2 STEVE: -- talk to him? He says --

3 DAVID: Tell him to go drink a glass of
4 milk.

5 STEVE: He says, he says nah, go drink a
6 glass of milk.

7 DICK: Listen. We have it ready for you.

8 STEVE: (Indiscernible.)

9 DICK: So this is going to be another
10 rejection on, on our, on your part toward the efforts
11 that we've made. Let me, let me go into -- you
12 remember this article I spoke to you about this
13 morning?

14 STEVE: Dick says, Dick says I guess this
15 will be another rejection on your part.

16 DAVID: Another what?

17 STEVE: Rejection on your part to the
18 efforts that are being made.

19 DAVID: (indiscernible).

20 STEVE: He says you're making no damn
21 efforts.

22 DICK: Well, and what you define what I just
23 offered to you, to David? Have David define what that
24 is if that's not an effort on our part?

25 STEVE: Could you define what that is today?

1 What their, their offer of the 6 frozen gallons for
2 four children?

3 He's not answering. So that, that must mean
4 that's an insult --

5 DICK: No, it's -- I, I -- it's not an
6 insult --

7 STEVE: Because he had 4 --

8 DICK: -- at all.

9 STEVE: -- at least I know it was at least 4
10 days ago. Maybe it was 5. I can't even --
11 (unidentified male voice in background not
12 discernible) --

13 DICK: Well, listen.

14 STEVE: Like he said. He gave \$1,000. He
15 never thought that would be a consideration
16 (indiscernible).

17 DICK: Well, we're going to, we're going to
18 send it in to you at no cost to you.

19 STEVE: All right.

20 DICK: Okay?

21 STEVE: Well, that's what was expected back
22 4 days ago. Because we were -- at that time if you
23 recall, Dick, we were sending children out. And they
24 would have kept on coming out. But when all of a
25 sudden an issue is made out of something like that

1 after \$1,000 was sent, it did not show a good faith on
2 your half or a good working relationship of trust.

3 DICK: Well --

4 STEVE: I mean even if those children we
5 sent out would have remained here, they would have got
6 some of that milk before they went out, but they'd
7 have still gone out. He, he -- it had nothing to do
8 with anything like that.

9 DICK: Steve, let -- you know, we talked
10 earlier about negotiations. You, you make repeated
11 effort -- or statements concerning negotiations.
12 Negotiations on the basic level are a tit for tat, a
13 concession on both parts, a backing down in some
14 instances, a moving forward in other instances. It's,
15 it's --

16 STEVE: You know, a wiser -- okay.

17 DICK: -- an agreement to agree not --

18 STEVE: A wiser question on your behalf
19 might be David, what could we do if anything at all,
20 you know. What we'd like to do is see maybe another
21 child or two or whatever. Is there anything that we
22 could do to maybe ensure that one or two could come
23 out? I would think that you might just want to ask
24 that, put it in his head, and see what he has to say
25 about it or as a reaction.

1 DICK: Well, I'll tell you what. Listen.
2 Send two kids out, and we'll send the milk in.

3 STEVE: No, you --

4 DICK: Tell, tell David --

5 STEVE: -- you already told me you were
6 going to send the milk in regardless.

7 DICK: Now who told you that? That's not at
8 all what I said.

9 STEVE: You just said, you just said 3
10 minutes ago.

11 DICK: That is absolutely unequivocally
12 untrue.

13 STEVE: Okay.

14 DICK: I said milk for four children is what
15 you and I discussed. And David talked about sending
16 people out two by two making the reference to a
17 Biblical passage. Let's send two of the kids out.
18 I'll get the milk to you for two kids.

19 STEVE: Oh, by the way. (Unidentified male
20 voice in background not discernible.) Sita is right
21 here. Okay, Sita wants to talk to you.

22 DICK: Good. Put her on. I'll be happy to
23 speak with her. (Unidentified male voice in
24 background not discernible.)

1 SITA: Hello?

2 DICK: Sita, how are you this morning?

3 SITA: Not very happy.

4 DICK: Not very happy? Did you -- David
5 just --

6 SITA: I'm not very happy with the picture.

7 DICK: With the picture?

8 SITA: Yes.

9 DICK: Why, what's your unhappiness with the
10 picture?

11 SITA: (Indiscernible) I specific asked that
12 those kids have a special diet. No pork. Those hot
13 dogs were pork. And my kids weren't happy in that
14 picture.

15 DICK: Not -- absolutely untrue. Absolutely
16 untrue. Those were --

17 SITA: What I saw --

18 DICK: -- all beef hot dogs. What we'd ask
19 them to give them --

20 SITA: What I saw in that picture --

21 DICK: I know. But listen, Sita. Let me
22 explain that to you. Because if that's what you're
23 unhappy about I can tell you --

24 SITA: No, not --

25 DICK: We have told those folks that turkey

1 or all beef as a substitute, but there is to be
2 absolutely no pork. Absolutely. We, we monitor those
3 requests. We, we honored them and, and we will
4 continue to do that when we can. Those kids are being
5 well cared for. Pork is not in their diet.

6 SITA: Not what I saw in that picture.

7 DICK: Sita, are you going to tell me that
8 you can look at a hot dog and tell me whether it's --

9 SITA: I can see the color of that picture.
10 And the kids were forced to smile. And why did you
11 guys cut Nahara's (phonetic sp.) hair?

12 DICK: Cut her hair?

13 SITA: Cut his hair. And who gave you guys
14 the right to cut those kids' hair?

15 DICK: Perhaps the child -- I don't even
16 know that the child's hair was cut. But if it was,
17 maybe it was the child's request to cut it. Maybe
18 they had some medical problems. Maybe there were some
19 bugs in the hair.

20 SITA: Bugs! That's baloney!

21 DICK: Sita, I'm not going to -- listen.

22 SITA: His hair was so --

23 DICK: Sita.

24 SITA: -- short already.

25 DICK: You listen to me for a moment, okay?

1 I'm telling you that those kids are being properly
2 cared for. Their hair is clean. They're getting a
3 healthy diet. We've made the request that they were
4 not to receive pork. And I'm doing that for you. We
5 are doing that for you. And now you're going to get
6 on and condemn us for what we've done for those kids?

6 Listen, I'm not going to listen to that.

7 SITA: Then don't talk to me then.

8 DICK: Then you just put Steve back on.

9 SITA: Okay.

10 DICK: Because I'm telling you we have done
11 that for you. And then all of a sudden you want to
12 get on there and call me a liar. That's, that's just
13 absolutely not true.

14 Now let's talk about the pork thing a little
15 bit. We know that you sincerely do not want those
16 children to have pork. And we can honor that, because
17 there are agents that don't eat pork either. And
18 that's completely reasonable. And we want to honor
19 any reasonable request. And we have done that. The
20 kids do not get pork.

21 SITA: And one thing too. When the kids
22 were supposed to come out we, we sent a letter where
23 their, where they were going. And they are still here
24 also.

1 DICK: That's, that's right. And we
2 addressed that issue before. This cannot be done
3 overnight. We're hoping to reunite you and your kids.
4 We're hoping to reunite the two of you. And we
5 understand where you want those kids to go in the
6 event that's not done. But these things, you know, it
7 has to be done on a timely basis. And I know your
8 time and --

9 SITA: Jim promised me that he'll call their
10 grandparents or whoever they were going to the next
11 day. That's what's my understanding. That's why I
12 went out for my life with my kids.

13 DICK: Um-hum.

14 SITA: And now not even one word. And I
15 cannot even speak to them.

16 DICK: Well, yes, you can speak to them.
17 That's, that's your choice. You said that you wanted
18 to stay in there.

19 SITA: Yes. I want to speak to them.

20 DICK: Well, you can speak to them. But you
21 know, it was your choice. We asked you to come out.
22 We're ready to have you come out any time you like.
23 But until you do that --

24 SITA: Yes, I can come out any time I want.

25 DICK: Sure. David said you could.

1 SITA: But what you guys been doing, coming
2 inside the property which you were told, were told not
3 to come in. And day after day they keep coming in and
4 flashing their butt and sticking their finger at us.

5 DICK: Listen. I want to find out what time
6 that was. That's one of the things I wanted to ask --

7 SITA: It was yesterday.

8 DICK: -- of, of Steven. Pardon me?

9 SITA: It was yesterday.

10 DICK: I understand that. Because he
11 brought that to my attention. But I wanted to follow
12 up on that and so that I can run that down. Because
13 that's unacceptable. And I told him that.

14 SITA: It's very childish.

15 DICK: Yeah, it's more than that. It's
16 unprofessional. It's unprofessional. If it was just
17 childish, maybe we would deal with that. But it's
18 unprofessional, and we're not going to allow it. And
19 there has been a great deal of consternation about
20 that. And you can bet that it better not happen
21 again. Because the man that did that if he's an FBI
22 agent is going to be fired, period. End of story.
23 He's gone. That's not going to happen.

24 Now did Steven tell you that, that we've,
25 we've tried to get the milk in and done those kinds of

1 things? And that we're trying to honor your requests?
2 We have some of the parents there that say hey, send
3 the kids out to, to the folks who have been designated
4 by those people. And others say keep them all
5 together. Don't move them into foster homes.

6 You know, we have to confront these issues
7 one by one. And what you want and what someone else
8 wants may be different. And we have to deal with all
9 those issues as soon as we can and in the best way we
10 can. In the meantime, those kids are being well cared
11 for.

12 And the reason we sent the pictures in is
13 because there was some suggestion from somebody inside
14 there that, that the kids had been sent to foster
15 homes. We said absolutely untrue. And then what,
16 what do we get? We get you're lying. So instead, we
17 went out and took videotape which we sent in to you
18 that we're tell, told did not work. And we send in
19 hard copy --

20 SITA: There's nothing, there was nothing in
21 the --

22 DICK: Okay. Well, we're making
23 arrangements to get you another copy of that. Okay?
24 We'll, we'll send that in again so you can take a look
25 at it. But that's what we're doing, Sita. We got to

1 work together, and we're doing that for you.

2 And I can appreciate your position as a
3 mother. Because I would have the same concerns as a,
4 as you as a father of two children myself. So I can
5 appreciate some of your, some of your, your concerns.

6 And I --

7 SITA: (Indiscernible.)

8 DICK: -- certainly I'm not getting mad at
9 you, Sita, for expressing those. Because as a mother,
10 that's your responsibility to ensure that your wishes
11 are, are followed and that the kids' wishes are. So
12 please, I can appreciate that. I know you're
13 frustrated.

14 SITA: I (indiscernible).

15 DICK: I know you're tired. Sita, trust me.
16 We're -- I'm going to take, make sure that those kids
17 are, are handled properly. Please. If there's
18 nothing else that happens here, understand that I will
19 ensure and we will ensure the FBI that those kids are
20 properly cared for. And the only way we can improve
21 on that care is for you to come out and take care of
22 those kids themselves -- yourself. (Unidentified
23 voice in background not discernible.) And you know,
24 you and I both know that, Sita, that you're --

25 SITA: Excuse me. There is a girl want to

1 talk to you.

2 DICK: Okay. What -- who is this I'm
3 speaking with?

4 SITA: She's Nick. And she's the brother
5 who -- (unidentified female voice in background not
6 discernible) -- the sister of the brother who died
7 wanted -- (unidentified male voice in background not
8 discernible) --

8 DICK: Okay, put her --

9 SITA: That wouldn't take, excuse me --

10 DICK: Put her on. I'll be happy to speak
11 with her.

12 SITA: Just a minute.

13 [gap]

14 NICOLE: Hello?

15 DICK: Hi. Who's this?

16 NICOLE: This is Nicole.

17 DICK: Nicole, how are you this morning?
18 This is Dick. Have I spoken with you before?

19 NICOLE: No. I spoke to Jim. But I --

20 DICK: Okay.

21 NICOLE: -- haven't spoken to you before.

22 DICK: Good. I'm glad to have the
23 opportunity to speak with you.

24 NICOLE: I think personally you're a real
25

1 asshole myself.

2 DICK: Now that's, that's -- thank you. I,
3 I appreciate that.

4 NICOLE: Okay? I'm pretty teed off with the
5 whole situation.

6 DICK: Okay. What are your concerns? Tell
7 me specifically what your concerns are.

8 NICOLE: I will. I will tell you very
9 specifically.

10 DICK: Okay. And I'll answer. Give me one
11 at a time, and we'll answer them one at a time.

12 NICOLE: Number one.

13 DICK: Okay.

14 NICOLE: You send your agents here, you
15 murder my twin brother.

16 DICK: Who, who is that?

17 NICOLE: Peter Gent.

18 DICK: Peter Gent is your brother.

19 NICOLE: He's been laying --

20 DICK: Okay, please accept my, my regrets.

21 NICOLE: Your regrets --

22 DICK: Nicole, I was not there. The FBI was
23 not there. That was an ATF attempt to serve that
24 warrant. And they are as upset about this obviously,
25 they lost four agents.

1 NICOLE: Well, they --

2 DICK: They're as upset as you are about it.

3 NICOLE: I don't think so. We let them come
4 in here and take their dead man, their wounded. And
5 you guys won't even take my dead brother out of here.
6 I think it's sick. You people are sick in the head.
7 And I'm really --

8 DICK: We will try to do that. We
9 understand your concern.

10 NICOLE: We'll try. When? Next year? He
11 is down -- he's dead. And I bet --

12 DICK: I know that.

13 NICOLE: -- you haven't even notified my
14 parents, have you? They've come all the way from
15 Australia. You -- I'm just so teed off with this
16 whole situation. I have a little baby. David sends
17 out \$1,000, and you don't even have enough human
18 decency to send in 6 gallons of milk.

19 DICK: Nicole, I spoke with him about that.
20 We're ready to send that milk in.

21 NICOLE: When? We asked for that 4 days
22 ago.

23 DICK: It's here. We will -- we're ready.
24 We're ready to go on that. We're ready to go on it.

25 (Unidentified male voice in background not

1 discernible.) I just told Steven about that and David
2 too.

3 NICOLE: David says stop bullshitting, all
4 right?

5 DICK: We're not --

6 NICOLE: I mean you --

7 DICK: We're not doing that at all.

8 NICOLE: You are. Because you're trying to
9 develop some sort of trust here. And from what I can
10 see in observation, there is none. You have been
11 telling lies. I've seen with Steve you've just been
12 telling lies over and over again. You've got your
13 bulldozers all around this place trampling over
14 things. I mean who do you people think you are?

15 DICK: Nicole, I understand your
16 frustration.

17 NICOLE: You don't understand my
18 frustration. You're not in here. You're not in,
19 sitting in my room with my kids trying -- and I've got
20 a stupid --

21 DICK: I know. I know.

22 NICOLE: -- bulldozer aimed right at my
23 room. I mean you've got jerks in those tanks. You
24 need to get your act together.

25 DICK: Nicole, I understand what you're

1 saying.

2 NICOLE: You don't understand what I'm
3 saying.

4 DICK: Yes, I do. Yes, I do.

5 NICOLE: You guys have done nothing,
6 absolutely nothing.

7 DICK: I know you're concerned. We're
8 concerned, and we're trying to work this out together.

9 NICOLE: You want David to release people on
10 what elements? There is no trust.

11 DICK: Well, yeah, that's exactly true. And
12 we --

13 NICOLE: Exactly.

14 DICK: -- we -- listen, Nicole, yesterday we
15 offered to move our Bradleys back --

16 NICOLE: Well, how come they --

17 DICK: -- and to do other --

18 NICOLE: -- how come they keep rolling back
19 in here? Every time they go out --

20 DICK: Because David won't, won't help us.
21 He won't work with us.

22 NICOLE: David?

23 DICK: You're going to have to, you're going
24 to have to talk with David and get David to work with
25 us.

1 NICOLE: You're not working with us. That's
2 what the point is. You have not proven yourself at
3 all.

4 DICK: Really?

5 NICOLE: Really, you have not.

6 DICK: What are these offers that we have
7 made for, to you repeatedly over time and, and the
8 things we have done already.

9 NICOLE: What have --

10 DICK: We send you pictures for the kids.

11 NICOLE: And you cut off all their hair.
12 Are they still together? You're going to send them
13 out to foster parents. They were all given out --

14 DICK: We're not. We're not.

15 NICOLE: -- with addresses.

16 DICK: I know that.

17 NICOLE: You're not -- I don't trust you
18 guys. I really don't trust you guys at all.

19 DICK: Well, then you know the answer to
20 that is?

21 NICOLE: Where's our line? Where's our
22 phone?

23 DICK: You know what the answer --

24 NICOLE: Where's our phone line to the
25 press?

1 DICK: It's -- that's all in place.

2 NICOLE: We have none.

3 DICK: We suggested yesterday that we would
4 make people available when you come out -- you can
5 pick people that you want to be there to ensure
6 everybody's safety when you come out. We'll do that.

7 NICOLE: I'm not coming out. I am not
8 coming out. Based on what you guys have done, I'm not
9 coming out. I don't want to come out. I am not
10 coming out.

11 DICK: Okay. Well, that's your option. I'm
12 not trying to convince you to do that.

13 NICOLE: Good. Don't.

14 DICK: I'm suggesting that, that David has
15 said that that's an option and that if, if at --

16 NICOLE: An option?

17 DICK: -- a point in time you want to do
18 that then, then please, we will, we'll love to have
19 you out here. You can care for your children. Now
20 one child apparently I was told at least one child
21 asked to have his hair cut.

22 NICOLE: What -- David said your option is
23 you're going to burn hot and in hell. I mean this is
24 ridiculous.

25 DICK: Well, I'm sorry you feel that way.

1 We're --

2 NICOLE: Oh.

3 DICK: -- we're just doing the best we can
4 under --

5 NICOLE: I don't think so.

6 DICK: -- this is a difficult situation for
7 all of us. And we're doing the best we can, and what
8 we ask is in return for you to work with us. And
9 we'll get, we'll get things worked out. It may not be
10 as quickly as you would like. And it may not be as
11 quickly as I would like.

12 NICOLE: Quickly. How long does it take to
13 get a dead body out of this place?

14 DICK: Again, we're trying to deal with all
15 these requests of yours. And again it's not getting
16 done as quickly --

17 NICOLE: Look.

18 DICK: -- as you want, Nicole.

19 NICOLE: You came in here. When you guys
20 fired on us, you guys fired first. I have bullet
21 holes in my son -- I'm glad he wasn't in his bed. He
22 would have been killed.

23 DICK: Nicole, you need to tell the world
24 that very same thing.

25 NICOLE: Well, then why don't you give us a

1 line out?

2 DICK: You will have the opportunity to do
3 that.

4 NICOLE: When? When, Dick? When?

5 DICK: You know, listen. Let me tell you
6 what again, very briefly what we went over this
7 morning with Steven concerning a local article that
8 was written in the Forth Worth Star Telegraph where a
9 person writes in and says that the, the attack, he
10 calls it an attack on the compound by federal agents
11 was an attempt to suppress religion simply because the
12 members live communally.

13 And he goes on to say the government has
14 become a police state. They want everybody to bow
15 down to them. Goes on to say, he said the raid's
16 violence which left four ATF agents and at least some
17 Dividians dead was the fault of the U.S. Government.

18 Now that's the kind of support you're
19 getting out there. But you need to, to ensure that
20 that is communicated by the people inside that can
21 tell what happened from their viewpoint.

22 NICOLE: Dick, don't try and patronize me.

23 DICK: ATF is --

24 NICOLE: You don't want us to have a line.
25 You don't want us to have a line out. That is a,

1 that's a fact. You don't. Because you would have
2 given it to us a long time ago.

3 DICK: Your best line is to walk out of
4 there and talk to whomever you want to talk to.

5 NICOLE: I'm not walking out of -- oh,
6 freedom of speech. What happened to the Constitution
7 of America? It doesn't exist.

8 DICK: What did I just tell you? You have
9 the ability to talk to anyone you wish. When you come
10 out of there absolutely. And I told David and Steve
11 there will be so many requests to talk to you folks
12 you'll be able to get your story out in any fashion --

13 NICOLE: That's a load of baloney.

14 DICK: It isn't a load of baloney.

15 NICOLE: It's -- that's bullshit, Dick.

16 DICK: Listen, Nicole. Let me review a
17 couple of things for you, the things that we've done
18 at your request. Not specifically yours. But the
19 folks inside that were done for you, okay? A phone
20 line was opened up. Obviously --

21 NICOLE: (Indiscernible.)

22 DICK: -- that was for both. That was for
23 both of us.

24 NICOLE: Keep going.

25 DICK: Okay, but it was done. You had the

1 same interest in it as we have. And that was done on
2 the 28th, Sunday.

3 And then David wanted to make a statement,
4 and in return for that he said I will bring all my
5 people out. He gets an hour on the telephone -- or
6 I'm sorry. An hour in the media after he does a
7 statement of his own choice. He puts it together.
8 Nobody, nobody edited that statement. He put exactly
9 what he wanted on there. And it was played verbatim.

10 Then we get, we get a reference to play the
11 tape on national TV and they will come out. Now that
12 comes from Scott. It's, it's played. Again, you
13 don't come out. Then someone suggested, Rita I
14 believe, said play the tape during prime time, and the
15 women and the children will come out. Of course, it's
16 played during prime time. Nobody comes out. Or you
17 know, the group doesn't come out.

18 David wants 150 feet of phone line. We
19 furnish that to him.

20 NICOLE: You, you don't hook it up?

21 DICK: Well, how can we hook it up? We're
22 not in there. We sent in a telephone for it.

23 NICOLE: Why did you cut off all
24 communication in the first place?

25 DICK: That -- and again I told you I'm not

1 going to lie to you. That is commonly done --

2 NICOLE: Commonly done.

3 DICK: -- in these, in these situations.

4 NICOLE: Freedom of speech. Commonly done.

5 DICK: No.

6 NICOLE: Yes.

7 DICK: There's actually has nothing to do
8 with freedom of speech. It has to do with as I
9 suggested to some of the guys yesterday when you have
10 this kind of incident, as unfortunate as it is, there
11 are all kinds of people out there that, that want to
12 involve themselves to some degree. And some, just
13 people with some off --

14 NICOLE: Dick --

15 DICK: -- the wall things --

16 NICOLE: Dick the truth is --

17 DICK: -- to say will call in.

18 NICOLE: -- David and Steve were on, on the
19 press. They were speaking live to the people on
20 radio. And they were telling what you happened, and
21 you guys didn't like it. So you cut our lines.
22 That's what happened. (Unidentified male voice in
23 background not discernible.)

24 DICK: Absolutely.

25 NICOLE: Absolutely.

1 DICK: We did --

2 NICOLE: You didn't like what they were
3 saying.

4 DICK: No, I'm saying we cut the lines.
5 It's not because what, of what you were saying --

6 NICOLE: Because you didn't like it.
7 Because they told how the BATF --

8 DICK: Um-hum.

9 NICOLE: -- came in here and started firing
10 first. And they did not know that. They accused us
11 of that first.

12 DICK: Nicole, there's been a national
13 inquiry made, a Congressional inquiry made reference
14 to yesterday in the paper.

15 NICOLE: (Indiscernible.)

16 DICK: They're opening up an inquiry on
17 that. And you'll all get a chance to say exactly what
18 you saw, what you did, and what you saw the ATF do.
19 That is -- it's your right. It's your responsibility.
20 And the world will demand it.

21 NICOLE: Dick, it doesn't make one hell of a
22 difference, all right? So that's not -- still until I
23 start seeing some milk or, or some --

24 DICK: We've got the milk.

25 NICOLE: -- such element here, I, I really

1 have nothing more to say to you.

2 DICK: Nicole, we have the milk.

3 NICOLE: Well, where --

4 DICK: And I made that clear to both --

5 NICOLE: Are you going to let it go sour?
6 Are you going to let it sit out there and go sour?

7 DICK: No. We're -- I told, I told the
8 fellows in there that we're, we're prepared to, to
9 give you the milk and to send the kids out and the
10 milk will go in.

11 NICOLE: No, we're not sending the kids out.
12 We want the milk here.

13 DICK: That's exactly where it's going to
14 be.

15 NICOLE: Well, why --

16 DICK: We're going to send the milk in.

17 NICOLE: Okay. And we're not sending the
18 kids out. We, we need the milk here for the babies.

19 DICK: I hear what you're saying, Nicole.
20 But as I indicated to Steve and to David --
21 (unidentified male voice in background not
22 discernible) -- we need to make concessions to one
23 another. This is how you --

24 NICOLE: Look, these are David's babies, all
25 right? They need milk.

1 DICK: I know.

2 NICOLE: They've had none for 3, 4, 5, 6
3 days because the mothers are so stressed out with all
4 this baloney, garbage stuff you're throwing up at us.

5 DICK: Well, it's not garbage. I am sorry
6 you feel that way. Because we are ready to send the
7 milk in. And --

8 NICOLE: Well --

9 DICK: -- and I've said that repeatedly this
10 morning. Was the first thing I said to --

11 NICOLE: You keep saying, Dick. But we
12 haven't seen it.

13 DICK: What did I tell them? Did they tell
14 you what I suggested?

15 NICOLE: You want kids out.

16 DICK: Absolutely.

17 NICOLE: Well, then what, what point --

18 DICK: And the milk will come in.

19 NICOLE: -- is there in bringing milk in?

20 DICK: Pardon me? What, what does that have
21 to do with bringing milk in? My bosses have indicated
22 they're willing to do that if you're willing to send
23 some people out. We have to work with one another.
24 There has to be some give and some take. And we're
25 willing to do that.

1 NICOLE: Look.

2 DICK: And you're going to have to be
3 willing to give and take.

4 NICOLE: Dick, there's seven seals, all
5 right? And I've been in this message for 5 years, in
6 this truth.

7 DICK: Um-hum.

8 NICOLE: I have seen more than what you
9 could have ever seen. I have an experience that you
10 don't understand. God said wait. And so I'm waiting.
11 Because I am trusting in something that I have seen,
12 that I have experienced. I don't trust in you kind of
13 people.

14 DICK: Well, I think we've shown you a lot
15 of good trust and good faith and reason for you to --

16 NICOLE: No, you've shown me no trust at
17 all.

18 DICK: No, that's not --

19 NICOLE: No trust.

20 DICK: -- true. I'm sorry you feel that
21 way, Nicole. But that is --

22 NICOLE: Lamb-like and you speak like a
23 dragon. That's what I've experienced.

24 DICK: Nicole, we're interested in ensuring
25 your safety and all the other folks in there --

1 NICOLE: My --

2 DICK: -- and your kids.

3 NICOLE: You come in here and start blasting
4 the place while it's full of kids. You don't, you
5 don't come with your arrest warrant. I was down there
6 when Robert Gonzales came in here, all right?

7 DICK: Um-hum.

8 NICOLE: I was there. I noticed -- I was
9 very suspicious of his behavior.

10 DICK: Okay.

11 NICOLE: The way he was in the study.

12 DICK: Um-hum.

13 NICOLE: I was very suspicious. And then he
14 said he wasn't going to come back until Monday. He
15 shows up on Sunday morning with a newspaper with an
16 article on our members here full of baloney from the
17 press. He comes in. He sits down.

18 DICK: Is that the first time you had seen
19 that article?

20 NICOLE: No. We, we -- that was -- we'd
21 already had one the day before.

22 DICK: Okay.

23 NICOLE: Okay?

24 DICK: Okay.

25 NICOLE: And he came in here. I remember

1 standing at the window. I was about to walk off. And
2 he looked up at me. But the expression he had on his
3 face made me even more suspicious again. Okay?

4 DICK: I understand what you're saying.

5 NICOLE: Then he leaves. Ten minutes later
6 we've got the whole place in bullets. I mean --

7 DICK: Nicole, all of us -- please. I am as
8 appalled about what happened as you are. You'll have
9 to believe that. I don't want to ever see anything
10 like this happen. I was not there. I'm with another
11 agency. They're --

12 NICOLE: You have, you have agents that have
13 left your agency for this very reason. Because
14 they're trigger happy.

15 DICK: From the FBI?

16 NICOLE: The BATF.

17 DICK: Well, see, again I'm not with the
18 BATF.

19 NICOLE: It's all the same thing.

20 DICK: Well, no, it isn't.

21 NICOLE: You're all lamb-like and speak like
22 a dragon.

23 DICK: That's like saying your religious
24 group -- that's like saying your group is the same as
25 every other religious group. And that's not true, is

1 it?

2 NICOLE: You're all under the same
3 government.

4 DICK: Absolutely. We all are under the
5 same God too.

6 NICOLE: Exactly.

7 DICK: And we're all under the same God.
8 But yet you have --

9 NICOLE: No, we're not all under the same
10 God.

11 DICK: Well --

12 NICOLE: But we're judged by the same God.

13 DICK: We, we all believe in a form of a
14 God, do we not? I mean most of us. Let's face it,
15 most of us do.

16 NICOLE: You don't know our God.

17 DICK: In the same fashion the FBI and the
18 ATF are not even under the same department in the
19 government. We're not even under the same department.
20 And I will tell you that all our respective agency
21 heads are just, just devastated by the way this thing
22 was handled on Sunday. We do not condone it. We do
23 not accept it. We will not accept it. And everything
24 that we do in not only ATF --

25 NICOLE: Dick.

1 DICK: -- but the FBI will be scrutinized so
2 that --

3 NICOLE: Dick.

4 DICK: -- make sure that doesn't happen
5 again.

6 NICOLE: I have a 1-year-old little girl.

7 DICK: Okay.

8 NICOLE: Okay?

9 DICK: What's her name.

10 NICOLE: Her name is Paigis (phonetic sp.).

11 DICK: Paigis?

12 NICOLE: Okay? And she hasn't had any milk
13 for 5 days.

14 DICK: Okay.

15 NICOLE: Okay, I'm doing the best that I
16 can --

17 DICK: You as a mother then should demand
18 that we, that, that David allow us to get that milk
19 into you then. They say they're no longer interested
20 in milk, because it came up 4 days ago, and because
21 it's there you no longer have an interest. It would
22 seem --

23 NICOLE: We have an interest.

24 DICK: -- to me that interest would be even
25 greater now.

1 NICOLE: Why don't you send it in?

2 DICK: We are prepared to send it in.

3 NICOLE: Well, just send it in. I don't
4 know what the big hold up is.

5 DICK: David, David is not agreeable to
6 that.

7 NICOLE: He's not agreeable for you to send
8 the milk in.

9 DICK: Exactly.

10 NICOLE: I have nothing more to say to you,
11 Dick.

12 DICK: Well, I hope you're doing well. I
13 hope your child is doing well. And, and I hope
14 that --

15 DAVID: Dick, listen to me.

16 DICK: I'm listening.

17 DAVID: The God that you do not understand
18 in the Book of Colossians, Paul talks about there are
19 those with fleshy minds who intrude into things that
20 they do not understand. Their fleshy minds puffed up.
21 Mankind has been separated from God, the realities of
22 God and the deep knowledge of God. God in his mercy
23 has said unto men messages and truth of things which
24 to the carnal mind would un (sic) be, would not be
25 even comprehended. The deep things of God. The

1 mysteries of God.

2 DICK: Um-hum.

3 DAVID: Now you don't know what you're
4 dealing with.

5 DICK: David, I'm just trying --

6 DAVID: No, listen to --

7 DICK: -- to deal with you as best I can.

8 DAVID: -- no, no, no, no. Okay. Well, I'm
9 going to deal with you the best I can. But let me
10 tell you something. You don't understand these
11 children.

12 DICK: I know they need milk, and we're
13 ready to bring it.

14 DAVID: You don't know the reason for these
15 children. And the thing of it is you're sticking your
16 finger in a position that God's going to break your
17 finger off and shove it up your rear end. Now there
18 is not a power on earth greater than the power of God.

19 And the God that I speak of you do not understand.

20 You can go ahead, and you can listen to me
21 talk, and you can listen to me rattle. And you can
22 listen to me go line upon line, precept on precept,
23 here a little, there a little and show you all over
24 the book the comparisons of the same ideology as the
25 prophets. But what you fail to understand is the fear

1 of that God who's going to back those words. Ezekiel
2 says there will come a time when there will be the
3 effect of every vision. Now you're going to be in
4 trouble.

5 And you know something, one of the greatest
6 things that's going to be done to people like you is
7 that for 100 years all the great men, the mighty men,
8 the wicked men of the earth are going to be hurled
9 together. And that's going to be your hell. You're
10 going to live in a world where pride and arrogance
11 (sic) opinion and self is going to be predominant.
12 And you know what? There's people in the world that's
13 been bigger than you, more deceptive than you.

14 Now, I asked for you milk for the children.
15 They're neutral. And God is registering exactly
16 everything --

17 DICK: David, I understand they're neutral.
18 Send those kids out. They are neutral. Send them
19 out.

20 DAVID: Hey. I told you my God said wait.
21 Now if you want to make a move, buster, go ahead and
22 make a move.

23 DICK: We -- David I'll assure you --

24 DAVID: Now --

25 DICK: -- that there is not going to be any

1 move made.

2 DAVID: Listen to me. It doesn't make any
3 difference to me at this point. Because like I said,
4 you're going to learn the hard way. And I got a gift
5 for you. You read Psalms 137 and let me remind you it
6 shall be filled upon you and your family to the
7 letter. Do you understand? Read this Psalm and try
8 to observe some wisdom. And that's from God.

9 DICK: David, you said you cared about me
10 the other day. And then all of a sudden now you're
11 mad at me. I don't understand why.

12 DAVID: Hey. You're getting me mad. And
13 that's all right --

14 DICK: Well, I'm not trying to.

15 DAVID: -- because in Psalms 2 you don't
16 want to kiss with me, then go ahead and make me angry.
17 Remember, it's just the Bible. If it's not true, you
18 have no fears. But if it's true, you have a great
19 fear to come upon you unlike you've ever known.

20 DICK: David, I read an article to, to Steve
21 and to Nicole with that, you know, is representative
22 of some of the stuff that people are saying. Can I
23 give you a minute to go over that with you? I want to
24 show you what people out there think about the
25 government. I know you're concerned that what the

1 government did is wrong.

2 OLIVER: Hello.

3 DICK: It is wrong. Listen to me. Listen
4 to what it said here in the Fort Worth Star dated the
5 7th. An article from a fellow who suggests that the
6 February 28th raid on the compound by federal agents
7 was an attempt to suppress religion simply because its
8 members live communally. He goes on to say the
9 government has become a police state.

9 OLIVER: Hello.

10 DICK: He said the raid's violence which
11 left people dead and wounded was the fault of the
12 government. (Unidentified male voice in background
13 not discernible.) You attack a man's home, and he
14 will fight back. I think that that was a set up.
15 Those are things that people are saying publicly out
16 there. So there is that support for you, Dave. It
17 really is. There really is that support.

17 OLIVER: Hello.

18 DICK: And, and we need to get that, we need
19 to get that message out.

19 OLIVER: This is not Dave.

20 DICK: I'm sorry. Who do we have now?

21 OLIVER: This is Oliver.

22 DICK: What's your name, please?

23

1 OLIVER: My name is Oliver.

2 DICK: Oliver?

3 OLIVER: Gyarfas.

4 UNIDENTIFIED MALE SPEAKER: Oliver.

5 DICK: Spell that last name?

6 OLIVER: G-Y-A-R-F-A-S.

7 DICK: Okay. What can I do for you?

8 OLIVER: I'm Hungarian.

9 DICK: Okay.

10 OLIVER: Yeah, I have a sister here that has
a young baby.

11 DICK: All right. What is her name, and
12 what's the baby's name? (Unidentified voices in
background not discernible.)

13 OLIVER: Her name is Isha (phonetic sp.)
14 Gyarsas. She's my sister.

15 DICK: Okay. And, and she has a baby? What
16 age is the baby?

17 OLIVER: She's around 1, 1-1/2.

18 DICK: She needs some milk is what you're
saying.

19 OLIVER: Yes, she needs the milk. You know,
20 she's real hungry. She, she's dependent on it.

21 DICK: I absolutely am willing to get that
22 milk in to you. I've communicated that to Nicole,
23
24
25

1 Steve and David this morning a number of times.

2 OLIVER: She's also fixing to have another
3 one.

4 DICK: Well, what time is she going to do
5 that? I mean how far along is she?

6 OLIVER: It's quite soon. I'm not really
7 sure as to the date but, you know --

8 DICK: Okay. Well, let's get the milk in.
9 We're, we're willing -- you know. We're willing and
10 we're ready to do it.

11 OLIVER: Well, when? You know --

12 DICK: As soon as you get the children with
13 their coats on and send them out. (Unidentified male
14 voice in background not discernible.)

15 OLIVER: I don't, I don't think we can send
16 the children out, you know.

17 DICK: You know, David just told me that the
18 kids are neutral. That means that there is no reason
19 for the children to stay there. (Unidentified male
20 voice in background not discernible.) We've asked
21 that four children come out, and we will send in milk.
22 An adult will come out with them and take the milk
23 back in, and the children will be, will remain with
24 us. And we will ensure their safety and their,
25 their care and their well-being. Your sister, please,

1 have her send one of her children out.

2 OLIVER: See we, we understand that. But at
3 the moment, we want to keep the kids. And while we're
4 keeping the kids we'd, we'd like some milk for the
5 kids, you know? I mean --

6 UNIDENTIFIED MALE SPEAKER: That's what you
7 want.

8 DICK: That's exactly what I want to do.

9 OLIVER: -- I'm sure we'd send them out
10 eventually. But you know, it's -- we, we want milk
11 right now, because they need it right now.

12 DICK: I understand. And we're ready to go
13 right now. We're ready to go right now. You have to
14 tell David and others -- and you guys sit down and
15 talk about this.

16 OLIVER: Believe me, we have.

17 DICK: Don't let somebody make your decision
18 for you.

19 OLIVER: Oh, no.

20 DICK: Talk it over amongst yourselves. Get
21 together with your sister.

22 OLIVER: Hey, if I wanted to leave, buddy,
23 I'd leave right now.

24 DICK: I'm not suggesting you'd leave at
25 all. Not at all.

1 know, I don't know how I can, I can tell you any --
2 you know, we're ready. We're ready to go. It's here.
3 It's a demonstration of what we're willing to do for
4 you. But yet on the other hand, you're unwilling to
5 do anything for us.

6 OLIVER: We sent you a lot of kids, buddy.
7 We, we did send you, send you a lot of kids.

8 DICK: There are a number of kids that came
9 out. And is that something that we're supposed to be
10 happy about? It's these children --

11 OLIVER: Well, sure --

12 DICK: -- that we're interested in caring
13 for. I mean you, you think that's something, you
14 know, is that for me? Or I mean what it is it's for
15 the welfare of those children and the families.

16 OLIVER: Oh, yes.

17 DICK: You said -- David said that all of
18 you would come out if we allowed you to do certain
19 things which we allowed. We -- you, you put the tape
20 together. We didn't edit it. It got on national
21 television in its entirety. No editing. David
22 assured us that as soon as that was done all of you
23 were coming out. So we took David at his word.

24 OLIVER: Okay. There's someone else who
25 wants to talk to you, another mother. Okay?

1 DICK: Put, put her on.
2 [gap]
3 KATHY: Hello?
4 DICK: Good morning.
5 KATHY: Good morning.
6 DICK: Who is this?
7 KATHY: This is Kathy.
8 DICK: Kathy, how are you this morning?
9 KATHY: Just fine (indiscernible).
10 DICK: I hope you're doing better.
11 KATHY: I'm sorry?
12 DICK: I hope you're doing well.
13 KATHY: Well, I'm trying. It's hard with
14 the babies when they're hungry and crying for the milk
15 we've asked for.
16 DICK: Kathy, I'm a father of two children.
17 KATHY: Then you should understand.
18 DICK: I completely understand.
19 KATHY: Doesn't seem like it.
20 DICK: I understand your concern. And I
21 will agree. I want to get the milk in. I've told
22 David that. I've told Steven that. I've told that to
23 Nicole. I'll tell it to you. And, and the fellow I
24 just spoke with. I've told you all the same thing.
25 We have the milk. We'll, we'll get the milk in to

1 you. But --

2 KATHY: Oh, you have the milk. Good, good.

3 DICK: The milk we --

4 KATHY: Will we be expecting it today, then?

5 DICK: You will expect it as soon as you
6 send the kids out to us.

7 KATHY: As soon -- we don't need the milk to
8 send the kids out to you.

9 DICK: Pardon me?

10 KATHY: Not only that, but I don't really
11 want to send my child out to you. Know why? Because
12 you did not keep your promise. Those children were to
13 be sent to their homes with people they know, they're
14 familiar with. You go off, you keep them at some
15 house. I don't know where they are.

16 DICK: Kathy, they're all together.

17 KATHY: Cut off their hair. Oh, my God.

18 DICK: Kathy, that's completely in error.
19 One child asked to have his or her hair cut.

20 KATHY: One child asked to have his hair
21 cut? Which one?

22 DICK: I don't know which child it was. I
23 don't have the name. However, those children are
24 being well cared for. And there was some concern, and
25 I'm sure you had some concern, too, about how the kids

1 were going to be cared for. So rather than have
2 somebody accept my word, we got a videotape --

3 KATHY: Dick, Dick, Dick, Dick. Why did
4 Nahara have his hair cut?

5 DICK: Pardon me?

6 KATHY: Why did Nahara have his hair cut?

7 DICK: I have no idea. But you know what, I
8 will find that out for you. That's --

9 KATHY: Thank you. I would appreciate that.

10 DICK: We will do that. And please tell
11 Sita that we will find that out.

12 KATHY: Okay.

13 DICK: We'll be happy to. But Sita was
14 worried about her child having pork. And I've assured
15 her that that child is not having pork. You know --

16 KATHY: Good --

17 DICK: -- I know you folks are concerned
18 about the care of those kids. The only person that
19 will do a better job is the mother or the father. And
20 you have that option, but you're not going to exercise
21 that option. So --

22 KATHY: We, we really have no choice in that
23 matter --

24 DICK: Are you going to hold me --

25 KATHY: -- as far as your treatment, as far

1 as what you've done.

2 DICK: We are treating those children very,
3 very well.

4 KATHY: When you find out why Nahara got his
5 hair cut, please make sure you call us back and tell
6 us. We're very concerned.

7 DICK: I'm going to run that down certainly.
8 I'll --

9 KATHY: Good.

10 DICK: -- I'll find out. Kathy, I will have
11 the milk there for you. Please, talk among yourself
12 and, and let's work together on this. And, and you
13 folks get together. And the overriding concern in
14 this whole, this whole thing is for the care of those
15 children immediately.

16 KATHY: Okay, well, when you find out all
17 these things and when you get the milk sent out,
18 please call back, okay? Goodbye.

19 * * * * *

20 SCOTT: Hello?

21 DICK: Hello, this is Dick. Who's this?

22 SCOTT: Scott.

23 DICK: Scott, listen. I just wanted to let
24 you folks know, and I'm sure you have not forgotten.
25 But the daily press briefing that I know you have a

1 lot of interest in --

2 SCOTT: Um-hum.

3 DICK: -- is going to be on in short
4 moments. And we'll get back to you after the
5 conclusion of that.

6 SCOTT: Okay.

7 DICK: All right. Very well.

8 SCOTT: Okay, bye.

9 DICK: Bye now.

11 DICK: We didn't do something right. We got
12 no ringing.

13 * * * * *

14 STEVE: Hello?

15 DICK: Hello?

16 STEVE: Hello?

17 DICK: Hello, Steve?

18 STEVE: Yes. Dick?

19 DICK: Can you hear me?

20 STEVE: Yes, I can hear you.

21 DICK: Okay, well, I can't hear you well.

22 STEVE: You can't?

23 DICK: How about now?

24 STEVE: Yeah, I -- you're fine. I can hear
25 you very plainly.

1 talking about, Dick? Make yourself plain. There's a
2 guy in the tower. What does that mean?

3 DICK: With camouflage paint as though he's
4 looking the area over and making some sort of a move
5 on something. Is that what you want to do?

6 STEVE: I don't -- now this is the first
7 I've even heard of it. I don't even know what you're
8 talking about. I'd have to go investigate.

9 DICK: Well, then you better find out what
10 we're talking about. You're the person in charge in
11 there, you and David. You better take care of these

20 UNIDENTIFIED MALE SPEAKER: Hood.

21 STEVE: I have no idea.

22 DICK: It's a hood. It's a hood.

23 STEVE: It's a what?

24 DICK: It's a hood that goes over the face.

25

1 STEVE: We don't even have such a thing. I
2 don't know where on earth you have that. There's a
3 woman up there -- we got some jackets a long time ago.
4 Some guy sold us some things. They were cheap like a
5 dollar or so for the clothes. So the -- and they're
6 100 percent cotton. There's a woman up there that had
7 a jacket on that is looking out the window.

8 DICK: Let me tell you something, Steve.
9 I'm sitting here trying to work with you getting no
10 cooperation from you --

11 STEVE: Are you, are you hearing me though?

12 DICK: And then --

13 STEVE: That's -- I'm telling you what it
14 is. I checked it out. That's exactly what it was.

15 DICK: Well, I'm glad you did. But let's
16 caution those people in there about those kinds of
17 things. We've got people out there that get concerned
18 when they see that kind of thing.

19 STEVE: See someone looking out the window?

20 DICK: No.

21 STEVE: No, no. You listen to me. We --

22 DICK: Making those kind --

23 STEVE: -- get concerned when you're on our
24 damn property and you have never come around and said
25 what you would do from the beginning. I am tired of

1 even dealing with you, Dick. I really am tired of it
2 day after day after day going on this merry-go-round
3 with you. Over and over again the same thing. Remove
4 your crap off our property, and we might get serious
5 with you like you originally said.

6 You call me threatening me because we have a
7 human being in our building looking out the window
8 with a bala what is it, whatever it is? You speak
9 your stupid, crazy language. I don't even know what
10 you're talking about. Don't accuse me and threaten me
11 of anything. If you want to take me out and take
12 these people out, do so. You don't believe in God.
13 You don't believe in the Bible. Try it and find out.

14 I'm anxious to see myself.

15 UNIDENTIFIED MALE SPEAKER: See if they
16 believe in God.

17 STEVE: See if you believe in a God. I
18 know, I really know you don't.

19 DICK: You think you're the only one that
20 talks to God out there?

21 STEVE: I have never said that, Dick. But I
22 mean these, the way your manner has been round and
23 around, we've only -- we've been so clear about things
24 from the beginning with you --

25 DICK: If anything that you have been clear

1 about --

2 STEVE: -- you guys, you have not
3 complied -- no, no, no. You have not complied from
4 day one with having your vehicles on our private
5 property which you agreed to. You agreed to that,
6 Dick, you and your people there. And still they
7 wander around, and you've got the audacity to call me
8 up because a human being is looking out a window when
9 you've got guys in our automobiles, moving our
10 motorcycles, doing things that you never called me

24 background not discernible) --

25 DICK: Listen --

1 STEVE: Listen. And you're evading your
2 statements. You asked me to look at that press
3 conference. I did. It made me sick also.

4 DICK: Listen, when you fired on federal
5 officers, you lost some of your private property
6 rights.

7 STEVE: No, when they fired on human beings
8 that are to be protected by this very government which
9 is for the people, by the people. They should be
10 stuck in jail right now. That investigation should --
11 just a minute. Here's David.

12 STEVE TO DAVID: He says we lost our rights
13 when we fired on them.

14 DAVID: Now, Dick, let me say something.

25 with the living God. And this nation is going to

1 learn of a living God. As little David of old went
2 before Goliath, I stand before you. You and this
3 nation's going to learn there's a God in heaven. He
4 has a truth, and just because you wish to evade it,
5 just because you do not know the fear of the Lord does
6 not mean you're going to be without responsibility.
7 You are going to pay.

8 Now keep your press conferences going. Keep
9 communications going. But remember, I'm telling you
10 there's a lot more of us than you know. A lot more
11 than you realize.

12 DICK: What is that supposed to imply?

13 DAVID: That implies you go ahead and you do
14 with us what you feel. You go ahead and tell the
15 press what you want.

16 DICK: We're trying to --

17 DAVID: Because that's what you're doing.

18 DICK: -- communicate to you in part --

19 DAVID: And I am trying to communicate with
20 you. Everything I've said you've got recorded. Now
21 you -- I suggest to you you review in the fear of God
22 very prayerfully what I've shown you all over that
23 scripture, all over that Bible.

24 DICK: Listen, David, we're going to work
25 together to resolve this issue. We are --

1 DAVID: Oh, you, you --

2 DICK: -- going to do that.

3 DAVID: -- we, we referring to you and who
4 else there?

5 DICK: No. That we meaning we here and you
6 in there are going to work together to resolve this
7 issue. And the sooner that we agree on that, the
8 sooner we're going to get it resolved appropriately
9 with --

10 DAVID: Do not call us up and tell us that
11 someone is looking out the window. We have the right
12 to look out. This is God's world. His sun is shining
13 outside. We can look out if we want to.

14 DICK: I did not tell you to look out the
15 window. I said take care in the manner in which you
16 do that so nothing --

17 DAVID: Right. You fire on us --

18 DICK: So that nothing happens.

19 DAVID: -- you fire on us and it starts.

20 DICK: There is no firing going to be done.

21 DAVID: Okay. So you don't have to warn us
22 about looking out the window then.

23 DICK: I am telling you that the safety
24 rules need to be followed. We talked --

25 DAVID: Okay. So follow them.

1 DICK: -- about that. You understand them.
2 We understand them.

3 DAVID: Follow them.

4 DICK: And as long as we both understand
5 them, there will be no problem.

6 DAVID: Follow them then, Dick. Okay?

7 DICK: Do we agree? They're -- the safety
8 rules --

9 DAVID: We agree.

10 DICK: -- are going to be followed. Is that
11 correct?

12 DAVID: Mine and yours.

13 DICK: Absolutely. There will be no
14 problems. But we'll work together with one another to
15 ensure that does not happen.

16 DAVID: Are you worried about dying, Dick?

17 DICK: Am I worried about dying?

18 DAVID: Yes.

19 DICK: Not today or tomorrow, now.

20 DAVID: Okay. That's good. We share the
21 same.

22 DICK: Well, then let's get this worked out
23 between us and ensure that there is no further injury
24 to anybody on either side. And to do that --

25 DAVID: Well, then why are you calling us up

1 now? What's the nature of this call?

2 DICK: The nature of the call is to --
