2 HENRY GARCIA: -- to handle the  
3 responsibility that you thrust upon yourself and  
4 Linda.

5 DAVID KORESH: Right.

6 HENRY GARCIA: When you were in that  
7 situation, you paid for that with the pain and  
8 anguish --

9 DAVID KORESH: They could be --

10 HENRY GARCIA: -- that you --

11 DAVID KORESH: -- tried of God.

12 HENRY GARCIA: Exactly. Exactly. You paid  
13 for it.

14 DAVID KORESH: Um-hum.

15 HENRY GARCIA: Okay? I mean, it, it was  
16 difficult for, for you to know what to do in that  
17 situation and you did what you had to. I, I think a  
18 lot of it was just reaction. The -- you know, I mean,  
19 all of a sudden here you get this information. You  
20 don't know what to do with it. You don't know how to  
21 deal with it --

22 DAVID KORESH: You mean, when, when you're  
23 talking about is when God first began to communicate.

24 HENRY GARCIA: No, no, no.

25 DAVID KORESH: I --

1 HENRY GARCIA: I'm saying when, when, when  
2 she told you that she was pregnant.

3 DAVID KORESH: Oh, yeah. Oh --

4 HENRY GARCIA: I mean, you didn't --

5 DAVID KORESH: -- definitely.

6 HENRY GARCIA: -- you didn't know what to do  
7 with, with that situation. But then you paid the  
8 price. Okay? You paid the price, the anguish that  
9 you had to go through --

10 DAVID KORESH: Uh-huh.

11 HENRY GARCIA: -- as a result of being  
12 separated from her -- or -- and of finding out,  
13 because now you're looking forward towards having, you  
14 know, the baby and it's going to be a part of you and  
15 you're actually starting to, to think in terms of what  
16 your life is going to be like.

17 DAVID KORESH: Right.

18 HENRY GARCIA: And, and --

19 DAVID KORESH: Then it's gone.

20 HENRY GARCIA: -- and then it's gone. And  
21 then it's gone. My God. You know, what a, what a  
22 difficult situation to live with, particularly when  
23 you've been -- when you've had this very meaningful  
24 relationship that you've always felt that you had with  
25 God. You know?

1                   DAVID KORESH: Because I didn't understand  
2 it then. Because you've got to realize that this  
3 world is really a nice place when you come under the  
4 flesh.

5                   HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum. Here you were in a  
6 situation where you needed to show responsibility and  
7 you didn't.

8                   DAVID KORESH: Didn't know how yet.

9                   HENRY GARCIA: Exactly. Exactly --

10                  DAVID KORESH: Was playing without the  
11 responsibility of knowing what I was playing with.

12                  HENRY GARCIA: Sure. Sure. Sure. But, you  
13 know, I'm -- I, I hear -- I mean, I, I really like the  
14 things that I hear you saying.

15                  DAVID KORESH: See -- I don't mean to  
16 interrupt you. I want to give you time to speak.

17                  HENRY GARCIA: Go ahead.

18                  DAVID KORESH: But this is what I was  
19 telling Jim. I said Jim, in all honesty, we was  
20 coming out the other day, in all honesty. But, Jim,  
21 my problem is is that, in all honesty, these seals are  
22 really more important than people realize and this is  
23 the time. Look. I can't help it -- but Noah couldn't  
24 help it in his day. Okay? I know -- I -- look. It  
25 doesn't hurt my feelings. Like Psalms 19-- Psalms

1 119, those that love God, nothing offends them. I  
2 mean, I, I, I, I don't have any animosity to anything  
3 people say about me at all. You know -- oh, I'm  
4 sorry. I'm sorry. I put, I put my hand back behind  
5 the pillow there and there was somebody underneath the  
6 other pillow and I --

6 HENRY GARCIA: Okay.

7 DAVID KORESH: Okay. But what I'm saying is  
8 is that, you know, I'm here trying to explain to, to  
9 my -- see, God, God's not what people think God is.  
10 Okay. Look. Let's pretend you yourself -- let's  
11 pretend you found the keys to the universe.

11 HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum.

12 DAVID KORESH: And you found this key, same  
13 like Moses or Elijah --

14 HENRY GARCIA: Uh-huh.

15 DAVID KORESH: -- that deal, deal, deals  
16 with the causal of nature.

17 HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum.

18 DAVID KORESH: Naturals of nature. Joy and  
19 pain.

19 HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum.

20 DAVID KORESH: Warm and cold.

21 HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum.

22 DAVID KORESH: Wet and dry.

1 HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum.

2 DAVID KORESH: And let's, let's say that you  
3 so -- you didn't learn school -- you didn't learn the  
4 patterns of the system, but you simply became  
5 acquainted with the natural nature and the both  
6 comforts and the pains of the natural nature and you  
7 went the middle road.

7 HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum.

8 DAVID KORESH: Which is wisdom.

9 HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum.

10 DAVID KORESH: Okay. And let's say that,  
11 that unlocked them to you. Solomon calls it the  
12 secret place to stairs. Okay?

12 HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum.

13 DAVID KORESH: And, and you, and you  
14 actually were being judged not knowing. And that  
15 ability or that wisdom or that humanity, which has  
16 gone way beyond you --

17 HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum.

18 DAVID KORESH: -- that dwells beyond the  
19 stars or throughout the planets and other stars, they  
20 counselled and they said okay, let's go and let's  
21 take, let's take Henry here --

21 HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum.

22 DAVID KORESH: -- and let's, let's go and  
23  
24

1 let's, let's go ahead and manifest the reason and  
2 purposes of this, of this life which he has. Let's  
3 give him the answers and, and we'll use him, because,  
4 you know, he has already, from basic natural  
5 simplicity, already shown that he's in the direction  
6 which allows men to be redeemed or, or be transferred  
7 from this. Because, you know, with, with these  
8 principles established in our minds and hearts, we, we  
9 can guarantee the safety of all those other billions  
10 of millions of billions of millions of governments --

10 HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum.

11 DAVID KORESH: -- all under the one prime  
12 government.

12 HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum.

13 DAVID KORESH: Okay. And, so, so you had  
14 this experience and it's like you know it and you have  
15 to speak very simply to people and only those who are  
16 looking and knocking and asking can look at you and  
17 say, well, okay, what do you know. And, so, you tell  
18 them what you know and they go, well, how -- well, how  
19 did you learn that? So, you begin to unfold the  
20 seals. And then you explain to them well, I -- this  
21 happened to me. And they go well, I've always wanted  
22 to know this. So, then you -- the knowledge becomes  
23 mutual. Right?

1 HENRY GARCIA: Right.

2 DAVID KORESH: Okay. So, then what happens  
3 is, is that then we become confronted with a situation  
4 to where man, who has not been given this  
5 understanding as of yet, are to be judged because we  
6 come to a crisis called time no longer, where the  
7 nations of the earth are making moves to, to u-- to  
8 capitalization to form another form of government,  
9 move into the last phase which providence says they  
10 will move into. And, remember, there's only one  
11 Messiah.

11 HENRY GARCIA: Right.

12 DAVID KORESH: That's the Word of God.

13 HENRY GARCIA: Right.

14 DAVID KORESH: And from, and from, and from  
15 Adam all the way down, there's only one sons of God.

16 HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum.

17 DAVID KORESH: Those who hear God's words.

18 HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum.

19 DAVID KORESH: And, remember, if, if -- the  
20 greatest of us is to be the servant of all. You know,  
21 you, you'll notice, you'll notice that, that, that I  
22 have never flaunted or, or tried to become something  
23 that I'm, that I'm not. I mean, you know --

24 HENRY GARCIA: Uh-huh.

25



1                   DAVID KORESH:  -- I don't -- you know,  
2 you've seen my car out there, that black Camero.

3                   HENRY GARCIA:  Um-hum.

4                   DAVID KORESH:  Well, it's something we built  
5 together.

6                   HENRY GARCIA:  Uh-huh.

7                   DAVID KORESH:  And other guys built things  
8 together, you know.

9                   HENRY GARCIA:  Uh-huh.

10                  DAVID KORESH:  I mean, I have to admit one  
11 time a person thought that I needed a better car, and  
12 so they bought me a, a, a Prelude, a new Prelude, but  
13 I got rid of it after a few months because it just, it  
14 just does-- it just didn't seem right.

15                  HENRY GARCIA:  Um-hum.

16                  DAVID KORESH:  And, besides, it just didn't  
17 have no power anyway.

18                  HENRY GARCIA:  Uh-huh.

19                  DAVID KORESH:  Okay.  So, what I'm saying is  
20 I'm saying that I know and I am willing to be or to  
21 take whatever punishments that, you know, that would  
22 help the world to see that what I believe in is  
23 something that I will believe in and give me life.  
24 Because, see, God has given me this life and nobody  
25 can ta-- really take this life from me.  And my

1 greatest sorrow is that -- you know, like I'm, like  
2 I'm standing before my God and I'm explaining to God  
3 that -- you know, like with Robert with the, with the  
4 ATF agents that came here --

5 HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum.

6 DAVID KORESH: -- you know, honestly, I did  
7 everything in my -- I was going to let him stay here  
8 and live with us.

9 HENRY GARCIA: Uh-huh.

10 DAVID KORESH: We'd already made  
11 arrangements for that.

12 HENRY GARCIA: Yes.

13 DAVID KORESH: I told him. I said Robert,  
14 I, I -- look -- I -- see, I knew who he was anyway.

15 HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum.

16 DAVID KORESH: And the reason why we knew  
17 you'all were coming was not from a phone call. That  
18 morning, you know, when they said a phone call was  
19 coming in --

20 HENRY GARCIA: Uh-huh.

21 DAVID KORESH: -- that was fake. I'd  
22 already, I'd already told them, you know, and they was  
23 wanting to know. So, they said, you know, there's a  
24 phone call. And they asked me, they says, the --  
25 well, what's going on? I said, look, don't worry

1 about it. I'm going to talk to Robert right now.  
2 And, you know, we've been giving him studies and I --  
3 and I'm pretty sure that he's going to realize, you  
4 know, to hold this thing off. So, I went back out and  
5 told him, I says, oh, it was nothing. You know. And,  
6 so, I, I started telling him. I says, now, Robert --  
7 and I looked him straight in the eye. I said, you  
8 know, I've been honest with you. You know, I've  
9 brought you over here. I've given you several  
10 studies. You know. And I said, and I expect, you  
11 know, I expect you to really, you know, apply your  
12 heart to what you've been learning because you know  
13 it's true.

12 HENRY GARCIA: Uh-huh.

13 DAVID KORESH: You know. And, and -- you  
14 know, I know that things are happening, and what I  
15 want you to realize is is that, you know, I want you  
16 to do what you've got to do, because you know I'm  
17 going to do what I'm going to do.

18 HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum.

19 DAVID KORESH: You know. And he looked at  
20 me like, you know, it's like a surprise is, all right,  
21 and I -- and, and I thought for sure that he  
22 understood that I -- what I was asking from him was  
23 for him to go out and say, look guys, let's hold off  
24  
25

1 on this. Let's deal with it a different way.

2 HENRY GARCIA: Uh-huh.

3 DAVID KORESH: You know. But I actually  
4 think that there was a mess-up. Because, you know,  
5 there is, there is, there is a, there is a -- there's  
6 other beings that have been rejected out of the  
7 communion of what the universe holds.

7 HENRY GARCIA: Uh-huh.

8 DAVID KORESH: And they, and they, they try  
9 to promote us in the sensuality and overbearing and,  
10 and, and evil, and they try to get us into the spirit  
11 of, like, yeah. You know, you know, like this evil --  
12 you know, getting free off of the hurting pain of  
13 others.

13 HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum.

14 DAVID KORESH: You know. And, and it didn't  
15 work.

16 HENRY GARCIA: Uh-huh.

17 DAVID KORESH: And I've been trying to  
18 explain to, to God through the communications that are  
19 coming -- I'm trying to explain that, you know, Robert  
20 in himself more than likely had a battle that morning  
21 -- because like, you know, when he would come over,  
22 he'd like -- he like brought his pistol over and he  
23 brought, you know, his, his target pistol --

1 HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum.

2 DAVID KORESH: -- and he brought his AR, the  
3 107 Twish (phonetic), you know, the, the one that  
4 shoots heavier grain tracer rounds?

5 HENRY GARCIA: Uh-huh.

6 DAVID KORESH: It's a sniper rifle, is what  
7 a lot of, you know, guys use them in the, in the  
8 police and stuff.

9 HENRY GARCIA: Uh-huh.

10 DAVID KORESH: And he had such a, an awesome  
11 trigger job done on that, that -- I mean, I told him,  
12 I says, you know -- I, I shot it for him and all that,  
13 you know, and, and -- I told him, I says, I says,  
14 Robert, I says, you know what you've got here? I  
15 mean, honestly, we did everything to let those guys  
16 next door know that we were -- that they were ATF  
17 agents, you know, and, and we let them come in and,  
18 you know, I told him, I says, Robert, look if you give  
19 me time --

20 (Child crying in background.)

21 DAVID KORESH: What, what's wrong with the  
22 baby?

23 (Child crying in background.)

24 DAVID KORESH: Well, well, well, well, go,  
25 go check on him. I -- you know, I told him, I said,

1 if you give me time, if you learn these seals, you'll  
2 know everything there is to know about me. I'll hide  
3 nothing from you. Then that newspaper article came  
4 out Monday with all those accusations and all those,  
5 all those twisted up and turn-around things about me,  
6 you know.

6 HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum.

7 DAVID KORESH: Okay. Like that one tape  
8 they play? It says, it says, who's this on the  
9 throne? You know, I'm screaming, right?

10 HENRY GARCIA: Uh-huh.

11 DAVID KORESH: But, but the reasons behind  
12 that is is that people had been doing things that you  
13 just don't do when you're supposed to be following  
14 Christ. This concept that, that people, you know, are  
15 always happy and holy people because they believe in  
16 Jesus is wrong.

16 HENRY GARCIA: That's right.

17 DAVID KORESH: I mean, a lot of people that  
18 come into the house of God are really very evil  
19 people.

19 HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum.

20 DAVID KORESH: And they had to be dealt  
21 with, with, with a rebuke.

22 HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum.

23

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1                   DAVID KORESH: Now, that one tape they play  
2 around where it talks about when I put my, my, my horn  
3 inside of a woman's body, you know, and all this kind  
4 of stuff, I forgot what tape it was, you see, unless a  
5 person knew what it means between a priest and a  
6 sanctuary -- okay. The first priest of God, the first  
7 mediator of God was Adam. And where -- what -- where  
8 was his first church at? Where was his first church?  
9 Where did he get his congregation from?

9                   HENRY GARCIA: Who are you asking about?

10                  DAVID KORESH: Adam.

11                  HENRY GARCIA: Adam?

12                  DAVID KORESH: Yeah, Adam.

13                  HENRY GARCIA: In the Garden of Eden?

14                  DAVID KORESH: That was his church?

15                  HENRY GARCIA: I'm, I'm asking is that --

16                  DAVID KORESH: Okay. Okay. Let's say,  
17 let's -- let's say his first sanctuary was the Garden  
18 of Eden, okay?

19                  HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum.

20                  DAVID KORESH: Who was his real garden  
21 though?

22                  HENRY GARCIA: Eve.

23                  DAVID KORESH: Eve. See, it's beautiful.  
24 It's -- and, and inside of a woman's body is two  
25

1 bridges. They're called, they're called ovaries.

2 Okay?

3 HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum.

4 DAVID KORESH: And man being made from the  
5 dust is just like the plants, after his kind, the  
6 scripture says. Seed in the earth; man's seed in the  
7 woman. And that's why -- and it talks about in the,  
8 in the -- between, between the woman and her seed and  
9 the devil's seed. And Zechariah's prophet shows you  
10 the canister with the golden bowl. Now, when it talks  
11 about the anointing and talks about they would be  
12 anointed and I, and I will anoint you, the actual  
13 knowledge of the anointing was -- is that when God  
14 rose up a prophet or a king, he wanted to make a  
15 covenant with them, that if they would keep his laws  
16 he would also anoint him as king and, and give the  
17 same gifts to the offspring.

16 HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum.

17 DAVID KORESH: Now. Okay. So, a man's not  
18 a king until he becomes anointed, right?

18 HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum.

19 DAVID KORESH: Okay. So, if you're Adam,  
20 the only way you could become a king is if you're  
21 anointed. Now, you can't be anointed unless you have  
22 a kingdom. And the first part of your kingdom starts

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1 with the anointed. And the woman, the woman anoints  
2 you. Well -- ah, I know it sounds funny at first, but  
3 this is, this is coming from a higher source than us.  
4 Everything in God's kingdom is poetic and in harmony.  
5 God made Adam a king by giving him Eve, by giving him  
6 a chance to become one with his own soul.

6 HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum.

7 DAVID KORESH: The way you become one with  
8 God is by becoming one with God's image, becoming one  
9 with your own glory. The way you love God is by  
10 loving yourself. The way you love yourself is by  
11 becoming one with one that is given to you of God, the  
12 woman. The man with the woman. She anoints you.  
13 Your horn is a symbol of your power, your power to be  
14 as God, to procreate. Now, when you procreate, you  
15 have children. Right?

15 HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum.

16 DAVID KORESH: I mean, she believes you're a  
17 king, doesn't she?

18 HENRY GARCIA: Yep.

19 DAVID KORESH: And she anoints you, doesn't  
20 she?

20 HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum.

21 DAVID KORESH: Okay. And then she gives you  
22 a kingdom, doesn't she?

23

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1 HENRY GARCIA: Right.

2 DAVID KORESH: Then you have one, two,  
3 three, four, five, six, fifteen, twenty, thirty,  
4 forty, fifty, 100, 1,000, maybe 2,000, 20,000, maybe a  
5 million kids. Now, who is king? You are.

6 HENRY GARCIA: Right.

7 DAVID KORESH: And everyone else is  
8 brethren.

9 HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum.

10 DAVID KORESH: Okay. Well, that's what the  
11 kingdom of God is. Through God and his glory, all  
12 that is made is begotten of the one spirit. So, that  
13 woman in Revelation 12, she is real. She's not, she's  
14 not a church. It says that John saw the temple of God  
15 open in heaven and behold a great wonder of woman.  
16 No. See, the temple is the temple. But the Sikina  
17 (phonetic) or, or the, or the Shaddai (phonetic), the  
18 great-breasted one? I mean, this is the one that  
19 Moses saw where, where, where Moses says to God,  
20 Yaveh, havey, havey (phonetic). He says, you know,  
21 let me see Thy glory. And, and, and God says you may  
22 see only the hind part of my glory, for no man can see  
23 the face of my glory and live. And you know what  
24 Moses saw in the mount that made his face shine? A  
25 woman. I mean -- I know. See, to, to, to, to men of

1 the world, there's so many things they don't  
2 understand.

3 HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum.

4 DAVID KORESH: But, you know, God says -- I  
5 mean, let's go back to basic scripture. And God said,  
6 let us make man in our image after our likeness.

6 Okay? Right?

7 HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum.

8 DAVID KORESH: So, what did God make? Male  
9 and --

10 HENRY GARCIA: Female.

11 DAVID KORESH: Exactly. So, so, when, when,  
12 when Christ came to die, when God came in the form of  
13 humanity, okay, the one sitting on the throne, when he  
14 came to die -- he didn't marry, did he?

14 HENRY GARCIA: No.

15 DAVID KORESH: But out of his side came  
16 blood and what --

17 HENRY GARCIA: Fluid.

18 DAVID KORESH: Blood and water. Exactly.  
19 Now, some people say well, what that was is that the  
20 blood separated and everything from the plasma and  
21 everything, and that's not what the scripture said,  
22 because the prophecies will tell you that it will be a  
23 fountain of water and a fountain of blood. And the

1 one who tells you that is the one who originated it,  
2 which is called the wisdom of heaven. Okay. When you  
3 read Proverbs 8 and 9 -- okay. Now, for instance,  
4 people say how do I know the scriptures, right?

5 HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum.

6 DAVID KORESH: Well, let me explain this.  
7 How do you learn a phone number? You memorize it,  
8 right?

9 HENRY GARCIA: That's right.

10 DAVID KORESH: I mean, but you've got to use  
11 it.

12 HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum.

13 DAVID KORESH: Okay. Well, if you was to  
14 study in my past records, my biggest problem was the  
15 ability to -- of not to comprehend. I mean, I, I  
16 didn't know my alphabet till the third grade, and I  
17 still didn't know it that well, because I did not have  
18 attention. I did not have a stuttering problem. I  
19 didn't have the ability as a child to be able to read  
20 and comprehend what I was reading. But when you see  
21 the whole picture, when God shows you everything --

22 HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum.

23 DAVID KORESH: -- the whole picture, then  
24 all of a sudden I, I -- all my early days I could  
25 remember pictures.

1 HENRY GARCIA: Hmm.

2 DAVID KORESH: I mean, I, I did know the  
3 mysteries in regards to nature and the different kinds  
4 of trees and bugs, and I did have a good memory with  
5 regards to anything to do with my visual, but not  
6 through visual through hieroglyphics. I couldn't  
7 understand reading and writing, but I could understand  
8 looking at a car or a motor or anything I could touch,  
9 put my hands on.

9 HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum.

10 DAVID KORESH: Okay. So, when, when I was  
11 given the knowledge of the visions, when I was shown,  
12 you know, the whole story that, that the Bible's  
13 already a record about -- you know, I'm not the first  
14 one that's been shown this.

14 HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum.

15 DAVID KORESH: I mean, this has been shown  
16 all the way back to the days of Moses.

17 HENRY GARCIA: Uh-huh.

18 DAVID KORESH: You know. Then all of a  
19 sudden that, that's what I say, you know, I know who  
20 the sons of God are. You know, I know who the Bible  
21 writers are. You know? And I know that -- like, for  
22 instance, when it says in Isaiah 45 about Koresh, it  
23 says, it says, thus sayeth the Lord to his anointed --  
24  
25

1 | which in the Hebrew is Meshia (phonetic), Messiah --  
2 | to Koresh, whose right hand I have holden up, for I  
3 | will subdue nations with him and overthrow kingdoms.  
4 | Okay?

5 |           HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum.

6 |           DAVID KORESH: Now, it says here -- it says,  
7 | ask of me things to come concerning my sons and the  
8 | works of my hands commend you me. Okay. So, in other  
9 | words, the first thing that, that we learn about is  
10 | that the only reason why that the father gives the  
11 | book to the lamb in heaven -- right?

12 |           HENRY GARCIA: Uh-huh.

13 |           DAVID KORESH: -- is so that he can come and  
14 | give it to who? Everybody else.

15 |           HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum.

16 |           DAVID KORESH: Give his -- or everybody  
17 | else. Okay. So, it's kind of like God is like this,  
18 | God's going to give one little boy an ice cream cone  
19 | -- right?

20 |           HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum.

21 |           DAVID KORESH: -- and to go outside and say  
22 | look what I got. Wow. You want some? And all the  
23 | kids go yeah. You know?

24 |           HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum.

25 |           DAVID KORESH: And all those that don't get

1 jealous, get angry, get mad, they go yeah, where'd you  
2 get that? He says, well, come in hither and I will  
3 show you.

4 HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum.

5 DAVID KORESH: And, you know, this is, this  
6 is the father. He's got the ice cream scooper. He's  
7 got the ice cream out and this is a free gift. You  
8 see?

9 HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum.

10 DAVID KORESH: So, that's the way it works.  
11 Now, now, if I say I'm Jesus Christ or I'm the Son of  
12 God, I mean, come on. No one's going to believe that.

13 HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum.

14 DAVID KORESH: You know? And --

15 HENRY GARCIA: Hmm.

16 DAVID KORESH: -- it's -- that's, that's why  
17 it says in, in Matthew 24 when the Son of Man shall  
18 come. You see, this is God referring to when the Son  
19 of Man shall come. Why? Because all sons of men are  
20 the sons of God. They just don't know it yet.

21 HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum.

22 DAVID KORESH: They're, they're, they're  
23 still out having their prodigal and they haven't come  
24 to their senses yet.

25 HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum.

1                   DAVID KORESH: Who wants to live their lives  
2 feeding pigs when there is existences above and beyond  
3 that are doing far better than us?

4                   HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum.

5                   DAVID KORESH: So, anyway, when you look at  
6 Proverbs 8 and 9 -- okay. For instance, it says let  
7 him have the wisdom, count the number of the beasts.  
8 I, I think you'll really enjoy this, especially when  
9 -- it'll help bring you and your wife closer together.  
10 It's Proverbs 8 and 9.

11                   HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum.

12                   DAVID KORESH: Because, see, the, the final  
13 judgment that we're trying to settle here, you know,  
14 for, for the one that I work for -- and that sounds  
15 funny, I know, but -- it says, it says right here.  
16 Okay. Proverbs 8 and 9. You don't have a Bible  
17 there, do you?

18                   HENRY GARCIA: No, I don't have it right  
19 here.

20                   DAVID KORESH: Okay. It says right here.  
21 I'll, I'll just read it to you. This, this is taken  
22 from Proverbs. And it says, let not wisdom cry and  
23 understanding put forth her voice. You know what a  
24 conscience is, don't you?

25                   HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum.



1                   DAVID KORESH: Okay. And it says also, it  
2 says down here, she's standeth at the top of the high  
3 places by the way and the places of the path. She  
4 crieth into the gates at the entry of the city at the  
5 coming in at the doors. Unto you, oh, men, I call,  
6 and my voice is to the sons of man. When you read  
7 this conscience like -- um, I shouldn't do that?

8                   HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum.

9                   DAVID KORESH: Yeah. Okay. Oh, ye simple,  
10 understand wisdom, and ye fools. Ye of an  
11 understanding heart, hear, for I will speak of  
12 excellent things. And the opening of my lips shall be  
13 of right things, for my mouth shall speak truth. And  
14 wickedness is an abomination to my lips. All the  
15 words of my mouth are in righteousness. There is  
16 nothing forward nor perverse in them. They are all  
17 plain to him that understandeth and right to them that  
18 find knowledge. Receive my instruction and not  
19 silver, and knowledge rather than the choice gold, for  
20 wisdom is better than rubies. And all the things that  
21 may desired are not to be compared to it. I, wisdom,  
22 dwell with prudence and I find out knowledge and witty  
23 inventions. The fear of the Lord is to hate evil.  
24 Pride and arrogancy. And the evil way and the forward  
25 mouth do I hate. Counsel is mine and sound wisdom. I

1 am understanding. I have strength. From -- by me  
2 kings reign and princes decree justice. By me,  
3 princes rule and nobles, even all the judges of the  
4 earth. I love them that loves me. And those that  
5 seek me early shall find me. Now, remember Psalms 2?  
6 It says be wise ye kings of the earth? Remember that  
7 one?

7 HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum.

8 DAVID KORESH: Okay. Now, you'll understand  
9 that statement after we get through with this. Okay.  
10 I love them that love me and people that seek -- find  
11 me early will -- seek me will find me early.

11 HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum.

12 DAVID KORESH: Riches and honor are with me.  
13 Durable riches and righteousness. My fruit is better  
14 than gold, hidden fine gold, and my revenue than  
15 choice silver. I lead in the ways of righteousness in  
16 the midst of the paths of judgment that I may call  
17 those that love me to inherit substance --

17 HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum.

18 DAVID KORESH: -- and I will fill their  
19 treasures. For the Lord possessed me in the beginning  
20 of his way. This is awesome. Before his works of old  
21 I was set up from everlasting. From the beginning,  
22 wherever the earth was, -- even before the earth was,

23

24

1 when there were no depths I was brought forth.

2 HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum.

3 DAVID KORESH: When there was no fountains  
4 abounding with water, before the mountains were set --  
5 I got to, I got to see this. This is, this is  
6 awesome. Before the hills was I brought forth.  
7 Remember Eve came out of Adam's side?

8 HENRY GARCIA: Uh-huh.

9 DAVID KORESH: Okay. Watch this. While as  
10 yet he had not made the, the earth nor the paths,  
11 fields nor the highest places or the dust of the  
12 world, when he prepared the heavens I was there. But  
13 he said it cometh on the face of the depth. When he  
14 established the clouds above, when he strengthened the  
15 foundations in the deep, when he gave to the, the sea  
16 his decree that the water should not pass his  
17 commandment, when he appointed the foundations of the  
18 earth, then I was by him as one brought up with him  
19 and I was daily his delight. Now, this, this, this  
20 used to, this used to -- when I saw this, when I was  
21 allowed to see this, I mean, literally see this with  
22 my eyes?

23 HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum.

24 DAVID KORESH: You know, God said let us  
25 make men in our image?

1 HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum.

2 DAVID KORESH: Us? Aw. People think that's  
3 God the Father and God the Son. What was the image  
4 God made? Male and --

5 HENRY GARCIA: Female.

6 DAVID KORESH: Female. Now, no. See,  
7 there's, there's something that's really off in there.  
8 Mona's got to see her backside. Now, watch this. It  
9 says here: when he appointed the foundation of the  
10 earth, then I was by him as one brought up with him  
11 and I was daily his delight, rejoicing always before  
12 him, rejoicing in the habitable parts of his earth.  
13 Now, watch this: and my delights were with the sons  
14 of men. You know, Christ loves us, don't he? He  
15 loves guys, right?

16 HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum.

17 DAVID KORESH: Who do you think this wisdom  
18 loves? What was with the sons of men? Women.

19 HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum.

20 DAVID KORESH: I mean, this is awesome.  
21 Now, therefore, harken unto me oh ye children for  
22 blessed are they that keep my ways. Hear instruction  
23 and be wise and refuse it not. Now, watch this. This  
24 is serious. Blessed is the man that heareth me,  
25 watching daily at my gates, waiting at the posts of my

1 doors. What gates? What door? Well, you know, what,  
2 what, what gates? What door? Where's this wisdom  
3 found? You know, where is she found? Wisdom, she,  
4 right?

5 HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum.

6 DAVID KORESH: For who so findeth me findeth  
7 life and shall obtain favor of the Lord. I want that  
8 wisdom, right? But he that sitteth against me  
9 wrongeth his own soul. All they that hate me love  
10 death. Now, you've heard against some-- you've heard  
11 about the sin against the Holy Spirit, right?

12 HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum.

13 DAVID KORESH: Jesus says wisdom is  
14 justified of her own children. Now, wisdom hath  
15 buildeth her house. She hath hewn out her seven  
16 pillars. She hath killed her killing. She hath  
17 mingled her wine. She hath also furnished her table.  
18 Now, remember the body of Christ?

19 HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum.

20 DAVID KORESH: Christ said I'll destroy this  
21 temple and in three days rise it up?

22 HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum.

23 DAVID KORESH: Okay. She hath sent forth  
24 her maidens. She crieth upon the highest places of  
25 the city. Who so is simple, let him turn in hither

1 and have for him the one understanding she sayeth.  
2 Come eat of my bread and drink of the wine which I  
3 have mingled. What with that mind would mock the wine  
4 mingled with? Water. Blood and water.

5 HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum.

6 DAVID KORESH: Now, who built the body of  
7 Christ? What is this temple. What was Revelation  
8 Chapter 12, which takes place after Chapter 11.  
9 There's where this mystery is finally revealed. Let  
10 me show you now. I mean, this, this is, this is --  
11 see, in the Dark Ages, man didn't even -- they lost  
12 the whole knowledge of woman's image of the Godhead,  
13 you know?

14 HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum.

15 DAVID KORESH: They just thought well, you  
16 know, God just made me this woman here just to, you  
17 know, have fun with and all that. That's not the  
18 case. Now, watch. Okay. In Chapter 11 of Revelation  
19 -- you know, Chapter 10 the mighty angel comes down,  
20 so we know there's a message in the last days, right?  
21 Chapter 10, verse 7, days of -- seventh angel, time  
22 no longer, seven thunders, right?

23 HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum.

24 DAVID KORESH: So, in Chapter 11, there was  
25 given me a reed like unto a rod. The angel stood,

1 saying rise and measure the temple of God, which is  
2 this -- this is how the temple is measured in heaven.  
3 It's counted. Okay? And the altar, and them that  
4 worship therein. Now, if you don't, if you don't come  
5 up hither and you don't learn these seven seals,  
6 you're not worshiping in the temple of God. But the  
7 court which is without the temple leave not and  
8 measure it not for it's given to the Gentiles. And  
9 the Holy City shall they tread under foot forty-and-  
10 two months. So, this period of time, they, they don't  
11 care about this truth of the sanctuary. They don't  
12 care about the mighty angel. They don't care about  
13 the seven seals. They -- you know, this has been  
14 taking place for quite awhile now and it's finishing  
15 up. And I'll give power to my two witnesses and they  
16 shall prophesy a thousand two hundred three score  
17 days, which is the same period of time, clothed in  
18 sackcloth, which means, you know, no one has the  
19 answers to these two witnesses because hey, you know,  
20 the Gentiles don't care. They trample under the foot.  
21 Okay. Now, in Zechariah's prophecy, Zechariah showed  
22 you a rock with seven eyes?

20 HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum.

21 DAVID KORESH: He showed you seven  
22 candlesticks --

23

24

25

1 HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum.

2 DAVID KORESH: -- and he showed you seven  
3 lamps on the candlesticks and two olive trees. And  
4 the Spirit says this has the word of the Lord to those  
5 who come from Babylon, saying they cannot do it under  
6 their own might nor by their own power, but only by  
7 God's spirit, which is God's word. You can't get out  
8 of Babylon by your own mind or by your own power.  
9 It's got to be something that's shown to you in the  
10 light of these seven candlesticks is what Zechariah  
11 says.

11 HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum.

12 DAVID KORESH: So, it's just like, you know,  
13 the same as -- okay. God's the rock. Zechariah is  
14 true. God is the rock. He has seven eyes. He, he  
15 writes the book. Christ is the lamp. He has seven  
16 eyes. And, you know, the seven seals have to be  
17 known. These are the two olive trees and two  
18 candlesticks standing before the God of the earth.  
19 And if any man will hurt them, prophecies out of their  
20 mouth and devour them, their enemies, if -- if any  
21 will hurt them, he must in this manner be killed.

20 HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum.

21 DAVID KORESH: These have power to shut  
22 heaven, that it rain not on the days of their  
23  
24  
25



1 prophecy, and have power over the waters to turn them  
2 to blood and do smite the earth as often with plagues  
3 as often as they will. Now, you know Moses and Elijah  
4 did they anciently, right?

5 HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum.

6 DAVID KORESH: No. Really, Christ did it  
7 through them.

8 HENRY GARCIA: Oh, okay.

9 DAVID KORESH: You see? See, that's the  
10 whole meaning. 2,000 years ago the two witnesses of  
11 Christ's kingdom was is that -- well, they were the  
12 mode of transfiguration. Both Moses and Christ and  
13 Elijah stood together, didn't they?

14 HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum.

15 DAVID KORESH: As one. Right?

16 HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum.

17 DAVID KORESH: I mean, Christ worked through  
18 Moses and Christ worked through Elijah. Right?

19 HENRY GARCIA: Through the two of them.

20 DAVID KORESH: Exactly. But they all were  
21 of one spirit, weren't they?

22 HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum.

23 DAVID KORESH: Only Christ was perfect  
24 though.

25 HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum.

1                   DAVID KORESH: And those other two were just  
2 looking to him that was perfect?

3                   HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum.

4                   DAVID KORESH: So, that's why they're called  
5 the olive trees, the anointed ones. Okay. Now, it  
6 says here: when they shall have finished their  
7 testimony, and after this three-and-a-half year period  
8 of time, the beasts -- this is out of the bottomless  
9 pit which scripture says is carnal man that comes out  
of a woman's womb without knowledge, right?

10                  HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum.

11                  DAVID KORESH: You know, shall make more  
12 against them and shall overcome them and then kill  
13 them. Okay. Now, what happens is, is that -- you  
14 see, I'm supposed to teach this stuff so it don't  
15 happen. Prophecies, prophecies are given so that they  
can be avoided and instead a blessing can be given.

16                  HENRY GARCIA: Uh-huh.

17                  DAVID KORESH: You know? Now, it says here  
18 -- remember the lamblike beast that speaks as a  
19 dragon? Anyway, it says here -- okay: kill them and  
20 their dead bodies shall lie in the great street of the  
21 city, which spiritually is called Sodom and Egypt  
where our Lord was crucified.

22                  HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum.

23

24

25

1                   DAVID KORESH: And there the people, and of  
2 the kingdoms, the nations, and tongues, shall see  
3 their dead bodies three days and a half and shall not  
4 suffer their dead bodies to be put in graves. And it  
5 says here: and they have the people that dwell upon  
6 the earth shall rejoice over them and make merry and  
7 shall send gifts one to another because these two  
8 prophets tormented them until up on the earth.

8                   HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum.

9                   DAVID KORESH: And I beheld after three days  
10 and a half that the spirit of life from God entered  
11 into them and they stood upon their seat and this  
12 great fear fell upon them which saw them. Okay. So,  
13 what happens is -- and then the judge when this, when  
14 this is, when this is fulfilled -- excuse me. I'm  
15 going to need some -- okay. We see over here that --  
16 verses 11, the same hour there a great earthquake,  
17 which this is the resurrection of the 200 million that  
18 the sixth seal talks about. And it talks about the  
19 city falling, the men -- I mean, people were slain and  
20 the, and the remnant that are -- remain after God  
21 destroys the wicked, they were involved in this.  
22 Because not everybody's involved in it.

21                   HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum.

22                   DAVID KORESH: They give glory to the God of  
23  
24  
25

1 heaven.

2 HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum.

3 DAVID KORESH: And it says here that the  
4 seventh angel sounded with -- thus the mystery is  
5 finished now. That there were great voices in heaven  
6 saying the kingdoms of this world become the kingdoms  
7 of our Lord and of his Christ, which is the  
8 fulfillment of Psalms 2. You know, God told them to  
9 kiss the son lest they be angry.

9 HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum.

10 DAVID KORESH: Right?

11 HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum.

12 DAVID KORESH: And to be wise judges. You  
13 know, to be wise ye kings. And it says here, and he  
14 shall reign forever and ever. And the four-and-twenty  
15 elders which sit before God -- which they are the ones  
16 judging you'all right now. You know, they're the -- I  
17 mean, while you'all are, are, are ready to judge me,  
18 and I don't mind that. I understand that's, that's  
19 what has to be done.

18 HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum.

19 DAVID KORESH: You know. That right now --  
20 I know it sounds kind of funny, but I've got to speak  
21 the truth. Right now -- where I was taken and, and  
22 brought back from, you know, Christ, God -- I mean,

23

24

25

1 the Father of us all, the one that created us all,  
2 right?

3 HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum.

4 DAVID KORESH: He is on the throne and the  
5 judiciary is actually discussing and, and, and  
6 actually passing judgments on attitudes that are being  
7 developed and characters that are being developed in  
8 regards to the situation that's taking place right  
9 now.

9 HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum.

10 DAVID KORESH: That's why, that's why I'm,  
11 I'm told to wait. Otherwise, I'd be out. You know.  
12 I mean, I know it's complicated. Let me, let me  
13 finish here. Maybe we can get a little more insight  
14 --

14 HENRY GARCIA: Say that --

15 DAVID KORESH: -- on it.

16 HENRY GARCIA: -- one more time.

17 DAVID KORESH: Huh?

18 HENRY GARCIA: Say that one more time.

19 DAVID KORESH: Okay. While -- see, see, I  
20 -- remember, I'm of, I'm of this world.

20 HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum.

21 DAVID KORESH: Okay. I've just, I've just  
22 been taken to another world -- I mean, other worlds.

23

24

25

1 It sounds funny, but I'm saying that while, while  
2 we're doing right now is taking place, everyone  
3 already knows that Christ was terribly misjudged 2,000  
4 years ago. Right?

5 HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum.

6 DAVID KORESH: Okay. Now, we know that  
7 2,000 years ago who that Christ was. That was God,  
8 wasn't he?

9 HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum.

10 DAVID KORESH: I, I mean the original number  
11 one in the beginning. I don't mean son number one,  
12 number two, number three. I mean the first one. I  
13 mean God. And, and he was on the cross. And what was  
14 he doing up there? Man's judgment, right?

15 HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum.

16 DAVID KORESH: Now, whoa. That was bad.  
17 But he says, Father, forgive them, for they know not  
18 what they do. Right?

19 HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum.

20 DAVID KORESH: And he did everything he did  
21 as an example that it might be written. He said to  
22 the disciples on that day you will know that I'm in  
23 the Father and the Father's in me, I and my Father are  
24 one. Okay? But the one thief up there on the cross,  
25 he says to him, you know, Lord, I've never known what

1 I've done all my life. I mean, I've always done so  
2 wrong. He says, if you have a kingdom that's based  
3 upon forgiving people because they don't know what  
4 they're doing, can you remember me? I mean, I lived  
5 my whole life and ah, ah, ba, da (weeping/talking  
6 sounds). You know, I'm ready -- I deserve this  
7 punishment. I deserve to be crucified. You know.  
8 But aahh, I've never known what it was for in the  
9 first place. Can you forgive me? And so that's the  
10 whole key, you see. That's the position I'm taking,  
11 that even if I -- you know, if I -- you know, look,  
12 I'm in trouble. Let's just face the facts.

11 HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum.

12 DAVID KORESH: Nonetheless, I know the one  
13 I'm looking over to.

14 HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum.

15 DAVID KORESH: See, by, by people misjudging  
16 God, naturally they're going to misjudge me.

17 HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum.

18 DAVID KORESH: I mean, that's -- that goes  
19 for all of us.

20 HENRY GARCIA: Sure.

21 DAVID KORESH: You know. So, so, you know,  
22 we've got to put our grudges down and all that. We've  
23 got to say now, just look. I'm just going to keep  
24  
25

1 looking to the one on the middle of the cross. And,  
2 so, you know, one thief, unlike the other one, was  
3 just like David. He -- you know, he was, he was  
4 saying I've got to take this punishment. Now, I've  
5 done some evil. I've hurt some people. I didn't mean  
6 to, but nonetheless, you know, I've had some good at  
7 the expense of others.

7 HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum.

8 DAVID KORESH: Okay. So, you know, Christ  
9 turns to him. And then we're talking about Christ  
10 being really God.

11 HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum.

12 DAVID KORESH: He says I've saved you today.  
13 You know, this is the kind of heart that God accepts,  
14 a poor and contrite heart, broken spirit. You shall  
15 be with me in paradise.

16 HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum.

17 DAVID KORESH: Okay. So, now, as Christ  
18 sits on the throne, which is the rock, God, all of a  
19 sudden he gives this book to this lamb. Okay, now.  
20 Now, it says here that in Chapter 11 we were learning,  
21 something to do -- after Chapter 10. After Chapter 10  
22 we know that a mighty angel comes down to earth,  
23 right?

24 HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum.

25



1                   DAVID KORESH:  And there's seven thunders  
2 uttered, right?

3                   HENRY GARCIA:  Um-hum.

4                   DAVID KORESH:  And we know that there is  
5 going to be a judgment to where only those who are in  
6 the temple of God who come up hither and say, hey,  
7 what's going on up hither? -- will be numbered amongst  
8 the righteous.

9                   HENRY GARCIA:  Um-hum.

10                  DAVID KORESH:  And the rest of them who  
11 don't care about learning these seven seals, these  
12 seven thunders, will be on the outside, and they  
13 trample the truth or they trample God's judiciary  
14 kingdom under foot.  Remember, this earth is a part of  
15 heaven too, you know.

16                  HENRY GARCIA:  Um-hum.

17                  DAVID KORESH:  All in heaven belongs to God  
18 and all the fullness thereof.

19                  HENRY GARCIA:  Um-hum.

20                  DAVID KORESH:  We're still on God's real  
21 estate here now.

22                  HENRY GARCIA:  Um-hum.

23                  DAVID KORESH:  So, what happens is is that  
24 in so doing, finally what happens is is that the ones  
25 who don't understand, scripture warns that those who

1 are of the flesh, those who come out of the carnal  
2 womb, you know, without being born again by knowledge  
3 and truth, they come out and they'd kill these  
4 witnesses. Well, all they're killing is they're  
5 killing, they're killing -- for instance, Zechariah  
6 said he saw in vision a rock with seven eyes, didn't  
7 he?

7 HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum.

8 DAVID KORESH: Zechariah said he saw a  
9 candle, a lamp with seven, with seven lamps. And  
10 there's two witnesses by two olive trees, right?

11 HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum.

12 DAVID KORESH: Moses and Elijah, the sons of  
13 oil. Now, we know that Christ is delight of the world  
14 according to the New Testament. That's already been  
15 made plain for us. And we know in the mount of  
16 transfiguration the kingdom of God deals with Christ  
17 standing on the mount, Moses and Elijah standing by  
18 him, and they all three are one.

19 HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum.

20 DAVID KORESH: They've got one work to do,  
21 and that's to save souls with the word of God.

22 HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum.

23 DAVID KORESH: Okay. So, so, when it comes  
24 down to this final revelation when, when, when God  
25

1 sends his Son into the world to reveal the seven  
2 seals, then all the sons of God are going to want to  
3 learn the seven seals, aren't they?

4 HENRY GARCIA: Yes.

5 DAVID KORESH: Okay. So, the thing of it is  
6 -- but man, whose carnal in-- remember, wisdom says  
7 she hates pride and arrogancy and carnality? She says  
8 now, I've built my house, I've hewn my seven pillars?  
9 You know, we know that wisdom built Christ. Let me  
10 explain. And wisdom builds everybody. Now, here is,  
11 here is the clincher to it. It says here: for the  
12 kingdoms of this world becomes the kingdoms of our  
13 Lord and of his Christ and he shall reign forever and  
14 ever. And the four-and-twenty elders which sit before  
15 God on their seats fell down upon their faces and  
16 worshipped God, saying we give Thee thanks, oh, Lord,  
17 God Almighty, which art and was and are to come,  
18 because Thou has taken a great power in his reign --  
19 which this is where God has to intervene. For the  
20 nations were angry -- which is like Psalms 2, the  
21 heathen raged -- and Thy wrath has come -- which the  
22 sixth seal went -- what's going to happen is is that  
23 the sum of the stars are going to be dark and all the  
24 natural elements of light and the heaven is going to  
25 depart and everyone in this world is going to get to

1 look up and see something they never seen before,  
2 something I was already shown. But, of course, what  
3 happens is is that I'm supposed to show it through a  
4 book. And then what happens is they're going to  
5 realize that, that -- see, all I've ever wanted out of  
6 my life is peace. So, God uses the weak and he uses  
7 the, the ones who try to seek peace, the ones who do  
8 not want violence and all that, he, he, he strengthens  
9 them like in Psalms 18 to overthrow the proud and the  
10 arrogant. It's a sad thing. We don't want it to  
11 happen, and that's what's a lot of things happening  
12 right now. And Thy wrath has come and the time of the  
13 dead that they should be judged, that Thou shouldest  
14 give reward to Thy servants, the prophets, and to Thy  
15 sayings, those that were sanctified by the prophets,  
16 knowing their truth, to them that fear Thy name, small  
17 and great, and shall destroy them which destroy the  
18 earth. God doesn't like the way our economic system  
19 is doing to our world today. And the temple of God --  
20 now, watch this. This is, this is off of -- remember  
21 wisdom said those who find me find life?

19 HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum.

20 DAVID KORESH: Remember?

21 HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum.

22 DAVID KORESH: They shall obtain the favor

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25

1 of the Lord? Now, watch this. And the temple of God  
2 was opened in heaven. See, this is the -- this is,  
3 this is the, the thing that causes the sin against the  
4 Holy Ghost. Now, watch. Now, the temple of God was  
5 opened where? In heaven. And there was seen in this  
6 temple the ark of his testament -- which is what Moses  
7 made a model of, right?

7 HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum.

8 DAVID KORESH: And there were lightnings and  
9 voices and thunderings and an earthquake and great  
10 hell. Now, God's angry. And there appeared a great  
11 wonder in heaven, a woman, clothed with the sun, the  
12 moon under her feet and upon her head a crown of  
13 twelve stars. Now, who is she? And she, being with  
14 child, cried, travailing in birth and pain to be  
15 delivered. Now, remember in Proverbs 8 and 9 she said  
16 -- you know? She's the mother of Christ, isn't she?

17 HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum.

18 DAVID KORESH: I mean, she's the mother of  
19 you. She's the mother of me.

20 HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum.

21 DAVID KORESH: She's the mother -- like it  
22 says right down here, it says here that this dragon  
23 makes a war with her. He hates her. And it says  
24  
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1 right down here in verses 17, it says: and the dragon  
2 was wroth (sic) with the woman and went to make war  
3 with the remnant of her seed -- which keep the  
4 commandments of God and have the testimony of Jesus  
5 Christ -- which is the seven seals. Awesome, huh?

6 HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum.

7 DAVID KORESH: Okay. So, so, the thing of  
8 it is is that in Proverbs 8 and 9 she says, come drink  
9 of my bread -- I mean, drink, drink of my wine and eat  
10 of my bread. In the, in the New Testament, you know,  
11 it's, it's, it's hard to look at mankind in any  
12 different light than what we have been trained or  
13 raised to look at mankind in. You know, it's -- but,  
14 but if you're looking -- you, you look -- like, for  
15 instance, when I looked out the window here the other  
16 day and I saw those ATF agents laying down there and  
17 blood dripping down, you know -- I mean, I had been  
18 shot too, but yet I was still alive.

19 HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum.

20 DAVID KORESH: You know, and I was there  
21 when the first burst came into the front door. And  
22 I'm thinking like, you know, like we'll, we'll -- you  
23 know, like I'm looking on the same -- you know, God,  
24 are you going to, are you going to shelter me or, or  
25 what, what am I supposed to do now, you know? Because

1 we, we had been -- I had been told about this long  
2 before. So, I'm like there and I'm looking at -- I'm  
3 thinking, you know, God, you know, what can we do? I  
4 mean, it's like, you know, those are friends of mine.  
5 They could have been just like with Robert. There's,  
6 there's, there's just no mean in this kind of stuff,  
7 you know?

7 HENRY GARCIA: Really?

8 DAVID KORESH: I mean, I mean, they're,  
9 they're laying there on, on the top of the roof, you  
10 know, and, you know, I, I didn't even know, I didn't  
11 even know till I came around back to the side window  
12 over here that they -- that, that anyone had even been  
13 shot. And it's like -- I'm like thinking to myself,  
14 you know, this -- it's not necessary.

14 HENRY GARCIA: Really?

15 DAVID KORESH: You know, why? It's just  
16 like here is somebody that was a baby just 20-  
17 something, 30-something years ago. A child --

18 HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum.

19 DAVID KORESH: -- that, that came into the  
20 world, that, that was a baby that toddled, and now  
21 it's over. You know?

21 HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum.

22 DAVID KORESH: And, and it's just like it's,  
23  
24  
25

1 it's so, it's so contrary to -- you know, like, like I  
2 myself have got a lot of babies. Now, I'm -- now,  
3 look. I know it's, it's funny and it's, it's strange.

4 You know, I have a lot of wives.

5 HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum.

6 DAVID KORESH: And it's not according to  
7 your law. I realize that. You know, I do realize  
8 that.

9 HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum.

10 DAVID KORESH: And people say that I'm a  
11 brainwasher on that. That's not the truth now.

12 HENRY GARCIA: That what?

13 DAVID KORESH: They say I'm a brainwasher.

14 HENRY GARCIA: Uh-huh.

15 DAVID KORESH: That's, that's not the truth  
16 now. I'm -- I can't brainwash you. I mean, let's,  
17 let's face it. You're going to take what I say and  
18 you're going to judge it for yourself. But here's the  
19 thing. David of old was chosen of God. And David had  
20 a spirit that God -- you know, the heavens look down  
21 on us every day.

22 HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum.

23 DAVID KORESH: And Psalms says that God  
24 looks down from the heavens and beholds all the sons  
25 of men. He fashioned all their hearts alike and he



1 | considers all their doings.

2 |           HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum.

3 |           DAVID KORESH: Right?

4 |           HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum.

5 |           DAVID KORESH: So, God chose David. He  
6 | didn't choose his seven other brothers, did he?

8 | youngest one who was -- who liked to care for --
