DICK: -- at 10:30.

STEVE: Okay.

DICK: And I want you to make sure -- you and Dave watch that to make sure that -- and if you've got points that you dispute, please give them to me and, again, we'll pass them on.

STEVE: Okay.

DICK: And I'll try to clarify them.

STEVE: You know, it has been asked by the press about, you know, communication to us.

DICK: Uh-huh.

STEVE: I would like at least let it be known that it's not our choice that we're cut off or that we don't at least have one line to at least one news agency, where they can at least monitor us, see if we're okay, or whatever else.

DICK: You know what, when we were -- when we were apart from one another, I, I had a thought here. One of your big concerns is that you don't believe that anybody will listen or that you will have

1 the opportunity to present your case. I know you're
2 concerned about that. So, what I've asked is to make
3 that known to the press --

4 STEVE: All right.

5 DICK: -- that you're concerned that you
6 won't get the opportunity --

7 STEVE: I appreciate that.

8 DICK: -- and, and that --

9 STEVE: I'm sure that helps.

10 DICK: Sure. That will put that right to
11 them that, hey, you said that you're concerned, and I
12 want to go to them and tell them of your concern,
13 directly to them, so that they will know and you will
14 know that we're not trying to cover up or hide any of
15 the -- any of these comments that you eventually would
16 like to make. So, how's that? I mean that, that --
17 that's (Indiscernible) isn't it?

18 STEVE: It's, it's a small, small, small
19 part --

20 DICK: But it's, it's a step.

21 STEVE: -- of it in the right direction.

22 DICK: Sure, it's a step and you guys -- it
23 will show you that, in fact, we're not opposed to that
24 at all. In fact, we demand that you do that. I mean
25 we, as citizens, secondarily, I mean --

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STEVE: (Indiscernible)

DICK: -- we demand that you do that.

STEVE: That's good to hear.

DICK: Because I don't want that to happen again.

STEVE: Okay. I'll, I'll call you as the soon as the -- I'm going to start preparing that we can watch this on T.V.

DICK: Okay.

STEVE: That gives us about 10 minutes to get the thing going here.

DICK: All right. And then you guys -- you working on some of the folks that you, you --

STEVE: Yes.

DICK: Okay.

STEVE: Most definitely.

DICK: And then tell David, if you would, that I've done this for him and I'd like to get an opportunity to talk to him when I get back, too.

STEVE: All right.

DICK: So, between us, between all three of us, perhaps we can, we can get some of these issues past, you know, past center line here.

STEVE: Okay.

DICK: And, and we'll work, we'll work

1 together on it and we'll get it done.

2 STEVE: Okay.

3 DICK: All right. We'll be back -- we'll be
4 back in touch after, after the press conference then.

5 STEVE: Okay. Thank you.

6 DICK: All right.

7 STEVE: Bye.

8 DICK: Bye-bye.

9 RACHEL: Hello.

10 DICK: Hello. Dick. Who's this?

11 RACHEL: Rachel.

12 DICK: Rachel, how are you today?

13 RACHEL: Fine. Just a minute, I'll get
14 Steve.

15 DICK: How about David?

16 (No response)

17 (Pause)

18 STEVE: Hello.

19 DICK: Steve?

20 STEVE: Hello, Dick.

21 DICK: Yes.

22 STEVE: Okay.

23 DICK: I thought you were going to try to
24 get Dave up here so we could go over some of these
25 issues you guys were concerned about.

1 hospital, quite obviously the guy would be in and out
2 all the time, which he is all the more so here because
3 he doesn't have quite the --

4 DICK: Sure.

5 STEVE: -- attention as in the hospital.

6 DICK: Sure, sure.

7 STEVE: But, no, I will do. I'm serious. I
8 mean --

9 DICK: Can you get that phone maybe over to
10 him rather than trying to get him up?

11 STEVE: Well, that's what I'm saying. In
12 fact, I've got -- right now I have pulled the phone
13 over by him. He's out totally right now. I'm looking
14 right at him. And I mean if he's awake or if I can
15 get him awake --

16 DICK: Well, we'll give it a couple of
17 minutes and why don't you go ahead and shake him up.
18 But did you see that -- did you see the press
19 conference?

20 STEVE: Yes, I did.

21 DICK: What --

22 STEVE: He, he didn't, though, because he
23 was even out -- in fact, I told them to wake him up so
24 he could see it. Apparently, he wouldn't wake up.

25 DICK: Well, I wish he had seen it. I think

1 he'd have been -- I think he'd have been happy with --
2 I don't think they're trying to --

3 STEVE: I don't think he would be.

4 DICK: Really?

5 STEVE: No, I really don't because there was
6 a number of things that were brought out. I listened
7 very carefully myself.

8 DICK: Okay. With what, what -- do you have
9 some --

10 STEVE: Well, number one, you know, it was
11 implied by I believe his name is Bob Ricks?

12 DICK: Right.

13 STEVE: It was implied that, that you people
14 are under the impression that these people are not
15 free to go and well, you can make that assumption.
16 I've told you over and over again --

17 DICK: No, those were questions asked of us.

18 STEVE: Right, but I'm talking about the
19 response to those questions.

20 DICK: Uh-huh.

21 STEVE: And it was not made clear -- these
22 people are -- they can leave anytime they want, from
23 day one. They still can. But like I told you, they
24 choose to see -- they believe in his God. That's the
25 point (Indiscernible).

1 DICK: No, I know. I passed that on that --

2 STEVE: All right.

3 DICK: -- that you've all said that but -

4 STEVE: Okay.

5 DICK: -- I guess we continue to get calls
6 from like some of these people -- remember John talked
7 with you last night about, these people are making
8 inquiry about --

9 STEVE: That, that's fine, whatever --

10 DICK: People (Indiscernible)?

11 STEVE: Yeah, that's fine.

12 DICK: Okay. What was the other issue that
13 you were concerned --

14 STEVE: Okay. Let me look down here and
15 see. Okay. Now, the latest thing was that the man, I
16 think his name was Dan Hartnet --

17 DICK: Right --

18 STEVE: -- said that --

19 DICK: -- the ATF representative.

20 STEVE: -- they did have a felony charge, a
21 felony charge warrant for D.K. Okay, that's -- and
22 then it went on -- they asked about -- I can hardly
23 see or I have very little light here. Just a moment.

24 Let me -- do you have a flashlight there? I'm
25 sitting in a spot here. It's kind of dark. See, I

1 don't want to turn the lights on here because he's
2 sleeping. So, I'll just --

3 DICK: True. Do you know what we -- while
4 you're going through your notes there, I just want to
5 make -- bring you up a comment here. You know, we
6 talked about a list of, of people that you guys might
7 be interested in having to talk with but aren't you
8 and David going to have to get together to -- on that?

9 STEVE: No. He's already said that anybody
10 that wants can come to the phone and talk. I just now
11 even went to a lot of people, just right now, --

12 DICK: Uh-huh.

13 STEVE: -- and said to them, there's a man
14 on the phone and his name is Dick. He's an F.B.I.
15 agent. he's a negotiator. He's a very decent guy.
16 If you'd like to talk to him about anything, about
17 leaving, about your children, about relatives, about
18 speaking with someone on the outside, about any of
19 your needs or wants --

20 DICK: Uh-huh.

21 STEVE: I talked to at least 20 people in
22 one place at one time. Then I walked down and talked
23 to a few more here and there. And they all said to
24 me, you talk, you know what we want. And I says,
25 well, what do you want? That's what I asked them,

1 | what do you want? And they says, well, make it known
2 | that before a lot of us were afraid to make a step
3 | forward. They can say what they want but we don't
4 | have that line to the outside world. We want somebody
5 | without -- the press to be nearby, to see, to be able
6 | to video, to be in part of this negotiation process.

6 | DICK: Okay.

7 | STEVE: That's what, that's what they told
8 | me.

9 | DICK: Remember --

10 | STEVE: And then they said to me, well, you
11 | speak for us. And I says, --

11 | DICK: Okay.

12 | STEVE: -- I will.

13 | DICK: All right.

14 | STEVE: I will.

15 | DICK: All right. Well, you know, we'll go
16 | with that but I guess I was making reference to more
17 | is, is, is the, the people that you had suggested you
18 | might want to later to talk with, that you were going
19 | to give me names of those people, remember? I, I'm
20 | not talking about the people inside to talk with me
21 | but those people that you might want --

21 | STEVE: Right.

22 | DICK: -- to give us --

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1 STEVE: Right.

2 DICK: -- as a possible --

3 STEVE: I, I did ask them. This is what
4 their -- I'll give you some of those names, if you'd
5 like. This is what they mentioned to me. They
6 mentioned Larry King, Paul Harvey. I never heard of
7 this man, a David Gold, a Rush Limbo I think the name
8 was.

8 DICK: Rush Limbaugh?

9 STEVE: Limbaugh, is that it?

10 DICK: Yeah. I think there's a fellow by
11 the name of that.

12 STEVE: Apparently, he's in a lot of
13 controversial issues or something, I don't know. Paul
14 Harvey, many people are --

14 DICK: Yeah, I know Paul Harvey.

15 STEVE: Exactly. Oprah Winfrey, I guess.

16 DICK: Well, I'm sure -- I'll guarantee you
17 that when this thing -- when you come out, there will
18 be a lot of invitations to go on Oprah Winfrey's show.

19 STEVE: Well, you and I -- you and I are --
20 well, I'm not -- we're not interested in that kind of
21 thing.

22 DICK: No, I know, but to get the word out
23 I'm saying.

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1 STEVE: Yeah, right. Well, okay, but right
2 now what the thing is, these people are afraid to make
3 the move without him --

4 DICK: Okay. Sure.

5 STEVE: -- and an involvement there.

6 DICK: And, remember, I told you moments ago
7 when I spoke to you then --

8 STEVE: Right, you, you did.

9 DICK: -- your concern about not being able
10 to get to the press. And we're going to -- we're
11 going to make sure the press is aware of that so that
12 if you're concerned --

13 STEVE: I was hoping that that would have
14 happened during that conference even.

15 DICK: Well, you know that came up. This --
16 obviously, they're gone from here --

17 STEVE: I see okay.

18 DICK: -- when they get this conference
19 together.

20 STEVE: All right.

21 DICK: So, that, that should come up on the
22 next one.

23 STEVE: Is there going to be another one
24 today?

25 DICK: No, not today.

1 STEVE: All right.

2 DICK: But that will be -- we've asked that
3 that be included in the next one because I --

4 STEVE: I see.

5 DICK: -- I -- that's a good point. And I
6 know you're concerned about that and I will -- I'm in
7 total agreement, as is everyone else here, that your,
8 your story needs to get out. I know you're concerned
9 that you don't think we will allow it, too. So, this
maybe will, will give you that sign that it will get -

10 STEVE: Right.

11 DICK: You will get that opportunity. So,
12 that's good. We'll work with that.

13 STEVE: You know, of course, you know, when
14 I listen to a conference like that, you observe, you
15 know, all these different things that are taking place
16 and what's being said. It really bothers me that it's
17 us that are being spoken of of having felony charges
and all the rest. What --

18 DICK: Uh-huh.

19 STEVE: The insanity of the whole thing. I
20 mean when you really sit down and look at it from
beginning to end, the insanity of it all --

21 DICK: Right. Did you hear Mr. Hartnet say
22 that the ATF --

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1 STEVE: Yeah, I mean but --

2 DICK: -- has to be responsible for what
3 they did?

4 STEVE: Well, yes, I did, but many times in
5 the past these different bureaucracies have slapped
6 the hands of individuals. You never hear of them
7 going up on charges of murder and so forth. I mean
8 the total disregard of human life here was -- it was
9 awesome. I mean I've talked to a lot of people. I
10 got to see the firsthand witnesses, the approach of
11 the vehicles. You weren't there, I don't believe,
12 were you?

13 DICK: Absolutely not.

14 STEVE: Okay. But they were. They saw what
15 was happening and --

16 DICK: No --

17 STEVE: -- when they fell to the floor,
18 there were bullets that went -- I'm talking about
19 missing them by an -- you will be able to come into
20 this premises ultimately and look it over yourself,
21 where the different people resided, in what rooms and
22 so forth. You're going to be -- it's a miracle that
23 there aren't at least 20 more people dead here. I'm
24 telling you the truth.

25 DICK: I know you are.

1 STEVE: So, when it --

2 DICK: I know you are, Steve.

3 STEVE: -- comes down to federal charges
4 being filed, felony charges against people here, I
5 mean what are we talk -- we're talking about defense.
6 There was an offense that was committed and there was
7 a defense here taking place.

8 DICK: I know that's your position and
9 that's what you need to make known to people.

10 STEVE: None of these people -- you know
11 that 99% of these people have never even held a gun
12 before that day or touched one or seen one, hardly
13 seen one?

14 DICK: I have no doubts that that's true.

15 STEVE: So, I mean it's just -- it bothers
16 me to hear that, you know, there's going to be felony
17 charges on one side, plural. But on the other hand,
18 I'd like to hear the same kind of language employed on
19 the other, also.

20 DICK: Well, if that's what this, what this
21 inquiry determines, then there will be but they have
22 to be -- the evidence has to be looked at first,
23 Steve.

24 STEVE: But, obviously, Dick, you and I know
25 that through the years -- it's -- when has that ever

1 taken place with federal agents, especially federal
2 agents, someone at that level, let alone like police
3 officers and so forth? It's a rare, rare, rarity. I
4 can't even think of an instance where it's happened.

5 DICK: Well, how about the Rodney King
6 incident, for instance?

7 STEVE: Well, I don't know, it's ongoing and
8 I --

9 DICK: Well, it is, but it has to be
10 resolved.

11 STEVE: Yes, but I haven't been -- I haven't
12 been --

13 DICK: They've been charged, haven't they?

14 STEVE: -- (Indiscernible) with that.

15 DICK: I know, but they've been charged.

16 STEVE: I guess. I haven't been following
17 it so I don't know what's -- you can fill me in and
18 let me know what's happening.

19 DICK: Well, they have been charged. And,
20 and you know that because there was an earlier trial.
21 So, they -- you know they were charged.

22 STEVE: Well, you know, the greatest thing
23 that would help get this process going and people come
24 out -- these women, especially, that I was talking to
25 just before you called me back to the phone here --

1 DICK: Uh-huh.

2 STEVE: I was saying, well, what do you
3 want? They says, Dick will talk to you. You let him
4 -- if you want to go, tell him that. I mean Dave was
5 not even around when you're talking to these people.

6 DICK: Sure.

7 STEVE: He don't, he don't care who talks to
8 or says -- he's laying down sleeping right now.

9 DICK: Okay.

10 STEVE: It's quiet around him. It's -- he's
11 in a dark spot here. He's trying to get some rest.
12 And he, he, he told me, while I was talking to you, he
13 interrupted my speech with you earlier --

14 DICK: Uh-huh.

15 STEVE: -- and said to me, let anybody talk
16 to him. Let the women talk to him. He went like that
17 to me. So, I mean -- and they --

18 DICK: Well, --

19 STEVE: -- and then when I said, I said,
20 look, he's going to be calling me back. Instead of me
21 getting on the phone with Dick, why don't some of you
22 take your turns. You can talk to him. He wants -- he
23 does want -- I told them --

24 DICK: Did you tell them about the personal
25 messages I had for some of them?

1 -- okay, here it goes. Barbara Reed.

2 DICK: Right.

3 STEVE: Here it quits again. Let me try a
4 different pen. Could someone get -- well, here, I've
5 got another pad. Just one minute. See if I can't
6 find something else to write with.

7 DICK: You know, while you're listening and
8 trying to find a pen there --

9 STEVE: Yeah.

10 DICK: -- a case came to mind. There was a
11 federal jury down the Southern District of Florida
12 that --

13 STEVE: Uh-huh.

14 DICK: -- that dismissed cases against a
15 fellow down there who's a pilot for a family down
16 there. And they, they just -- they ruled that the ATF
17 had entrapped the man and the jury acquitted him on,
18 on three charges in, in just a couple of days.

19 STEVE: Is that right?

20 DICK: Oh, yeah. It's called the Scott
21 case.

22 STEVE: Okay.

23 DICK: The ATF entrapped him and, and
24 remember the Delorean trial years ago, remember that,
25 John Delorean?

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STEVE: Yeah.

DICK: Involved in a big drug thing.

STEVE: Yes, I do.

DICK: And he got, he got an acquittal by a jury of his peers.

STEVE: Okay.

DICK: And that's the way the system works. You go into court --

STEVE: I know it does happen.

DICK: Sure, it does.

STEVE: That man was very powerful with a lot of connections at the same time.

DICK: Well, here's a fellow -- one of the guys told me about a case that he was involved in -- a guy up in Coleville, Washington, which is a very, very small town, was another ATF case. And, apparently, there was some, some SWAT team, ATF SWAT team used. And, and the charges were dismissed.

STEVE: Well, I'm sure --

DICK: So, I mean it happens. It happens.

STEVE: -- it happens.

DICK: You know, it, it does happen because sometimes people are a little over zealous in doing their job. I mean -- in some of these other cases --

STEVE: I know -- I would believe that you

1 would be a person that would try to be quite informed
2 day by day on a day by -- especially because of the,
3 the job that you have. Have you ever viewed that
4 video on BAPF, Breaking the Law or Above the Law or
5 something like that. I can't remember exactly the
6 wording but someone once said to me they had --
7 someone had passed the tape to them and they says, I
8 want you to see this. And I said, I told him I didn't
9 really have the time, it didn't concern me because I
10 was not into guns and all the rest. But he says,
11 Steve, it's the principle. So, I sat down to watch
12 and I was astounded to see what was taking place, you
13 know, and especially even against police officers by
14 the ATF. And that's not to say that all these guys
15 are aware of what's taking place but there's
16 definitely -- they're taking privileges that are not
17 or to me that are very unlawful, that are
18 unconstitutional, that should not be.

17 DICK: Steve, it, it sounds a little trite
18 but I'm going to tell you, none of us are perfect. We
19 in the F.B.I., the ATF, the police departments, we're
20 not perfect and we certainly do make errors and have
21 made and unfortunately will probably continue to make
22 errors. But we don't -- we want to make sure -- all
23 of us that are involved in this particular incident
24
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1 want to make sure that nothing like this happens
2 again.

3 STEVE: Right.

4 DICK: And, and, certainly, I'm, I'm going
5 to concede that we make errors. I guess if we were
6 perfect, we wouldn't be doing what we're doing, will
7 we? I mean, you know --

8 STEVE: Dick, what were some of those names
9 then? I'll get you back to that then. I've got a pen
10 here.

11 DICK: Okay. You got the pen ready to go
12 again?

13 STEVE: Yeah.

14 DICK: Okay. And let me just give you one -

15 STEVE: Barbara --

16 DICK: -- one more point that I want --

17 STEVE: Okay.

18 DICK: -- to make before we --

19 STEVE: All right.

20 DICK: -- go to that list. You were
21 concerned earlier in the conversation that the film
22 taken during this Sunday incident would be altered to
23 some degree. We also are going to make sure that
24 people know you're concerned about that. And so that,
25 you know, it's known that, that continues to concern

1 you.

2 STEVE: Can I ask you, what do you know
3 about that film 'cause, obviously, we have not seen
4 it? Was that done by a number of news crews from that
5 distance that they were allowed to be at or were they
6 inside an area where the ATF would have not chosen to
7 have them?

8 DICK: My belief and, again, I would have to
9 confirm this --

10 STEVE: Yeah.

11 DICK: -- but it's my understanding that a
12 news crew -- there was one news crew that, that did
13 not go with ATF but followed ATF based on this --
14 perhaps on this article that appeared in the paper.
15 They may have been --

16 STEVE: Right.

17 DICK: -- may have been watching ATF offices
18 or something in preparation for what they felt might
19 have been some attempt to serve a warrant and, and --

20 STEVE: Okay.

21 DICK: -- did, in fact, film it. And that -
22 - we have taken that film. They've been kind enough
23 to give us a copy of that film. While they keep the
24 film, mind you, we didn't confiscate it, they gave us,
25 meaning law enforcement, a copy of it. And it was

1 shown nationwide. I didn't see the whole thing 'cause
2 I only caught excerpts of --

3 STEVE: Well, could we see it?

4 DICK: Sure, you'll be able to see it,
5 absolutely.

6 STEVE: No, no, no, I'm talking about what,
7 what's the problem -- you tell me what the problem
8 would be with now to view it.

9 DICK: To do now?

10 STEVE: Yes.

11 DICK: To --

12 STEVE: So we can see just exactly what's
13 going on from outside inside. Maybe that would be one
14 of the things that help some of these people here make
15 a decision about walking out.

16 DICK: That's, hey, you know, that's a
17 thought.

18 STEVE: 'Cause I'm telling you, they do have
19 fears.

20 DICK: That's a thought.

21 STEVE: You, you, guy got to keep on
22 reminding you it's not so easy to tell this group,
23 well, hey, it's okay because they do not think so
24 because they're -- ever since we were cut off from the
25 press, that's when the greatest fears start taking

1 place with these people. Every time I go around
2 saying that there's a man, Dick, on the telephone,
3 he's willing to talk with you, they're telling me that
4 they don't trust you because of not having nearby or
5 someone either recording or someone that's unbiased
6 like say news media or they want to get -- that -- it
7 would make all the difference. So, there are those
8 people that -- this is what they're telling me anyway.

8 DICK: Okay. Well, --

9 STEVE: So, keep it in mind with whatever
10 kinds of --

11 DICK: I will.

12 STEVE: -- thing you've got in mind --

13 DICK: I will.

14 STEVE: -- for negotiation.

15 DICK: Okay.

16 STEVE: Uh --

17 DICK: Well, let's go. You got your pencil
18 there, your pen?

19 STEVE: Yeah, I do, I do.

20 DICK: Okay. There's a Leane Josephson and
21 a William Josephson.

22 STEVE: Joseph -- let's see, my pen quit
23 again. Josephson. Okay. And a which?

24 DICK: A William or a Bill Josephson.
25

1 STEVE: Okay.

2 DICK: A Jeff Little.

3 STEVE: Okay.

4 DICK: Margarita or it's spelled M-A-R-G-A-R

5 --

6 STEVE: Oh, yeah, we went -- last night I
7 think it was, was that John and I that --

8 DICK: Yeah, yeah.

9 STEVE: Jeff Little is someone that is here?

10 DICK: Right.

11 STEVE: And his family, again, his father
12 called or something or is there with --

13 DICK: Yeah, exactly. Lonnie Little --

14 STEVE: Lonnie Little, okay, I'll write that
15 down.

16 DICK: -- called.

17 STEVE: Lonnie Little. Okay.

18 DICK: Well, you think -- you don't -- you
19 want to take this list down or do you want to talk
20 directly to them? Well, what do you want to do?

21 STEVE: Well, I'll, I'll ask them. I --

22 DICK: Okay. All right.

23 STEVE: -- I'll say to them, do you want to
24 talk to these people, what do you want to do?

25 DICK: Okay.

1 STEVE: I'll go around. So, --

2 DICK: The next one is a Catherine --

3 STEVE: But you mentioned a Barbara Rush or
4 something?

5 DICK: No Barbara Rush. Barbara Reed, R-E-
6 E-D. Barbara Reed was one of the names I gave.

7 STEVE: Oh, Barbara Reed. Who is she with
8 or asking for?

9 DICK: Apparently, she's one of the folks
10 that's thought to be inside there with you.

11 STEVE: A Barbara Reed?

12 DICK: That's what -- that's what we --

13 STEVE: We've never heard of the person.

14 DICK: Okay. Well, you get inquiry from
15 these folks. Maybe that's the child of the Josephsons
16 or some such thing. I--

17 STEVE: Who are Josephsons? Who are they
18 connected to or who are they --

19 DICK: A Lynn Josephson --

20 STEVE: Okay.

21 DICK: -- has made inquiry about, about
22 three people, Reed and Leane and William Josephson.

23 STEVE: We know none of those three. And
24 the --

25 DICK: Okay.

1 STEVE: -- person inquiring was, again, who?

2 DICK: Lynn Josephson.

3 STEVE: Lynn, yeah -- no one to do with us.
4 Must be some other thing totally.

5 DICK: Okay. Now, you mentioned to me
6 before you really hadn't had contact with everybody.
7 Are you, are you quite sure that this is accurate?

8 STEVE: Oh, yeah, no question about it.

9 DICK: All right.

10 STEVE: I'll go to make sure, of course.
11 I'll ask a lot of people --

12 DICK: Okay.

13 STEVE: -- anybody here ever hear of a Lynn
14 Josephson or a Barbara Reed, a Leane Josephson, a Bill
15 Josephson? Yeah, no one -- they're all shaking their
16 head. They've never heard of such persons.

17 DICK: Okay.

18 STEVE: Okay. And then the next person you
19 mentioned was Lonnie Little in relation to Jeff
20 Little?

21 DICK: Jeff Little is supposed to be inside
22 with you, yeah.

23 STEVE: Right.

24 DICK: And you said he's okay, is that
25 correct?

1 STEVE: Yes, that's -- this is correct.
2 DICK: Okay.
3 STEVE: Who else?
4 DICK: And Margarita Vega. She's all right
5 I understand.
6 STEVE: Right. I had mentioned that also
7 last night.
8 DICK: Okay. Sherry Jewel.
9 STEVE: Okay. And she is also.
10 DICK: She's okay?
11 STEVE: Yeah.
12 DICK: Okay. A --
13 STEVE: Who was asking for Margarita? I
14 believe it was her daughter, Gessiler or something.
15 DICK: Ursula.
16 STEVE: Ursula, that's what it was.
17 DICK: Ursula. Gerdman, I think it's
18 pronounced?
19 STEVE: That's correct.
20 DICK: Okay. Sherry Jewel?
21 STEVE: Okay. And it was Mosers --
22 DICK: Moser.
23 STEVE: -- the mother, yeah.
24 DICK: Right. She, she's fine, right?
25 STEVE: Yes.

1 DICK: Okay. A Mary Jean Borst.
2 STEVE: Mary Jean Borst. Okay.
3 DICK: And that inquiry comes from Darrin
4 Borst.
5 STEVE: From Dan?
6 DICK: From Darrin.
7 STEVE: Oh, Darrin, okay.
8 DICK: Yeah. The next one --
9 STEVE: It must be a son.
10 DICK: It is. The next one is the -- and I
11 understand she might be okay, is that correct?
12 STEVE: Yeah, she is.
13 DICK: Okay. A fellow -- geez, I'm not
14 familiar with this name, G-R-A-E-M -- I think it's a
15 Graem Cradock.
16 STEVE: Oh, Graem Cradock.
17 DICK: Graem, okay, that's what that is.
18 STEVE: Yeah. Yeah.
19 DICK: Okay. I guess that's what this says.
20 Graem Cradock, fine?
21 STEVE: Yes.
22 DICK: Okay. A Douglas --
23 STEVE: Is that from his mother, maybe?
24 DICK: Yes.
25 STEVE: Okay.

1 DICK: No, I'm sorry, Barry Cradock.
2 STEVE: Okay, Barry.
3 DICK: Yeah. From -- these folks are from
4 Australia.
5 STEVE: Right, they are.
6 DICK: Okay. A Douglas Martin.
7 STEVE: Okay, Douglas Martin.
8 DICK: Okay. From Anthony Greenwood. Is
9 Douglas all right?
10 STEVE: Yes, he is.
11 DICK: How about Sheila? She's all right,
12 also?
13 STEVE: Yes.
14 DICK: Both of them are there --
15 STEVE: Right.
16 DICK: -- and they're both fine. Okay. How
17 about Paul Fanta, Fatta, F-A-T-T-A?
18 STEVE: He seems to be okay, also.
19 DICK: And --
20 STEVE: Who's, who's been asking for Paul?
21 DICK: Irma.
22 DICK: Okay. Paul is -- it's Irma. See, I
23 better write some of these -- must be a grandparent.
24 DICK: Yeah, I don't know. There's no, no
25 indication here.

1 STEVE: Okay. (Indiscernible)

2 DICK: And --

3 STEVE: Anyway, I got it down. Don't worry.

4 DICK: Kalani Fatta.

5 STEVE: Okay.

6 DICK: Both these folks are okay? There was
7 some --

8 STEVE: Yes.

9 DICK: Apparently, you mentioned last night
10 you weren't sure about that. That's one of the names,
11 I think, that David asked me about yesterday.

12 STEVE: Right.

13 DICK: So, Paul Fatta and Kalani are, are
14 both fine?

15 STEVE: Yes, from what I'm hearing anyway.
16 This is what I've been told.

17 DICK: Okay. But you -- okay.

18 STEVE: Okay. And who else do you have?

19 DICK: All right. Then we have some inquiry
20 from the British Consulate.

21 STEVE: Okay, British -- okay.

22 DICK: Making inquiry on a Winston Blake.

23 STEVE: Winston Blake.

24 DICK: Is he okay?

25 STEVE: I believe he is (Indiscernible).

1 DICK: Well, now don't tell me that if you
2 don't know.
3 STEVE: No, no, I'm -- that's why --
4 DICK: Because --
5 STEVE: -- I say, I'm going to -- let me
6 check on him, okay?
7 DICK: Okay.
8 STEVE: All right.
9 DICK: Because, you know, these, these folks
10 are --
11 STEVE: Right.
12 DICK: People are concerned about them and -
13 -
14 STEVE: Right.
15 DICK: -- and we just don't want to tell
16 them that --
17 STEVE: Okay. Do you have a name for
18 Winston that --
19 DICK: No, I don't have --
20 STEVE: Okay.
21 DICK: I don't have --
22 STEVE: These are just ones that are being
23 raised, huh, as names or something?
24 DICK: Right.
25 STEVE: Okay. Who else?

1 DICK: A Beverly Elliott.

2 STEVE: Beverly Elliott, okay. Okay.

3 DICK: Okay. Susan Benta, B-E-N-T-A.

4 STEVE: Okay. Yes.

5 DICK: Are you telling me she's -- these,
6 these other two folks, Beverly and Susan, are both
7 fine?

8 STEVE: Yes, they are.

9 DICK: Okay. Cliff Sellers.
10 (Someone playing with telephone buttons)

11 STEVE: Oh, someone just hit --

12 DICK: Okay. It's all right. I'm still
13 here.

14 STEVE: Okay. Okay.

15 DICK: Cliff Sellers.

16 STEVE: Yes, fine.

17 DICK: Okay. Marjorie Powell.

18 STEVE: Fine.

19 DICK: Okay. Now, again, when you're saying
20 fine, they're all there and doing well?

21 STEVE: That's right.

22 DICK: Okay. Yvette Fagan, F-A-G-A-N.

23 STEVE: Fine.

24 DICK: Okay. Livingston Fagan.

25 STEVE: Fine.

1 DICK: Mike Malcolm.

2 STEVE: Let's see, Mike Malcolm, Mike
3 Malcolm. I don't know any Mike Malcolm. Could it be
4 a Livingston Malcolm? It must be 'cause --

5 DICK: Yeah, I suppose that it's possible.
6 There's a Livingston Fagan.

7 STEVE: Right.

8 DICK: You mean you've got a Livingston
9 Malcolm, also?

10 STEVE: That's correct. That's correct.

11 DICK: Okay.

12 STEVE: If he's got a nickname, Mike, or
13 something, then --

14 DICK: Well, that's possible. That's
15 certainly possible. A Natalie, last name is N-O-R-B-
16 R-E-G-A.

17 STEVE: You have her.

18 DICK: Okay. Bernadette Mombelly, Mombelly,
19 is that how it's pronounced?

20 STEVE: Yeah, she's here.

21 DICK: Okay. Okay. Ramos, Ramos, last name
22 is A-V-R-R-M.

23 STEVE: What's the first name?

24 DICK: Renos or Ramos.

25 STEVE: Or Renos, okay, yes.

1 DICK: Okay?

2 STEVE: Uh-huh.

3 DICK: All righty. An Alrick Benette, B-E-

4 N-E-T-T-E.

5 STEVE: Benette. What's the first name?

6 DICK: Alrick, A-L-R-I-C-K, Alrick.

7 STEVE: Alrick.

8 DICK: Might -- they might call him George.

9 STEVE: Oh, I see. Yes.

10 DICK: Middle name is apparently George.

11 STEVE: Okay.

12 DICK: All righty.

13 STEVE: All right.

14 DICK: A Derrick Lovelock.

15 STEVE: Yes.

16 DICK: Okay. And a Sonja Murray?

17 STEVE: Yes.

18 DICK: Okay. Let me see if I have any other

19 names here. Those are folks that people made inquiry

20 on. I think I had some other names here but it may

21 have been included on this list here.

22 STEVE: Okay.

23 DICK: Okay. All right. Well, I'm sure --

24 you know, we'll pass this on to these folks and I'm

25 sure they'll appreciate your confirming that they're,

1 that they're fine.

2 STEVE: All right.

3 DICK: Now, how about -- some of these
4 folks, they want me to pass directly on to them the
5 concerns of these other people, the people that have
6 called in?

6 STEVE: Like?

7 DICK: Well, I'm just saying, if you have
8 some of these folks here that --

9 STEVE: Here's what I'll do.

10 DICK: -- whose names I just gave you.

11 STEVE: Can you give me about an hour or two
12 and --

12 DICK: Well, we'll give you some time.

13 STEVE: Well, here's what I'm going to do.
14 Well, of course you are. But anyway, we're -- I'll go
15 around with especially this list and even with others
16 who, who have not been inquired about.

17 DICK: Okay.

18 STEVE: I'll ask them if they want to make
19 known to their parents, to other relatives, to
20 friends, anything through or by yourself. This list
21 here, I'm going to even pass it on to them and --

21 DICK: Okay.

22 STEVE: -- ask them if they want to talk to
23
24
25

1 you to let them know their condition or whatever else.

2 DICK: Okay. You know, while your --

3 STEVE: So far I haven't really talked to a
4 lot of those that are from Britain as much as like I
5 told you just --

6 DICK: Okay.

7 STEVE: -- a little while ago, I was talking
8 to a group of people and, and a few others which they
9 said they wanted me to be their spokes person, trying
10 to get a line open for someone else other than the
11 very agency that would be arresting them. So, that's
12 what you and I are were talking about, which didn't
13 seem unreasonable to yourself, having an in between
14 go between --

15 DICK: Sure.

16 STEVE: -- and you and I will continue to
17 work on that.

18 DICK: All right. Let me see. I have one
19 other thought concerning those folks -- there are,
20 obviously, a lot of other people in there we've not
21 talked to.

22 STEVE: Uh-huh.

23 DICK: If you could get me a list of their
24 names and a list of, of the person that they want us
25 to pass on some -- a message to, we will certainly

1 entertain that.

2 STEVE: Right.

3 DICK: We would -- you give us a telephone
4 number, a name, an address and --

5 STEVE: You know, I'll -- you would, of
6 course, know that I'd want to do that except for the
7 very reason of logistics. I mean the whole problem
8 being that, you know, we don't want you to know
9 exactly who is here totally, do we?

10 DICK: Well, that may well be and that's --
11 if that's your choice, that's fine. I just wanted --

12 STEVE: Yeah, but, but you would know that,
13 of course.

14 DICK: Well, I understand that might be a
15 concern of yours but I thought maybe because all of
16 those people are in there voluntarily, they might want
17 to just let people know that they're fine, that
18 they're okay.

19 STEVE: That's why we're still trying to,
20 you know, we're trying to go to the nth degree to try
21 to work something out. When I tell you that if these
22 people want to go, believe me, they'll be out there
23 with assistance.

24 DICK: Sure. Oh, I understand what you're
25 saying. I just thought if they don't want to go. You

1 cannot believe the deluge of telephone calls that
2 we've --

3 STEVE: Oh, I can believe, for sure.

4 DICK: -- received here from people
5 wondering, one, are their, are their loved ones in
6 there? And, two, are they okay if they're in there.
7 So, what we're trying to do is just --

8 STEVE: I'm --

9 DICK: -- get a message to those folks.

10 STEVE: -- I'm shocked that there haven't
11 been more phone calls and more requests, in fact, than
12 what you've given me here.

13 DICK: Oh, there are. We're just trying to
14 get them to you when we can but, unfortunately, some
15 of those folks that are in there are unknown, and
16 we're going to have to work backwards from your end
17 there with the name and telephone numbers for those
18 people that we can contact.

19 STEVE: I can imagine for sure.

20 DICK: And we'll be happy to do that for you
21 and for them.

22 STEVE: Okay.

23 DICK: So, you know, you get together a list
24 of those folks for me and then, and then a list of,
25 you know, people that you might have some interest in

1 in talking to later.

2 STEVE: Right. Well, I'll be doing that in
3 the next few hours then.

4 DICK: Well, yeah, you know what you could
5 do, Steve?

6 STEVE: What's that?

7 DICK: Have -- assign that -- delegate to
8 someone and have them -- several people go out.

9 STEVE: Well, that's what I would -- that's
10 what I would be doing, of course.

11 DICK: Okay. Good. Good.

12 STEVE: When I say that, I'm just saying now
13 get the process started.

14 DICK: Yeah, don't do it yourself, send out
15 somebody to get it done for you.

16 And David's still, still down?

17 STEVE: He's still out. I'm looking -- in
18 fact, I'm looking at him now.

19 DICK: You know, one thing that concerns me,
20 if he's sleeping so much, that might be an indication
21 that his health is not as good as it might be.

22 STEVE: Well, I don't know 'cause aren't
23 usually -- the best thing for sickness for someone's
24 that sick no matter what the problem is, I think the
25 body recovers the fastest when it does get the rest.

1 DICK: Well, that's true to a degree but too
2 much rest might mean that there's something wrong.

3 STEVE: Well, well, you know yourself,
4 though, Dick, that he's healed -- I think he --
5 didn't he talk for six hours the other night? Who was
6 it, was it -- was it your -- no, it wasn't you. I
7 think it was with Henry, for about six hours I think
8 it was.

8 DICK: Yeah, I think he did. I think he
9 did.

10 STEVE: And then, in fact, even John told me
11 last night even how he -- of course, he had been
12 listening and, and to some of the subject matter of
13 what was being spoken about and his reaction to that.

13 DICK: Sure.

14 STEVE: So, I mean the truth is -- I mean he
15 expends a lot of energy in the condition he is to talk
16 on the phone for that length of time, pouring out that
17 much of his soul into what he's trying to say and
18 reach out to people like yourselves. So, then, the
19 next thing you know, he's back sleeping again. So,
20 that, you know, this is the way it's been.

20 DICK: Sure, I understand that. The only
21 thing is my -- I guess our concern is is that a
22 sickness is one thing, a wound is another.

23

24

25

1 STEVE: Right.

2 DICK: There's a chance for infection and
3 peritonitis and gangrene and those kinds of things.
4 So, you know, sleeping, while it, it's a recuperative
5 thing that we all want to do when we're sick, it's a
6 little different when you have a gunshot wound.

7 STEVE: Yeah, I know, but we're keeping an
8 eye on him.

9 DICK: Okay.

10 STEVE: He seems to be doing okay so far.
11 Every now and then, of course, he'll be talking or if
12 he makes a movement or even if he does make a
13 movement, he'll get a lot of pain in, of course, that
14 area.

15 Yeah, someone's just showing me a message
16 here. Let me see what it says here.

17 DICK: Okay.

18 STEVE: (Indiscernible) regards to news
19 briefings mentioned. Our needs are being made since
20 there's still children in there. Okay. They -- one
21 of the women just came with a note saying, where's the
22 milk, you know, I mean -- what's his name again, the
23 agent, --

24 DICK: Hartnet?

25 STEVE: -- Bob Ricks?

1 DICK: No, that was Mr. Hartnet, I believe.

2 STEVE: Anyway, they made the statement
3 that, you know, a lot of this is being met, which is
4 not so.

5 DICK: Well, I think --

6 STEVE: Bob -- okay, let me go through this
7 list here. You asked --

8 DICK: Okay. Okay, go ahead. In fact, I'll
9 jot them down while you're doing it.

10 STEVE: Okay. Let me take a look here. One
11 of the statements that were made was D.K. or David
12 hasn't said anything about any -- or anymore about the
13 bodies that are inside.

14 Well, you know, we've been harping since I
15 believe it was yesterday on the one that is -- that we
16 do have very clearly. We know who he is. And we've
17 been trying to do something about that but it came
18 across contrary to that. And, of course, you guys hid
19 the fact that we do, in fact, want to get that body
20 out. Okay?

21 DICK: Okay. What's the next item?

22 STEVE: Let me take a look here. And this
23 statement is given again in regards to that body.
24 They could give no predictions if and when the body
25 will be removed.

1 Well, that's -- he didn't go on to say it
2 was because it was your choice. I wish you would have
3 told them that.

4 DICK: You know what? I felt a little
5 uncomfortable with that answer, too. I wish you -- I
6 wish you would have added because we're primarily
7 concerned right now with the living and we want to get
8 aid to the living and we'll deal with, with, with the
9 dead when we, when we can.

9 STEVE: Right.

10 DICK: I wish you had gone on to say that
11 because, obviously, all are emphasis here is --

12 STEVE: I like honesty, you know. I mean
13 this is the thing that will get a lot of these people,
14 if you would want them to come walking out, those are
15 the things they're looking for. They're really are.
16 You know, I can't move anybody here. They're not
17 going to listen -- when it comes right down to it,
18 they came here because they heard David opened the
19 book. So, that, you know, that's the bottom line.
20 But for them to make a choice contrary to that, they
21 might, but it would have to be based upon a trust
22 relationship that's been developed by what they're
23 hearing and seeing. And this is what they're telling
24 me. This is why they keep on asking me to be a spokes
25

1 person for them and not to let them down. They want
2 to have some kind of an outside line, of course, to
3 the press and so forth. They want that kind of
4 assurance.

5 Anyway, another statement was made after
6 that again about bodies and the decomposition
7 question. And the agent would like to get all out of
8 the compound. Well, you know, why not the one that we
9 already have even.

10 What other questions do you have here you
11 put before me? Someone just handed me a statement
12 that they -- well, anyway, a couple of these women,
13 they just dropped that note to me about the milk, that
14 it -- this has been now like what two days, I believe,
15 at least. So, I mean before -- I mean it's -- you've
16 got to remember, like I told you and I think I said it
17 to John Cox, that if need be, they'll forego milk.
18 They'll give the baby water, whatever else.

19 DICK: No, I know you said that.

20 STEVE: Yeah.

21 DICK: I know you said that and --

22 STEVE: Okay. I mean I'm just telling you
23 as it is with their mind, the way they're thinking and
24 the way they're looking at it.

25 DICK: Yeah, I understand that and I told --

1 STEVE: Okay.

2 DICK: -- and I told you, and please pass on
3 to them --

4 STEVE: All right.

5 DICK: -- I'd be happy to drive down the
6 lane with those -- with that milk --

7 STEVE: I believe that.

8 DICK: -- and the response I'm getting in
9 answer to that question is that, we're, we're prepared
10 to, to provide all the necessary and desirable aid to
11 those children. And it's up to the parents to insure
12 that that happens and -- by coming out and bringing
13 the kids out with them.

14 STEVE: Okay. So, we'll just forget the
15 milk, then, and -- I'll tell you what, well, you can -
16 - we'll be talking in a couple of hours then.

17 DICK: All right. Well, let's, let's don't
18 make it that long because --

19 STEVE: Well, it's going to take me a little
20 while 'cause these --

21 DICK: I know.

22 STEVE: -- people are all over the place.

23 DICK: Well, we'll have some of those folks
24 and you and I -- I know, I know you have some more
25 questions for me.

1 STEVE: I'll try to get those questions
2 down.

3 DICK: Concerning, you know, the procedures
4 when you come out. I know those things are of an
5 issue with you and with others --

6 STEVE: Well, sure they are.

7 DICK: -- in there, and I'm prepared to
8 answer those questions for you and --

9 STEVE: All right.

10 DAVID: -- to make you feel more comfortable
11 about that process and that procedure because I know
12 it scares people. I've been doing this job for a long
13 time and it's very concerning to people because
14 they're not sure, it's the unknown, it's the fear of
15 the unknown. You're comfortable there. You're
16 fearful that when you come out, what is going to be
17 done. I can answer those questions for you. I'm
18 prepared to do that. And we will do that. And I
19 think you'll feel very comfortable with the -- with
20 what we're trying to do to make sure that you're
21 handled both under lawfully and comfortably and, and
22 in a way that, that you'll feel safe.

23 STEVE: Uh-huh.

24 DICK: And, and we're doing that. And
25 that's all we want, is your safety and the safety of

1 everyone here. The kids especially, all of us want to
2 insure the kids' safety first and foremost but things
3 have been done here to insure that when you come out,
4 that you're, that you're going to be handled very,
5 very quickly, very compassionately, and so that you
6 can get your folks back to your families as soon as
7 possible.

8 And, certainly, I'm not going to lie to you,
9 there are going to be some charges with, with some
10 folks but the majority of the folks are going to be --
11 are going to be interviewed and, and they're going to
12 get an opportunity to, to tell us what happened. And
13 then they're going to be reunited with, with family
14 members, with the kids and that sort of thing.

15 So, please pass that on to the folks in
16 there.

17 STEVE: All right.

18 DICK: And then, and then I know they're
19 going to have questions. You gather those questions
20 and we'll go through that procedure, how it's done,
21 why it's done and the accommodation we're making to
22 you folks in there to insure that you're not, you're
23 not concerned and your concerns are needless as -- in
24 terms of what's going to be done because it will be
25 done in, in an appropriate fashion right here with a

1 magistrate right here. You're not going to have to
2 go, you know, any distance, and you'll be bused over
3 here and -- together.

4 STEVE: Uh-huh.

5 DICK: And we'll deal with those issues.
All right?

6 STEVE: All right.

7 DICK: All right. I'll get back to you,
8 then, not too distant future. Get, get some of those
9 questions and you and I can discuss those questions
10 while somebody else is getting the names of those
11 other folks and the people that they might want to
contact.

12 STEVE: All right.

13 DICK: All right.

14 STEVE: Talk to you in a little bit.

15 DICK: All right.

16 STEVE: Good bye.

17 DICK: Bye.

* * * *

18 DICK: Hello.

19 STEVE: Hello, is this Dick?

20 DICK: It is, Steve, but I can't hear you
21 well.

22 STEVE: Yeah.

23

1 DICK: Let me, let me call you back.

2 STEVE: All right.

3 DICK: Well, here we go.

4 STEVE: Okay. Here we go.

5 DICK: Here we go.

6 STEVE: Yeah, we're having our afternoon or
7 our evening worship right now. I wanted to let you
8 know. But at the same time, we were going to play a
9 cassette tape, we can't find it. And I believe it was
10 left in David's car in the front. So, we're going to
11 send somebody out to get that cassette tape which is
12 probably on the dashboard of his car.

13 DICK: No, no, we can't, we can't do that.
14 We can't do that.

15 STEVE: Well, you, you let your men know
16 because we're going to do it. You can do what you
17 want to do but --

18 DICK: Well, listen, I have a very -- what I
19 think that you and David will consider a very
20 important question that --

21 STEVE: All right.

22 DICK: -- you're going to have to entertain.

23 STEVE: I mean because, you know, this is
24 the same kind of a -- I just want to say in regards to
25 that reaction, it's a reaction to what's happening on

1 the premises still.

2 DICK: Uh-huh.

3 STEVE: So, if you make your movements
4 wrong, you don't talk to us, the same will be so. You
5 want to take one of our people out, well, it will
6 begin again.

7 DICK: Well, we're not going to do that. We
8 have a -- we have a --

9 STEVE: Okay. Well, that's --

10 DICK: -- proposal to, to, to talk with you
11 about.

12 STEVE: Okay. I'll -- I'm open for that but
13 --

14 DICK: Let's --

15 STEVE: -- but let me say he wants to get
16 the cassette tape out of his car. It's part of our
17 worship service.

18 DICK: Hold on. Let me, let me -- give me a
19 minute, okay?

20 STEVE: All right.

21 DICK: What time -- let me get back to you
22 in just a minute. Okay?

23 STEVE: Okay.

24 DICK: You, you hold on --

25 STEVE: No problem. We'll be unarmed, of

1 course.

2 DICK: Well, listen, don't send anybody out
3 until I talk to people about it, okay?

4 STEVE: All right.

5 DICK: I'll get back to you in just a couple
6 of minutes.

7 STEVE: Okay. I'll be back. Okay, thanks,
8 Dick.

9 DICK: Bye-bye.

10 * * * *

11 STEVE: Hello.

12 DICK: Steve?

13 STEVE: Yes.

14 DICK: Dick.

15 STEVE: Okay. Hi, Dick.

16 DICK: Yeah. Listen, I just didn't want you
17 to send somebody out there until people knew what was
18 happening because, you know, people get -- after these
19 periods of time, sometimes there's some, some fatigue
20 and that sort of thing. So, we don't want to do
21 anything without talking to one another.

22 Now, where, where is this tape now?

23 STEVE: Where is the which? The tape --
24 it's in the black Camero which is sitting right in the
25 front of the building, just a little off -- I think

1 it's just left of the front door.

2 DICK: All right, right out front with the
3 vehicles in front?

4 STEVE: Exactly, very clear in the open and
5 everything.

6 DICK: All right. That -- you know, that's
7 fine but, again, the reason I was concerned about you
8 doing it before I cleared is 'cause I just wanted to
9 make sure that your fellow comes out safely and that
10 our people knows he's coming out and that sort of
11 thing.

12 STEVE: Well, you know, like I said, you
13 know, I mean it almost seems funny at times because,
14 number one, they're all in armored tanks and so forth
15 and so --

16 DICK: Let's -- you know, we don't, we don't
17 need to quarrel about that. We know that. I just
18 want to make sure that he isn't --

19 STEVE: I know.

20 DICK: And no weapons.

21 STEVE: You know, it has bothered me,
22 though, that you expect that from me and then on the
23 other hand, these guys are digging on our property,
24 moving around, things that they shouldn't be touching.

25 DICK: Well, that's one of the things we

1 want to discuss.

2 STEVE: All right.

3 DICK: I want to discuss directly with
4 David.

5 STEVE: All right.

6 DICK: Now, you're talking about a prayer
7 service from --

8 STEVE: Yes.

9 DAVID: -- from what period?

10 STEVE: Right -- well, right now we're still
11 in it and --

12 DICK: Okay.

13 STEVE: -- let me see. Let me look down at
14 my watch here. So, it will probably be another 45
15 minutes.

16 DICK: Let's make it -- it's 3:19 now.
17 Let's --

18 STEVE: Okay.

19 DICK: -- let's make it at a quarter to -- a
20 quarter to four. I'll call you back. I need to talk
21 to David because I have --

22 STEVE: Well, let's make it at 4:00 or just
23 a few minutes after.

24 DICK: Let's make it 4:00.

25 STEVE: All right.

1 DICK: High -- 4:00 straight up, and I need
2 to talk to David because I have, I have some -- what I
3 think he'll find to be very important and interesting
4 development.

5 STEVE: Okay.

6 DICK: All right.

7 STEVE: Very good. I'll talk to you then.

8 DICK: All right. Very well.

9 STEVE: Okay. Bye.

10 DICK: Bye.
