppies
8 ready, Mark? You got a van down there waiting for us?

9 JIM: Yeah, yeah. Dave?

10 DAVID: Yes.

11 JIM: I'll check on the van and you check on
12 the boy, okay?

13 DAVID: I will.

14 JIM: Oh, hold on just a minute. Let me
15 check on this. Okay. Dave?

16 DAVID: Yeah.

17 JIM: Oh, okay. I just wanted to say before
18 we did that, I think I got a better understanding of
19 that stuff and I appreciate you --

20 DAVID: Well, what I'm saying is is that --

21 JIM: But let, let me tell you that I had to
22 make some arrangements about those puppies.

23 DAVID: Oh, at least take them to the kennel
24 cause, you know, you -- they shot their mother.

25 JIM: How -- no, we're not going -- you

1 know, we want to take care of them. How many, how
2 many are there?

3 DAVID: How many are there, of the puppies.

4 UNIDENTIFIED SPEAKER: I think there's
5 eleven.

6 DAVID: Eleven.

7 JIM: Eleven, okay. All right. I know
8 that's -- here's what, here's what I want you to do is
9 just have Mark -- can you put them in a box or
something?

10 DAVID: Yeah, we'll put them in a box.

11 JIM: Okay. Just have him walk out with the
12 box and just walk down the driveway to one of those --
13 to where the stretcher was?

14 DAVID: Right.

15 JIM: Okay, you know, like we did before,
16 the same thing.

17 DAVID: Uh-huh.

18 JIM: And one of -- that ambulance down
19 there is going to get him because I don't want nothing
20 to happen to him now. He's 12 years old, and I'm just
--I want extra precaution. And I want him to walk
down to that ambulance.

21 DAVID: All right.

22 JIM: Okay. And I'll have him and the
23

1 puppies on that ambulance. Ain't nothing going to
2 happen to that boy, okay. We're going to make sure
3 it's safe.

4 DAVID: Oh, I believe you.

5 JIM: Yeah, I know. I know.

6 DAVID: Make sure it's not a bomb.

7 JIM: Oh, hey, don't worry.

8 DAVID: A puppy bomb.

9 JIM: No, no, no, no. Don't worry about
10 that. Don't worry about that. Who's, who -- is he
11 your boy?

12 DAVID: No. Well, you know, all children
13 are all of our responsibilities.

14 JIM: Okay. Go, go ahead and send him out
15 and I'll, I'll advise the ambulance, okay.

16 DAVID: Okay. Be sure and tell them --

17 JIM: Okay.

18 DAVID: -- yeah, okay. And be sure and tell
19 the guys around here that he's not doing nothing
20 funny, all right?

21 JIM: Oh, hey, I -- let me square that away.
22 Okay. All right. Let me, let me get them. You just
23 get the kid ready but keep the line open.

24 DAVID: Okey-doke.

25 JIM: Okay.

DAVID: They'll be -- I'll be running -- another 15, 20 minutes probably. Boy, I hate to see people like Jim perish. God help them.

DAVID: Well, the word of God does come to pass, don't it?

(David speaking to unidentified persons in the background).

DAVID: Our barrel is on, on the tanks, right? Our barrels are on the tanks, right? What? Yeah. Just write her name in it.

JIM: David?

DAVID: Yes, sir.

JIM: Hey. I just checked up there, and they're ready for Mark to walk out.

DAVID: All right.

JIM: Is his name Jones --

DAVID: Yeah.

1 JIM: -- Mark Anthony Jones?

2 DAVID: Mark Jones.

3 JIM: Mark Jones. Okay. He can walk out
4 with the puppies and tell him to walk down to that
5 ambulance vehicle and they're going to -- they'll take
6 good care of him.

7 DAVID: All right. And he's going to bring
8 a Bible, too. So --

9 JIM: A bottle, okay.

10 DAVID: A Bible for Angelica.

11 JIM: A Bible for Angelica, sure. We'll get
12 it to her. Put her name in it.

13 DAVID: That's what -- I just had them do.

14 JIM: Okay. All right. How's Scott's leg
15 anyway? I haven't heard from him.

16 DAVID: All right. He, he's up and around.

17 JIM: Is he? He's not getting an infection,
18 is he?

19 DAVID: No.

20 JIM: Okay. Well, we get Mark safely out
21 there and -- that's real good because you're showing
22 me some compassion. And I'm going to make sure I tell
23 that to the, to the commanders, you know.

24 DAVID: I wish I could have a direct line to
25 all the commanders.

1 JIM: Well, I'm telling them for you.
2 They're so busy they couldn't sit down and, anyway,
3 they're running, you know, running around.

4 DAVID: Yeah, they don't know what they're
5 dealing with. I, I don't blame them.

6 JIM: But, you know, the qualities of a good
7 leader, right? I mean conviction, compassion,
8 courage. You've got conviction. I know --

9 DAVID: Well, the thing of it is is that --
10 like it says in Revelation, it says, in righteous that
11 he does judge and make war. Now, let's, let's
12 understand the first principle here and that is people
13 don't know where I'm coming from. Small means --
14 let's say in the days of -- let's say we were
15 Amorites.

16 JIM: Uh-huh.

17 DAVID: And here comes these Israelis,
18 right?

19 JIM: Uh-huh.

20 DAVID: And they're going to overthrow our
21 city. And Moses is the leader. Now, do you think the
22 Amorites and Hittites and all those people thought
23 Moses was a man of God?

24 JIM: Okay, David, excuse me.

25 DAVID: What?

1 JIM: They're saying they're ready and
2 they're watching for Mark.

3 DAVID: Okay.

4 JIM: Is he, is he there with you?

5 (David speaking to unidentified persons in
6 the background).

7 DAVID: Can someone get Mark now. They're
8 boxing up the, the puppies.

9 JIM: They're boxing the puppies up?

10 DAVID: Yeah.

11 JIM: Okay. Okay. Has he got a warm coat?

12 (David speaking to unidentified persons in
13 the background).

14 DAVID: Yeah, get him, get him some warm
15 clothes, too.

16 (Gap)

17 (David speaking to unidentified person in
18 the background).

19 DAVID: Hey, where's, where's Mom at, son?
20 Where's Mom at? Tell her to come here.

21 JIM: David? David?

22 (David speaking to unidentified persons in
23 the background).

24 DAVID: Every one of them. That's the first
25 thing to do is to shine them up, right.

1 BOBBY: Me, Bobby.

2 JIM: (Laughing) Who's -- who's there,
3 Bobby? Isn't that the three year old?

4 DAVID: Yeah. No, that's my little one.
5 What, is she two yet, Rach?

6 UNIDENTIFIED SPEAKER: No, she's only 14
7 months.

8 DAVID: Oh, she's 14 months. Oh, she's a
9 cutie, too.

10 JIM: Fourteen months.

11 DAVID: Yeah. Our dogs were malamutes,
12 registered malamutes.

13 JIM: Oh, really?

14 DAVID: Come here, Bah-bah. Come here.
15 Ohhhhh. Hello. You want to talk on the telephone?

16 (Jim laughing)

17 DAVID: Huh? What you eating? Hey, you
18 want to talk on the telephone? Say, hello.

19 JIM: Hello. Hello.

20 DAVID: Hello.

21 JIM: Hello. Hello, Bobby.

22 DAVID: Say, hello.

23 JIM: Hello, Bobby.

24 DAVID: Hello, Jim.

25 (Jim laughing)

1 JIM: Hello, Bobby.

2 DAVID: You eating candy. You don't want to
3 talk, huh? Say, hello. She's, she's eating candy.
4 What is that, what kind of candy is that? Oh, it's
5 strawberry candy. She's looking at me, though. She's
6 real, real -- my children talk real -- early -- hey,
7 Bobby, Bobby.

8 JIM: Yeah. Bobby?

9 DAVID: Here, say something to her.

10 JIM: Okay. Bobby, Bobby, this is Jim.
11 Bobby? Hello. Bobby? How ya doing? You listening
12 to me? Bobby, are you listening to me?

13 DAVID: Say something. Say something,
14 Bobby.

15 JIM: Say something, Bobby. Say, hi, Bobby.
16 Say, hi, Jim.

17 DAVID: She's not being -- she's not being
18 talkative.

19 JIM: She's quiet today, huh?

20 DAVID: Yeah.

21 JIM: Yeah. That's the way the little ones
22 gets, you know.

23 DAVID: Bah-bah.

24 (David speaking to Steve in the background).

25 DAVID: So, when they going to do that,

1 Steve? They're starting to do that now?

2 STEVE: Do what?

3 DAVID: Cut everything.

4 STEVE: Are they?

5 DAVID: Well, that's what I thought you
6 said. STEVE: No. No, I haven't heard
7 anything.

8 DAVID: Oh. Watch out.

9 STEVE: I know those guys (indiscernible)
10 they're in our garage back there doing (indiscernible)
11 with the plastic things, you know, piddling around.

12 DAVID: They're probably riding the
13 motorcycles.

14 JIM: Who, the kids are out?

15 DAVID: No.

16 (David speaking to Steve in the background).

17 STEVE: And they ran over our one building,
18 I watched them run right over the top of that.

19 DAVID: Which building was that?

20 STEVE: The one right next to the shed, like
21 next to the garage.

22 Oh, that old, that old shed, that old
23 building?

24 STEVE: They ran right over the top of it.

25 JIM: What did they do, David?

1 DAVID: Oh, they ran over our building.

2 JIM: Which one?

3 DAVID: Well, I don't know, Jim. You're
4 supposed to know all that.

5 JIM: Well, I can't see out there. I have
6 to wait, you know, call them on the radio, get
7 somebody to call them because I don't -- I can't see
8 out there.

8 DAVID: Yeah.

9 JIM: Is -- it's out in the back, you got
10 some -- a lot of little buildings out there?

11 DAVID: Yeah, it's the building out near the
12 garage.

12 JIM: Oh.

13 DAVID: Where all the motorcycles were.

14 JIM: Oh, yeah, okay. You know that little
15 silver trailer? Is that where you mean?

16 DAVID: Not, not the -- not, not, not the
17 silver trailer. Yeah.

18 JIM: All right. Let me check on that.

19 (Jim speaking to unidentified person in the
20 background).

21 JIM: Check and see if they ran over a shed.
22 David said they did.

23 Okay. Yeah, we're checking -- I'm going to
24
25

1 check on that and see. Was one of those ladies that
2 came out yesterday one that lived in that little
3 silver trailer?

4 DAVID: I don't know if she did or not but
5 usually the one that lived in that trailer was one of
6 the real, real old ladies.

7 JIM: Yeah.

8 DAVID: They get to a -- and her name was --
9 her name was -- oh, I can't think. Wait a second.
10 What, what's -- Trudy. Trudy. She's not here. But
11 they, you know, see, they're not -- nothing to do with
12 -- they're just real old ladies. They're like in
13 their 80's or so.

14 JIM: Yeah, wow, really?

15 DAVID: Yeah.

16 JIM: They've been there a long time?

17 DAVID: Well, -- no, what happened was when
18 I used to travel, I used to go to these, you know,
19 like orthodox religious meetings, right, where people
20 are like, you know, real orthodox and they want to
21 dress, you know, like the --

22 JIM: Yeah.

23 DAVID: -- Amish and all that, Mennonites.

24 JIM: Yeah. I've seen a lot of them people
25 in, in Tennessee and --

1 DAVID: Right.

2 JIM: -- Pennsylvania.

3 DAVID: Right.

4 JIM: That's kind of interesting. They ride
5 these buggies, you know.

6 DAVID: Yeah.

7 JIM: And have horses. Have you ever seen
8 that?

9 DAVID: Oh, yeah.

10 JIM: Yeah.

11 DAVID: And so when, when I give studies,
12 you know, they just -- they are so interested. They
13 just wanted to learn.

14 JIM: Yeah.

15 DAVID: So, they come down. And sometimes
16 they get, you know, and you got -- it's kind of like
17 you got to have half way a nursing home, you know.

18 JIM: Oh, I understand. Yeah. That's --

19 DAVID: Yeah. Yeah. I bet, I bet they
20 freaked out when they got charged with conspiracy to
21 murder.

22 JIM: I'm, I'm sure they did. I told you I
23 took care of that, didn't I?

24 DAVID: Well, it's --

25 JIM: I took care of that now. That's not

1 the case. There, there --

2 DAVID: It's just so sad 'cause like, you
3 know --

4 JIM: No. It's -- I know. I understand
5 that. And that was just one of the attorneys there
6 but they're just held as a material witness and that's
7 all.

8 DAVID: Bobby, no, you can't eat my
9 telephone.

10 (Jim laughing)

11 JIM: Heck, don't do that.

12 DAVID: Say something.

13 JIM: Hi, Bobby, how are you doing?

14 DAVID: Bah-bah. Bah-bah.

15 JIM: Hi, Bobby. David, is Mark there? Is
16 Mark there?

17 DAVID: She's not saying nothing, Rach.

18 JIM: David?

19 DAVID: Well, she ate the thing. She don't
20 want to talk, She's eating candy.

21 JIM: Oh, okay. Is, is Mark there?

22 DAVID: Mark's here now, isn't he? Run and
23 get him real quick and then send him out.

24 JIM: Yeah, send him out. They're waiting
25 for him.

1 DAVID: Good kid.

2 JIM: He's probably looking for the dog box.

3 (Gap)

4 JIM: Is Rachel doing okay?

5 DAVID: She's fine. Do you want to say
6 something? Say, hi.

7 JIM: Hi, Bobby. Hi, Bobby. Hello?

8 DAVID: Say something. Hello?

9 JIM: Hello? Hi, Bobby.

10 DAVID: Hello.

11 JIM: Hello. How are you?

12 DAVID: Hello. She almost said something.

13 JIM: I gotta see that child. I bet she's
14 cute.
15 clown.

16 DAVID: She's beautiful. She's a little
17 clown.

18 JIM: What color hair?

19 DAVID: Blonde, just like her mother.

20 JIM: Her mother, yeah.

21 DAVID: Bobby, say something. Are you
22 saying something to her?

23 JIM: Yeah, I was talking to her but she,
24 she just listened, I guess. Was she grinning or
25 something? She can hear my voice but she doesn't --
Bobby? Bobby? Oh, it's okay.

1 (Bobby crying)

2 JIM: Oh, I hear her. How are you, honey,
3 huh? How are you?

4 DAVID: I don't guess -- I don't guess she
5 wants to talk.

6 JIM: I guess she's not too talkative today.
7 You and me are the guys that do that, right?

8 DAVID: Yeah. Hey -- Dah-dah. Dah-dah.
9 No, why not? What you want, Nah-nah? -- I can't,
10 what that means, Rach.

11 JIM: Hey, David, see if you could send
12 Rachel to speed Mark up a bit.

13 DAVID: Yeah. Where's Mark at now? Mark,
14 you got the puppies? Okay. You're ready? Okay,
15 Mark, here's the deal. Yeah, put the picture in,
16 yeah. Okay, the Bible's in that bag? Okay. And
17 there are Barbies? Okay. Okay, Mark, look out the
18 window there and at the front of the gate there's an
19 ambulance. It's -- like an armored vehicle, right?

20 JIM: Yeah. It's an armored ambulance.

21 DAVID: Okay. It's, it's a big truck, okay.
22 And just take the puppies up there and then just, you
23 know, get in with them and they'll take you over to
24 the place. And give us -- they'll give us a call when
25 you get there, okay?

1 JIM: David, does, does --

2 DAVID: Not to be scared or nothing.

3 JIM: David, do I need to talk to him?

4 DAVID: Uh --

5 JIM: No? All right.

6 DAVID: Yeah, go ahead, yeah, you can talk
7 to him. Yeah, you know, you can explain it to him.
8 This is Jim. This is the guy you'll be seeing, okay?

9 MARK: Hello?

10 JIM: Hello, Mark?

11 MARK: Yes.

12 JIM: This is Jim. How are you?

13 MARK: Fine.

14 JIM: Just do what David says, okay?

15 MARK: All right.

16 JIM: Walk out the driveway with the puppies
17 down to that ambulance -- funny looking truck, okay.
18 And those guys will take you over to me.

19 MARK: All right.

20 JIM: And you'll be fine. You'll be safe.
21 So, don't be scared. And when you get over here, you
22 can talk to David.

23 MARK: All right.

24 JIM: Okay. See you later. Bye.

25 MARK: Bye.

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SITA: Jim?

JIM: Yeah. Who's this, Sita?

SITA: Hi. You recognize my voice.

JIM: Yeah, I've been missing you.

SITA: I'm -- I miss you, too, because I keep hearing different people talking, you know.

JIM: Oh, well, yeah, we're pretty busy. I'm sorry. How ya doing?

SITA: I'm doing fine. I'm just missing my kids.

JIM: Well, listen, I want you to come out, and the kids do need you. They've been asking. And Human Services has contacted us about that.

SITA: Oh --

JIM: I'd like to see you guys come out and get reunited. So --

SITA: I know, but I, I got some stuff -- I got some of their Bibles.

JIM: Okay.

SITA: Bibles and some -- a few clothes and their dolls, Barbie.

JIM: Okay. I'll get it to them for sure, Sita.

SITA: Jim, could you please?

JIM: I guarantee it.

1 SITA: Her name -- their name -- one is
2 Crystal and Angelica.

3 JIM: Right. I remember them. I'll do
4 that.
5 Are you going to come out later?

6 SITA: We'll see how it goes. I, I, I much
7 want to do this also but we have to wait what's going
8 to happen.

9 JIM: Okay.

10 SITA: And --

11 JIM: I understand. I've been talking with
12 David, and he said that right now everything's fine.
13 He just wanted to wait.

14 SITA: Yes.

15 JIM: And --

16 SITA: Oh, I thank you, too.

17 JIM: But I want you guys to hang in there
18 because we're going to get you all out here. These
19 kids need you.

20 SITA: Oh, we love you.

21 JIM: These kids need --

22 SITA: Thank you for helping.

23 JIM: Okay. Well, you just stick with me
24 now and --

25 SITA: Yeah, I know, because I don't quite

1 understand. We just got off from -- out of church and
2 went my room, opened my window. All of a sudden these
3 guys came -- get out of that trailer and just start
4 shooting.

5 JIM: I understand.

6 SITA: My kids -- if I didn't get up, up in
7 my room -- they were in my -- the bunk bed. And you'd
8 see it, it's all full of holes. They would have been
9 gone. Do you know that?

10 JIM: I understand that. I'm real sorry
11 about that.

12 SITA: But you must know why. They didn't
13 tell us they was going to come or anything. They just
14 start shooting -- just got out of that trailer and
15 just shot -- just start shooting.

16 JIM: I understand, Sita. I regret that
17 happened. I really am sorry that happened.

18 SITA: I just hope nothing happens again.

19 JIM: Well, that's --

20 SITA: I don't understand but I just hope
21 you guys can handle your side of -- we didn't do
22 anything.

23 JIM: Oh, listen. I can handle it. But you
24 guys have got to work with me and you've got to help
25 me, you know. And if you do, I mean we can resolve

1 this thing safely and quickly. And that's what we
2 want to do. And David says he will. And I thought
3 yesterday afternoon we were about resolved.

4 SITA: Yes.

5 JIM: And David says he will. And I want
6 you guys to support him on that. And if he does, then
7 you can come out here and be reunited with these kids
8 and you guys. I mean what kind of life is this,
9 sitting in there with, with --

10 SITA: Yeah.

11 JIM: -- you know, police everywhere? I
12 mean that's no kind of a life.

13 SITA: I know.

14 JIM: So, you need to come out and get
15 reunited and everybody safe. Hey, listen, --

16 SITA: Yes.

17 JIM: -- nobody regrets what happened more
18 than me and you, too. We know it was bad, but we
19 can't go back and change it.

20 SITA: I know.

21 JIM: So, we've to take -- right this today
22 and go forward and do the right thing, you know.

23 SITA: Well, --

24 JIM: You're smart and you're intelligent
25 and you're --

1 SITA: I try to be.

2 JIM: Hey, has Mark left yet?

3 SITA: They're coming down now. They're
4 saying good-bye to David.

5 JIM: Saying good-bye to David.

6 SITA: Yes. Every time a kid come, they
7 want to give him a big hug and stuff.

8 JIM: Well, I understand. It's just those
9 guys are out there waiting for him, you know.

10 SITA: Okay.

11 JIM: And I don't want him to --

12 SITA: Yeah. They're, they're saying good-
13 bye to David.

14 JIM: Okay. Is there -- it's just one
15 coming, though, right? Is there two kids? Just one,
16 isn't it?

17 SITA: Uh --

18 JIM: Mark?

19 SITA: Mark.

20 JIM: Yeah. I think it's just Mark.

21 SITA: Yeah, Mark, and the, the little pups.

22 JIM: And the puppies, yeah.

23 SITA: Yeah. They thought they were dead,
24 too, but when I put that flag, they were yelping.

25 JIM: Oh, really.

1 SITA: So, I, I just take my life for them
2 to bring them in.

3 JIM: Uh-huh.

4 SITA: Because they were outside, and their
5 mom, their mom was, you know.

6 JIM: Well, take a deep breath and relax and
7 everything is going to be fine. We'll get through
8 this. And, you know, we've already -- 18 kids are in
9 safe hands and, and the two ladies.

9 SITA: Yeah.

10 JIM: There's no reason for, for the rest of
11 you not to be out here. It's just David's got to
12 decide and you guys have to decide.

12 SITA: Uh-huh.

13 DAVID: And I mean that's the way to do it,
14 you know. (End of tape.)

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
