2 DAVID: All right, what about sending a  
3 couple of girls up there to get it, is that all right?

4 JIM: Oh, yeah, anybody you want.

5 DAVID: Okie-doke.

6 JIM: Send C.D., you know, I don't care.  
Send anybody you want, who cares.

7 DAVID: Okay.

8 JIM: And then, but only two men on the  
9 dogs.

10 DAVID: All right, no problem.

11 JIM: Okay, and no guns or nothing, you  
12 know.

13 DAVID: No guns, promise.

14 JIM: All right. And then think about what  
15 children you want to send down.

16 DAVID: Okay, we're thinking.

17 JIM: Okay. You know, anything, any time  
before dark is always safer, so just think about that,  
18 okay?

19 DAVID: All right.

20 JIM: But watch that press conference at  
3:30 and I'll talk to you after that.

21 DAVID: Okay.

22 JIM: And just do me one, one favor.

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1           DAVID: Yeah, Jim.

2           JIM: David, I love Steve, but I like to  
3 deal with you.

4           DAVID: I know, but look, you know, there's  
5 people saying that, you know, I didn't get hit and  
6 stuff like that, look --

7           JIM: That's --

8           DAVID: It doesn't make any difference,  
9 look. The thing of it is --

10          JIM: You and I know you got hit.

11          DAVID: Today -- I have never in my life, of  
12 this 33 years, ever had such a -- hey, you know, I  
13 used to be a distance runner, you know. I used to be  
14 a, a very, very proficient athletic person.

15          JIM: Um-hum.

16          DAVID: And I have never in my life had such  
17 a physical feat that I have today. I mean --

18          JIM: I --

19          DAVID: To be able to, to get up on a one-  
20 foot tall plastic pot to do a number two.

21          JIM: Um-hum.

22          DAVID: I mean, I'm telling you. And when  
23 I, when I finally descended back into a position to  
24 where I could lay down, I mean I might as well have  
25 climbed Mt. Everest and come back.

1 JIM: Um-hum.

2 DAVID: I mean it, it was unreal.

3 JIM: I'm sure it was painful.

4 DAVID: It's not, not just the pain so --

5 JIM: I want, I want to get you, I want to  
6 get you --

7 DAVID: -- the, the shrink that he used  
8 just, with just the parts that I could use without any  
9 pain.

10 JIM: Listen, when, when -- and I, and  
11 listen, don't get me wrong. Don't get me wrong, I'm  
12 not pushing you, but when you decide to come out,  
13 we're going to make sure you get the best medical care  
14 and get your strength back and get that fixed up,  
15 okay?

16 DAVID: Well, I'm drinking grape juice now  
17 because, like I said, the loss of blood was a lot.

18 JIM: I know it.

19 DAVID: So as long as I'm in a prone  
20 position, you know, my vital signs and all that are  
21 good.

22 JIM: Um-hum.

23 DAVID: But it's like, it's just like any,  
24 it's like it, it's probably a bit of anemia because of  
25 the loss of blood, and I need, I need just to build up

1 blood content a little bit.

2 JIM: All right.

3 DAVID: So we're, we're utilizing the proper  
4 juices to do that with.

5 JIM: Okay. Well, think about walking out  
6 of there and getting some good medical care, and  
7 leading all those people out. They need you.

8 DAVID: Yeah. Well, let's think about God  
9 on the throne too now, Jim.

10 JIM: Okay, David, I will.

11 DAVID: I want you all in the, in your  
12 system and all the men of this nation who have ears to  
13 hear and eyes to see to have every opportunity --

14 JIM: I know.

15 DAVID: -- before you end up standing in  
16 front of guns that you have no power against.

17 JIM: Um-hum.

18 DAVID: I mean honestly.

19 JIM: Okay.

20 DAVID: Okie-doke.

21 JIM: Hey, watch that thing at 3:30.

22 DAVID: I will.

23 JIM: And I'll talk to you later.

24 DAVID: Thank you now. Bye.

25 JIM: Bye.

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RACHEL: Hello?

JIM: Rachel?

RACHEL: Yeah.

JIM: This is Jim. Is David there?

RACHEL: Yeah, but we'll talk to you later  
'cause he's listening, he's watching the TV.

JIM: Well, but listen, this is an  
emergency. The guys in tactical vehicles just told me  
that three men walked out of the house carrying guns.  
This is --

RACHEL: No, I, I don't think that's true.

JIM: Well, they -- it is true. They just  
told us.

RACHEL: Just a minute.

JIM: The red side?

STEVE: Hello?

JIM: Hello, Steve?

STEVE: Yeah.

JIM: This is Jim.

STEVE: Jim, okay.

JIM: The tactical guys just reported that  
three men just walked out of your building with guns.

STEVE: With guns.

JIM: With guns.

1 STEVE: No, they didn't.

2 JIM: Well --

3 STEVE: That's not true.

4 JIM: Over on the --

5 STEVE: I can tell you their very names who  
6 went out to get the dogs and drag the bodies of those  
7 dogs --

8 JIM: What were then carrying? What were  
9 they carrying?

10 STEVE: Probably shovels.

11 JIM: Okay, 'cause --

12 STEVE: Or were they -- wait, just, let me  
13 find out.

14 JIM: Okay.

15 STEVE: I'll tell you the very names of --

16 JIM: Just confirm it. Just confirm it.

17 STEVE: Okay. Wait just a minute. Would  
18 somebody go there for me and look to see who went out  
19 to take the dogs?

20 UNIDENTIFIED FEMALE SPEAKER: Cliff and  
21 Greg.

22 STEVE: Cliff and Greg did? Two guys did,  
23 right? That's it, two?

24 JIM: Two? They said three. You check and  
25 tell me.

1                   STEVE: And they're unarmed, totally  
2 unarmed.

3                   JIM: Okay. All right, let me tell them.

4                   STEVE: Okay.

5                   JIM: Totally unarmed. Yeah. What were  
6 they carrying, they asked?

7                   STEVE: What were they carrying? Well find  
8 it, tell somebody right -- find out. Who's around  
9 here? Okay.

10                  JIM: Okay, maybe is it just shovels?

11                  STEVE: I don't know yet.

12                  JIM: Okay. Which door did they go out, the  
13 front?

14                  STEVE: The front.

15                  JIM: Okay.

16                  STEVE: That's where the dogs are, right --  
17 in fact, as you look to the building, the dogs would  
18 be to the left side of the entrance.

19                  JIM: Okay. Yeah, that's --

20                  STEVE: I'm waiting to hear back from them,  
21 but they --

22                  JIM: Still there? Steve.

24                  STEVE: Hello, Jim.

25                  JIM: Hello. Yeah, Steve?



1                   STEVE: Yes. You were right, there were  
2 three guys out there. One guy took it upon --

3                   JIM: Okay, hold, hold on a minute, Steve.  
4 Hey, I'm sorry, go ahead.

5                   STEVE: I was going to say, one guy took it  
6 upon himself to go out there and collect the -- he was  
7 going to go collect some things that he thought  
8 belonged to some of the guys that were here to see --  
9 he totally took it upon himself, though. We knew  
10 nothing about it.

11                   JIM: Okay. Okay.

12                   STEVE: We just, in fact, just jumped all  
13 over the place on top of him.

14                   JIM: All right, good. I, you know, thank  
15 you, Steve. I'm just concerned about, you know, we  
16 know in advance. I don't want any --

17                   STEVE: Exactly.

18                   JIM: You know.

19                   STEVE: I know the, you know, what you're  
20 all going through just to get the thing worked out so  
21 there's no problems and --

22                   JIM: Well, I appreciate it.

23                   STEVE: I really am sorry for that.

24                   JIM: Don't worry. Tell them it's for their  
25 own safety.

1           STEVE: Exactly.

2           JIM: Did you watch the press conference?

3           STEVE: Yeah, only got to see about half of  
4 it because I was trying to, you know, I lost the  
5 connection with you there, and that --

6           JIM: Well, it's still on. Go watch the  
7 rest and I'll talk to you.

8           STEVE: Oh, okay. Well, we only get Channel  
9 2 there. Okay, I'll call you back or you can call me,  
10 then, when it's over.

11           JIM: Okay.

12           STEVE: Okay, thanks, Jim. Okay, bye.

13                           \* \* \* \*

14           STEVE: Hello?

15           JIM: Steve?

16           STEVE: Yes.

17           JIM: This is Jim. Did you call me?

18           STEVE: Yeah, I did.

19           JIM: Oh, I'm sorry. I was on the --

20           STEVE: Yeah, we got it all straightened out  
21 with that, and the two, the two guys that did go out,  
22 though, all they had was gloves on their hands.

23           JIM: Okay. Well listen, it's not -- I  
24 already straightened it out with the tactical  
25 commanders.

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STEVE: Okay.

JIM: And appreciate you calling me back.

STEVE: Right.

JIM: No sweat. I mean, that's the kind of communication we want.

STEVE: Right.

JIM: If something's awry, let's both look into it.

STEVE: Okay, sounds good.

JIM: And, and make sure it's not, you know, so. That's all. That's all.

STEVE: Okay. They're ready to go out there then and start dragging those bodies out.

JIM: The dogs?

STEVE: Yeah, the dogs.

JIM: Yeah, okay. Okay.

STEVE: Okay?

JIM: Yeah, I think it's okay, but are they going to dig a hole? Tell me what they're going to do.

STEVE: Oh, they say that -- there's also a goose that apparently is -- what is he, penned up or -

- UNIDENTIFIED MALE SPEAKER: Yeah, he's penned up.

STEVE: He's penned up and they want to

1 leave the thing loose.

2 JIM: I don't care.

3 STEVE: Okay, that's all right also. Oh,  
4 how far away is that, though, just so --

5 UNIDENTIFIED MALE SPEAKER: On the left-hand  
6 side of the --

7 STEVE: Left-hand side of the building, so  
8 they're be walking over by the left-hand side of the  
9 building and right by the fence there, there's a goose  
10 that's been stuck there for days now.

11 JIM: A goose?

12 STEVE: A goose, a white goose.

13 JIM: A goose. Yeah, okay, let him out.

14 STEVE: Okay.

15 JIM: Yeah. And, and are they going to bury  
16 the dogs or just drag them out?

17 STEVE: They're going to -- what are you  
18 going to do with those dogs, drag them out or what are  
19 you doing? (Unidentified voices in background not  
20 discernible.) I mean, but are you dragging them or  
21 what? Picking them up? Okay.

22 JIM: Are they going to bury them or not?

23 STEVE: You're going to bury them?

24 (Unidentified voices in background not discernible.)

25 I guess just, what --

1 JIM: Just drag them out away from the  
2 house.  
3 STEVE: Yeah, I think you're right.  
4 JIM: That's fine, where they don't bother  
5 you.  
6 STEVE: Okay.  
7 JIM: Okay, Steve.  
8 STEVE: Okay, that's what they'll do.  
9 JIM: Okay. Hey --  
10 STEVE: Yeah.  
11 JIM: Talk to David now, he, he was --  
12 STEVE: All right.  
13 JIM: -- going to send some kids out and --  
14 STEVE: All right.  
15 JIM: If we could do it before dark, I'd  
16 sure like to do it.  
17 STEVE: Okay, I'll talk with him.  
18 JIM: Kids get scared at night.  
19 STEVE: Okay.  
20 JIM: Yeah.  
21 STEVE: Is that --  
22 JIM: Hey, let me talk --  
23 STEVE: Is that conference over or --  
24 JIM: Oh, I don't know, I just came to  
25 answer the phone.

1 STEVE: Okay.

2 JIM: I'll let you go so you can do the dog  
3 thing.

4 STEVE: Right, and I wanted to see if  
5 anything else was on there myself.

6 JIM: Okay, and, and then talk to David  
7 about the kids and have David call me.

8 STEVE: All right, I'll do that.

9 JIM: Have the kids get ready, you know.

10 STEVE: Okay, I'll have him call you.

11 JIM: Okay, bye.

12 STEVE: Okay, bye.

13 GREG: Hello?

14 JIM: Hello?

15 GREG: Yeah.

16 JIM: David?

17 GREG: No, this is Greg.

18 JIM: Oh, Greg. This is Jim.

19 GREG: Hi, Jim, How are you doing?

20 JIM: Pretty good, did you --

21 GREG: Hold on, hold on a second, here's  
22 Steve.

23 JIM: Okay.

24 STEVE: Hello?

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JIM: Steve?

STEVE: Yeah, Jim.

JIM: Did you get those dogs?

STEVE: Yeah, they just, they pulled them  
away and did you get that goose also or --  
(Unidentified male voice in background not  
discernible.)

JIM: The goose?

STEVE: Yeah, well, that's where, remember?  
That's what I mentioned to you --

JIM: Yes, yes.

STEVE: We were going to let that thing  
loose? Yeah.

JIM: Yeah. Well, good, I don't want him  
to, I don't want him to die in there. Did he get him  
out?

STEVE: Yeah, they got him out, they let him  
loose.

JIM: Well, he'll have plenty to eat in the  
fields, I guess.

STEVE: And there's a whole lot of chickens  
in a pen too. I hate to keep, but what do you think?  
I don't know.

JIM: Where, where is it?

STEVE: Where's, where's the chickens at?

1 UNIDENTIFIED MALE SPEAKER: Over on the  
2 north side.

3 STEVE: It's over on the north side, toward  
4 like where the Bradley is.

5 JIM: The north side -- let's --

6 STEVE: I don't know, can they be, you can't  
7 really see, though, from where you're at anyway, from  
8 where they're -- unless someone flew over, I'd  
9 imagine. But it's a pen with a whole -- I don't know,  
10 how many chickens are there in there? About 50  
11 chickens in there.

12 JIM: Okay, let me, let me wait on it.  
13 Let's just wait on the chickens for a minute and --

14 STEVE: Yeah.

15 JIM: See if we can --

16 STEVE: Wait on the chickens, yeah. It  
17 does, it does sound funny to me too, I must admit.

18 JIM: Well, we -- I'm glad, you know, we  
19 don't want them to be hurt, you know, so.

20 STEVE: Yeah.

21 JIM: How about some kids coming out, did  
22 David -- did you talk to David?

23 STEVE: I just started to when we were  
24 bringing something in on the TV station, then the  
25 thing went out again. We're trying to -- we don't,



1 see, we don't have capability, I thought we did on  
2 this TV, for UHF.

3 JIM: Oh, um-hum.

4 STEVE: So I don't know what's wrong with  
5 it. What is it? (Unidentified male voice in  
6 background not discernible.) See there, the good TV  
7 that we did have was all shot up when, when they  
8 arrived.

8 JIM: Oh, I see.

9 STEVE: So that's what we're trying to make  
10 do and, like what you were telling us what you were  
11 watching, we -- but that must be Channel 25, maybe?

12 JIM: Yeah, that was 25, yeah.

13 STEVE: Yeah, see, we can't, well, the only  
14 thing we get is Channel 2.

14 JIM: Oh, okay. Did you get the --

15 STEVE: So he wants to know, did you come up  
16 with any names of anybody you wanted to send out or --

17 DAVID: No, not yet.

18 STEVE: Not yet, he said.

19 JIM: Okay. Oh, he already gave us the  
20 names.

20 STEVE: Oh, he did, okay.

21 JIM: Yeah. Dailand (phonetic sp.), Pages.

22 STEVE: All right.

23

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1                   JIM: Cyrus, Star, Bobby. I just -- let's  
2 see, who else. Chanelle.

3                   STEVE: Uh-huh.

4                   JIM: Catherine.

5                   STEVE: Okay.

6                   DAVID: When are we going to get

(Indiscernible)

7                   JIM: I just want -- which ones he wanted to  
8 send.

9                   STEVE: Just a minute. Huh?

10                  DAVID: When are we going to get a line

(Indiscernible)

11                  STEVE: He says, when are we going to get a  
12 line out to answer some of the media questions?

13                  JIM: As soon as you come out you can do all  
14 that stuff.

15                  STEVE: He says, as soon as we come out we  
16 can do all that sort of thing.

17                  UNIDENTIFIED SPEAKERS: Oh, yeah.

(Indiscernible)

18                  STEVE: Man, I don't know.

19                  JIM: Well, you know, we, we did that with  
20 the Christian Broadcast Network and we kept our word.  
21 You know, if you come out, those people all want to  
22 interview you and I'm sure it can be arranged, so.

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1                   STEVE: He's sure it can be, if we all come  
2 out, that, like the Christian station, they  
3 interviewed us. I mean, they've -- Jim, you're funny.

4                   JIM: Oh, hey --

5                   STEVE: You're very funny.

6                   JIM: Do you want me to check with them?

7                   STEVE: Huh?

8                   JIM: Do you want me to check with them?

9                   STEVE: No, well, yeah, you mean about  
10 giving us a line back out to the media?

11                   JIM: No, I mean about giving you an  
12 interview after you come out.

13                   STEVE: About giving us an interview after  
14 we come out?

15                   JIM: Right.

16                   UNIDENTIFIED MALE SPEAKER: Everyone's  
17 calling.

18                   JIM: Every I mean, we get a million calls,  
19 everybody wants to interview you. You know, if David  
20 said he's coming out, I'd say if you want to interview  
21 him when it -- if you want to talk to them when you  
22 come out, you know, everybody wants to talk to you.  
23 Yeah. I mean, you told them you were coming out, and  
24 they're sitting there waiting for you, you know. It's  
25 a big chance to, to deal with them, you know.

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STEVE: Okay.

JIM: Well, anyway.

UNKNOWN: He's waiting on his God right now.

STEVE: He said he's waiting on his God  
right now.

JIM: Okay, I understand.

STEVE: How long are you going to be there  
till, Jim?

JIM: Oh, I don't know. I guess Henry will  
probably come after a while.

STEVE: But I, I'll probably give you a call  
here in a little bit.

JIM: Okay.

STEVE: You're going to be there how late  
though, do you think?

JIM: Oh, I don't know. Can, can you get  
any of the kids ready?

STEVE: That's what he just got done saying,  
waiting.

JIM: He wants to --

STEVE: He gave you the names. He's, he --  
to tell you the truth --

JIM: Uh-hum.

STEVE: He's been contemplating all that's  
been going on for the last five days with the movement

1 of the Bradleys, these guys coming out sneaking  
2 around, you know, all that kind of thing. They're  
3 running over the shacks, all that.

4 JIM: Um-hum.

5 STEVE: I mean, it's not consistent with  
6 your rapport, your, you know, the way you are, the way  
7 you've been communicating.

8 JIM: Well, I know, I got a lot of bosses  
9 and commanders here.

10 STEVE: He keeps on saying, you know,  
11 looking like -- you sound like a lamb, but you know,  
12 the actions are like a dragon.

13 JIM: But I haven't lied to you and that's -

14 - STEVE: But you know, right from the  
15 beginning you and I agreed. When you and I talked  
16 together right from the beginning Sunday.

17 JIM: Right.

18 STEVE: We had agreed that nothing would --  
19 these three vehicles would be on the perimeter, on the  
20 edge of the property but not on the property.

21 JIM: Steve, Steve, I made mistakes and you  
22 have made mistakes.

23 STEVE: I know. No, no, that's okay, that's  
24 okay, but just since --

25 JIM: You know, we --

1                   STEVE: No, no, no, no, no. No, no, no!  
2 But yours continue. Do you call it encroachment, do  
3 you call it intimidation, do you -- whatever you call  
4 it, you're doing it, though, that's the point.

5                   JIM: Yeah.

6                   STEVE: That is the point.

7                   JIM: Okay, I --

8                   STEVE: If you want to do what you want to  
9 do, well then we would say, go ahead and do it.  
10 Ultimately, we'll say go ahead and do it.

11                   JIM: I understand. But there's no, no  
12 shots are fired, no effort to attack.

13                   STEVE: That's not a -- beside the point.  
14 Ultimately, that, you keep on -- it's just like a lion  
15 or something like that, just slowly creeping up to a  
16 victim or something. Same thing. We're not doing  
17 anything, I'm just smiling at you, I'm just smelling  
18 the air. I mean it, you know, the whole thing is  
19 contrary to the way it all began with you and I and  
20 with you and David.

21                   JIM: Well --

22                   STEVE: What would you think, though, I  
23 mean, after --

24                   JIM: Well, you know, you know what I think?

25                   STEVE: What, what, after agreements,

1 conclusions, and all of a sudden here is this Bradley  
2 out here running over -- what was that -- did you find  
3 out why they did that? Was that under your  
4 commanders, did he give the order? Is that kids out  
5 there fooling around, getting an opportunity to play  
6 with these machines or what? What is that?

6 JIM: I mean, I think both of us share this.

7 STEVE: No, no, what, what -- tell me about  
8 it? Go, you --

9 JIM: I'm trying to tell you, but you won't  
10 let me talk.

11 STEVE: I'm going to leave you talk. Tell  
12 me what that incident was about, why they did that up  
13 at the guard shack there.

14 JIM: Well, I think they were just trying to  
15 get that building out of the way so nobody would be  
16 hiding behind it.

17 STEVE: Why didn't you say something to us  
18 ahead of time about it?

19 JIM: Well, I think it happened when I  
20 wasn't here.

21 STEVE: Well, why didn't Henry? Is he not,  
22 is he not in your caliber, or can't he be trusted?

23 JIM: Well -- oh, yeah, sure.

24 STEVE: Well, why did he not say something?  
25

1                   JIM: Well he, he should have. I'm sorry if  
2 he didn't, I apologize.

3                   STEVE: And why did -- then in the back they  
4 did the same thing. And here they're on the prop--  
5 what are they doing when, you know, you both -- by the  
6 way, you said the same thing as yourself.

7                   JIM: But Steve, but Steve, listen. I mean,  
8 I could say the same thing. Three men walked out of  
9 the house, you didn't tell me. I mean, I'm sitting --  
10 you know, it's the same thing.

11                   STEVE: Yeah, that's a pretty big thing  
12 though, to go riding over property and all that. Come  
13 on, let me run your house over and you tell me that.  
14 Let's you and I switch this around and you sit in a  
15 position like this.

16                   JIM: I'd walk out with my hands up and  
17 surrender and go to court, that's what I would do.

18                   STEVE: I don't believe so.

19                   JIM: I would.

20                   STEVE: Not if you had the same information  
21 and knowledge, you would not.

22                   JIM: You know we're not going to do  
23 anything, that's what I would do. That's what I would  
24 do, honest to God, if that was me, I'd walk out.

25                   STEVE: Well, you know, I really -- that's



1 what I really actually thought, I really did. But I  
2 mean, it's contrary to what one sees and what you're  
3 hear around here, especially at night time. These  
4 guys think they're cute or something.

5 JIM: Um-hum.

6 STEVE: Apparently they don't fear the same  
7 God I do. It's obvious they don't. No wonder all the  
8 prophets talked about the way they did in the final  
9 days, about a little group and all that. You know,  
10 it's hard for even me to buy. But just by the things,  
11 the events that have taken place, transpiring here,  
12 you see it happening.

13 JIM: Um-hum. Well, the solution is simple.

14 STEVE: Okay, what is it, what do you think  
15 it is?

16 JIM: Yeah. You come out like you said and  
17 this'll be over. And then the, then the final --

18 STEVE: What'll, what'll be over?

19 JIM: What will be over?

20 STEVE: It will be over for what, you? For  
21 your part of this communication?

22 JIM: No, I'm talking about all your people  
23 in there that are not in safety.

24 STEVE: We will do you -- we will do like we  
25 told you we will, but the only element there that has

1 not changed, and he's waiting, is he was told to wait.  
2 So even for me, I would -- it would have been no  
3 problem to walk right on out there, but it's that very  
4 God that showed him the information that have  
5 convinced and convicted us that the Bible is true, it  
6 can't be gainsaid, the information there.

6 JIM: I'm not, I'm not disputing that,  
7 Steve.

8 STEVE: No, no, but that's the reason why  
9 we're still here. Otherwise, we would walk out right  
10 now. There would be no problem.

11 DAVID: We're not afraid (Indiscernible)

12 JIM: Well, again --

13 STEVE: And like he's, he's telling me right  
14 now, like, we're not afraid of you or your law.  
15 That's not the problem.

16 DAVID: (Indiscernible) fear God and his  
17 laws.

18 JIM: Yeah.

19 STEVE: And I -- that's right, we fear God  
20 and his laws. You know, as you and I have discussed  
21 before.

22 JIM: I don't, and I don't dispute that.

23 STEVE: I can't stress, I can't stress it  
24 any stronger. That's why your trying to coerce and,  
25

1 through salesmanship and all the rest to send out one  
2 more, one more, whatever, we'll go as fast as  
3 possible. In fact, he's already done more than I  
4 would have thought he would have done, just because  
5 he's been waiting on that word. He was already told,  
6 wait.

6 JIM: Um-hum.

7 STEVE: So that's exactly what we've been  
8 doing.

9 JIM: Yeah. Well, I have no dispute over  
10 that.

11 STEVE: One of these days I'd sure like to  
12 hear your reaction to -- he, he definitely had a lot  
13 to say to you yesterday, I mean spiritually speaking.

13 JIM: Um-hum.

14 STEVE: And now and then I'd come by and  
15 listen. I'm really interested in what you really,  
16 your response to that is.

17 JIM: Yeah? Well, I, I felt a little more -

18 STEVE: Apparently I don't, I really don't  
19 think there was one, because I can tell by how you  
20 continue with me, you continue with him. I, I really  
21 doubt that -- you're probably, on the contrary, you're  
22 not convinced, but if anything, you -- I know, you've  
23 got a job to do. Let's get us out there, get us in  
24  
25

1 jail, go through the court system, and then the rest  
2 will be over. You can go back to living your life and  
3 doing the same with others.

4 JIM: Well, I think everyone will go back to  
5 living their lives. You will too. I mean, this is,  
6 this is something you've got to get over. You've got  
7 to deal with it. You can't run away from it. You've  
8 got to deal with it.

9 STEVE: Yeah, like David just said, let's  
10 process the fish.

11 JIM: What does that mean?

12 STEVE: Well, you tell me.

13 JIM: I don't know.

14 STEVE: Let's process the fish.

15 JIM: You said it. I don't know.

16 STEVE: He doesn't, he says what does that  
17 mean.

18 DAVID: Tell him I'm praying hard for him.

19 STEVE: David says he's praying hard for  
20 you, Jim.

21 JIM: Okay, well, I, I'm praying for him,  
22 too.

23 STEVE: I'd sure like to see what you look  
24 like, I mean just to see who I'm talking to here.

25 JIM: Well, you'll see me when you come out.

1                   STEVE: He says I'll see him when I come  
2 out. (Laughs.) Jim, I tell you. You're something  
3 else.

4                   JIM: Steve, we're going to work it out.

5                   STEVE: I know we are. I really, I -- but I  
6 want the best -- I'm not concerned for myself, Jim,  
7 I'm concerned for you, I really am. That's why --

8                   JIM: Aren't you concerned for those  
9 children and those women in there?

10                  STEVE: No, I really am -- I'm not concerned  
11 for anybody within, in honesty, not in the least.

12                  JIM: Well, I am. I'm concerned for every,  
13 every one of them.

14                  STEVE: They believe in a living God. You  
15 know, the Bible separates the beliefs of the world  
16 from those that believe in the living God, as it says  
17 in Revelations 7. I mean, you would think that every,  
18 every god that everyone worships is a living God, but  
19 not so. The Bible shows clearly, not too many know  
20 that living God. But anyway --

21                  JIM: Steve --

22                  STEVE: Should I give you, should we give  
23 you a call back, or what do you want to do?

24                  JIM: I'll tell you what I'd like.

25                  STEVE: Okay.

1 JIM: And you discuss it with David, okay?

2 STEVE: Okay.

3 JIM: What I'd like is for you to send a  
4 couple of children out before it gets --

5 STEVE: I don't -- it's not possible. He  
6 just, I just asked him, he said no.

7 JIM: Okay.

8 DAVID: (Indiscernible)

9 JIM: Well, he told me earlier it was, and  
10 that's the only reason.

11 STEVE: To send a few children out.

12 DAVID: No, I'm not going to send the kids  
13 out right now.

14 STEVE: He says I'm not going to send them  
15 out right now, that's what he said.

16 JIM: Okay. All right.

17 STEVE: I just, I mentioned it loudly enough  
18 so he could hear.

19 JIM: Okay, that's fine. And maybe he'll  
20 tell us later.

21 DAVID: Tell him I want to see, I want to  
22 see these tanks and stuff out of my --

23 STEVE: He wants to see these tanks out of  
24 his back yard, he wants to --

25 DAVID: These guys out of (Indiscernible)

1                   STEVE: And these guys out of his yard and  
2 out of the vehicles and things like that.

3                   JIM: Yeah, I know.

4                   STEVE: He wants to see what you guys will  
5 do now.

6                   DAVID: The original promise --

7                   STEVE: The original promise.

8                   JIM: Yeah.

9                   STEVE: Actually, he told us, he said even  
10 with that tape and with all that that was being sent  
11 out, he wanted to see there right all the way up to,  
12 how you were, and even after.

13                   JIM: Um-hum.

14                   STEVE: I mean, of course, you know --

15                   JIM: But Steve.

16                   STEVE: Yes.

17                   JIM: He broke his promise. He said --

18                   STEVE: No, you did, from before it even  
19 started with us. Before it started with us, you told  
20 me that you would have those on the perimeter.

21                   JIM: But, but --

22                   STEVE: But contrary to that, you had,  
23 you've had infantrymen, you've had personnel on the  
24 property, you've done things that were totally -- I  
25 mean, never talked to me about it.

1                   DAVID: (Indiscernible)  
2                   JIM: But Steve, let me talk just a second.  
3                   STEVE: She's a cheap reconnaissance is  
4 right.  
5                   JIM: Let me talk just a second.  
6                   DAVID: (Indiscernible)  
7                   JIM: I'm not disputing it, that truck/tank  
8 thing.  
9                   STEVE: Well, okay, no, here's what David's  
10 saying, though. Jim, let's just do it this way.  
11 We're going to take --  
12                   JIM: Well, let, let --  
13                   STEVE: We're going to --  
14                   JIM: Well, let me talk to him.  
15                   STEVE: Wait, wait, wait, wait. We're going  
16 to take a little break now.  
17                   JIM: Um-hum. Okay.  
18                   STEVE: And what we wanted to see is what  
19 you do with these guys that are on the property.  
20                   JIM: Um-hum.  
21                   STEVE: The three vehicles, the two Bradleys  
22 behind the old garage building and the one in front.  
23                   JIM: And then what --  
24                   STEVE: The guys running around on the  
25 property and all that.



1                   JIM: But then what will you do? What will  
2 you do it if I do something?

3                   STEVE: Well, let's see. You try us,  
4 because, you know, right now -- well, let's see.

5                   DAVID: (Indiscernible)

6                   JIM: Well, Steve, you told me you're not --

7                   STEVE: Let's see how -- okay, here's what  
8 David just said. Let's see how much you and those  
9 people love these children. That's what he said.

10                  JIM: Okay, now, can you listen to me for  
11 just a second.

12                  STEVE: I will.

13                  JIM: Okay. You said you were going to come  
14 out; you didn't. David said he was going to come  
15 out; he didn't. Isn't that what happened?

16                  STEVE: How long do you want to sit on the  
17 phone, because what I just said is what it is.

18                  JIM: Okay.

19                  STEVE: Because you said what you said also.  
20 That's what I'm telling you. You before me. Is that  
21 not true, Jim? The first night, the first day you and  
22 I began communication --

23                  JIM: Um-hum.

24                  STEVE: -- you stated some things to me.  
25 And so finally I gave in and said okay. I didn't like

1 the idea of even these things sitting even on the very  
2 perimeter.

3 JIM: Right.

4 STEVE: But finally I said okay, he said  
5 okay also.

6 JIM: Okay, Steve --

7 STEVE: But it's never been that. So --

8 JIM: But give me just a second, now.

9 STEVE: Okay.

10 JIM: I listened to you. The, the problem I  
11 had, do you remember the day the commanders jumped all  
12 over me?

13 STEVE: I do.

14 JIM: And that was the day that we played  
15 the tape on the Christian Broadcast --

16 STEVE: I don't even know if that's true, of  
17 course, but I'm going to take your word.

18 JIM: Well, you listened to them.

19 STEVE: I don't know why they would jump on  
20 and you, and now you are as a negotiator in the first  
21 place.

22 JIM: Wait -- all right, let me finish. We  
23 played the tape, as you requested, the Christian  
24 Broadcast Network for an hour. And on the tape, David  
25 said everyone was going to immediately come out.

1 Nobody came out. The commanders were mad at me. It  
2 wasn't until after that, that there was any  
3 encroachment on your compound. It was all before --

4 STEVE: No, no, that isn't true, Jim.

5 JIM: Yes!

6 STEVE: No, it's not!

7 JIM: Yes, the only ones with --

8 STEVE: You've got -- no, they actually had  
9 been moving around before then. That is the truth.

10 JIM: They never came in.

11 STEVE: I'll go get an, I'll get an  
12 eyewitness accounts by the people here. They watched  
13 them.

14 JIM: Well.

15 STEVE: Seriously.

16 JIM: Well, I'm telling you, that was my  
17 recollection.

18 STEVE: 'Cause I remember even raising the  
19 question to you even before the day that that was  
20 mentioned that we'd immediately come out. I even  
21 mentioned to you, it seemed to be -- I thought you  
22 were going to do something about it, nothing was.  
23 Nothing was done about it.

24 JIM: Well, when did they, when did they --

25 STEVE: So it's just been left.

1                   JIM:  When did they crush that building?  
2  Wasn't that last night?

3                   STEVE:  That was last night, that they  
4  started going that far.  They've been doing, diddling  
5  around -- Pardon?

6                   DAVID:  -- the radio said, just like, you  
7  know, when David comes out, shoot him in the head.

8                   STEVE:  The radio, like the radio said.  
9  When David comes out, shoot him in the head.

10                  JIM:  What radio?

11                  STEVE:  One of the stations said that.

12                  JIM:  Oh.  Well, that's crazy.  That's not  
13  going to happen.  You know, it was a tough, a tough  
14  sell for us to convince that Christian Broadcast  
15  Network.

16                  STEVE:  You said it's not gonna -- I mean,  
17  that's what has been said, though, on the radio, on  
18  the waves.

19                  JIM:  It's not going to happen.

20                  DAVID:  (Indiscernible) that too, you know.

21                  JIM:  It's not going to happen, unless he  
22  comes out --

23                  STEVE:  So how -- that's what I'm talking  
24  about.  One's got to consider all these things.  One's  
25  got to consider the, the history and the record of ATF

1 in the past, how they've dealt with others.

2 DAVID: (Indiscernible)

3 STEVE: Yeah, just a minute.

4 JIM: Um-hum. Well, it's not, it's not  
5 going to happen.

6 STEVE: Wait, wait, just -- wait. I want to  
7 pass something on to you, he's talking to me.

8 JIM: Okay.

9 DAVID: -- about the, the machine gun fire  
10 from the helicopters, how it shot my room all up, more  
11 than any other room in the (Indiscernible)

12 JIM: Hey, put him on the phone, Steve.

13 STEVE: Okay. Do you want to talk to him?  
14 He wants to talk to you. No, he says no.

15 JIM: Okay.

16 STEVE: Okay, he says tell Jim --

17 JIM: Okay, well --

18 STEVE: -- how when the choppers came in,  
19 how they shot up his bedroom --

20 JIM: Um-hum.

21 STEVE: -- more than anyplace on the  
22 perimeter.

23 JIM: They didn't have any guns on them.

24 STEVE: They had. They guy saw him come and  
25 they just started shooting up. You ought to see the

1 size of the holes in that, in that wall of the  
2 building.

3 JIM: Uh-huh.

4 STEVE: Yes, they did, Jim.

5 JIM: Yeah.

6 STEVE: You ought to seen how many witnesses  
7 watched that.

8 JIM: Okay.

9 STEVE: That, that didn't come out in the  
10 press or in the news, did it, Jim. I don't see how it  
11 ever will --

12 JIM: Hey, hey, Steve?

13 STEVE: -- unless God does something about,  
14 do you? ((Unidentified male voice in background not  
15 discernible.))

16 JIM: I think, I think those were outgoing  
17 rounds through the wall.

18 STEVE: No, they were not outgoing rounds,  
19 no, no. ((Unidentified male voice in background not  
20 discernible.))

21 JIM: It's clearly shown on the TV tape.

22 STEVE: They are not, yes.

23 DAVID: Why do you think they were going  
24 towards my room?

25 STEVE: Yeah, why do you think they were

1 going towards his room in the first place?

2 JIM: Yeah, but I think, and on some of  
3 those --

4 STEVE: All right, yeah?

5 JIM: On some of those TV tapes, you're  
6 going to see those rounds coming out.

7 STEVE: I'd like to see those TV tapes. I  
8 never got to see them.

9 JIM: Well, come on out, you can see them.

10 STEVE: No, send us, send me a tape here.  
11 We've got a VCR.

12 JIM: Send me some kids out.

13 STEVE: He wants, he says send me some kids  
14 out.

15 JIM: And I'll send you a tape.

16 DAVID: We don't play that now.

17 STEVE: We don't play that now is right.

18 JIM: We'll send -- I'll send you all the  
19 news coverage.

20 DAVID: (Indiscernible)

21 STEVE: We're, we're going to go back to the  
22 first thing about you doing the first thing that you  
23 said you were going to do.

24 DAVID: (Indiscernible)

25 JIM: Well, you back away, Steve. We could

1 have -- you want, you want it, but when we ask you for  
2 something, you back away. You don't want to follow  
3 through.

4 STEVE: No, no, no. This was the first  
5 thing you and I agreed on. We want to go back to  
6 square one. We want to go back to square one. Let's  
7 resolve and take care of the very things that were  
8 stated then.

9 JIM: Um-hum. Um-hum. Well, I think we  
10 need to, you know, set the record straight, and that  
11 is that there was no guns on the helicopters, and  
12 whether or not you want to believe ATF, there was  
13 National Guard officers on those helicopters.

14 STEVE: He says there was no guns on those  
15 helicopters.

16 DAVID: That's a lie! That is a lie. He's  
17 a damn liar.

18 STEVE: Did you hear that?

19 JIM: I, I know what he said, but it's, it's  
20 not true.

21 STEVE: He says he wants to talk to you now.

22 JIM: All right.

23 DAVID: Now, Jim, you're a damn liar now.  
24 Let's get real.

25 JIM: David --



1                   DAVID:  You're --  No, you listen to me.  
2  You're sitting there and telling me that there were no  
3  guns on that helicopter?

4                   JIM:  I said they didn't shoot.  There's no  
5  guns shot --

6                   DAVID:  You are a damn liar!

7                   JIM:  Well, you're wrong, David.

8                   DAVID:  You are a liar.

9                   JIM:  Okay.  Well, just calm down.

10                  DAVID:  And -- no, let me tell you  
11 something.  When I am ready to cry unto my God, you  
12 are going to stand before a furious God who's gonna  
13 judge you from the time you were conceived.  You don't  
14 fear God, and I understand that.  And I've come to  
15 this world just like you, and I know the reasons why  
16 you don't.

17                  JIM:  Um-hum.

18                  DAVID:  But there comes a point where there  
19 has to be a bridge made between carnality and divine  
20 inspiration.  There is a truth of a God, whether it's  
21 true or fictitious.  Whether it's a Peter Pan story or  
22 not.  The storybook for infidelity says there's a God  
23 who sits on a throne.

24                  JIM:  Um-hum.

25                  DAVID:  Now, if it's just a story of

1 infidelity, it's a political matter, because this  
2 country, this nation states that in a God it trusts.  
3 Now, I want to know which God we're trusting in. I  
4 want to know why bureaucracy allows men and women of  
5 this world to exercise a religion or a mental kind of  
6 sedition that allows them to go and sit  
7 congregationally and hear words of hope and words of  
8 peace, when in this world there is none. Now, if the  
9 Bible's a lie, then the system that allows such an --  
10 speech is a lie. But if the Bible's true, and there  
11 are those who will believe its witness, then it must  
12 be a judgement involved. Okay, so you say the Bible's  
13 true, Jim. All right. So you know the Bible now. So  
14 you say Christ, you believe in Christ. So you know

12           DAVID: I agree with you on that.

13           JIM: All right, then that's, that's the

18           DAVID: I agree with you.

19           JIM: Okay. Okay, so see? We're not even  
20 in dispute, and Steve is getting all worked up over  
21 it.

22           DAVID: Well, no, what the dispute was over,  
23 I believe, Jim, is that you said that they didn't fire  
24 on us from the helicopters.

25           DAVID: Well, what I mean is, a mounted gun.

1 A mounted -- you know, like a mounted machine gun.

2 DAVID: Yeah, but beside the point, what  
3 they did have was machine guns.

4 JIM: Okay, I don't, I don't know what they  
5 had. They were armed. The people inside had pistols  
6 or rifles.

6 DAVID: We agree, then.

7 JIM: Okay. All right, that's good. That's  
8 good, we agree, okay? Let's just leave it at that.  
9 Okay?

10 DAVID: All right.

11 JIM: How you doing otherwise?

12 DAVID: Like I said. We're, we're sitting  
13 here, we're waiting, we're praying for you all.

13 JIM: Yeah, okay.

14 DAVID: And we're trying to, hopefully, that  
15 as this nation, as the, as what I stated is being  
16 heard and people are asking, you know, for copies of  
17 that tape, 'cause some people, you know, want to, they  
18 want to hear what it said. Others are --

18 JIM: Did you get our phone? Did you get  
19 our phone?

20 DAVID: Yeah, we got it.

21 JIM: Okay. Does it work okay?

22 DAVID: Oh, it works fine.

1 JIM: Are you on it? Are you using it?

2 DAVID: Yeah, we're using it.

3 JIM: Oh, okay. Good.

4 DAVID: And others are scoffing.

5 JIM: What do you mean?

6 DAVID: Well, you know, people are scoffing.

7 You know, Psalms 1. You remember Psalms 1.

8 JIM: Um-hum.

9 DAVID: I mean, the situation that's at hand  
10 is a situation to where, you know, it appears as a  
11 maniac and there's an arms charge and this, that.

12 JIM: Unless --

13 DAVID: There's a lot of, a lot of different  
14 lines and details to it and, you know. Any time  
15 anybody judges a picture before he sees the whole  
16 thing is kind of a fool, isn't he?

17 JIM: Well, I think -- you know, there's a  
18 lot of people like that, skeptics, but you can't, I  
19 mean, you've got to deal with one person at a time,  
20 you know. It's hard to deal with the masses  
21 sometimes.

22 DAVID: Right. Okay.

23 JIM: You know how inaccurate the media's  
24 been, so.

25 DAVID: Right.

1                   JIM: I saw them on there today and talked  
2 about, they talked about more negotiators than's  
3 anywhere around here. You know, I mean.

4                   DAVID: They said what now?

5                   JIM: They said there's three teams of  
6 negotiators talking to David, you know. That's not  
7 true.

8                   DAVID: No, well, no, that's not true,  
9 'cause I wanted, I wanted one negotiator, and you, I  
10 talked with you because first of all, you have your,  
11 your proficiency down.

12                   JIM: Yeah.

13                   DAVID: You know, you have an intelligence  
14 behind your ability to talk.

15                   JIM: Right.

16                   DAVID: You know, you don't just have a  
17 radio disk jockey's voice, you've also --

18                   JIM: Well, you're a, you're a bright guy  
19 yourself, and we've been able to communicate, and I  
20 think that's --

21                   DAVID: Well --

22                   JIM: That's real good, you know. So --

23                   DAVID: And then the, then the second guy  
24 that came, what was his name, Gary?

25                   JIM: Gar? Yeah.

1                   DAVID: Oh, boy. That guy needs to go back  
2 to school, Jim.

3                   JIM: Yeah, I know it.

4                   DAVID: Oh, talking about pushy, I mean, you  
5 know.

6                   JIM: I agree with you.

7                   DAVID: By right of, by right of trade, you  
8 know --

9                   JIM: I don't like him either, really.

10                  DAVID: We're the ones that are supposed to  
11 be hot-headed, you know.

12                  JIM: Yeah.

13                  DAVID: We're the ones supposed to be, you  
14 know -- I want the \$5,000 and I want the airplane  
15 (Indiscernible) or I'll not come -- you know, we're  
16 the ones supposed to be like that, you know?

17                  JIM: I think he needs a different line of  
18 work.

19                  DAVID: What do you mean?

20                  JIM: Don't you?

21                  DAVID: Who, Gary?

22                  JIM: Yeah.

23                  DAVID: Yeah, he's very --

24                  JIM: Abrupt, I would say.

25                  DAVID: Real tough guy, you know, and being



1 a tough guy just makes the crazy guys tougher.

2 JIM: Well you don't, we don't need no John  
3 Waynes, you know?

4 DAVID: Yeah.

5 JIM: We just need --

6 DAVID: Well anyway, I told Gary, I said,  
7 look Gary, I said I made a deal with somebody, you got  
8 to respect it. Oh, no, he wouldn't listen.

9 JIM: Um-hum.

10 DAVID: Now, the reason why we've talked to  
11 Henry is because Henry, like yourself --

12 JIM: Right.

13 DAVID: -- you know, knows how to, he knows  
14 how to be a waitress.

15 JIM: Right.

16 DAVID: And that's what you people are,  
17 you're professional waitresses, and you know  
18 professional waitresses --

19 JIM: (Laughs.) That's a good analogy.

20 DAVID: -- that are really good get tipped  
21 good.

22 JIM: Um-hum.

23 DAVID: And we have really been happy with  
24 you, you first, and secondarily Henry. So, you know,  
25 we commend you all.

1                   JIM: Well, I appreciate your say -- I  
2 appreciate your saying that, and frankly, I appreciate  
3 the way you've been, and I really do, and --

4                   DAVID: Check on, check on the baby. What's  
5 she crying about?

6                   JIM: Everything okay?

7                   DAVID: 'Cause some-- could be -- could  
8 someone go check on her, please? I don't want to hear  
9 them cry, kind of rips my heart.

10                  JIM: Is that Bobby?

11                  DAVID: No, I think it's, it's one of the  
12 other ones. Let me look at my list here, so I can see  
13 which names I gave you; otherwise, I might let another  
14 name slip.

15                  JIM: Okay.

16                  DAVID: Okay.

17                  JIM: Let's see, I had Chan--

18                  DAVID: You got Dailand --

19                  JIM: (Indiscernible)

20                  DAVID: -- Pages, Star, Cyrus, Bobby and  
21 Chanelle.

22                  JIM: Right, I got that. Okay. Are those,  
23 any of those child -- oh, let's see Cyrus, Star, and  
24 Bobby are your children.

25                  DAVID: All these are mine.

1           JIM: Oh, they're all your children, okay.

2           DAVID: Yeah. These are my babies.

3           JIM: Yeah, we'll take good care of them --

4           DAVID: Oh --

5           JIM: -- just like they're my own.

6           DAVID: Well, there's something about those  
7 babies and prophecies you all don't know.

8           JIM: Well, I --

9           DAVID: All through the Bible it talks about  
10 Messiah, the prince?

11           DAVID: Um-hum.

12           DAVID: Having children?

13           JIM: Um-hum.

14           DAVID: Supposed to be greatest honor to the  
15 world to be unitified (phonetic sp.) with the family  
16 of the universes?

17           JIM: Um-hum.

18           DAVID: Of God?

19           JIM: Um-hum.

20           DAVID: Christ died two thousand years ago  
21 that you all might receive the knowledge of the holy.

22           JIM: Yeah. Well, there's nothing more  
23 beautiful than a child.

24           DAVID: But if you don't understand it, God  
25 plainly states what'll happen to the children of the

1 world.

2 JIM: Um-hum.

3 DAVID: You know, that's the message of  
4 Malachi, said that before the great and dreadful day  
5 of the Lord --

6 JIM: Um-hum.

7 DAVID: -- God will send the spirit of  
8 Elijah, messenger of the covenant.

9 JIM: Um-hum.

10 DAVID: And his purpose is to turn the  
11 hearts of the fathers to the children and the heart of  
12 children to the fathers, lest I come and smite the  
13 earth under the curse.

14 JIM: Um-hum.

15 DAVID: But if you don't understand the  
16 importance of God and his knowledge of marriage --  
17 well, like, like I was saying, Jim. I mean, I know  
18 you're pacifying me, but maybe, just maybe --

19 JIM: Tell you, I'm not.

20 DAVID: Maybe what, some of the things I say  
21 might, you know, might enlighten a little question  
22 within your own heart. You know, why does God  
23 tolerate sin? That's the first question. Why didn't  
24 God, when Adam and Eve sinned, why didn't God just  
25 wipe them out, and we wouldn't have all this today,

1 would we?

2 JIM: Um-hum. That's right.

3 DAVID: I mean, you know, such suffering and  
4 sorrow. What kind of wisdom is applied in all of  
5 this? Well, remember the statement. Many people  
6 overlook it, but the whole story of creation basically  
7 starts like this: Moses wrote the first records of  
8 creation. Okay? And in the times of Egypt, when  
9 Egypt was the most predominant empire of its day, the  
10 Egyptian pharaohs believed that they were gods. You  
11 know, you understand that, don't you?

12 JIM: Yeah.

13 DAVID: They were worshipped as gods, and  
14 when they died, their whole families -- course you  
15 know, all the early --

16 JIM: They built the pyramids, right?

17 DAVID: Oh, well no, actually, Joseph was  
18 the one that gave the knowledge of the pyramids.

19 JIM: Um-hum.

20 DAVID: You see, when you, when you read in  
21 the scripture about the ark of the covenant, it talks  
22 about the covenant having oracles --

23 JIM: Um-hum.

24 DAVID: -- and having chains between the  
25 covenant and the oracles?

1                   JIM: Um-hum.

2                   DAVID: And you know, scholars, they're,  
3 they've always had a hard time interpreting certain  
4 words of the manuscript 'cause they don't understand  
5 what the words are.

6                   JIM: Um-hum.

7                   DAVID: And that's why get a concordance and  
8 it says possibly unknown root word, could be this,  
9 that, this, that, and the other. They try to put a  
10 word in there in the line of the verse. But really,  
11 the way the sanctuary was built is that the ark of the  
12 covenant was designed to where it had a -- well, you  
13 know, science has already discovered this -- it had a  
14 high electrical current through it.

15                   JIM: Um-hum.

16                   DAVID: Very, very high electrical current.  
17 And the purity of its gold and the fashionability of  
18 its structure permitted it to be used in a way to  
19 where God could communicate with a high priest. Well,  
20 what man fails to understand in regards to the records  
21 of, of Deuteronomy, Leviticus, and you know, all these  
22 testimonies or say chronicles and kings in regards to  
23 this mysterious ark of the covenant, is that when men  
24 such as Moses and the prophets were commanded to build  
25 these things, they were also assisted by higher

1 intelligences. You know, we're talking about, we're  
2 talking about beings from -- well, look, you've got a  
3 sun, don't you?

4 JIM: Um-hum.

5 DAVID: Did the sun come up this morning?  
6 Aren't you, aren't you on a ball, aren't you like,  
7 don't you have an atmosphere and everything, and don't  
8 you have certain laws of this nature and realm, to  
9 where you're on this planetary, basic ball and you're  
10 rotating it so much miles per hour, revolving around  
11 the sun, so many days per year. I mean, you are  
12 really on a path, you're traveling through space,  
13 aren't you.

14 JIM: Um-hum.

15 DAVID: And you keep coming back around to  
16 the same place. Okay. Well, I mean, this is really  
17 unique, to think that we're flying out here, hung in  
18 the abyss of distance.

19 JIM: Um-hum.

20 DAVID: You know? Now, the thing of it is,  
21 is that, as I say, it's not theoretical, it's  
22 scientific.

23 JIM: Um-hum.

24 DAVID: That from the beginning of time, the  
25 ancients, whether it be through poetic or whether it

1 be through scripture, have always -- and this is not  
2 just a Judaism, this is, you know, from all your  
3 cultures, from all around the world. They talk about  
4 visitors from the stars who come here in some form or  
5 type of vehicle, right?

6 JIM: All right. Well, what would that be,  
7 a spaceship or something, hum? Sounds like.

8 DAVID: Well, remember, the spaceship  
9 concept is something that's not really understood  
10 until man finally reaches a point of evolution to  
11 where he finds out that he can, by wisdom, by the  
12 sermon of nature and the principles of construction to  
13 the laws of nature, he can fly. He -- the atmosphere  
14 is dense enough to be able to lift up the poundage  
15 that gravity holds down. You know, when you learn  
16 about energy and direction of energy, forces, the  
17 things of science, the natural energies, how to  
18 harness them, how to utilize them, then yes, man is,  
19 man has found the ability to, to strengthen then  
20 natural into the supernatural. What I mean is this:  
21 I mean that, to a primitive man or a man that's been  
22 separated from God, say from Eden, and has been left  
23 without the knowledge of the origin of creation,  
24 right?

25 JIM: Right.



1                   DAVID: Man would find himself in a base,  
2 natural aftermath of nature or creation, such as the  
3 animals of the field, the natural source of the, the  
4 biological world, the geographical world, the nature  
5 of the world, and the natural habitat of nature, such  
6 as a man in Africa and a man in South America or a man  
7 in Alaska. You know, man will adapt to his nature,  
8 won't he.

8                   JIM: Um-hum.

9                   DAVID: And what nature presents to him will  
10 make him natural man. The ability to eat, to survive,  
11 to procreate, are all the natural instincts of man.  
12 So that's why the Bible says that man, by nature,  
13 without the instruction of God, is a beast. He's like  
14 the beast of the field. Okay. But, whereas man  
15 becomes inspired when his mind is able to all of a  
16 sudden perceive a better way --
