STEVE: Hello.

DICK: Steve?

STEVE: Yes.

DICK: Dick.

STEVE: Okay.

DICK: Is David there?

STEVE: Just a moment.

DICK: Okay.

STEVE: Yes, here he is. Just hang on.

DICK: Good. Thank you.

DAVID: Hello, Dick.

DICK: Good afternoon, David. How are you  
doing?

DAVID: Oh, we're doing all right. Is this  
Dick?

DICK: It is.

DAVID: Okay.

DICK: You feeling a little better? I  
understand you were feeling --

DAVID: Oh, yes.

1                   DICK:  -- a little tired this morning.

2                   DAVID:  Yeah, we -- we're, we're, we're

3 recovering.

4                   DICK:  Did you ever send anybody out to get

5 that tape?

6                   DAVID:  Did we send anybody out to get the

7 tape yet, Steve?  No, not yet.

8                   DICK:  Are you still considering it?

9                   DAVID:  He said that he was waiting on you.

10                  DICK:  Oh, he misunderstood.  I said, go

11 ahead and send a fellow out to get the tape and I

12 would call back to talk to you about what I think is

13 an interesting proposal here.  And that you could go

14 ahead and send your man out for the tape.

15                  DAVID:  All right.

16                  DICK:  So, I, I'm -- you know, we

17 misunderstood one another there.

18                  DAVID:  So, what are we trying to develop

19 now?

20                  DICK:  Okay.  Well, are you going to send

21 your fellow out to pick up the tape?

22                  DAVID:  Yes.

23                  DICK:  I want to go ahead and relay that if

24 you're going to do that.

25

1                   DAVID: Go ahead, go ahead and send the guy  
2 out to get the tape.

3                   DICK: Okay. Listen, --

4                   DAVID: Well, let me -- it's probably on the  
5 dash or right there near the console.

6                   DICK: Okay.

7                   DAVID: Right, it's the demo tape.

8                   (Unidentified people talking in the  
9 background).

10                  DAVID: Well, it's amazing none of those  
11 tanks blew up, you know it? Yeah.

12                  DICK: Okay. Are you going to start him  
13 out, David?

14                  DAVID: Are they starting off yet? Go  
15 ahead.           (Pause)

16                  DAVID: It just, it just takes one person  
17 for the tape. It's just one tape.

18                  DICK: Yeah. Just ask them to go ahead and,  
19 you know, send one out to pick it up.

20                  DAVID: What, they want to get that gas  
21 tank? Where's it at? No, where at? Oh, just right  
22 there at the door?

23                  (Unidentified persons talking in the  
24 background.)

25                  DAVID: Well, he, he can just grab that when

1 he comes in. Anyway, he wants, he wants to grab a  
2 propane tank on the, on the way back. It's just right  
3 there at the door.

4 DICK: That's okay.

5 DAVID: Says it's all right. It's amazing  
6 those tanks didn't get, didn't get hit.

7 DICK: Well, I guess so. I guess so.

8 DAVID: I've never seen one of them blow but  
9 I hear they're pretty potent.

10 DICK: Yeah.

11 DAVID: They just filled up some propane  
12 tanks and, and they're what -- they're like what, ten  
13 gallons, five gallons --

14 DICK: Yeah, I think the normal one, with  
15 the barbecue, is, is 10 pounds, 20 pounds.

16 DAVID: They're right there by the door.

17 DICK: So, you're going to send your fellow  
18 out?

19 DAVID: Yeah, he's coming out now.

20 DICK: Okay.

21 DAVID: No. One guy to get the tape and  
22 when he comes around, just grab the ear of the tank  
23 and he can drag it in. Yeah. Unless they want to get  
24 shot.

25 DICK: I think that probably got their

1 attention.

2           DAVID: Oh, you know, these guys don't care.  
3 They've, they've learned every prophecy all the way  
4 from, from Deuteronomy 32, the Song of Moses, all the  
5 way through the prophetic writings. They -- they're,  
6 they're awesome young men and awesome young women.

7           DICK: Oh, is he, is he on his way out now?

8           DAVID: Yeah, as far as I know. I'm -- you  
9 know, I can't see where they're at right where I'm at  
10 --

11           DICK: Okay.

12           DAVID: -- but they should be coming out.

13           DICK: All right.

14           DAVID: I sure wish you guys knew, knew the  
15 reasons for the Bible.

16           DICK: Well, you know, Dave, over the last  
17 few, you know, few days that we've had an occasion to  
18 talk here and especially yesterday and today, I've  
19 been hearing a lot of sincere concern in your mind.  
20 And, of course, I've got those same concerns, and I  
21 want to work with you, and I think I've shown you  
22 we're trying to work with you. And for the last  
23 couple of hours when I haven't been here and I know we  
24 haven't had a lot of conversation today --

25           DAVID: Well, I've been sleeping off and on.

1 DICK: Sure. And I spoke --

2 DAVID: I've been trying to walk now.

3 DICK: Well, that's good.

4 DAVID: And --

5 DICK: Get up and do a little walking and  
6 try to get some of the muscle tone back.

7 DAVID: Well, I get up and then my head goes  
8 real light. They say it's just a loss of blood.

9 DICK: Yeah.

10 DAVID: So, we're trying to get some iron  
11 and some spinach and stuff but --

12 DICK: Sure. Well, you know, again, I've  
13 been hearing this concern and we've, we've reached a  
14 point now where we're not making a lot of headway and  
15 things haven't been working out really well for, for  
16 the last half of yesterday and part of today. So,  
17 what I've done and, again, why we've not been out  
18 there speaking with you today is because I've gone up  
19 to the bosses and I've taken upon myself to, to take  
20 this up to them and suggest to them that, listen, I'm  
21 trying to deal with David. He's trying to deal with  
22 me. And it looks like our position is that he doesn't  
23 fully trust me and I haven't been able to fully trust  
24 him. And we've got to do something to show good faith  
25 on both sides. And we've kicked this back and forth

1 at some -- for some time. And I've really gone out on  
2 a limb to represent you guys out there in an effort to  
3 get this done. And a couple of things we've done --  
4 we mentioned that -- Steve yesterday was indicating  
5 that they're concerned or you're concerned that you  
6 haven't been able to get the word out. So, I -- what  
7 I've done is gone to the bosses and said, listen,  
8 please, in one of these next press conferences, if you  
9 can, mention that the folks inside are concerned that  
10 they're not going to be able to get their word out for  
11 fear that the government, the F.B.I is going to try to  
12 suppress the thoughts of those inside. So, they --  
13 they're aware that, that you're concerned about that.  
14 And they've, you know, responded very favorably.  
15 That isn't going to be the case. So, I've asked them  
16 to make reference to that so that the media knows that  
17 at some point in time there's going to be a full  
18 accounting from you folks as to your perspective in  
19 there.

20 In addition to that, I know you're, you're  
21 very concerned about the Bradleys, and I know that --

22 DAVID: No, we're not worried about the Brad  
23 -- that's why we haven't done nothing to them yet.

24 You know --

25 DICK: No, I'm talking about the property



1 line.

2           DAVID: Yeah. Well, the thing of it is is  
3 like I say, we've allowed, we've allowed you all to  
4 infringe upon your statements and but, honestly, one  
5 thing -- our main problem is, and I understand it very  
6 clearly, is that it's naturally, it's naturally the  
7 skeptics point of view to believe that a person  
8 doesn't -- a God doesn't talk to man but --

8           DICK: But, Dave, let me, let me finish my  
9 thought here because, you know, again, --

10           DAVID: Okay.

11           DICK: -- I've, I've really put out some  
12 effort to get this done for you and the commanders  
13 here have, have really listened at length to this, and  
14 we've tried to work together here to come up with a  
15 proposal for you. And we think that you're going to  
16 be happy with it and it will get us off of this  
17 impasse. And, of course, to get this, this incident  
18 resolved, it's, it's going to -- it's going to require  
19 that the two of us work together. So, what I'd like  
20 you to do here, I'd like you to commit to the release  
21 of, of all the folks in there and we will agree to  
22 withdraw all the Bradley vehicles from your property  
23 line. And in, in doing this, I know you would be  
24 reluctant and I would be reluctant to do one thing  
25

1 without the other person agreeing, so we need to work  
2 out this mutual trust. And what would I -- what I  
3 would propose is that you send out four people,  
4 children, women, if you like. At the same time as  
5 they're walking up the road, we'll withdraw all the  
6 Bradley vehicles from your property. And then  
7 following those developments, that is the kids leaving  
8 and the vehicles withdrawing, to be followed by the  
9 rest of the folks inside.

9           DAVID: Okay. One second.

10           DICK: And we can talk about, you know, --  
11 the way that we need to do this is just the way we  
12 talked about it the first day when you folks were  
13 going to leave in that fashion.

14           STEVE: Okay. This is, this is Steve. Go  
15 ahead.

16           DICK: What happened to David?

17           STEVE: He handed the phone to me. He  
18 wanted me to hear what you had to say.

19           DICK: Okay. Well, as I proposed to him,  
20 we've had some problems over the last day or so  
21 working out a way we can get past this point where we  
22 seem to be hanging up. There's obviously a reluctance  
23 on your part to accept that we're trying to do  
24 everything we can on your behalf. So, as I was  
25

1 | telling David, the reason I haven't called in today is  
2 | because I've gone to the commanders up here and made  
3 | some requests of them and we've been talking at  
4 | length, trying to, trying to resolve this impasse.  
5 | And, so, we're, we're offering this proposal that if  
6 | you folks in there will commit to coming out of, of  
7 | the compound, we'll withdraw the Bradleys from the  
8 | property, back across from the property lines. And as  
9 | we're withdrawing the Bradleys, you send four kids or  
10 | four adults up the, up the path there as we're moving.  
11 | So that way we know that you're going to be committed  
12 | to your part of the agreement and you know that we're  
13 | committed to our part of the agreement. And then once  
14 | those Bradleys are off the property, then the rest of  
15 | you folks go ahead and follow the kids out or those  
16 | first four individuals out in the same fashion as --

17 |                 STEVE: Well, I should actually -- I should  
18 | have you save your breath because right now you and I  
19 | are so far apart, Dick, that there's no sense in even  
20 | talking.

21 |                 DICK: Okay. Well, offer me a suggestion.

22 |                 STEVE: You need to go back -- you need to  
23 | go back to the commanders --

24 |                 DICK: Okay.

25 |                 STEVE: -- and start talking sensibly and

1 then you can call me when you've got something  
2 worthwhile to talk about.

3 DICK: Well, let's, let's don't -- let's  
4 discuss this, then.

5 STEVE: Okay.

6 DICK: What, what --

7 STEVE: Dick, David would like to talk to  
8 you again. He'd like to give you a little study. One  
9 thing is for sure, is what he's saying, you don't  
10 believe what he's telling you. But you would -- here,  
11 here he is. He wants to talk to you again. Okay?

12 DICK: All right. I'll be happy to.

13 STEVE: Here he is.

14 DICK: We'll work this out.

15 DAVID: Say, Dick, I, I appreciate your  
16 offer and from your perspective I understand that,  
17 that, you know, your offer is a good offer and  
18 everything and I would love to do it.

19 DICK: Okay.

20 DAVID: I would just love to adhere to it  
21 but, remember, you have to negotiate with your bosses  
22 and I have only one boss.

23 DICK: I understand. What would you offer  
24 in return? I mean what, what is your position there?  
25 I mean give me, give me a reason to go back to my

1 boss. You said that was a good proposal. What, what  
2 is your opposition to it?

3 DAVID: You see, I have already agreed to  
4 come out and everybody else with us.

5 DICK: Okay.

6 DAVID: You see, what we're failing to  
7 understand is that the Gospel of Christ, the one God,  
8 the one church, all the New Testament writers point to  
9 a place in heaven. And through the mediation of the  
10 prophets, the apostles, there will be inscriptured a  
11 record of truth that in the latter days --

12 DICK: David, excuse me for a second.  
13 Listen, please, listen to me for a minute. I spent a  
14 lot of hours this morning, as did the commanders here,  
15 going over this. And you suggested you felt it was a  
16 reasonable proposal but you, obviously, have some  
17 opposition to parts of it. So, can we work out --  
18 work this thing out? And then I'm perfectly willing  
19 to listen to, to you, as I have in the past, and I  
20 think I've shown you that but let me go in with, with  
21 an alternate plan to the commanders and --

22 DAVID: Well, Dick --

23 DICK: -- so that we can get it worked out.

24 DAVID: Dick, let me, please, for -- you  
25 know, bear with this fool just a moment, you know,

1 just, just bear with this fool just a moment.

2 DICK: Okay. Can we, can we -- can I make  
3 you a counter proposal here? Can, can I give you some  
4 time? Let's, let's work back and forth here. I'm  
5 perfectly willing to listen and I appreciate your  
6 taking the time to talk to me in this fashion.

7 DAVID: Well, we love you.

8 DICK: Well, I understand that.

9 DAVID: We, we love you -- every one of you  
10 guys. We love the commanders. We have no grievances  
11 against you.

12 DICK: Isn't this a significant offer,  
13 David?

14 DAVID: Well, look, it's, it's as good as  
15 the original offer, you know, before the Bradleys --  
16 your show of might does not scare us at all.

17 DICK: This is not a show of might at all,  
18 not at all.

19 DAVID: No, what I'm saying is is that, you  
20 see, the very show of -- look, you, you've been  
21 working a lot, right?

22 DICK: Uh-huh.

23 DAVID: I've been working since 1985. I was  
24 shown at that time --

25 DICK: David, David, offer me, please --

1 this is very important that we -- this is a very  
2 significant development that we need to talk about.  
3 And let's, let's spend some time talking about this.  
4 And then, then, please, I'll be happy to listen to you  
5 because it's worth listening to. I, I'm certainly in  
6 agreement with that but let us work out this -- some  
7 details here so that others that I can pass this on  
8 and it will be considered and we can work on this.  
9 This is, this is a very important time. This is, this  
10 is Saturday. We've been here seven days.

11 DAVID: It's the Shabbat Sabbath, right?

12 DICK: It is, it is. And it's an important  
13 date for you and for us.

14 DAVID: It's the day -- it's the day that,  
15 that the nations in the world, they, they have  
16 profaned the Sabbath. They don't know the meaning.

17 DICK: Absolutely, and we're trying to  
18 demonstrate our goodwill to you, David, and I think we  
19 have. I'm working hard on this.

20 DAVID: What if God was trying to offer you  
21 a way out of a, of a, of a present oncoming disaster  
22 of this nation, what if God has a witness to this  
23 nation because God is ready to deliverate his people  
24 from the, from the bands and the rulerships of all  
25 nations, and what if God is really going to set up his

1 kingdom like they did in ancient times.

2 DICK: Well, --

3 DAVID: And what if the prophet Daniel and  
4 the prophets who foretold the rise and fall of  
5 empires, what if God is not ready to, to show his  
6 mercy to the last generation of men on earth and what  
7 if God is ready to, to judge the nations of these --  
8 as foretold by these prophets.

8 DICK: Then we'll have to be prepared.  
9 David, we'll have to be prepared.

10 DAVID: And how can you prepare it if you  
11 deny his word by ignorance, willful ignorance to his  
12 word?

12 DICK: I don't mean to be ignorant at all  
13 and I'm willing to work with you but this --

14 DAVID: But you --

15 DICK: -- but this is a genuine effort on  
16 our part to try to work this out, David, and, please,  
17 work with me.

18 DAVID: I -- hey, look, I am working with  
19 you. I'm listening to you. But understand this is  
20 also a political matter. We are to serve God first  
21 and then --

21 DICK: David, I'm serving God also.

22 DAVID: No, the God that you serve is not my  
23  
24  
25



1 God.

2 DICK: Well, --

3 DAVID: Your God has not given to you a  
4 knowledge of his will. Your God is not the God of the  
5 prophets.

6 DICK: David, offer me a -- what -- offer me  
7 a counter, offer me a counter proposal that you can  
8 deal with that we can deal with. Offer me one right  
9 now. I know you, --

9 DAVID: Okay.

10 DICK: -- you said that this was an earnest  
11 agreement. Offer me something that I can take into my  
12 bosses and let's, let's face it, David, we have to  
13 work together, a little give, a little take. It's a  
14 classic example of we have to work together and work  
15 with one another and make, you know, some lateral  
16 movements and forward movement.

16 DAVID: Sure.

17 DICK: And we're willing to do that. Help  
18 us resolve this.

19 DAVID: Your -- I would love to. Your  
20 considerations are acknowledged of God. That's one  
21 thing I can tell you. But the little tape that I sent  
22 out, the basic little tape that people are trying to  
23 tear apart, I am not having the liberties or the  
24

25

1 freedoms to be able to be countered on what I have  
2 taught.

3 DICK: Uh-huh.

4 DAVID: Now, it's like this. If a man, any  
5 man, is able to make a statement, it's natural amongst  
6 the sons of men for people to perceive that statement  
7 in different areas of perception. Now, that's why in  
8 a, in a, in a meeting or in a encounter, even with the  
9 ATF agents in front of their little news media there,  
10 when a man makes a statement, someone else says, now,  
11 can you explain that to me more thoroughly or can --  
12 about what you just said, did you mean that -- and, of  
13 course, a person is allowed to clear himself. I used  
14 additional words. That's not the position we have. I  
15 gave a, I gave a little study on the radio. I was  
16 told to make it as short as possible. It took 58  
17 minutes to get the one point out. Now, the question -  
18 -

19 DICK: That's because we wanted to make sure  
20 that you had the opportunity to get the whole message  
21 on, on the air, David.

22 DAVID: Right.

23 DICK: Our experience has been -- and when  
24 have you ever heard on television -- I don't -- you  
25 know -- on any network or on the Christian Broadcast

1 Network, anybody make a, a, a, you know, a plea that  
2 you were able to do for 58 minutes. It's unheard of  
3 in history, in the history of the broadcast industry.

4 You were given a golden opportunity there and you  
5 took it. And you did -- you made the best of it. You  
6 did a terrific job. The impact from the, from the  
7 public was, was unbelievable. It was overwhelmingly  
8 favorable. We just -- we fell short of the original  
9 agreement but we're willing to go on from there.

9 DAVID: No, we didn't fall short of that.  
10 It's just what took place was is that the one that I  
11 communicate with, my God, stated to wait 'cause things  
12 are happening right now, things that you cannot see  
13 with your eyes. But if you knew the time of which we  
14 were in, if you understood the prophetic rise of the  
15 prophets, if you believed the words of the prophets  
16 and the words of Christ and if you realize that God in  
17 heaven that sits on the throne has these words  
18 contained in seven seals, then you would be shaking  
19 and trembling in your shoes right now. All of you  
20 would be. If, if these young men knew the events that  
21 are to take place here shortly, they, they would, they  
22 would be so far away from here they wouldn't even want  
23 to come around this place.

22 DICK: David, listen, listen to me for a  
23  
24  
25

1 second. I'm willing to go a step further, you know.  
2 I'm putting my job on the line for you here, okay.  
3 I'm willing to go into the bosses and tell them the  
4 women and children are coming out. Now, that, that is  
5 -- certainly should be acceptable to you, is it not?

6 DAVID: Well, if they wish to, they may. I  
7 mean I am not holding anybody --

8 DICK: No, but I mean it's going to be up to  
9 you to go ahead and send those folks out and we'll  
10 move the Bradleys off the property.

11 DAVID: Well, do, do you mean to tell me  
12 that you want me to lose my job with God by making a -  
13 - an order or something that I don't have the right to  
14 make?

15 DICK: No, it's -- you know, I'm not asking  
16 you -- I --

17 DAVID: You just do not believe that -- and  
18 God speaks to me.

19 DICK: No, David, what I'm suggesting is  
20 that these folks have a lot of confidence in you. If  
21 you go to them --

22 DAVID: Well, why do they have a lot of  
23 confidence in me?

24 DICK: Because of, of your gifts and your  
25 abilities.

1                   DAVID: I have never lied to them. I've  
2 always shown them the biblical truth unlike what this  
3 nation and other nations have offered through their  
4 ministries.

5                   DICK: But earlier on you were willing to do  
6 this, David. And we're not asking you to come with  
7 these folks.

8                   DAVID: And I'm sure we're willing to do  
9 this.

10                  DICK: We're asking you to send the women  
11 and children so that women can care for the children  
12 that have already come out and that the rest of the  
13 children will come out. And, and we'll move those  
14 Bradleys. David, help me out. I've been trying to  
15 represent you.

16                  DAVID: Dick, I would love to. I would love  
17 to but you're not representing me. God's going to  
18 represent me.

19                  DICK: I know but you can help me out, okay,  
20 as a personal favor to me.

21                  DAVID: Dick, I -- okay, look.

22                  DICK: As a personal favor to me.

23                  DAVID: Here's how I could help you out.  
24 Would you like to know the seven seals?

25                  DICK: Certainly. I'll be happy to learn

1 about the seven seals, but I need to go to my bosses -

2 - DAVID: You got -- do you got your Bible?

3 DICK: I'll be happy to go with it but,  
4 please, let's do this first. And I will sit here and  
5 I will listen to the seven seals. I want to  
6 understand about the seven seals but I have to go to  
7 my bosses and represent a proposal to them. So, work  
8 with me on this, David. Please, work with me, and I  
9 will work with you. I, I've, I've shown you that. I,  
10 I made a sincere effort. The bosses have made a  
11 sincere effort, but I believe I can go into them and  
12 convince them that this is the thing to do. And I  
13 will be happy to do that. And as soon as I return  
14 from that, the two of you or the two of us, we'll,  
15 we'll, we'll get -- I want to learn about the seven  
16 seals but --

17 DAVID: Don't --

18 DICK: -- but --

19 DAVID: -- tell them that I said that I'm  
20 going to send the women and children out.

21 DICK: Well, I'm certainly not going to tell  
22 them --

23 DAVID: What I said, it still goes along  
24 with Jim, you know. I am ready and willing and so is  
25 everybody else to, to leave this place. We're witness

1 in this generation. This organization is a witness  
2 unto God. Now, when our God who has shown me these  
3 mysteries tells me to wait, then I must wait. But  
4 everybody else here makes their own decisions.

5 DICK: I understand.

6 DAVID: God does not speak to them like God  
7 speaks to me, you see. That is, that is obvious.  
8 That is a reality. But there is a young lady here  
9 who's already stated that she does want to leave.  
10 And, so, you know, I'm not hindering her at all, you  
11 know, but she does want to leave. But the thing of it  
12 is is that, you know, evidently, Steve -- who was  
13 talking to last night Steve? No. Well, who was you  
14 talking to last night that -- the last guy. John.  
15 I've never talked to him, did I?

16 DICK: David, did you see -- did you see Bob  
17 Ricks on television today?

18 DAVID: I didn't see much of anything today.

19 DICK: All right. Well, Mr. Ricks is a very  
20 devout Christian and he prays to God, as we all do.  
21 And it took him a lot to make these concessions. And  
22 I believe the reason he did that is because he prayed,  
23 he prayed at length and he came back and he said,  
24 Dick, this is, this reasonable. I've given a lot of  
25 thought. I've prayed about it. And this is

1 reasonable. And we're, we're willing to concede,  
2 we're willing to work because we know that he's  
3 sincere in his belief. We want to show him we're  
4 equally sincere. And this is --this is what it's  
5 going to take, this kind of effort, prayer, and those  
6 kinds of things. And Mr. Ricks did that and --

6 DAVID: Well, did God talk to him?

7 DICK: He told me that he prayed to God and  
8 he came back with this, with this answer.

9 DAVID: Okay. So, God spoke to him, then.

10 DICK: That's, that's correct.

11 DAVID: Well, why would God tell him one  
12 thing and me another?

13 DICK: I have no idea but what, what he's  
14 telling you --

15 DAVID: Maybe God's trying to get us to  
16 fight or something, you know.

17 DICK: No, that's not it at all.

18 DAVID: You've got to watch this God.

19 DICK: What he's trying to do is to, to  
20 resolve this with no further injury. And we've made  
21 great strides toward that. There has not been any  
22 further injury. We've talked together reasonably for  
23 days. We will continue. Let's work together on this.  
24 Help me out, personally. I went in there. Help me.



1 Help me and help yourself at the same time.

2 DAVID: Oh, you've got a one track mind, I  
3 mean.

4 DICK: It is. It's safety, safety for  
5 everybody and the safe release of your people and the  
6 -- and given you a chance to use your gifts --

7 DAVID: The safety aspect is over. I'm the  
8 one that did everything to achieve safety, not you,  
9 not your organization, not your bureaucracy. I'm the  
10 one that made an alliance with Robert Gonzales.

11 DICK: Work with me. Work with me. Forget  
12 Robert Gonzales. Work with me.

13 DAVID: No, let's do not forget a reality  
14 that has brought us to this point. You see, I'm the  
15 one that first sent young men over to talk with these  
16 friends across the street. I'm the one that told  
17 Robert that everything that he wants to know about me  
18 or this organization, I would show him. No, but see,  
19 these individuals, the way their system works, set a  
20 time schedule, you know. They wanted to come in here  
21 and bust us up. They wanted glory. They wanted to be  
22 great. They wanted to have something to talk about,  
23 something to brag about, you know, and it didn't turn  
24 out that way.

25 DICK: They certainly got none of those

1 things.

2           DAVID: All of, of the system's fault --  
3 Robert and his pride and arrogancy, he hasn't even  
4 tried -- he hasn't even called me yet, you know. I  
5 asked, I asked Jim to, to get him to contact me. You  
6 know, I want, I want to be able to talk to him and ask  
7 him --

8           DICK: That may well be arranged.

9           DAVID: -- and ask him --

10          DICK: That may well be arranged in the  
11 future but you know what, I was telling Steve this  
12 morning --

13          DAVID: Do you know --

14          DICK: -- those fellows that were out there  
15 are no longer working because they're being --  
16 there's, there's an inquiry. And you know that  
17 Robert, he did what he was supposed to do. He was  
18 given an assignment.

19          DAVID: He could have stopped. Yeah, but he  
20 was also given something else, too, the best  
21 friendship he could have ever gotten from anybody.

22          DICK: You understand that he is a D.E.A  
23 agent, do you not?

24          DAVID: Oh, I know that Robert --

25          DICK: I mean an ATF agent, I'm sorry.

1                   DAVID: Yeah. I know what Robert was. I  
2 knew what he was when he first came over.

3                   DICK: Well, then, he's doing -- you know,  
4 I'm sure that he had a great deal of difficulty  
5 dealing with those issues.

6                   DAVID: I kept telling him I knew who he  
7 was.

8                   DICK: Once he got inside, it's my  
9 understanding that, that he really had to struggle  
10 with his continuing employment with the ATF because of  
11 the things that you taught him. And it was very, very  
12 difficult for him. It still continues to be difficult  
13 for him.

14                   DAVID: I know, and that's why I want to  
15 talk to him so I can tell him something that's very  
16 important.

17                   DICK: We -- we're not saying you can't talk  
18 to him.

19                   DAVID: Well, then put him on the phone.

20                   DICK: Well, he's not here, like I tell you  
21 --

22                   DAVID: When you put him on the phone and I  
23 talk to him, then Melissa's going to come out, okay?

24                   DICK: We, we don't even have availability  
25 to him.

1           DAVID: Yes, you do.

2           DICK: Is Melissa the gal that you said  
3 wants to come out?

4           DAVID: Right.

5           DICK: Well, let's send her out and we'll --

6           DAVID: No, let's --

7           DICK: -- see what we can work with.

8           DAVID: Well, wait a second. Tell Melissa  
9 to come here. I want to ask her something. I mean,  
10 Robert, you know -- a lot of the guys that are in law  
11 enforcement, you know, they have a -- they have a  
12 sense of right and a sense of wrong and --

13           DICK: Uh-huh.

14           DAVID: And, you know, they hate drugs and  
15 stuff like that, and I hate drugs. I've always hated  
16 drugs. And no one here takes drugs. You know, and  
17 the thing of it is is that, you know, we, we have one  
18 -- we have one -- that's one thing about a Christian.

19           Paul says, be all things to all men. And we've got  
20 to find a bridge to all types. And there's nothing  
21 that I ever wanted more than to have, you know, law  
22 enforcement agencies and stuff to realize the real,  
23 really deep principles of our convictions and our  
24 beliefs.

25           DICK: David, I'll tell you what I'm going

1 to do. Now, Robert is nowhere around the Waco area.  
2 You know, he's struggling with this whole thing. He's  
3 --

4 DAVID: Well, tell him to come on back.

5 DICK: The grief that this man is, is  
6 undergoing is much like the grief that you're  
7 undergoing. He, he just can't deal with it now.

8 DAVID: Well, --

9 DICK: It's a mandatory thing. His agency  
10 mandatorily sent him out. Now, I will deliver a  
11 message, if I can find somebody that can give him --  
12 those guys are, are sent home. Anytime a law  
13 enforcement officer is involved in a critical  
14 incident, there is absolutely no deviation, they are  
15 sent packing with their family so that they can get  
16 away and, and forget the -- all the agony that was  
17 suffered on both sides. And he'll return to duty at  
18 some time in the future but this man has told his  
19 friends that it was horribly, horribly difficult for  
20 him because of, of, of what has happened here due to  
21 your teaching. He's even going to have to see a  
22 doctor about this because he's having a difficult time  
23 with this.

24 DAVID: Well, Melissa, Melissa will come out  
25 --

1                   DICK: Okay.

2                   DAVID: -- once we get to talk to Robert,  
3 okay?

4                   DICK: Well, let me talk to Melissa now.  
5 Let me see if we can work out this thing. But let's  
6 go back to the original, original talk that we had  
7 here. Give me something. Let me go into the boss  
8 here.

8                   DAVID: I just did.

9                   DICK: Offer me --

10                  DAVID: I just did. Jim and all them kept  
11 telling me that, that they would get in contact with  
12 Robert, that he was around there. Now, you're telling  
13 me opposite.

13                  DICK: Well, give me a message and I'll try  
14 to run Robert down but in the meantime, let's take  
15 Melissa out of there if she wants to go.

16                  DAVID: Here, here's, here's the message.  
17 Wait a second.

18                  DICK: David?

19                  STEVE: She's -- he's asking a question, do  
20 you want to go? And she's saying, no. And then he  
21 asked her the question, would you go if it allow us to  
22 talk to Robert Gonzales? And she shook her head yes.

22 Hello?

23

24

25

1                   DICK: I'm still here.

2                   STEVE: Okay. Do you want to talk to the  
3 man on the telephone a little bit? Are you sure?

4                   DICK: Put her on.

5                   STEVE: Okay.

6                   DICK: Put her on, Steve, let me talk with  
7 her.

8                   STEVE: Okay, Dick, hang on just a second.  
9 She's shooking -- shaking her head no but I'm trying -  
10 -are you sure you don't want to? Say, hello. He's a  
11 real nice guy. Here -- Dick?

12                   DICK: Yes.

13                   STEVE: Okay, here she is.

14                   MELISSA: Hi.

15                   DICK: Hello, Melissa, how are you?

16                   MELISSA: Okay.

17                   DICK: Okay. How old are you?

18                   MELISSA: Six.

19                   DICK: You're six years old. Good. How --  
20 why don't you come out and we'll get together with --  
21 and sit down and talk for a while. David has  
22 indicated that you, you can go, you can leave the  
23 house. Will you do that for me?

24                   MELISSA: Yeah.

25                   DICK: Okay. You tell David you want to

1 | come out and talk to Dick, okay? You get your coat on  
2 | and you come out and you and I will sit down and talk  
3 | together. Can we do that?

4 |           MELISSA: Yeah.

5 |           DICK: We'll take good --

6 |           MELISSA: Bye.

7 |           DICK: -- we'll take -- Melissa?

8 |           MELISSA: Huh?

9 |           DICK: We'll take good care of you and we'll  
10 | put you together with all the other kids that came out  
11 | and --

12 |           MELISSA: Yeah.

13 |           DICK: -- you'll, and you'll get to play  
14 | with your friends. And what's your last name,  
15 | Melissa?

16 |           MELISSA: Morrison.

17 |           DICK: I'm sorry, honey, what is it?

18 |           MELISSA: Morrison.

19 |           DICK: Lar -- Morrison, Melissa Morrison?

20 |           MELISSA: Yeah.

21 |           DICK: Good. Well, you -- we'll get you  
22 | together with all the other kids and you can talk to  
23 | your friends. Do you, do you have your brother or  
24 | sister?

25 |           MELISSA: No.



1                   DICK: Okay. Well, you tell David that you  
2 want to come out now and talk to Dick.  
3                   MELISSA: Okay.  
4                   DICK: Will you do that?  
5                   MELISSA: Yeah.  
6                   DICK: Okay. Promise me?  
7                   MELISSA: Yeah.  
8                   DICK: Okay. You tell David right now that  
9 you want to get your coat and leave.  
10                  MELISSA: Bye.  
11                  DICK: You there, Melissa?  
12                  MELISSA: Yeah.  
13                  DICK: Okay. Will you tell him that?  
14                  MELISSA: Yeah.  
15                  DICK: You go over to him right now and, and  
16 tell him that you'd like to leave and you talk -- you  
17 want to go out and talk with Dick, okay?  
18                  MELISSA: Okay.  
19                  DICK: And we'll give you -- we'll give you  
20 a ride, okay?  
21                  MELISSA: Okay.  
22                  DICK: Okay. Let me talk to David.  
23                  ROSE: Hello, Dick?  
24                  DICK: Yes.  
25                  ROSE: Hi, I'm Melissa's mother.

1           DICK: Hi, how are you? What's your name?

2           ROSE: Rose.

3           DICK: I'm sorry?

4           ROSE: Rose.

5           DICK: Nice to meet you. I understand  
6 you're going to send Melissa out now?

7           ROSE: Can I just ask you something before I  
8 send her out?

9           DICK: Certainly.

10          ROSE: Where are the children being sent to  
11 and we've got conflicting information over here.  
12 We've been told once they're being sent -- well,  
13 they're being held together.

14          DICK: That's true.

15          ROSE: And then they're being fostered out.

16          DICK: No, that's not true.

17          ROSE: That's not true?

18          DICK: No, the kids, the kids are together.

19          ROSE: Okay. Can you tell me what's going  
20 to happen to the children?

21          DICK: At some point in time, we're going to  
22 reunite them with you. As soon as you folks come out,  
23 we're going to reunite, reunite you kids -- with your  
24 children and you're going to be giving them the care.

25          These kids want to get back with their parents.

1 There's no question about that. We want to get them  
2 back with their parents. And until we can do that,  
3 the kids will be well cared for by caring people. The  
4 kids are all together. We -- did you get a chance to  
5 look at those pictures we sent in to you the other  
6 day?

6 ROSE: Well, you sent the tape as well,  
7 right?

8 DICK: Well, we sent, we sent hard copy  
9 photos in also. You didn't get a chance to see those?

10 ROSE: I saw the photos but the tape was  
11 blank.

12 DICK: That's what I understand. I've been  
13 assured that that went in there with something on it.  
14 It must be your equipment in there. But the -- yes,  
15 the kids, the kids are all together. They will remain  
16 together. And we want to reunite you with your kids  
17 as soon as you can. Now, my understanding is is that  
18 David has absolutely no objection to you leaving with  
19 your daughter.

18 ROSE: That's true.

19 DICK: Why don't you come on out with her  
20 and then you can insure that these kids are together  
21 and being cared for properly?

22 ROSE: Well, that's not my choice.

23

24

25

1           DICK: It's not your choice?

2           ROSE: I mean that's not what I want to do.

3           DICK: All right.

4           ROSE: But at the same time, we've also  
5 gotten information coming in that once we come out,  
6 okay, we're going to -- you know, go through the  
7 judicial system and whatever. So, the children might  
8 not be able to be reunited with us. So, then, what  
9 will happen to the children? I mean most of the  
10 children taken out of here have been taken out with  
11 their names and --

12           DICK: They have.

13           ROSE: -- their relatives and whose the  
14 contact.

15           DICK: Well, as I've indicated before, the  
16 kids are being cared for and they're all together. At  
17 some point in time, we're going to reunite them with  
18 you and the other parents in there. And, obviously,  
19 some folks when they come out are going to be detained  
20 temporarily, some maybe even longer than that.

21           ROSE: Okay.

22           DICK: However, the kids are going to be  
23 well cared for. And we understand that they came out  
24 with addresses and that's what we want you to do also  
25 is to send, send out an address and a telephone number

1 of a contact person --

2 ROSE: Okay.

3 DICK: -- for us.

4 ROSE: The parents that's being detained,  
5 well, then what will happen to our children?

6 DICK: You talking about individually? I  
7 mean, in other words, parents of those -- parents that  
8 --

9 ROSE: Yes.

10 DICK: -- might be detained, what's going to  
11 happen to the kids?

12 ROSE: Yeah.

13 DICK: Well, temporarily, they're going to  
14 be housed together. And, obviously, at some point in  
15 time a decision has to be made in terms of placement  
16 but that's what we're talking about relatives.

17 ROSE: Some parents will be detained longer  
18 than others, okay.

19 DICK: Well, that's what the next of kin are  
20 for. In other words, if you send out a message, a  
21 telephone number, an address of grandparents,  
22 brothers, sisters or someone, immediate family member,  
23 then every effort will be made to contact those people  
24 and put -- and make them aware of the situation here.

25 And we'll place the kids with them when --

1                   ROSE: The kids will be placed with their  
2 relatives, right?

3                   DICK: Absolutely.

4                   ROSE: Okay.

5                   DICK: Absolutely. That -- we wouldn't have  
6 it any other way.

7                   ROSE: And I'm supposed to take your word  
8 for that, right?

9                   DICK: Well, you are. That's exactly -- you  
10 know, if you don't take my word for it, then, then we  
11 can't work this out. I am here to insure your safety  
12 and that of your children. And you have to work me.  
13 As I told David and Steven, we've made every effort to  
14 try to get this thing worked out for the safety of  
15 everyone inside. We've given you the opportunity to  
16 send your children out. We want your children out,  
17 and we want you folks out.

18                   ROSE: Okay. Well, look, I'm going to send  
19 my daughter out, okay?

20                   DICK: All right. And, please --

21                   ROSE: But not because of your word.

22                   DICK: Please. And, also, put -- give us a  
23 message as to who should be contacted relative to your  
24 child and tell the others in there that I'll be happy  
25 to talk to each and every one of them. We care for

1 the kids. I'm a father. You think that I would allow  
2 something to happen to your children?

3 ROSE: No.

4 DICK: I just won't do it.

5 ROSE: Okay, then. Okay. Well, she'll --

6 DICK: Would you pass that message on to the  
rest of the kids?

7 ROSE: Sure, I'll do that.

8 DICK: Now, hold, hold on for just a second  
9 here. I, I've got just one more thought I want to  
10 pass to you.

11 ROSE: You've got what?

12 DICK: I've got one more comment.

13 ROSE: Okay.

14 DICK: You know, your family -- are, are you  
from Australia or from England? From England?

15 ROSE: Am I from where?

16 DICK: Are you from the United Kingdom?

17 ROSE: England, yeah.

18 DICK: Okay. We have inquiries about you  
from your family.

19 ROSE: You do have inquiry?

20 DICK: Yes, we have.

21 ROSE: Okay. Can you -- go on.

22 DICK: And, you know, obviously, everybody's  
23  
24  
25

1 worried about your safety, your family members. And  
2 I'll be happy to give them a message. I'd like --  
3 frankly, I'd like to have you give the message to them  
4 yourself but if, if you won't or can't come out, then  
5 I will do that for you.

6 ROSE: You'll do that for me.

7 DICK: But, please, please, consider coming  
8 out yourself.

9 ROSE: Okay. Well, you can pass a message  
10 on for me then.

11 DICK: Okay. Give me, give me the message.

12 ROSE: You can tell my family I'm fine. I'm  
13 well.

14 DICK: You're well.

15 ROSE: And to keep the faith, the truth of  
16 the Bible.

17 DICK: Keep the faith and the truth of the  
18 Bible.

19 ROSE: Yeah. Tell them --

20 DICK: Okay.

21 ROSE: -- I stick by the Bible and they  
22 should do the same.

23 DICK: Well, --

24 ROSE: That's my message.

25 DICK: That's, that's, that's it. Okay.



1 And the telephone number you're going to send out with  
2 the child?

3 ROSE: It will be on -- it will be sent out  
4 with her.

5 DICK: Okay. Have you got a coat there for  
6 her?

7 ROSE: Pardon? Have I got coat?

8 DICK: Why don't you -- I'll tell you what,  
9 give me the telephone number, if you have it in your  
10 head now, and the address. Then we'll have it covered  
11 both ways.

12 ROSE: Okay.

13 DICK: Okay. What are your parents' names?

14 ROSE: Morrison.

15 DICK: Yeah, but I'm talking about your  
16 first name -- their first names. Both your, your  
17 mother and father?

18 ROSE: No.

19 DICK: Okay. Your mother?

20 ROSE: Yeah.

21 DICK: Okay. What is her name?

22 ROSE: Millie.

23 DICK: Millie Morrison?

24 ROSE: Yeah.

25 DICK: Okay. And what is her telephone

1 number?  
2 ROSE: It's 061 --  
3 DICK: Oh, six one --  
4 ROSE: -- 225 --  
5 DICK: Two, two five.  
6 ROSE: -- 1205.  
7 DICK: Twelve zero five.  
8 ROSE: That's right.  
9 DICK: And their address?  
10 ROSE: Five Talbott Road.  
11 DICK: Five -- I'm sorry, I didn't  
12 understand, five, what road?  
13 ROSE: Talbott.  
14 DICK: Talbott Road, okay.  
15 ROSE: That's right. That's Ladybond.  
16 DICK: Lake --  
17 ROSE: Ladybond, L-A-D- --  
18 DICK: Ladybond?  
19 ROSE: Yeah.  
20 DICK: Okay. And that's in -- is that in  
21 London or England?  
22 ROSE: That's Manchester, England, yeah.  
23 DICK: Manchester, England?  
24 ROSE: Uh-huh.  
25 DICK: Okay. And what is -- is there a zip

1 that goes with that or some sort of a code?

2 ROSE: No. No.

3 DICK: Okay.

4 ROSE: Manchester 14, if you want that.

5 DICK: Manford 14?

6 ROSE: Manchester --

7 DICK: Okay. Manchester --

8 ROSE: Fourteen.

9 DICK: Fourteen.

10 ROSE: In England, yeah.

11 DICK: England. All right.

12 ROSE: So, you're going to get that out to  
13 them?

14 DICK: We will -- we'll be in touch with  
15 them, yes. We will --

16 ROSE: Okay.

17 DICK: -- we will most definitely be in  
18 touch with them.

19 ROSE: When will that be?

20 DICK: As soon as we're able, as soon as  
21 we're able. We will, we will get to them and then  
22 we'll call you back as soon as we're able to reach  
23 them.

24 ROSE: Okay.

25 DICK: Now, is Melissa -- you got Melissa

1 ready to go here?

2 ROSE: Well, I'm going to get her ready now.

3 DICK: Okay.

4 ROSE: Okay. But she'll come out as soon as  
5 we speak with Robert.

6 DICK: As soon as you get her together,  
7 okay.

8 ROSE: As soon as we have spoken to Robert.

9 DICK: Pardon me?

10 ROSE: Pardon?

11 DICK: I'm sorry?

12 ROSE: As soon as we've spoken to Robert.

13 DICK: Well, no, that, that can't -- and the  
14 reason we can't do that is because we can't find  
15 Robert right now. Robert, as I told both David and  
16 Steven, Robert is, is not here because Robert -- when  
17 the law enforcements are involved -- law enforcement  
18 officers are involved in these kinds of things,  
19 they're given mandatory time off. They are sent away  
20 so they can get away from, from this incident.

21 ROSE: They have?

22 DICK: And so that they can sit down and  
23 write reports and that kind of thing. Now, at some  
24 point in time, we'll be happy to deliver a message to  
25 Robert and, and David will have an opportunity at a

1 point to confront him. There's absolutely no question  
2 about that. We guarantee that. But that shouldn't  
3 impact on Melissa coming out because I know you want -

4 - ROSE: Well, --

5 DICK: -- you're concerned about the safety  
6 and care of your daughter.

7 ROSE: Well, at the moment -- Anyway,  
8 there's someone here, there's a small child that wants  
9 to speak to you.

10 DICK: A small child?

11 ROSE: Yeah.

12 DICK: Get Melissa out and we'll, we'll work  
13 on the other thing. Why don't you -- get her coat on  
14 and we're ready to receive her up there at the road  
15 now. So, tell, tell David that you want to go ahead  
16 and send her out and then we'll contact the parents,  
17 your parents, your mother, and let her know.

18 ROSE: Well, we'll see how things go, okay?  
19 Good bye. Nice to speak with you.

20 DICK: Bye-bye.

21 STAR: Huh?

22 DICK: Who's this?

23 STAR: Star.

24 DICK: Star, how are you?

25 STAR: Fine.

1 DICK: Good. How's your brother and sister?  
2 STAR: Fine.  
3 DICK: Good. How's your mom and your dad?  
4 STAR: Fine.  
5 DICK: How old are you, Star? How old are  
6 you?  
7 STAR: Five.  
8 DICK: You're five years old?  
9 STAR: Yes.  
10 DICK: What -- what's your favorite toy?  
11 STAR: Barbies.  
12 DICK: Barbies. Have you got lots of  
13 Barbies?  
14 STAR: Only two.  
15 DICK: Just two Barbies?  
16 STAR: I mean I have three 'cause I have one  
17 little -- well, it's not really a Barbie, it's a  
18 little doll.  
19 DICK: A little doll. And my daughter liked  
20 Barbie dolls, too. What's your doll's name?  
21 STAR: I don't know.  
22 DICK: You don't give them a name yet? You  
23 didn't give your doll a name yet?  
24 STAR: My two big Barbies.  
25 DICK: Two big Barbies.

1 STAR: They're both-- their names are both  
2 Barbie.  
3 DICK: Both Barbie. Okay. They're both  
4 blondes, too, I'll bet, aren't they? They have blonde  
5 hair?  
6 STAR: I don't know.  
7 DICK: White hair?  
8 STAR: Yeah.  
9 DICK: How are your brothers and sisters  
10 doing?  
11 STAR: Fine.  
12 DICK: Good. How about mamma?  
13 STAR: Fine.  
14 DICK: Is David there?  
15 STAR: Yes.  
16 DICK: Could you put David back on the phone  
17 to me? Listen, you be a good girl, okay?  
18 STAR: Yes.  
19 DICK: Okay. You be a real good girl.  
20 STAR: Dick?  
21 DICK: Yeah. Are you still there? Hello.  
22 STAR: Hello.  
23 DICK: Are you still there? Can you --  
24 STAR: Yes.  
25 DICK: -- get David for me?

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STAR: Huh?

DICK: Can you get David for me, your dad?  
Can you get your dad for me?

STAR: Yeah.

DICK: Okay. You have a -- you have a nice  
day and you be a good girl. Will you do that? You do  
what your mom and dad tell you, okay?

DAVID: Oh, that hurts so much.

DICK: What does?

DAVID: I have two Barbies and both their  
names is Barbie.

DICK: I know -- I heard that. Did she get  
them both at the same time or what?

DAVID: Well, I bought all the kids here,  
the girls, a little Barbie doll.

DICK: Oh, did you?

DAVID: Yeah. And some of them had Barbies  
that were old.

DICK: Uh-huh.

DAVID: So, I bought some extra ones and  
somehow she ended up with two of them and then they  
had --

DICK: She had two of them, huh?

DAVID: -- they had a little Skipper or  
something and a little, little dolls.



1           DICK: Well, they can be twins.

2           DAVID: Yeah, but I -- you know, our kids  
3 save things and it's so serious yet --

4           DICK: Sure.

5           DAVID: -- it's so --

6           DICK: Well, they sound -- she sounds like a  
7 great little girl.

8           DAVID: Oh, they're beautiful kids.

9           DICK: You know, kids are the most fantastic  
10 things in the world.

11          DAVID: I know that more than --

12          DICK: My kids are growing up and I --  
13 especially when they're small like that.

14          DAVID: Oh, yeah.

15          DICK: My kids have grown a little, little  
16 older now and, and those kinds of things that she just  
17 said are gone and they're gone very quickly.

18          DAVID: Oh, yeah.

19          DICK: They grow so quickly. And a part of  
20 your life leaves when they leave. That, that's for  
21 sure.

22          DAVID: That's true.

23          DICK: The -- my wife and I, we elected to  
24 have two children. I wish we would have had more.

25          DAVID: Yeah, I've got -- let's see, I've

1 got one, two, three, four, five, six, seven, eight,  
2 nine, ten, eleven, twelve, thirteen, fourteen,  
3 fifteen, sixteen, seventeen -- I've got about 18 kids.

4 DICK: You've got 18 kids?

5 DAVID: Eighteen -- yeah, 19. Oh, yeah, 19.

6 DICK: Boy, they keep you busy, don't they?

7 DAVID: Yeah, it's, it's --

8 DICK: You've got 19 kids in there with you?

9 DAVID: Right, 19.

10 DICK: Those are your kids, all 19 of them?

11 DAVID: Yeah. Well, what happens is is that  
12 we've got -- we've got two of them, two of them in  
13 Hawaii right now. And they're with their mother.

14 DICK: Uh-huh.

15 DAVID: And one is in California. So --

16 DICK: Well, David, you've got a lot of  
17 memories -- you'll have a lot of memories of those  
18 kids and a lot of good times.

19 DAVID: Oh, yeah. Well, it's -- you know --

20 DICK: A lot of hard work, though.

21 DAVID: Well, yeah, to a degree but, no, not  
22 so much. It's -- you know, it's like, it's like when  
23 Isaiah talks, when he talks about Messiah, Paul quotes  
24 in Hebrew, he says, the sign -- he says, referring to  
25 Christ, he says (Indiscernible) wonders from the Lord

1 of Hosts and that's where the Messianic prophesy, they  
2 talk about Messiah and all of his children. It never  
3 was fulfilled 2000 years ago. But the promise is is  
4 not one jot or tiddle, not one jot or tiddle shall  
5 pass from the law or the prophets. They'll all be  
6 fulfilled. So, we have to repeat this, you know. The  
7 truth has to come back around again and the prophecies  
8 that have been obscured and unknown have to be brought  
9 to view and have to be fulfilled.

9 DICK: Uh-huh.

10 DAVID: Of course, today we're not in a  
11 world of swords and chariots, you know, as per se.  
12 But, of course, when we have swords that, that are as  
13 thunder and make lightning as fire, then, of course,  
14 we're talking about guns then, aren't we? So, you  
15 know, the scriptures, like I say, the ancient prophets  
16 could only illustrate the means of weaponry and the  
17 means of tactics in their day based upon what they  
18 themselves had. But, anyway --

18 DICK: David, --

19 DAVID: Sure.

20 DICK: -- are we agree or do we agree then  
21 that we're going to send Melissa out then?

22 DAVID: Oh, yeah.

23 DICK: Okay. Can you get her ready then?  
24  
25

1           DAVID: Well, you get Robert ready.  
2           DICK: Well, David, listen, --  
3           DAVID: That's what, that's what they said.  
4           DICK: -- listen to me, please.  
5           DAVID: They said, now, let's talk to  
6 Robert. Ever since I negotiated with Jim, this was  
7 supposed to have been arranged. And Robert was there  
8 for the longest time.  
9           DICK: I know that. I know that. Melissa  
10 said that she wanted to come out. And I'll tell you,  
11 I will, I will get a -- I will get a message. Send,  
12 send Melissa out and then I'll tell you what. Send  
13 Melissa out and you write a message in your own words  
14 to --  
15           DAVID: No, I need to talk to the boy --  
16           DICK: -- to Robert.  
17           DAVID: I need to talk to the boy --  
18           DICK: Pardon me?  
19           DAVID: -- word to word. I need to talk to  
20 --  
21           DICK: But let's give him that choice.  
22 Let's give him that choice, much like you're giving  
23 the choice to those folks inside. I will get the  
24 message to Robert. You send Melissa out. You pen a,  
25 a message, and you send it out tomorrow with another

1 child --

2 DAVID: Rose?

3 DICK: -- and I will get the message to  
4 Robert. And then let him make the choice.

5 DAVID: It's your decision. He's saying,  
6 send Melissa out first and pen a message to Robert and  
7 then leave it up to Robert to whether he calls us or  
8 not. Now, what do you say? Okay. Well, just wait a  
9 second.

9 ROSE: Dick?

10 DICK: Yes.

11 ROSE: I'm not going to do that, okay?

12 DICK: Why?

13 ROSE: Why?

14 DICK: Listen, you have to work together  
15 with me, okay. I'm making every effort to get this  
16 out --

17 ROSE: Look, you guys have been lying about,  
18 you know, from the beginning. And you're saying we  
19 have to cooperate with you. Yeah, we'll -- we've been  
20 cooperating. You guys have been doing all the lying.

21 DICK: That, that's not true. Please --

22 ROSE: That's not true?

23 DICK: -- please, that's not true at all.

24 ROSE: That is true.  
25

1                   DICK: That's not all true.

2                   ROSE: Well, look --

3                   DICK: I just made a proposal to, to David  
4 and to Steve as to how we can -- how we can work  
5 things out. And I just offered him an opportunity --  
6 you know, David is telling us that all you folks have  
7 the freedom to make the choice that you do. And my,  
8 my suggestion to him is that I will be very, very  
9 happy to deliver a message to Robert and then let  
10 Robert make a choice, must like the choice that you're  
11 able to make. Right now your daughter has made a  
12 choice that she wants to leave and I know you want her  
13 to leave.

14                   ROSE: My daughter -- she said she wants to  
15 leave? She said that she would leave once they've  
16 contacted Robert.

17                   DICK: That's not what she said.

18                   ROSE: She said she did not -- hold on a  
19 minute here. Hold on. I'll put her back on the  
20 phone, okay? Melissa, you tell him whether you want  
21 to leave or not. Do you want to leave?

22                   DICK: That's not --

23                   MELISSA: (Indiscernible).

24                   DICK: Hi, Melissa. You want to come out  
25 and talk to me, don't you?

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MELISSA: Huh?

DICK: You want to come out and talk to me -
