1 HENRY: Um-hum.

2 DAVID: How many wives did he have?

3 HENRY: About two.

4 DAVID: Too many -- 800, 800. Well, I never
5 have to worry about that.

6 (Laughter.)

7 DAVID: Because -- well, see, the -- here's
8 how this works now. There's a lot of churches, okay?

9 HENRY: Uh-huh.

10 DAVID: I mean, like I said, I, I -- I was
11 wanting to show Robert all this stuff. You know, I
12 was really hoping that me and Robert could get this
13 worked out because I really, you know -- what I do --
14 'cause when I sit down and give studies to people, I
15 show them out of the book and then I ask them. I go,
16 well, well, what do you think? Am I crazy or -- if
17 they, if they don't see a point, they'll go, well, I
18 don't really understand it right now and I'll, then
19 I'll show them from another angle.

20 Before they know it, they're learning the
21 whole Bible. And I'll ask them, see -- this is what
22 I've told my students -- look, I've had an experience
23 in my life to where my life means nothing in this
24 world. My life is only valued in regards to how much
25 it will increase your life in the knowledge of God.

1 So I'm going to always be in your hands, and any time
2 any and every one of you can do unto me or cause to
3 happen to me anything you desire, because you know I
4 will alway-- only show you a truth and my life is in
5 your hands. Okay?

6 So then I began to open up these seals. And
7 every time that I have -- a person sat down and
8 listened, you know, they, they've, they've always had
9 to say -- say, you know, David? It's right. One
10 thing about it is, it's different, it's strange, but
11 it's right.

12 HENRY: Um-hum.

13 DAVID: And others who, like, say well, you
14 know, they don't really listen, they, they get half of
15 what I say and they don't get the full picture and
16 then they start coming with all these ideals and crazy
17 things. Of course, from their point of view, you
18 know, I'm this -- I'm claiming that I'm Jesus, I'm
19 claiming I'm the only Son, I'm claiming -- I'm a child
20 molester and all that kind of stuff.

21 Now, it gets -- like for instance, last,
22 last year we -- they were said three times on the news
23 we were going to commit suicide. Did we?

24 HENRY: No.

25 DAVID: No.

1 HENRY: Now, where do these stories come
2 from that you're a child molester?

3 DAVID: Well, what happens is is that it
4 goes back to, to a young lady that was 12 years old,
5 Michelle.

6 HENRY: Um-hum.

7 DAVID: Okay? And what happened was is that
8 they say that when she was 12 years old that I was
9 having relationships with her and that's not true.

10 HENRY: Who's Michelle?

11 DAVID: Michelle is one, Michelle is one of
12 the Jones girls.

13 HENRY: Okay.

14 DAVID: Now, this was back -- this is what I
15 mean like she's like, what? Nineteen? How old is she
16 now? Nineteen? Anyway, she's like 19 or so, but you,
17 you'll get to meet her and everything. But, see, what
18 happens is is when certain individuals -- okay. For
19 instance --

20 HENRY: Well, who, who was it that was
21 saying that?

22 DAVID: Marc Breault.

23 HENRY: Who?

24 DAVID: Marc -- see, he was a student that I
25 had for the first four and a half years --

1 HENRY: Uh-huh.

2 DAVID: -- since 1986 when I first came back
3 from Israel with this message.

4 HENRY: Uh-huh.

5 DAVID: Now -- so what happens is this, in
6 the scriptures it talks about a king of the north. In
7 other words, the last political power that has
8 capitalistic power reaches over all nations. This
9 power is the one that's supposed to confront Messiah
10 because of a message. It says, and he shall have
11 intelligence with those that forsake the Holy
12 Covenant.

13 Now, if we could find out what the Holy
14 Covenant is, which we know is the seven seals, then we
15 know that those who forsake it are those who have
16 heard a portion and have not wanted it and have said
17 like, like in Psalms 2, let us break his bands
18 asunder, you know. They don't want it.

19 HENRY: Um-hum.

20 DAVID: They don't want the truth. They
21 don't want to -- see, if they don't acknowledge that
22 I'm the Son of God by God's Word, then God will not
23 acknowledge them that they're His son. So that's the
24 beauty of this message. You know, after, after I
25 teach -- soon as people look at me like, you know,

1 like wow. It's like Psalms 4 says, stand in awe and
2 sin not. God will hear when I call unto Him.

3 But they're like, wow, yeah, like man you're
4 Christ. I go well, now, let me explain. There's
5 something more to it than this, you know. It, it
6 brings out an incredible value in us as a people.

6 HENRY: Um-hum.

7 DAVID: I mean, you know, we got to respect
8 -- we're all sons and daughters of God. I mean
9 literally, you know.

10 HENRY: Um-hum.

11 DAVID: Okay. So, so when I began to show
12 them how I got this, then it goes on to say, you know,
13 thus said the Lord to His anointed, ask Me concerning
14 My sons and the work of My hands. Command ye Me. I
15 have made man upon the earth and forged him from the
16 dust of the earth. I have given him My Spirit and I
17 will raise him up and direct all his ways.

17 See, God begins to explain things and, of
18 course, you know, my advantage is that I never was
19 very good in literature, reading or anything, but if
20 -- once I was shown all these things, and it's like
21 wow. It's like whew! You know, the Bible calls the
22 quickening. The quickening is a process of learning
23 where knowledge is implanted -- right into your
24

1 spectrum of comprehension.

2 HENRY: Um-hum.

3 DAVID: It's just like, Bing! You're
4 quickened! Like, I know it all. You know. It's kind
5 of like -- have you ever seen the movie, "Lawnmower
6 Man"?

6 HENRY: Um-hum.

7 DAVID: Okay. See, Satan is a
8 counterfeiter. Course Satan has all the money in the
9 world. So see ever since I started, right?

10 HENRY: Um-hum.

11 DAVID: With this communication between, you
12 know, Orion and, and myself.

12 HENRY: Um-hum.

13 DAVID: All of a sudden, everything that I
14 was experiencing -- Satan came out and inspired men in
15 this world to try to counteract and counterfeit it by
16 making movies and stuff. Like "Terminator-2" and all
17 that kind of stuff?

17 HENRY: Yeah.

18 DAVID: Where you've got these fighting
19 machines and stuff that just blow everything up and
20 destroy everything? Well, that's the same as what
21 Joel through the prophecies talk about with regards to
22 Messiah and all that. You know, the mind and the

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1 world is getting so close to the fulfillment of all
2 the events that the ancients have been inspired to
3 see. In their day they couldn't explain it, because
4 they couldn't explain modern -- modernized, you know,
5 technology.

6 HENRY: Um-hum.

7 DAVID: They were still (indiscernible) of
8 the natural realms of social life. That's why God
9 caused Israel to have an economy which revolved around
10 agriculture, you know. The harvest, the feast days,
11 the planting, the sowing, the harvest.

12 HENRY: Um-hum.

13 DAVID: The offering of the first and second
14 fruits and then such and so forth.

15 HENRY: Um-hum.

16 DAVID: Okay? But in our day the, the time
17 when all the vision, the effect of our vision is at
18 hand, you know, we have to emphasize that well -- not,
19 like in Nahum where it says well, here's a prophecy
20 about Messiah and there are these mighty men and
21 they're in these torches that run like the lightnings
22 and like people up here, they're like looking out the
23 window going like -- they're going look how fast that
24 thing is. 'Cause these guys really cut out real fast.

25 I mean, it, it's kind of, it's kind of --

1 it's not funny, but it's really exciting for us in the
2 fact that, you know, here's like little kids still
3 remaining, a people like looking out here right in our
4 backyard, you know, and it's, it's such a terrible
5 cost too, to get to this point and yet here we see
6 this heavy piece of metal, you know, with men in it, a
7 chariot right?

7 HENRY: Um-hum.

8 DAVID: And you think, man, these things
9 move. And this thing like it can, it can like peel
10 out and shoot across this back field like you wouldn't
11 believe.

11 HENRY: Um-hum.

12 DAVID: You know, and it said they run like
13 lightnings, right?

14 HENRY: Um-hum.

15 DAVID: And have these flaming torches.

16 HENRY: Um-hum.

17 DAVID: You know, the next thing, you know,
18 we're, we're hoping not to see, 'cause we already
19 believe God anyway. Okay, God, we believe you. You
20 don't need to do it. You know?

20 HENRY: Yeah.

21 DAVID: They don't need to flame for us.
22 Because they'll probably flame in our direction, you

2 HENRY: Um-hum.

3 DAVID: Like, Steve went up the other day
4 and looked out the window and he looked out and this
5 tank just -- it, it caught him. It was kind of like
6 this (indiscernible) Computer System that grades the
7 imagery, you know, to where it can catch a whole,
8 whole view and you can, like, zero in on the dots and
9 it kind of comes to the one point like, say, eighth of
an inch or sixteenth of an inch circle.

10 HENRY: Um-hum.

11 DAVID: And that gun barrel will go right to
12 where the guy's looking, you know, on the, on the
13 screen. And I'm pretty sure they have these things in
14 there also. They have them in Israel, I know that.
15 But, you know, that barrel went straight toward Steve,
16 you know, that 25 mm. He goes like, whoa, and he was
telling me like, man, this is so awesome.

17 HENRY: Um-hum.

18 DAVID: I says yeah, you know, but still.
19 Okay. So, like, Joel, it's, it's you're like trying
20 to study without the vision, you're kind of like
21 going, what's these chariots and torches? What, they
22 got like torches that, you know, like they're trying
to get light from it? No. 'Cause these torches cause

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1 the trees to shake terribly.

2 HENRY: Um-hum.

3 DAVID: You see? It causes the ground to
4 thunder, just like Nahum in the prophecies say.

5 HENRY: Um-hum.

6 DAVID: But sad to say is that Nahum says
7 that when they confront those who, you know, fortified
8 their power mightily, which you know is us. I'm happy
9 to say in the light of God, I'm sad to say in the
10 light that, you know, there's no, I mean, you know, I
11 like you and Jim. I mean, I like all you guys.

12 HENRY: Well, thank you.

13 DAVID: There's a -- there, you know,
14 there's a sadness. It's kind of like in Noah's day,
15 you know. When Noah got into the Ark he was just
16 doing the best he -- okay. It's -- but it's like Cain
17 and Abel. We're brothers and all I'm trying to say is
18 that -- I'm trying to say, look, brother. You know,
19 really brothers. We're really family, right?

20 HENRY: Um-hum.

21 DAVID: I mean, if, if, like me and you had
22 not met like this way --

23 HENRY: Um-hum.

24 DAVID: -- you know, we could have been out
25 fishing or something. And I could have been there and

1 I could have been sitting there fishing and you could
2 have said, you know, how you doing? I go, how you
3 doing? You know, what do you do? Well, I'm a
4 musician. And, you know, what do you do? Well, I'm,
5 I'm a FBI agent. Oh, really, you know. Glad to meet
6 you. Boy, I bet you got a real hard job, you know.
7 And then you'd end up being surprised to find out I'm
8 involved in something like this later on, you know.

8 HENRY: Um-hum.

9 DAVID: -- had a better foundation
10 established.

11 HENRY: Yes.

12 DAVID: But I got more people that love me
13 than hate me.

14 HENRY: Well, you know --

15 DAVID: But --

16 HENRY: I'm sure of that and I'm sure that
17 you're going to be in a position where you're going to
18 have the opportunity to have a lot more people love
19 you in the future. One of the things that I think
20 that is going to happen to you because of this
21 facility that you have to teach and because you feel
22 so enthusiastic about sharing this gift that you have
23 and this knowledge that you possess, that you, you
24 know, as you said before, you realize that, that some
25

1 | punishment is, is coming your way.

2 | DAVID: Oh, yeah. I'm ready to take it.

3 | HENRY: And, and because of the fact that in
4 | punishment we learn, just like you did when you
5 | received the punishment you received with respect to
6 | that situation that you became involved with when you
7 | had that experience with Linda, you grew.

7 | DAVID: Well, that, that, that's true.

8 | HENRY: You grew and because of this,
9 | because of all that has happened and because you're
10 | going to have the position that you're going to be in
11 | a place where people are forgotten and here you are in
12 | a position to make a real difference to people that
13 | are forgotten. You will have -- and lots of times
14 | it's difficult for us to see because we, we become
15 | comfortable, all of us --

15 | DAVID: Exactly.

16 | HENRY: -- wherever we're at. Whether we're
17 | in Dallas, Texas, whether we're in New York, whether
18 | we're in Waco. Wherever we're at, and we're many
19 | times not expecting to be thrust into another --

19 | DAVID: Dimension.

20 | HENRY: Exactly. And here it is for you and
21 | because what you -- your message takes time. It takes
22 | time and what is it that these people are going to

1 have more than anything else? They're going to have
2 time. Time to listen. Time to make a difference.

3 DAVID: Well, we --

4 HENRY: I really believe that.

5 DAVID: I'm definitely aware of all of this.

6 HENRY: I really believe that.

7 DAVID: I explained to people like, like,
8 like, you know, our Father, Christ, said 2,000 years
9 ago. He says, you know, if any man wants to follow
me, he has to take up his cross.

10 HENRY: That's right.

11 DAVID: In other words, you know, you might
12 get electrocuted.

13 HENRY: That's right.

14 DAVID: You might go to the, you might go to
15 the, you know -- someday I said we should, we should
16 wear around our neck a necklace of electric chairs or,
17 or lethal injection because that might be
misinterpreted as drug addicts or something, you know.

18 HENRY: Um-hum.

19 DAVID: Because sometimes, you know -- you
20 know, sometimes it's like if, if you love somebody,
21 you know, you would just -- you say to yourself I
22 would just die if they could understand how much I
love them.

23

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1 HENRY: See, and the thing is I don't think
2 that, that it, you know, when you say if you love
3 somebody -- it's too, it's too almost like too
4 isolationist to say if you love somebody, because I
5 think in your case you don't have to -- you don't need
6 to have -- you don't need to love a person. All you
7 -- you do love people, you know, you love people per
8 se. You want to teach them. And I think you're going
9 to be thrust into a situation where you're not going
10 to have, you know, 10 people, 20 people -- you're
11 going to have thousands of people that you can
12 minister to. I really believe that.

12 DAVID: Well, you know, like that, that,
13 that's okay, like I said if you're just behind bars,
14 but you know --

15 HENRY: Well --

16 DAVID: -- like, for instance --

17 HENRY: But, but those people need it. You
18 know, I mean, who doesn't need it?

19 DAVID: Oh, for sure.

20 HENRY: You know, and, and, and who needs it
21 more?

22 DAVID: But you know --

23 HENRY: And lots of these people,
24 unfortunately, you know, they're in there, they come
25

1 out, and they're in a worse situation than when they
2 came -- than when they went in. You know --

3 DAVID: Well, I'm getting the people ready
4 for that.

5 HENRY: Well, good --

6 DAVID: You know, some people -- like, like
7 I'm telling these guys, you know, they're, they're
8 saying -- some of the guys, here, you know, like they
9 believe the message too, but remember they weren't
10 shown like I was shown. I'm the least one here, I
11 mean, I, I got shown something.

12 HENRY: Um-hum.

13 DAVID: And all they've done is believe the
14 Word of God.

15 HENRY: Right.

16 DAVID: I mean, I've connected all the loose
17 ends and developed the picture to show them from all
18 the prophecies and sometimes I like to say, well, now,
19 look. Let's just get a concordance over here and
20 let's understand this and they've gone like, oh yeah,
21 okay, we see, we see, we see. So they're going by
22 greater faith than I am.

23 HENRY: Um-hum.

24 DAVID: You know, me, I, I'm going by sight.

25 HENRY: Well, you --

1 DAVID: You know --

2 HENRY: But you've been able to open the
3 door for them.

4 DAVID: Well, God, God -- like I said, He
5 gave me work to do. Now, my frustration has been
6 that, you know, I end up back in this realm after
7 going to a different realm, and I'm like pinching
8 myself, saying to myself, you know, you know, what --
9 you know, where -- what --

9 HENRY: Well --

10 DAVID: What is this, you know. I'm telling
11 myself --

12 HENRY: Really --

13 DAVID: -- now, I, I just gotta, you know,
14 present what I been shown --

15 HENRY: Exactly.

16 DAVID: -- and go back to these books, the
17 scrolls, you know, the prophecies, and, and present
18 them in the true and proper light that I was shown,
19 where I was shown them at.

20 HENRY: That's right.

21 DAVID: And so I come in and I confront
22 people and the first, first one or two years that I
23 started this, you know, that this was given to me to
24 do or to finish, this work -- from 1985 --

25

1 HENRY: Um-hum.

2 DAVID: Every time I confronted a person
3 that already thought they knew the Bible, they would
4 be like, well, yeah, brother. Well, what have you
5 got, you know. I'm like well, I want to show you this
6 too. Oh, well, then they'd already start telling me
7 about about them. So I'd have to sit there and listen
8 to them, realizing that everything they were -- that
9 was coming out of their mouth was totally opposite
10 what was shown to me, you know, far away from here.

11 HENRY: But, see, that's because you've,
12 you've seen and, and seers become leaders, okay? And
13 understanders become followers. You see and,
14 therefore, you must lead. And the followers will
15 follow you to safety.

16 DAVID: Well, so, what happened is scripture
17 talks about my position, it calls me a servant of
18 rulers. Which makes proper sense 'cause, you know, it
19 takes a little time to deal with the natural-born
20 tendencies to be arrogant in one's own thought.

21 HENRY: Um-hum.

22 DAVID: So, you know, so like I've had to
23 sit a lot of times and let people tell me and then
24 I'll have to sit there and go, well, that sounds good,
25 but have you ever thought about -- and then I start

1 showing them out of the Bible. Like, for instance,
2 the -- one of the easiest ones is the sixth seal,
3 which -- here in Joel tells about the sun, moon and
4 stars being darkened. Here in Zephaniah, sun, moon
5 and stars being darkened. Here in Amos they kind of
6 go like, oh, yeah -- oh, yeah.

7 And all of a sudden they get excited because
8 like yeah, that's what that is. And they begin to see
9 that from the written word, their own Bible, the
10 picture becomes plainer than what -- and then more
11 enlightening than what they're own opinion of it was.

12 HENRY: Um-hum.

13 DAVID: So they -- in their own mind,
14 they're satisfied to divorce their own opinion and to
15 readily accept the wisdom that's been given by the
16 Book.

17 HENRY: Um-hum.

18 DAVID: So then they don't, they -- they
19 look at me and they go like, you know, yeah, you know,
20 yeah, that's good. I like that, you know.

21 HENRY: Um-hum.

22 DAVID: How did you learn this, they say?
23 Then I go, uh-oh, you know, well, let me, let me show
24 you something over here. Come up hither, you know.

25 HENRY: That's right.

1 DAVID: Because the Lamb wasn't there.
2 Remember when the question was asked, who's worthy?
3 The Lamb wasn't there yet.

4 HENRY: Um-hum.

5 DAVID: Said no man.

6 HENRY: Um-hum.

7 DAVID: Then all of a sudden, all of a
8 sudden the Lamb appeared. And the reason why it's as,
9 it's as -- been slain is because God knows that
10 already His truth is not going to be accepted by the
majority.

11 HENRY: Um-hum.

12 DAVID: You know. But yet the seven horns
13 mean the situation is completely under control,
14 completed power, and the seven eyes is complete vision
15 and every avenue opened, you know, and besides, God
16 says, when He refers to, to, to His Anointed One, you
17 know, which is the first-born of this generation, or
18 the first man that God will redeem, you know, He says
19 over here, and this is for the, this is for the
20 Gentiles. It's from chapter 60 all the way to 64 of
21 Isaiah is the message that's to be given to the
22 Gentiles while they're still under the dominion of
23 Babylon. So it says -- actually, I'm sorry. It's
24 from 40 to 66, instead of quoting it, I'll just read
25

1 it here. Here we go. Okay. Okay. So, in chapters,
2 in chapters 40 it tells you, it says, Behold, the Lord
3 God shall come with a strong hand -- of course that's
4 the Book.

5 HENRY: Um-hum.

6 DAVID: His arm shall rule for Him, which
7 (indiscernible) know as the Messiah. Behold His
8 reward is with Him, which is the Book, His work before
9 him. And His work is, He shall gather His flock like
10 a shepherd.

11 HENRY: Um-hum.

12 DAVID: He shall gather the lambs with his
13 arm and carry them in His bosom, and shall gently lead
14 those who are with youngs, which are the babies.

15 HENRY: Um-hum.

16 DAVID: Okay? So, then, all of a sudden,
17 you know, it's like, well, what is this reward? And,
18 you know, what is -- why has it got to be done this
19 way for? So the prophet goes to tell you something
20 about how deep this -- He goes, who would measure the
21 waters in the hollow of His hand. In other words, how
22 deep is this truth? In Heaven, you know, it's a sea
23 of glass, right?

24 HENRY: Um-hum.

25 DAVID: The Word of God is deep.

1 HENRY: Um-hum.

2 DAVID: And who has meted out Heaven with a
3 span and comprehend the dust of the earth.

4 HENRY: Um-hum.

5 DAVID: It says, who would -- who has
6 directed the Spirit of the Lord, being his counselor
7 had taught him. It says, behold the nations are a
8 drop of a bucket. That's why when the, when the, when
9 the son of man comes with this Book --

9 HENRY: Um-hum.

10 DAVID: That's why God's laughing at all of
11 these, these guys maneuvers out here with all these
12 little tin can tanks and all these heavy artilleries
13 and stuff.

13 HENRY: Um-hum.

14 DAVID: Of course, you know, to us, being of
15 the flesh to the rest of the people who are there,
16 they're kind of like, ehh, you know.

17 HENRY: Um-hum.

18 DAVID: They're kind of scared. It is, it
19 is very scary, you know, in the flesh.

19 HENRY: Sure.

20 DAVID: But the faith reaches up higher and
21 God already told us about it ahead of time anyway and
22 God's telling us that, you know, not to worry about
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24

1 it. That they're the ones that need to worry.

2 HENRY: Um-hum.

3 DAVID: Because they don't know what they're
4 doing.

5 HENRY: Right.

6 DAVID: It says here, and are counted as the
7 small dust of the balance.

8 HENRY: Um-hum.

9 DAVID: So it says here that -- it says,
10 have you not known? Have you not heard? Has it not
11 been told you from the beginning? Have you not
12 understood from the foundations of the world? It is
13 God that sitteth upon the circle of the earth, and the
14 inhabitants thereof shall be as grasshoppers, and He
15 stretcheth forth a curtains of the heavens and
16 spreadeth them abroad, as a tent to dwell in. For He
17 will bring the princes to nothing and He will make the
18 judges of the earth as vanity, which is the same as
19 Psalms 2.

20 HENRY: Right.

21 DAVID: The kings of the earth, the rulers,
22 you know, they -- God laughs at them.

23 HENRY: Um-hum.

24 DAVID: Yea, they shall not be planted,
25 which means -- see, they're going to be destroyed

1 because of their attitude towards, you know, the, the
2 Book. That's what, that's what tears me up. It says
3 here, yea, they shall not be sown, yea, their stock
4 shall take root in the earth, for God shall blow upon
them -- remember there's fire?

5 HENRY: Um-hum.

6 DAVID: And they shall wither and the
7 whirlwind, which is Jeremiah 30, the whirlwind of the
8 Lord, His fury, shall take them away as stubble.

9 HENRY: Um-hum.

10 DAVID: That's why Daniel says that the, the
11 rock hit the image in the feet. It all blew away.

12 HENRY: Um-hum.

13 DAVID: To whom then will you liken God, or
14 why, or why -- or shall I be equal saith the Holy One.
15 Lift up your eyes on high and behold who had created
16 these things from in the heavens? That bringeth out
17 their host by number, and see how the universe is up
there?

18 HENRY: Um-hum.

19 DAVID: For God calls them all by names by
20 the greatness of his might, for that he is strong in
21 power, not one faileth. Be awesome for one of those
stars to fall down and hit ours, wouldn't it?

22 HENRY: Um-hum.

23

1 DAVID: So why sayest thou, O Jacob, and
2 speakest, O Israel, that our way is hid from the Lord,
3 that our judgment is passed over from our God?

4 HENRY: Um-hum.

5 DAVID: See, 'cause in this, in this
6 situation, the prophecy, we get into a real scary
7 situation like, well, you know, well, are you going to
8 help us, God, or not? And God says, have you not
9 known? Have you not heard that the everlasting God,
10 the Lord, the Creator of the all the ends of the
11 earth, fainteth not, neither is weary? There is no
12 searching (indiscernible) His understanding.

13 For He will give power to the faint and to
14 them that have no might He will increase strength.
15 For in this, the youths will be faint, which we are,
16 and weary. The young men shall utterly fall, which we
17 have, but they that wait upon the Lord shall renew
18 their strength. For they shall mount up with wings of
19 eagles, they shall run and not be weary, they shall
20 walk and not faint.

21 Now, the reason being is in Matthew 24, this
22 is the fulfillment. These are the eagles that gather
23 with the carcass, and the carcass is the Lord who
24 comes with a strong hand, the Lord's body. Okay?

25 HENRY: Um-hum.

1 DAVID: So what God admonishes in His record
2 in 42 is He states, this is His announcement to the
3 world, He says, Behold My servant, whom I uphold.
4 Now, we know that the Father gives the Book to the
5 Lamb, right.

6 HENRY: Um-hum.

7 DAVID: Mine elect, I mean you know, the
8 Father elected him, right?

9 HENRY: Um-hum.

10 DAVID: In who My soul delighteth.

11 HENRY: Um-hum.

12 DAVID: Now, what makes him different than
13 anybody else? It says, I have put My Spirit upon him.
14 He shall bring forth judgment to the Gentiles. Now,
15 what he, what he, what he does is he brings God's
16 judgment to the Gentiles.

17 HENRY: Um-hum.

18 DAVID: In other words, the Gentiles will be
19 judged by him.

20 HENRY: Um-hum.

21 DAVID: But by the truth he's trying to
22 teach them.

23 HENRY: Um-hum.

24 DAVID: He shall not cry, nor lift up, nor
25 cause His voice to be heard in the street. That's why

1 you never heard me out, you know, on -- in, in -- I'm
2 not an evangelist. I don't go around all over the
3 world going, you know, and the Lord said, you know.
4 You know how those guys do.

5 HENRY: Um-hum.

6 DAVID: Now, a bruised reed shall He not
7 break, and the smoking flax shall He not quench, which
8 is true. I've never hurt anybody. He shall bring
9 forth judgment unto truth. In other words, what's the
10 truth? Seven seals.

11 HENRY: Um-hum.

12 DAVID: He shall not fail nor be cut off
13 until He has set judgment in the earth and the isles
14 shall wait upon His law, which His law is prophecy.

15 HENRY: Um-hum.

16 DAVID: They've got to, they've got to
17 believe that God's going to do what He says.

18 HENRY: Um-hum.

19 DAVID: Thus said the Lord God, He that
20 created the heavens, and stretched them out. He that
21 spread forth the earth, and that which comes out of
22 it. He that giveth breath unto the people that
23 (indiscernible) upon it, and spirit to them that walk
24 therein. I, the Lord, have called thee in
25 righteousness and I will hold thy hand and I will keep

1 | thee and give thee for a covenant of the people, for a
2 | light to the Gentiles.

3 | Okay? So that's, that's why, you know, that
4 | -- well, that's, that's why the seven seals are very
5 | important.

6 | HENRY: Right.

7 | DAVID: Now, these seals is to open the
8 | blind eyes, to bring out them that are sit in
9 | darkness, and out of the prison, and out of the prison
10 | houses.

11 | HENRY: Um-hum.

12 | DAVID: I am the Lord, that is my name, and
13 | my glory will I not give to another, neither my praise
14 | to graven images. We know no idolatries, right? It
15 | says here, for the former things have come to pass and
16 | I, I declare -- and new things do I declare, which are
17 | the seven seals.

18 | HENRY: Um-hum.

19 | DAVID: Before they spring forth shall I not
20 | tell thee of them? Which is, you know, the whole
21 | process of what we're dealing with here. But, you
22 | know, like they were making fun on the, on the TV the
23 | other day. They were saying, you know, they were
24 | saying, well, I, I thought that Jesus was perfect and
25 | we know this man's not and besides, this guy says, you

1 know, my little daughter made a good statement the
2 other day. She says -- that I didn't think about, but
3 just kind of goes to show you how smart kids are and
4 the news guy says, well, what was it? She said -- he
5 goes, she says, Daddy, this man can't be Jesus,
6 because Jesus don't wear glasses. Right?

6 (Laughter.)

7 HENRY: Listen, I just had a thought and I
8 don't know if, if we've talked about this or haven't
9 talked about this, but you know, whenever you, you
10 decide that you're coming out --

11 DAVID: Well, I've already decided to do
12 that.

12 HENRY: Oh, no, no.

13 DAVID: I'm just waiting for --

14 HENRY: Look, I mean, at the moment that,
15 you know, I don't know if we've talked about this and
16 I just want to make sure. You know, I want you and I
17 want everybody that's in there, and I want you to tell
18 everybody that's in there, that their safety is
19 guaranteed.

19 DAVID: Oh, they know that.

20 HENRY: Okay. Well, I, you know, I -- but
21 we haven't talked about it so I just want to make sure
22 that, that everybody realizes that, you know, just

23

24

25

1 doesn't -- isn't taking that like, you know, just
2 anticipating that that's going to happen without
3 somebody here having said that. Okay?

4 DAVID: All right.

5 HENRY: And whatever punishment is going to,
6 not be addressed, whatever -- it's not the FBI or, or
7 the ATF that's dishing out that punishment. I mean,
8 everybody's going to go and stand trial. You know how
9 that judicial system is.

10 DAVID: Oh, yeah, I do.

11 HENRY: Okay. So, you know, I mean,
12 everybody's going to go -- who, whoever is, is charged
13 is going to be, you know, go through the judicial
14 system. It doesn't mean that, that, that your safety,
15 or anybody's safety is not guaranteed. Everybody's
16 safety is guaranteed.

17 DAVID: Well, that's why it says here, it
18 says to open the blind eyes, to bring out the
19 prisoners from the prison, and them that sit in
20 darkness out of the prison house.

21 HENRY: Um-hum. Okay. Well, you know, I'm
22 sure that, that because you speak the truth, you know,
23 and the people that, as with the children who've
24 you've sent out, you know, everybody needs to
25 understand that, that everybody is going to come out,

1 and I'm sure that they do, but I want everybody to
2 understand that, you know, we're not just laying in
3 the weeds here waiting for somebody to show up and
4 then --

5 DAVID: I know. It's -- like, like the
6 other night. I kept telling guys if they was wanting
7 to shoot some of your guys out here in the front, and
8 I told them, I said, look. I said, blood is already
9 shed.

10 HENRY: That's right.

11 DAVID: I said, look, so these guys are out
12 here lying to you. They've lied to me so far and
13 y'all guys know it. Now here's the deal. I have not
14 lied to them. They tell me that they have bosses over
15 them and I've told them that I have bosses over me.

16 HENRY: Um-hum.

17 DAVID: They told me what they were going to
18 do, but I realized their bosses are over them. So you
19 might tell me a lot of things and when I get out of
20 here, boy! I may, I may have a real hell, you know.

21 HENRY: Yeah, I know.

22 DAVID: But the thing of it is this.

23 HENRY: No.

24 DAVID: But -- well, let me explain. Let me
25 just make, make, make it clear.

1 HENRY: Okay.

2 DAVID: But -- 'cause this is what I have to
3 remind the people that have believed God through what
4 I have shown them.

5 HENRY: Um-hum.

6 DAVID: Okay? But still nonetheless, we
7 have to keep our eyes single to the glory of God,
8 because, you know, y'all more or less have a harder
9 time to realize that I am taking orders, you see, and
10 that, and that my boss is making decisions on whether
11 not to pounce you or not. You know, I mean, you know,
12 and I don't want my boss to pounce you because you
13 don't understand me and I don't think -- and this is
14 honestly between myself and God.

15 I don't think that by myself being human I
16 don't think that I have done a good enough job or that
17 I have done everything that I can possibly do at the
18 present to try to, to, to inform you clearly what the
19 issues are from our side.

20 HENRY: Okay. And I --

21 DAVID: You see, and so --

22 HENRY: And I think, and I think that, that
23 that opportunity will be afforded to you not just, you
24 know, when you come out, but throughout the whole
25 process now --

1 DAVID: Well, we're doing that now. I mean
2 this, this is where I've -- this is where I've always
3 told the guys, you know, now Jim and them are -- have
4 pressure from on high -- I mean, you know, from their
5 hierarchy and I'm having pressure from my hierarchy,
6 but whereas you know man has given you and Jim, you
7 know, a certain leeway --

8 HENRY: Um-hum.

9 DAVID: -- a certain, you know, a bit, a bit
10 of liberty to, you know, call shots and all that? So,
11 for some reason because of my experience being in this
12 stupid flesh in the first place for so many years and
13 making so many mistakes, God has given me also a
14 heart, or a liberty, to be able to, to, you know, ask
15 for additional or extra, you know, time in regards for
16 y'all.

17 HENRY: Well, let me ask you this.

18 DAVID: That sounds funny. I know, it's --

19 HENRY: Let me ask you this. You know, one
20 of the concerns that I have now is remember when you
21 told me, you know, last night and early this morning
22 about the, the experience that you had with the
23 sheriff's office?

24 DAVID: Right.

25 HENRY: Okay. You --

1 DAVID: I forgive those guys. That was,
2 that was --

3 HENRY: Yeah. But you're not thinking that
4 that's going to happen again, do you?

5 DAVID: Well, no, not really, but it
6 doesn't --

7 HENRY: Tell me the truth.

8 DAVID: No, honestly, because see, I, I know
9 that the Federal Government -- I know, I know -- the
10 FBI's involved now.

11 HENRY: Um-hum.

12 DAVID: Now, if I had come out the first day
13 and the ATF guys -- you can't blame those football
14 players, you know. They lost good friends, you know.
15 That night they were out and a few of them having a
16 few beers, you know, and somebody said that, that they
17 called up on the talk show and they said they were out
18 here at one of the local clubs and three of those guys
19 were in the bar there and they were drinking, you
20 know, Saturday night?

21 And that they were in there talking about
22 coming out here to Mount Carmel and, and busting us up
23 real good in the morning and it was going to be, you
24 know, they were talking to each other about it and
25 they were laughing about it and, you know, and then

1 | this guy said he heard about it and then when it
2 | happened it really made him mad because, I mean, they
3 | were really sounding -- well, they were just being
4 | human, you know what I mean?

5 | HENRY: Um-hum.

6 | DAVID: You know, get those bad guys, so to
7 | speak.

8 | HENRY: Well, you know, I don't know
9 | anything about that, but I can tell you this, you
10 | know. The bosses have gone, you know, on TV, on the
11 | press conference and said that everybody's safety is
12 | paramount. Now, that means that if you tell me right
13 | now I'm -- we're ready to come out right now --

14 | DAVID: Uh-huh.

15 | HENRY: -- everybody, you know, all the big
16 | bosses are -- that's the first thing that they're
17 | going to say. We want everybody to be safe. Okay?

18 | DAVID: And not stick us into jail with any
19 | big guys.

20 | HENRY: What?

21 | DAVID: (Laughter.)

22 | HENRY: What?

23 | DAVID: And not put us into prison with any
24 | big guys.

25 | HENRY: (Laughter.)

1 DAVID: That'll poke us in the rear.

2 HENRY: Well, see, see --

3 DAVID: It's against our religion.

4 HENRY: One of the things that's going to
5 happen is, the people that are hurt, like yourself,
6 are going to be taken care of, you know, medically
7 first. I mean, you're not going to be put in jail
8 first. You're going to be put in a situation where
9 you are taken care of medically first. Okay?

9 DAVID: Right.

10 HENRY: Now, in terms of being put in a
11 situation where you're with some big guy, you know,
12 one of the things that, that you need to understand
13 is, your reputation precedes you. You are, you are a
14 man of the cloth and as such people are going to
15 perceive you in that fashion --

15 DAVID: Oh, they're going to --

16 HENRY: -- and they're going to want to hear
17 your message.

18 DAVID: They're going to first -- they're
19 going to want to bend me over to show me that I'm
20 nothing.

21 HENRY: Well, you know, I -- you, you
22 can't --

23 DAVID: Look, God knows -- I understand what
24
25

1 you're saying.

2 HENRY: -- you can't assume that and you --
3 see, that's right. God is going to take care of you
4 because you have a mission. Now, most of us don't
5 understand completely what our mission in life is and
6 I know that you know to a certain extent. But there
7 may be some things here and there -- a very strong,
8 sincere reason for you having to go, you know, at
9 least for a period of time, to make an impression
10 there and to cause there to be a change among those
11 people who are forgotten. That nobody really tends
12 to.

13 DAVID: Yeah. I feel sorry for them.

14 HENRY: Really.

15 DAVID: Some belong there and some don't.

16 HENRY: Really.

17 DAVID: My brother was always the one -- I
18 have a stepbrother.

19 HENRY: Do you have any brothers and
20 sisters?

21 DAVID: Well, I have -- like I say, my
22 original father was not -- he was -- I was a mistake
23 child, right?

24 HENRY: Um-hum.

25 DAVID: Supposedly?

1 HENRY: Um-hum.

2 DAVID: And I got brothers and sisters in
3 Houston that I've never really met but one sister.

4 HENRY: Uh-huh.

5 DAVID: And I have the one brother that I
6 was raised with and he, he's a, he's, he's Roger
7 Haldeman. He's always been in and out of trouble.
8 I've always tried to help him. You know, and, you
9 know, he's just -- he, you know, he has problems, you
10 know. He, he, he's gotten to the drug scene and all
11 that.

12 HENRY: Is he in Dallas?

13 DAVID: No, he's in, he lives in Tyler. He
14 was living in Waco for a while, but --

15 HENRY: Uh-huh.

16 DAVID: You know, he has -- everywhere he
17 goes he, he finds these people and he's weak in that
18 area.

19 HENRY: Um-hum.

20 DAVID: I mean, I've always told him I says,
21 well, Roger, you now, you, you've got to realize that
22 God understands these weaknesses and you have to, you
23 know, you have to fight against them to make them
24 stronger. Anything you exercise in your will is going
25 to be made stronger.

1 HENRY: Um-hum.

2 DAVID: But, you know, it's just -- I tell
3 you, there's powerful drugs today. Once you do it
4 once --

5 HENRY: Yeah.

6 DAVID: -- you're, you're hooked.

7 HENRY: Um-hum. Now, I -- if you have any
8 questions about, you know, what will happen, you need
9 to ask me and if I don't know the answer, I will find
10 answers for you. I want you to realize that, you
11 know, I believe that God has been protecting you and
12 protecting the people within the compound and he will
13 continue to protect those that are taken into custody.
14 I really believe that and I also believe, you know,
15 that in the federal system -- that the federal system
16 is very different from the state system.

17 DAVID: Yeah, it's meaner.

18 HENRY: Okay. No!

19 DAVID: Oh, yeah.

20 HENRY: Oh no, no, no, no.

21 DAVID: Yeah. (Laughter.)

22 HENRY: Really --

23 DAVID: The federal prisons are, are meaner.

24 HENRY: No, no, no. I think it's just the
25 other way around. I, you know, and there are, you

1 know, there are federal penitentiaries that are --
2 everybody calls them country clubs because they're
3 real easy.

4 DAVID: I'm not an income tax evader. I'm,
5 I'm --

6 HENRY: (Laughter.)

7 DAVID: -- considered a -- I don't know.
8 What do they consider me?

9 HENRY: I don't know.

10 DAVID: A terrorist?

11 HENRY: Nah -- see, I don't think so. I
12 don't think so. See, I don't know what they're going
13 to charge you with. I, you know, you know -- do, do
14 you have any questions that we need to resolve --

15 DAVID: No. I mean, like I say --

16 HENRY: I mean I know you're planning to
17 come out so --

18 DAVID: When, when, when, when, when, when
19 my god tells me to go, then I already know what y'all
20 are going to do. Okay? And what happens is, if, if
21 it's done otherwise, according to the other opposition
22 -- if what I've, what I've already said creates the
23 other opposition, I already know what happens then
24 too.

25 HENRY: Okay.

1 DAVID: So, you know, it's just like -- the,
2 the more, the more you learn -- you know, the more you
3 -- and then I, I know that Mike too, you know, he's,
4 he's got a Catholic background too, you know.

5 HENRY: Um-hum.

6 DAVID: And don't get me wrong, I mean, you
7 know --

8 HENRY: Thanks a lot.

9 DAVID: The --

10 HENRY: You don't like Catholics, do you?

11 DAVID: No, no, no, no, no.

12 HENRY: Thanks a lot.

13 DAVID: No, no, no, no. What I'm saying is,
14 like I said -- Antonio Munoz --

15 HENRY: Um-hum.

16 DAVID: The best people that I've ever known
17 have been Catholics that have treated me good.

18 Antonio Munoz is a devout Catholic. He had a shrine,
19 you know, the Mother Mary in his house and everything.

20 He, he owned a tile company; he did tile work. And
21 like I said, that, that kind of business during the
22 '70s and '80s was very, very prominent.

23 He made lots of money and he has a brand new
24 -- well, he has several homes in Dallas, but a brand
25 new home. He owns them all and when I used to go

1 around to the streets and stuff, you know, after '78,
2 '79, '80, you know, and I used to go and talk to
3 people of my experiences, you know, trying to bring
4 them closer to God, I lived in my car.

5 HENRY: Um-hum.

6 DAVID: And I would drive and I would go out
7 and I would take on subcontracting and I would do
8 decks or roofing or whatever I could find to do by
9 myself or with maybe one other person and make a
10 pocketful of money and then get in my car and, and
11 live a couple of months or so without any worries.
12 And I had all the time in the world to talk with
13 people and, and get familiar with, communicate with
14 people.

15 HENRY: Where, where was this guy Munoz
16 from?

17 DAVID: Okay.

18 HENRY: Was he --

19 DAVID: Originally he was from Mexico years
20 ago.

21 HENRY: Was -- is he Hinter or Antonio?

22 DAVID: His, his name is Antonio.

23 HENRY: Okay, Antonio.

24 DAVID: Antonio Munoz.

25 HENRY: And he was from Mexico?

1 DAVID: Yeah.

2 HENRY: Okay.

3 DAVID: But he, he lives down, he lives down
4 there in Saxy (phonetic sp.).

5 HENRY: Oh, okay.

6 DAVID: Okay? But anyway I had a -- I was
7 staying with a Russian lumber company in Wylie, Texas.

8 HENRY: Oh, okay.

9 DAVID: Which is up north of Lavonne
10 (phonetic sp.) Highway, if I'm, if I'm correct.

11 HENRY: Um-hum.

12 DAVID: And I was staying back there and
13 this one guy, Kevin, he was, he was fixing to, you
14 know, inherit the lumber company and he had just
15 bought a brand new El Camino.

16 HENRY: Um-hum.

17 DAVID: And he took the brand new motor out
18 and he wanted to put in a new motor, because, see, I
19 used to, to build hot rods all the time. I'm a
20 mechanic.

21 HENRY: Um-hum.

22 DAVID: And so I, I told him, I said, well,
23 I'll help you out. So we made friends and he found
24 out I didn't have a place to stay so he let me stay
25 there in the shop on the, on the lumberyard grounds.

1 So, you know, I built motors and then one day this guy
2 came along and his name was Eddie Munoz --

3 HENRY: Um-hum.

4 DAVID: -- a young man, you know, kind of
5 nice looking and everything and he came along and he
6 wanted me to build a motor, so, so I did, so his dad,
7 which is Antonio, came by and met me. And so I built
8 some engine stuff for his truck, 'cause he always had
9 these trucks which he used in the business, tile
10 setting and all that. So he wanted me to do one over
11 at his house, so I went over to his house and he told
12 me, he says, he goes -- my name is Vernon, right?

13 He says, he goes hey, Vernon, then he says,
14 you know you, you work on my truck, you know, and he
15 says I give you some money, he says. I tell you what,
16 he says, you, you don't sleep in your car. You stay
17 here in the night with -- you know, in the house for
18 the night. You know, you stay out in the den there,
19 you know. I said, oh, I can't do that, Mr. Munoz. He
20 goes, no, you, you stay out here. You work on my
21 truck, I give you some money, and you stay at my home,
22 you stay at my house tonight, you know.

23 So I, you know, I was very grateful and I
24 took a shower and I stayed there and he had his shrine
25 in there, you know, and everything and, and, you know,

1 Hilda was his wife -- beautiful family.

2 HENRY: Um-hum.

3 DAVID: You know, just really good people
4 and I'd, I'd give him Bible studies, you know, and
5 stuff, you know.

6 HENRY: Um-hum.

7 DAVID: Not, not to what I know now --

8 HENRY: Um-hum.

9 DAVID: -- but to what little light I had
10 back then.

11 HENRY: Sure.

12 DAVID: And he'd, he'd sit back and --

13 HENRY: See --

14 DAVID: -- he'd look at me and smile, you
15 know, and he'd go --

16 HENRY: See, that's what I --

17 DAVID: -- he'd go --

18 HENRY: See, that's what I think is going to
19 happen, you know. That's exactly the way that I see
20 it. I see that, you know, like then you ministered
21 to, you know, a very limited number of people, you
22 know. As time has gone on you've ministered to, to
23 more people, okay. You ministered to all the people
24 that are in the compound and, and, and some that are
25 not in the compound, you know?

1 And, and because of the exposure that, that
2 you've gotten, you know, you're going -- and because,
3 you know, either you'll be in prison or in custody for
4 a limited period of time or however much a period --
5 whatever period of time, you're going to wind up
6 ministering to a lot larger group of people. I really
7 believe that.

8 DAVID: Right. Well, see here, here's the
9 deal. In one aspect, okay, the way it is right now
10 because of my position --

11 HENRY: Um-hum.

12 DAVID: I mean, there's no way around it.
13 My charges are murder. I mean, you know, that's,
14 that --

15 HENRY: Well, okay, but that's not --

16 DAVID: Let, let's be honest. That's the
17 way it is --

18 HENRY: But that's, but that's what -- I
19 mean, that's what the charges may be, okay?

20 DAVID: And they have -- exactly. And they
21 have -- and that's capital punishment.

22 HENRY: Well --

23 DAVID: And so --

24 HENRY: -- see, you're, see you're talking
25 about, you know --

1 DAVID: Well, what I'm trying to tell you is
2 that I'm not afraid of that.

3 HENRY: Okay.

4 DAVID: You know, if, if I have an
5 opportunity, because, you know -- I mean, I mean,
6 whether, whether, whether you all come in here and
7 shoot me today or whether I get a chance a while to,
8 like I say you know --

9 HENRY: See, nobody's coming in to shoot
10 you.

11 DAVID: Well, well, what I'm saying is
12 that --

13 HENRY: I told you we talked about
14 guaranteeing your safety, for goodness sakes.

15 DAVID: Right.

16 HENRY: What are we talking about, David?

17 DAVID: Right. So, what happens is is that
18 when, when --

19 HENRY: Do you understand that?

20 DAVID: Well --

21 HENRY: Do, do you feel confident with that?
22 If not --

23 DAVID: Look if I -- if, if, if I didn't
24 have the communication I have right now, okay, listen
25 to me --

1 HENRY: Okay.

2 DAVID: -- Joh -- you know, Henry, seriously
3 then, you know, it was last night, there'd be more
4 dead agents around here.

5 HENRY: I'm sure. I'm sure.

6 DAVID: Because, you know, these guys are,
7 are, you know, some of the boys on the National Guard
8 side or whatever are, you know, they don't understand.
9 They don't understand. And some of their so-called,
10 you know, it's true, it's true, that in, in fog it's
11 true that, that night vision does not work. But, you
12 know, there's other types of visionary apparatuses
13 too.

14 HENRY: Um-hum.

15 DAVID: Which work with red lights and
16 stuff. And, you know, it's, it's true that, you know,
17 we understood everything about these tanks and
18 everything and what they can and can't do.

19 HENRY: Um-hum.

20 DAVID: You know, it's like, y'all been
21 preparing eight months, or the ATF --

22 HENRY: Well, see, but the AT -- you know,
23 right now, as you said before, the FBI is involved in
24 this too.

25 DAVID: Oh, yeah, right.

1 HENRY: So, so, you know --

2 DAVID: Well, we've been preparing ever
3 since 1985.

4 HENRY: Well, there you go. There you go
5 and you can't lose faith or courage, you know, because
6 your message is very powerful. And because of the
7 faith that you have in God, and I'm telling you, you
8 know, because there is no -- there would be no --
9 nothing served by killing you or anybody else. That's
10 why everybody has pulled back and maybe, you know, the
11 cowboys are driving around and, you know, flexing
12 their muscles or whatever, you know, and, you know, so
13 what. I mean, who cares? Forget about them. Okay?

12 DAVID: Yeah.

13 HENRY: When it comes time --

14 DAVID: That's easy for me and you to do,
15 but some of these guys here, like I said, they're
16 going strictly by remembrance and they're always
17 coming to me saying now, where was, where was that at
18 again? I say, over at Zephaniah, back at Habakkuk,
19 you know, you know --

19 HENRY: You tell me when -- you tell me when
20 you, when the time is. When you are, when you are
21 advised that you want to walk out at that moment and I
22 am telling you, I will work with you through this to

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1 ensure that everything is done as with the kids to
2 ensure that everybody's safety --

3 DAVID: I believe you.

4 HENRY: -- is guaranteed.

5 DAVID: I've always believed you.

6 HENRY: I want you to think that, I want you
7 to know that, and I want everybody there to know that.

8 I am not going to, I am not going to do anything that
9 is going to jeopardize your situation -- I'm not going
10 to let anybody do that. We don't want that to happen.

11 Okay? The cowboys may be flexing their muscles. Let
12 them flex their muscles. If that, you know, if they
13 feel good about that, let them feel good about that.

14 Okay? The perimeter -- okay, they have to keep their
15 perimeter? Okay. They're jumping around and big
16 deal, okay. They've got their perimeter, okay.

17 Great.

18 DAVID: Yeah. Now you --

19 HENRY: Great.

20 DAVID: -- now you know where we're coming
21 from.

22 HENRY: Okay. They've got their perimeter,
23 they're happy, they're delighted, hey, you know,
24 they're flexing the muscles. Fine. Let's get the
25 thing done that we need to get done.

1 DAVID: Right.

2 HENRY: And let's move on and let everybody,

3 you know, share your message because --

4 DAVID: See, the only thing --

5 HENRY: -- it's a powerful message.

6 DAVID: The only thing I'm worried about

7 handling --

8 HENRY: Okay.

9 DAVID: -- is that like I say, you know,

10 Christ had disciples 2,000 years ago. Right?

11 HENRY: Said what?

12 DAVID: Christ had disciples 2,000 --

13 HENRY: Yes.

14 DAVID: -- years ago. Right?

15 HENRY: Yes, yes.

16 DAVID: Now, Peter got edgy and chopped off

17 a Centurion -- (End of Tape #48.)

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
