2 JOHN: Good. Well, that's good.

3 DAVID: Okay. So anyway --

4 JOHN: I know we didn't want to bother you  
5 today and we --

6 DAVID: Are you, are you -- you're not at,  
7 you're not at the sheriff's department, are you?

8 JOHN: No, no.

9 DAVID: Oh, I see. Okay. So the -- all  
10 right then.

11 JOHN: That's why we had to patch you  
12 through.

13 DAVID: Have you read that Micah 7, John?

14 JOHN: I'm sure I read it a long time ago  
15 with you.

16 DAVID: Not Micah 7.

17 JOHN: You don't think so?

18 DAVID: No.

19 JOHN: How could I have missed?

20 (Bell ringing.)

21 DAVID: See, see a lot of things is --  
22 people, people don't realize that, you know, God  
23 requires what's been in the past. Well, there's a  
24 statement in the world. You know, we have no fear of  
25 the future so we forget what, you know, has been

1 learned in the past.

2 JOHN: Yeah.

3 DAVID: But oh, boy, I tell you. It's -- I  
4 hope the best for these guys.

5 JOHN: They'll be all right.

6 DAVID: Yeah, I know they will.

7 JOHN: And they'll be, you know, well cared  
8 for. And the Sheriff's a man of his word. He  
9 doesn't, he doesn't go back on his words. And he's,  
10 he's been a real class guy to deal with here and, and  
11 he's treating everybody very fairly. Plus they'll  
12 have some -- I'm sure they've already had some legal  
13 representation. And you know --

14 DAVID: Maybe we should stock the sheriff's  
15 department up with MREs.

16 JOHN: Oh, they've got plenty of good food.  
17 Plenty --

18 DAVID: Yeah.

19 JOHN: -- plenty of good, fresh food.

20 DAVID: Yeah.

21 JOHN: Don't you think so?

22 DAVID: Yeah. (Laughing.)

23 JOHN: Some home cooking, huh? Yeah.

24 DAVID: Some homely cooking. (Laughing.)

25 JOHN: Oh, no. Don't say, don't say that to

1 the man.

2 DAVID: Hey, you haven't eaten --

3 JOHN: He's been pretty gracious to  
4 everybody here.

5 DAVID: I've, I've eaten down there before.

6 JOHN: Have you?

7 DAVID: Yeah. (Laughing.)

8 JOHN: Don't tell me it wasn't much to write  
9 home about. Because he was pretty gracious to all of  
10 us.

11 DAVID: Well, he was, you know, they, they  
12 did us real good when we was down there last time.

13 JOHN: Sure. Sure. We going to get  
14 something working this evening?

15 DAVID: We're working on it.

16 JOHN: Good. Good.

17 DAVID: Like I say it's -- when, when you  
18 get forced into the Scriptures a lot of the things are  
19 not readily understood.

20 JOHN: Um-hum.

21 DAVID: People don't realize that, that what  
22 naturally is accepted in this generation as being just  
23 business is condemned by God.

24 JOHN: Um-hum.

25 DAVID: So you know, it's just like where do

1 you start with somebody, John? Where do you start?  
2 Where do you find a level point in the mind of one man  
3 towards another to where you can start building up on  
4 the, the foundation? You know, you could say well,  
5 look at Christ. But of course, not everybody is like  
6 Christ. People can't do what he did, right?

6 JOHN: Sure. That's right.

7 DAVID: Then how come God let him do it, and  
8 God let the apostles do it, and somehow somebody has  
9 missed the boat and no one can do that no more?  
10 Wonder what happened? Somebody went wrong somewhere,  
11 huh?

11 JOHN: You bet. You bet.

12 DAVID: We got to find out where the kink in  
13 the (indiscernible) of the hose is, don't we?

14 JOHN: Well --

15 DAVID: Oh, wouldn't it be --

16 JOHN: -- got a few, a few kinks in the  
17 hose, huh?

18 DAVID: Yeah, a few of them.

19 JOHN: That's for sure. Listen, we, we had  
20 a request from the Sheriff earlier when, when I  
21 discussed some things with the, the fellows that  
22 relieved me this morning --

22 DAVID: Uh-huh.

1                   JOHN:  -- I told them that, that we expected  
2 a female this evening.

3                   DAVID:  Right.

4                   JOHN:  And we got a request just a little  
5 while ago, Jack, the Sheriff, contacted us and wanted  
6 to make sure that a female was coming, because they  
7 were making arrangements for a female.

8                   DAVID:  Okay.

9                   JOHN:  And is it safe to go ahead and  
10 reassure him that he can plan on that?

11                   DAVID:  Yeah, see --

12                   JOHN:  Okay.

13                   DAVID:  -- Rita, like I said, Rita is, Rita  
14 is kind of petrified.

15                   JOHN:  Well --

16                   DAVID:  And she's, she's just --

17                   JOHN:  Try to be reassuring to her, because  
18 I sure tried last night to talk to her.  And, and I'll  
19 be happy to, to, you know, if you want me to talk to  
20 her again this evening, I'll be happy to do that too.

21                   But --

22                   DAVID:  Well, I mean she's, she's more  
23 concerned about her spiritual interests than she is  
24 about her --

25                   JOHN:  Sure.

1           DAVID:  -- her civil rights.

2           JOHN:  Hey.  Well, you, you know she's going  
3 to be able to keep her Bible.  You know she's going to  
4 be able to keep up with everything from a spiritual  
5 standpoint.  And none of that's going to be taken away  
6 from her.  And it's not going to be hampered in any  
7 way.  So we're certainly not going to do that.

8           DAVID:  Okay.

9           JOHN:  We respect that.  But they are  
10 setting aside so many facilities for females if, if  
11 there are females coming out and, and we're certainly  
12 prepared to handle her and anybody else at any time  
13 you want to let us know.

14           DAVID:  Okay.  Like I say it's -- what we're  
15 doing right now is we're just getting confirmations.

16           JOHN:  Sure.  Well, and be --

17           DAVID:  You ever gone to the, you ever gone  
18 to the priest before and made confession?

19           JOHN:  Many times.

20           DAVID:  Before, before you went on a job?

21           JOHN:  Sometimes it was lengthier than  
22 others.

23           DAVID:  (Laughing.)

24           JOHN:  And I sure have.  Sure have.

25           DAVID:  I believe you.



1 JOHN: You know, I really have. And --

2 DAVID: I don't, I don't take confessionals.

3 I just, I just --

4 JOHN: No, but --

5 DAVID: -- confirm to people --

6 JOHN: -- you listen and you, you're  
7 supportive of people. And you listen to them, and  
8 you're giving them some support. And that's what they  
9 need.

10 DAVID: These guys, old Kevin and Brad, were  
11 really messes in the beginning --

12 JOHN: (Laughing.) So you have to use a  
13 carrot, a stick?

14 DAVID: No, no. Like I say, people meet me  
15 and --

16 JOHN: They do.

17 DAVID: They meet me and they, you know, you  
18 got to be all things to all men. And they try to  
19 figure me out. And I start talking to them. And like  
20 Brad was in a bar, was down at a club one night.  
21 And --

22 JOHN: Uh-huh.

23 DAVID: -- Brad was there drinking a beer.  
24 And he was -- and Brad's the kind of guy that spends  
25 all his money on everybody else. And he's sitting

1 | there and he, he says hey, want a beer, want a beer,  
2 | want a beer. You know, like one of these kind of  
3 | guys, right?

4 |                 JOHN: Uh-huh.

5 |                 DAVID: And I was talking to the owner about  
6 | the card, Cyrus Production card, and some of the  
7 | passages on it. And, and this guy says oh, wow. He  
8 | says you know, he says I used to go to church years  
9 | ago. He says but I never learned anything like this.  
10 | And we was talking, and Brad overheard us and he, he  
11 | butted in and started telling us all about the  
12 | revelations and about all these different things. So  
13 | I sat there and listened to him for about, I don't  
14 | know --

15 |                 JOHN: Uh-huh.

16 |                 DAVID: -- thirty minutes to an hour. I  
17 | says really, really, really. So anyway, he was just  
18 | really getting off, because somebody was listening to  
19 | him, you know? So then I started asking him questions  
20 | and --

21 |                 JOHN: Put him on the spot.

22 |                 DAVID: Well, you know, and before you know  
23 | it we went off to Denny's and had dinner together, and  
24 | we started opening up to Scriptures, and we met a U.S.  
25 | marshal there that was sitting next to us.

1                   JOHN: Um-hum.

2                   DAVID: And we started opening up Scriptures  
3 to him and stuff. And then we just had a real good  
4 time that night. And he's been, you know, ever since  
5 he's just, he's just been real hungry to know these  
6 things.

7                   JOHN: That's great. Really is. And  
8 because --

9                   DAVID: Because we are --

10                  JOHN: -- a lot of people have that thirst  
11 for knowledge, and they don't know where to reach for  
12 it, where to grasp for it.

13                  DAVID: They don't know where the real  
14 source comes from. They don't know about God on the  
15 throne. They don't know about the path that God's  
16 already laid out for all men to see.

17                  JOHN: No, and you got so many, so many  
18 youngsters that, you know, their, their families are  
19 supportive up to a certain point. And then they,  
20 they're "mature", right. And they, they're out on  
21 their own, and they start swaying away from it. And a  
22 lot of us have, have done that over the years. And  
23 then we realize there's something there for, for us,  
24 and we better get back in touch with our God.

25                  DAVID: Maybe mom and dad were smarter than

1 we thought.

2 JOHN: Yeah. You bet. You bet.

3 DAVID: Yeah, absolutely. You know, theory,  
4 when, when it comes to theory, theory doesn't work in  
5 reality. And a lot of kids have a lot of theories  
6 given to them about God. When it comes to a working  
7 reality, that God is not really there when they need  
8 it. And so they don't understand that truth has a  
9 certain curriculum that has to be followed.

9 Like Brad, Brad has always been a, had a  
10 problem with alcohol, you know.

11 JOHN: Yeah.

12 DAVID: And there's a lot of people out  
13 there in the streets of LA and stuff that I've, that  
14 I've dealt with and stuff that, you know, "have a love  
15 for God." But of course, their God doesn't give them  
16 power to overcome their vice.

17 JOHN: Um-hum.

18 DAVID: And, and they felt very separate and  
19 lost, and they feel like they're going to hell. But  
20 they don't understand according to the covenants that  
21 in the latter days God allows vices to rule over his  
22 people, because it keeps them humble. You know --

23 JOHN: Sure.

24 DAVID: -- you get a guy that, that seems to  
25

1 be doing well in life and, and goes to church and, and  
2 seems to do everything that he thinks is right. He  
3 gets very proud and arrogant, you know. Very self-  
4 righteous. You know, and it's like Christ explains in  
5 the parable. He says there was a Pharisee in the  
6 synagogue, and then there was a sinner. And the  
7 Pharisee says I thank thee, O God, that I'm not  
8 another man. I pay tithes of all of that I own. And  
9 I fast twice a --

9 JOHN: There's a lot more to it than just  
10 going to church though, isn't there?

11 DAVID: Well, exactly.

12 JOHN: Sure. Sure.

13 DAVID: Going to church, Christ talks about  
14 your body being the temple of God. You are a walking  
15 church if you have the knowledge of truth in you.  
16 It's a 24-hour-a-day thing, 7-day-a-week thing.

17 JOHN: Yeah. Yeah.

18 DAVID: And the church is supposed to be  
19 for --

20 JOHN: Well, these guys are --

21 DAVID: -- instruction.

22 JOHN: You know, David -- David -- Kevin and  
23 Brad are -- I'm sure they've appreciated this, you  
24 know. And, and they're learning a lot from it. And  
25

1 they've got a lot more to learn. You know. But at  
2 least they'll have the opportunity to do it. The one  
3 thing that we certainly don't have any intention to do  
4 and, and I mean we on the outside which includes the  
5 sheriff's department and everyone else is to  
6 jeopardize anybody's religious freedoms. You know,  
7 they're cherished freedoms and, and they have to be  
8 respected. And if, you know, you can reassure Rita  
9 and anyone else that no one's going to interfere with  
10 those freedoms and those rights and they can't.

10 DAVID: Well, they already have. But like I  
11 say, it deals with a misunderstanding that --

12 JOHN: Well, they're not going to do it  
13 when, when they come out, that's for sure. In  
14 addition to the, the legal representation, nobody's  
15 going to interfere with their religious beliefs or  
16 their convictions or their ability to, to continue  
17 their, their study.

17 DAVID: Now whether we're bonded in the  
18 flesh as long as we know where our minds are we can be  
19 free in our spirits.

19 JOHN: Sure. You're absolutely right.

20 DAVID: John the Revelator was bonded in the  
21 flesh on the Isle of Patmos. He was considered a  
22 treasonist (sic). He was considered a bad person.

1 But of course, in the spirit he was in heavenly  
2 places, wasn't he?

3 JOHN: Yeah.

4 DAVID: Okay. All right, so let me finish  
5 up working here and --

6 JOHN: Okay.

7 DAVID: -- we'll get something going and --

8 JOHN: Would you --

9 DAVID: -- and we'll give you a call back  
10 real quick, okay?

11 JOHN: Okay. Would you let me talk to Steve  
12 for a minute?

13 DAVID: Okay.

14 JOHN: If he's around. Because I've got a  
15 message to give to him.

16 DAVID: Okay. Here. Rachel, take the phone  
17 to Steve.

18 JOHN: Thanks.

19 [gap]

20 RACHEL: Hello?

21 JOHN: Hello, Rachel.

22 RACHEL: John Cox.

23 JOHN: You're right.

24 RACHEL: How are you?

25 JOHN: Fine. How about yourself?

1 RACHEL: Good.

2 JOHN: Good.

3 RACHEL: Here -- Steve, he just went to get  
4 a bite to eat, that's all.

5 JOHN: He did?

6 RACHEL: Yeah.

7 JOHN: I bet he doesn't want a What A  
8 Burger, huh? Not after what --

9 RACHEL: What A Burger --

10 JOHN: Not after what David told me last  
11 night.

12 RACHEL: Really greasy, nasty. We've --

13 JOHN: David really put one on me last night  
14 about What A Burger.

15 RACHEL: David said they were going to go to  
16 hell. (Laughing.)

17 JOHN: (Laughing.) Particularly the chicken  
18 sandwiches.

19 RACHEL: Oh, really?

20 JOHN: Yeah. He said those chickens are  
21 laying around for 30 --

22 RACHEL: The devil -- sorry. He said the  
23 devil wouldn't eat it. (Laughing.)

24 JOHN: (Laughing.) Could be.

25 RACHEL: Fuddruckers is a little better --



1 JOHN: Depends how hungry the devil gets.

2 RACHEL: Yeah. Well, you know, he's a  
3 health reformer that, you know?

4 JOHN: Uh-huh.

5 RACHEL: Here's Steve.

6 JOHN: Thank you.

7 [gap]

8 STEVE: Hello, John?

9 JOHN: Hey.

10 STEVE: What's happening?

11 JOHN: I had a message from John 2.

12 STEVE: Okay.

13 JOHN: That I guess he spoke to you about  
14 talking to your sister, Susan.

15 STEVE: Okay.

16 JOHN: And the attorney and the legal  
17 process and everything. And he left me a note to tell  
18 you from her that when you come out she'll be there  
19 to, to see you.

20 STEVE: Oh, really?

21 JOHN: And -- yeah.

22 STEVE: Well, she doesn't need to do that.

23 JOHN: Well, I think she's made her mind up  
24 that she wants to see you and let you know that she  
25 loves you.

1                   STEVE: Okay.

2                   JOHN: Hey, it's the right thing. I spoke  
3 to David last night, because I missed you last night.  
4 You, you must have snuck out and decided that you  
5 wanted to get some sleep last night, huh?

6                   STEVE: Yeah, I think I did.

7                   JOHN: Well, I got to spend a little time  
8 with --

9                   STEVE: You did, huh?

10                  JOHN: -- with David last night. Yeah, and  
11 he snookered me. Four hours and five minutes worth.

12                  STEVE: Four hours and five minutes he said  
13 he talked with you last night. (Laughing.)

14                  JOHN: His nose is --

15                  STEVE: John, were you -- you were timing  
16 it, huh?

17                  JOHN: Hey, his nose is growing too.

18                  STEVE: He says your nose is growing too.

19                  JOHN: Yeah. When I talked to him, I  
20 mentioned to him that we had had some messages for  
21 several people in there.

22                  STEVE: Okay.

23                  JOHN: And after he gets done --

24                  STEVE: Did you want to pass, did you want  
25 to pass them on now maybe or --

1                   JOHN: Well, he -- I know he's busy, you  
2 know. He's doing something right now. He's --

3                   STEVE: Yeah.

4                   JOHN: -- he's talking to some folks. And  
5 one of the people that we had a message from was a  
6 Sandra Hardial, H-A-R-D-I-A-L. And he --

7                   STEVE: Want me to call her to the phone  
8 then or --

9                   JOHN: He said he didn't have any record of  
10 her being --

11                   STEVE: He didn't, he didn't never -- no,  
12 none of us really ever knew her last name.

13                   JOHN: Okay.

14                   STEVE: But, but I do know of such a person  
15 here. But I even myself --

16                   JOHN: Okay.

17                   STEVE: -- didn't know what her last name  
18 was.

19                   JOHN: Okay. What I would like to do is  
20 once he, once he talks --

21                   STEVE: They, they call her Sandra. So that  
22 might have thrown him off too.

23                   JOHN: Okay. Once he talks to Rita, and he  
24 talks to the other folks and --

25                   STEVE: Yeah.

1                   JOHN:  -- we resolve that issue, why don't  
2 we make arrangements to talk to her and, and maybe  
3 some of the other folks.

4                   STEVE:  All right.  So you --

5                   JOHN:  Okay?

6                   STEVE:  Not just yet then.

7                   JOHN:  No.

8                   STEVE:  So I'll give you a call -- after  
9 he's talking do you want to call me, or I'll call you  
or something?

10                  JOHN:  When he's done doing whatever --

11                  STEVE:  Okay.

12                  JOHN:  -- lecture with Rita and Rita -- you  
13 know, he wants to --

14                  STEVE:  (Indiscernible) lecture with Rita  
and all that I --

15                  JOHN:  He said that he wanted to talk to  
16 her, and kind of reaffirm the fact that yes, she'll be  
17 able to take her Bible.  She'll be able to continue  
18 her religious study and, and there were some others  
that he --

19                  STEVE:  Okay.

20                  JOHN:  -- wanted to talk to.  So why  
21 don't --

22                  STEVE:  So give you a call then?

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JOHN: Yeah.

STEVE: Okay.

JOHN: Give, give me a call when, when  
you're done doing that.

STEVE: Sounds good.

JOHN: Okay?

STEVE: Talk to you then.

JOHN: Thank you.

STEVE: Bye.

STEVE: Hello.

JOHN: Steve?

STEVE: Yes.

JOHN: How we coming along?

STEVE: Just a minute.

[gap]

STEVE: How, how we coming along?

DAVID: Tell him leave us alone until we get  
this done.

JOHN: (Whispering.) He's pissed.

DAVID: We're working on it.

STEVE: Okay. We're working on it still.

JOHN: Good.

STEVE: Yeah.

JOHN: Good.

1                 STEVE: And I'm, and I'm going to call you  
2 just as soon as we're done.

3                 JOHN: Do you need, need me to answer any  
4 questions?

5                 DAVID: Okay, now --

6                 STEVE: Not at the moment.

7                 DAVID: When it says (indiscernible) --

8                 JOHN: Okay, fine.

9                 STEVE: Yeah.

10                JOHN: Thanks.

11                STEVE: I'll be giving you a call.

12                JOHN: Thank you.

13                STEVE: Okay, sure. Bye.

14                JOHN: Bye-bye.

15                                     \* \* \*

16                JOHN: Hello?

17                STEVE: Hello, John?

18                JOHN: Hey, how are you?

19                STEVE: Not too bad.

20                JOHN: Good.

21                STEVE: Hey, do you have in your records  
22 there if a Herbert Leon has called in from Britain at  
23 all?

24                JOHN: I do not have that name right in  
25 front of me. Do you know --

1 STEVE: It's his --

2 JOHN: Hang on. Hang on. Let me flip  
3 through a couple of things. You got a second?

4 STEVE: Yeah.

5 JOHN: Hold on. Just doesn't ring a bell.  
6 We had the --

7 STEVE: He said he's an actor that's been in  
8 like I think it's Alien 3 and a number of other  
9 movies.

10 JOHN: What we've had is many of the calls  
11 coming for any of the Brits were from the British  
12 Consul.

13 STEVE: Oh, they're -- most of them are from  
14 the consul.

15 JOHN: Many were and --

16 STEVE: Yeah.

17 JOHN: -- I've got the name of the vice  
18 consul that called for, you know, to give the message  
19 to Melissa. And I'd really have to look through some  
20 other things but --

21 STEVE: Okay.

22 JOHN: -- in the list in front of me are the  
23 names that I gave David last night. I did not have  
24 that name at all, and it doesn't ring a bell.

25 STEVE: Okay, let --

1                   JOHN:  And I've been, I've been looking  
2 through everything I can find --  
3                   STEVE:  -- let me check on the last name  
4 then real quick.  
5                   JOHN:  Okay.  
6                   STEVE:  Just a minute.  
7                   JOHN:  Okay.  
8                   [*gap*]  
9                   (Radio playing in background.)  
10                  STEVE:  Yeah, I've got it right here.  
11                  JOHN:  Okay.  
12                  STEVE:  His mother is here, and her name is  
13 Victoria Hollingsworth.  What?  Victorian.  
14                  JOHN:  It's a male?  
15                  STEVE:  No, it's his mother.  
16                  JOHN:  Okay.  Hollingsworth.  
17                  STEVE:  Yeah.  
18                  JOHN:  And it would have been Leon is the  
19 fellow's last name?  
20                  STEVE:  That's her son, yes.  Last name  
21 Leon.  
22                  JOHN:  Okay.  And his first name was what?  
23                  STEVE:  The first name was Herbert.  
24                  JOHN:  Uh-uh.  
25                  STEVE:  Nothing there?



1                   JOHN: Nothing that I have. And I've got a  
2 list of -- I can tell you right now --

3                   STEVE: Let me find the -- okay.

4                   JOHN: -- the British Consul General's  
5 Office inquired initially, okay, about a lot of  
6 people --

7                   STEVE: Okay.

8                   JOHN: -- who they believed were in there --

9                   STEVE: John, can we, can we give you a  
10 number where he could be called?

11                   JOHN: They, they just want us to -- she'd  
12 just like to have us call and give some assurances?

13                   STEVE: Well, and probably --

14                   JOHN: Sure.

15                   STEVE: -- make some kind of a connection  
16 for her. Or I'm not sure what. You know, she's,  
17 she's an older person that was here and, and --

18                   JOHN: Uh-huh.

19                   STEVE: -- has been during this whole time  
20 right from the time it started has been sick in bed.

21                   JOHN: Well --

22                   STEVE: In fact, through all of this she's  
23 lost weight. Hey, I don't even know if he's going to  
24 recognize her after the last few weeks. She's man,  
25 lost a lot of weight.

1                   JOHN: Why don't we try and do something for  
2 her, huh?

3                   STEVE: That's true.

4                   JOHN: You know?

5                   STEVE: She's been too sick to even want to  
6 worry about it for a while. But now I, I think she's  
7 doing a little better so, you know, now we can at  
8 least make -- hope that she can maybe make it out  
9 okay.

10                  JOHN: Well, you can have a couple of people  
11 help her out.

12                  STEVE: That's true.

13                  JOHN: I don't mean that they have to do  
14 anything themselves but can walk --

15                  STEVE: Right.

16                  JOHN: -- walk her out there and --

17                  STEVE: Well, that's true.

18                  JOHN: Hey, we'd be happy to, to meet her.

19                  STEVE: Okay.

20                  JOHN: Do you have a number in a town or  
21 something like that? And I can try --

22                  STEVE: Yeah.

23                  JOHN: -- and research. Because --

24                  STEVE: Sure.

25                  JOHN: -- I'm looking at a list that I had

1 from the British Consul General's Office, and her name  
2 is not on it.

3 STEVE: All right. Vicky, do you have a  
4 number or would you have, would you have to get it, or  
5 do you know it? Okay. Here it is.

6 JOHN: Go ahead.

7 STEVE: (Vicky's voice in background not  
8 discernible.) It's what? 071 --

9 JOHN: Uh-huh.

10 STEVE: -- 263 --

11 JOHN: Uh-huh.

12 STEVE: -- 6973.

13 JOHN: Okay. And where is that?

14 STEVE: That would be London I would  
15 imagine.

16 JOHN: Okay.

17 STEVE: I think that to call out of here I  
18 think it's like 011 and then --

19 JOHN: Okay.

20 STEVE: 11 -- yeah. 011 and then it's 44  
21 and then the number you have.

22 JOHN: 01144.

23 STEVE: Yeah. And then the number you have  
24 there.

25 JOHN: Okay. Well, we can sure, sure try

1 and get a hold of him --

2 STEVE: Okay.

3 JOHN: -- and let him know that, you know --

4 STEVE: Let me ask how they want to connect  
5 on that or, or just what might, what they might want  
6 to do here. Just a minute.

7 JOHN: Yeah. Yeah.

8 [gap]

9 (Unidentified voices in background not  
10 discernible.)

11 JOHN: We threw that bone once. Tell him  
12 that we can maybe try and make the call, and give her  
13 a message.

14 STEVE: Okay. I guess it would be good if  
15 her, you know, if you could let her know, I mean let  
16 him know about being here for her. And we're still  
17 working with Rita coming out right now.

18 JOHN: Okay.

19 STEVE: But it seems like she's getting  
20 ready to come out herself --

21 JOHN: Okay.

22 STEVE: -- Vicky is, so.

23 JOHN: Well, do you think Vicky could come  
24 out with Rita maybe?

25 STEVE: That, that sounds good. That

1 probably would be a big help.

2 JOHN: I'll, I'll tell you what we could do.

3 STEVE: Okay.

4 JOHN: Is if you want her to do that, we  
5 would, we would try and hook her right up with him on  
6 the phone.

7 STEVE: Okay, just a minute.

8 JOHN: If you want us to try and do that.

9 [gap]

10 STEVE: I guess if, if (indiscernible) Vicky  
11 up with Rita and he could just hook her up with him on  
12 the phone (indiscernible). (Unidentified voices in  
13 background not discernible.)

14 UNIDENTIFIED MALE SPEAKER: Let's get her  
15 out. Let's get her out.

16 STEVE: Could you have what? Oh. She's  
17 saying, she -- Vicky I mean. She's right here. And  
18 she's asking me, she says could I have a couple of  
19 days? Because I'm still feeling sick, and I don't  
20 know if I can be getting up yet.

21 JOHN: Well, the best thing to do is  
22 probably --

23 STEVE: And, and David's saying that she  
24 needs to go as soon as possible because of that --

25 JOHN: Well --

1                   STEVE:  -- because she's been down and out  
2 for quite a while now.

3                   JOHN:  Why, why don't you and David try and  
4 encourage her to --

5                   STEVE:  Yeah, he is.  He, he --

6                   JOHN:  -- come out.  And we've got --

7                   STEVE:  He has been.

8                   JOHN:  -- we've got the medical assistance  
9 right down at the end of that road.  And --

10                  STEVE:  Vicky, he says --

11                  JOHN:  -- when we --

12                  STEVE:  -- they got the medical, you know,  
13 everything that you might need.

14                  JOHN:  We've had the doctors talk to people  
15 and, on the phone before, and we've had doctors tend  
16 to people coming out.

17                  STEVE:  Right.

18                  JOHN:  She can come out with Rita.  We can  
19 get her to some medical attention and get her on the  
20 phone with her son and he can be -- she can be  
21 reassuring to her son when she comes out.

22                  STEVE:  Yeah.  Just a minute.  Yeah.

23                  JOHN:  And, and the other thing that could  
24 be done is Rita probably could make a phone call back  
25 in and let you know that she's made contact with her

1 son and everything's fine.

2           STEVE: Okay. Just a minute. (David's  
3 voice in background not discernible.) Oh, she was  
4 even -- well, I don't know.

5           JOHN: What?

6           STEVE: You mean what cars do we have left?  
7 I don't know. Most of them are bullet shot up and --

8           JOHN: What?

9           STEVE: -- you know, like Rita had a real  
10 nice car. It was one of those Preludes, a Honda  
11 Prelude. But --

12          JOHN: Uh-huh.

13          STEVE: -- just Friday the tank came in and  
14 shoved her car all over the place along with the bus  
15 and a number, a couple, three, four cars here.

16          JOHN: Well, you know, we have one of those  
17 Bradleys that is --

18          STEVE: Ooh, man. I don't know if she could  
19 handle that.

20          JOHN: No. No, no. I don't --

21          STEVE: Okay.

22          JOHN: Hey. I'm not talking about somebody  
23 driving a Bradley. We have --

24          STEVE: No, I know. Not, not  
25 (indiscernible) --

1                   JOHN:  -- a Bradley that is an ambulance,  
2 okay?

3                   STEVE:  Okay.

4                   JOHN:  It's designed as an ambulance.  And  
5 we can have that Bradley right up the road and -- hold  
6 on just a second.

7                   STEVE:  All right.

8                   JOHN:  Hold on.

9                   [gap]

10                  STEVE:  He's checking on it now.

11                  DAVID:  We still got keys to the Blazer  
12 still, don't we?

13                  STEVE:  I guess.  He's talking about  
14 bringing a Bradley right up here.  The ambulance  
15 Bradley.

16                  DAVID:  Right up to the, to the front?

17                  STEVE:  Pretty close anyway.  Whatever we  
18 want.

19                  DAVID:  They, they can probably do that.

20                  STEVE:  All right.  He's talking about  
21 tonight, you know.  He's talking about now, this  
22 minute.  Okay.

23                  VICKY:  (Indiscernible.)

24                  DAVID:  You need to go, Vicky.  I mean let's  
25 start exercising some faith in what I'm doing.



1 VICKY: (Indiscernible.)  
2 JOHN: Steve. Steven.  
3 STEVE: Yes.  
4 JOHN: Okay. Going through a couple of  
5 options here. And, and I want your help on it. Okay?  
6 STEVE: Okay.  
7 JOHN: Your help and David's help. We can  
8 get a Bradley up pretty close if, if that would be of  
9 assistance.  
10 STEVE: Okay, I, I --  
11 JOHN: I mean -- and I don't mean in any  
12 threatening manner or anything.  
13 STEVE: No, no, no. I think that would be  
14 okay --  
15 JOHN: Because we have one that is designed  
16 like an ambulance would --  
17 STEVE: Okay.  
18 JOHN: -- have a doctor in it. Okay?  
19 STEVE: Okay.  
20 JOHN: And maybe Rita could help her out or  
21 anybody else could help her out into the Bradley, and  
22 then the two of them could leave that way. And she  
23 could -- Rita could be a little more reassuring to  
24 her, huh?  
25 STEVE: Well, yeah. He's, he's mentioning

1 | how Rita could be a little more reassuring to her  
2 | and --

3 |           DAVID: Rita is a basket job.

4 |           STEVE: And right now David's saying to me  
5 | Rita's a basket job right now.

6 |           JOHN: Well, do you have somebody else  
7 | then --

8 |           STEVE: Do, do we have someone else that  
9 | could --

10 |           JOHN: -- that could help the two of them?

11 |           STEVE: -- two of them that could help her?

12 |           JOHN: You know?

13 |           STEVE: Possibly he says.

14 |           DAVID: Tell him I'll call

15 | (indiscernible) --

16 |           JOHN: You know, I know --

17 |           STEVE: Can he, can he call you back in 15?  
18 | Because we haven't really, you know --

19 |           JOHN: You can, sure. But I, I know if, if  
20 | you're concerned about, you know, he mentioned others,  
21 | you know --

22 |           STEVE: Yeah.

23 |           JOHN: -- look at the others and see if  
24 | maybe they --

25 |           STEVE: Right.

1                   JOHN:  -- could help the two of the ladies  
2 out of there if Rita's really having some problems.  
3 And we can have Victoria hooked up or at least try.  I  
4 mean dial a number and see if her son is there and,  
5 and put her on the phone with him.  If it's necessary  
6 for Rita to drive her car out --

7                   STEVE:  Excuse me.  Yeah, but you know Vicky  
8 is doing very physically, mentally very poorly.

9                   JOHN:  Yeah, yeah.

10                  STEVE:  So you, she said --

11                  JOHN:  Well, we want to get her to a  
12 hospital then.  And if, and if it's essential that  
13 Rita drive a car out, we can do it.  You know, we'd  
14 rather not.

15                  STEVE:  Yeah.

16                  JOHN:  But if it's a necessary thing, we can  
17 do it.

18                  STEVE:  Okay.  Yeah, well let me call you in  
19 15 minutes.

20                  JOHN:  Fine.

21                  STEVE:  Okay.  I'll call you right then,  
22 John.

23                  JOHN:  Okay, 15 on the money.

24                  STEVE:  Right.

25                  JOHN:  All right.

1 STEVE: Okay. Bye.

2 \* \* \*

3 JOHN: Hello?

4 STEVE: John?

5 JOHN: Yeah.

6 STEVE: Yeah. I just wanted to make sure I  
7 called on time. He's still working with them. You  
8 know she is -- the older lady she is, she's sick. And  
9 she is -- he's trying to convince her and talk to her  
10 that --

11 JOHN: Okay.

12 STEVE: -- that now she'll get to hell and  
13 that --

14 JOHN: Sure.

15 STEVE: -- you know, she just -- she's  
16 pleading and asking if she can't lay down yet until  
17 maybe at least daylight and --

18 JOHN: Well --

19 STEVE: And --

20 JOHN: Let me tell you what we can work out.

21 STEVE: Okay.

22 JOHN: We can, we can bring one of those  
23 Bradleys right on up to the bend of the road.

24 STEVE: Okay.

25 JOHN: I guess there are some lights out

1 | there.

2 |           STEVE: Right.

3 |           JOHN: We can bring it right up there, one  
4 | of them that's designed as an ambulance and --

5 |           STEVE: Okay.

6 |           JOHN: -- you can have Rita and whomever  
7 | else you want to have --

8 |           STEVE: Right.

9 |           JOHN: -- bring her right on out. And  
10 | whoever comes out just will plan on leaving.

11 |           STEVE: All right.

12 |           JOHN: Okay? And there will be medical  
13 | assistance in the Bradley.

14 |           STEVE: Okay.

15 |           JOHN: All right? And then we will go  
16 | through the same procedure we've gone with everyone  
17 | else. And we will certainly make arrangements for her  
18 | to speak to Herbert, her son.

19 |           STEVE: All right. Okay, let --

20 |           JOHN: And you can be, you know --

21 |           STEVE: Right.

22 |           JOHN: -- be as reassuring to her as you can  
23 | and --

24 |           STEVE: Right. I have been.

25 |           JOHN: -- and let David do it. And if it

1 takes two people to help her --

2 STEVE: Um-hum.

3 JOHN: -- if it takes four people to help  
4 her, whatever it takes, you know, you be the judge of  
5 that. And, and David be the judge and hey. We don't,  
6 we don't want anything to happen to the woman. We  
7 know you don't either.

7 STEVE: Okay --

8 JOHN: You know, so we're all looking out  
9 for her welfare --

10 STEVE: Right.

11 JOHN: -- and her well-being and --

12 STEVE: Okay. Let me go back in and try to  
13 help her and encourage her a little bit, and see if we  
14 can't get her going --

14 JOHN: Just use your best judgment --

15 STEVE: We're doing --

16 JOHN: -- you know. You've been working  
17 hard. You've been working hard in the past --

18 STEVE: Oh, yeah, believe me.

19 JOHN: -- and --

20 STEVE: Voice is again is getting kind of  
21 sore.

22 JOHN: Let's just continue to build on the  
23 good things just like we're doing now.

24

25

1 STEVE: We're doing it. We're doing it.  
2 JOHN: Okay.  
3 STEVE: Okay. I'll call you right back.  
4 JOHN: About how long?  
5 STEVE: I, I don't know. You know, as long  
6 as I'm --  
7 JOHN: Well --  
8 STEVE: -- still going to talk to her. And  
9 I'm hoping to get her going here real quick.  
10 JOHN: Ten, fifteen minutes or --  
11 STEVE: Well, I hope. But you know, I  
12 mean --  
13 JOHN: Okay.  
14 STEVE: -- he's even trying to talk to her  
15 now and --  
16 JOHN: That's all right. That's all right.  
17 STEVE: -- tears are coming from her eyes  
18 and all that.  
19 JOHN: Hey, hey. Do what you have to do.  
20 STEVE: Okay.  
21 JOHN: Okay?  
22 STEVE: I'll call you, I'll call you back.  
23 JOHN: Thank you, Steve.  
24 STEVE: Sure. Bye.  
25 JOHN: Bye.

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\* \* \*

STEVE: Hello?

JOHN: Hey, Steve.

STEVE: Yeah.

JOHN: How's it going?

STEVE: Okay, we're getting it pretty now --  
we're just about done.

JOHN: Great.

STEVE: We kind of worked out now and --

JOHN: God bless you.

STEVE: Good.

JOHN: You're doing good.

STEVE: He says, yeah, can you get the  
Bradley ready then? The ambulance one?

JOHN: Yeah. All you have to do is tell us,  
you know, 2 or 3 minutes or something like that and --

STEVE: Okay.

JOHN: -- and then we'll call you back and  
go through the numbers with you.

STEVE: Yeah, well, he's just about done.  
And I've been talking to them. And we're just trying  
to get the last few minutes --

JOHN: Hey, just be strong with them, huh?

STEVE: Oh, yeah. I have been. You know,  
it's, it's not been easy. Because --



1                   JOHN: Oh, I know. I know.

2                   STEVE: Physically sick and all that and --

3                   JOHN: I know.

4                   STEVE: Like she's never gotten up since  
5 even before this all happened.

6                   JOHN: Hey. She relies on David. She --

7                   STEVE: Yeah.

8                   JOHN: -- relies on you and --

9                   STEVE: Oh, yeah.

10                  JOHN: -- everybody else in there. And  
11 that's who she's been relying on for years probably.

12                  STEVE: Yeah. So we're trying to talk her,  
13 you know --

14                  JOHN: Good.

15                  STEVE: -- it will be okay. And you know,  
16 just, just hang in there so --

17                  JOHN: Good.

18                  STEVE: I'll give you a call right back.

19                  JOHN: You got any idea if, if it's just  
20 going to be --

21                  STEVE: I think it's just moments, you know.  
22 Because --

23                  JOHN: The two of them, or is someone else  
24 going to help them out?

25                  STEVE: I don't know. Because I'm starting

1 to talk to a few more.

2 JOHN: Okay. Just --

3 STEVE: So --

4 JOHN: -- do what you have to do.

5 STEVE: Okay.

6 JOHN: And you call me back.

7 STEVE: Okay. I'll do that.

8 JOHN: Thank you.

9 STEVE: Sure. Bye.

10 \* \* \*

11 STEVE: Hello, John?

12 JOHN: Yes, sir.

13 STEVE: Yeah. Well, tell you what we're  
14 working on right now. We're talking to the two  
15 nurses.

16 JOHN: Uh-huh.

17 STEVE: And Vicky, she's, she's in the  
18 process, she's going for sure. And we're trying to  
19 talk one of the two nurses to go along.

20 JOHN: Okay. Great.

21 STEVE: And they're, you know, it's kind of  
22 one of these things well, which one should go. And  
23 they're kind of looking at each other and we're just  
24 about got convinced at least one of them to go, you  
25 know --

1                   JOHN: Okay.

2                   STEVE: -- with her and everything so -- and  
3 it's kind of a surprise to them. You know, it's late  
4 at night. And they're, they, they don't --

5                   JOHN: Yeah.

6                   STEVE: -- like the idea of going in the  
7 dark. And I'm trying -- we're trying to say well,  
8 they'll, they'll be gentle with you and --

9                   JOHN: You bet your life.

10                  STEVE: You know, they, they always want to  
11 wait until the morning when the sun's up and all that.  
12 And we're saying well, you know, Vicky she needs --

13                  JOHN: Well, would it do any good if I  
14 talked to them do you think or no? I mean you got to  
15 make the best judge --

16                  STEVE: I think I can, I think I can  
17 convince them, you know. Because I've told them I've  
18 talked to -- I said the nice -- I really like these  
19 guys John Dolan and John Cox. I've spent a lot of  
20 time with them as David has. John Cox, he's listened  
21 to a lot of studies.

22                  JOHN: (Laughing.)

23                  STEVE: You got to at least give him --

24                  JOHN: I don't have to go to church for 6  
25 months, Steve.

1                   STEVE: (Laughing.) John, you're all right.

2                   JOHN: You know?

3                   STEVE: Oh, boy. I tell you. Yeah, one of  
4 them are coming. I'll call you right back to let you  
5 know which. In fact, he's even right now saying come  
6 on, ladies, you know. Vicky needs --

7                   JOHN: The other, the other two are pretty,  
8 pretty well ready?

9                   STEVE: I guess he -- what's her name --

10                  JOHN: Vicky and Rita?

11                  STEVE: Rita. She wants to hold on a little  
12 bit. She's weak in the knees. She said she just  
13 wants to ask him a few more questions. She's --

14                  JOHN: Yeah.

15                  STEVE: -- she's -- in her mind she wants to  
16 go, of course.

17                  JOHN: Yeah.

18                  STEVE: You know, she says let me, let me  
19 wait until a time of day at least, and I can get my  
20 head straight here and --

21                  JOHN: Well --

22                  STEVE: -- and so we said well, Vicky, now  
23 she wants to go. And now we're trying to tell one of  
24 the nurses come on, let's -- you know, help out here.  
25 Help out here.

1 JOHN: Because --

2 STEVE: So you know, Dave --

3 JOHN: Hey, if it takes --

4 STEVE: -- he's, he's telling them himself,  
5 John. He says hey, I'm going out there myself. He  
6 says but I'm trying to get you people together and,  
7 and --

8 JOHN: Sure.

9 STEVE: -- get yourself moving here now.

10 JOHN: Sure.

11 STEVE: So that's kind of where he's at. So  
12 you know, you know, you know how it goes. They're  
13 weak in the knees, and they're a little afraid and  
14 apprehensive and all that and --

15 JOHN: Well, basically what we need is 15  
16 minutes to tell the people --

17 STEVE: You do. Okay.

18 JOHN: -- to bring that ambulance up there.

19 STEVE: Okay.

20 JOHN: And --

21 STEVE: So let, let me go and talk --

22 JOHN: -- do you want me to have them move  
23 it up there now?

24 STEVE: You know, you actually could. But  
25 then in the process they might need to go to their

1 rooms and kind of -- because they haven't even thrown  
2 their things together. This is the first they know of  
3 it. You know, he's been telling everybody, you know,  
4 get ready to go. Because we're going to be asking  
5 you. You got to get yourselves together, you know.  
6 Ever since this happened, you know, a lot of --

7 JOHN: Yeah.

8 STEVE: -- these women, the older ones, you  
9 know, they, all they heard was -- they never saw  
10 anything, anybody. They just heard bullets and --

11 JOHN: Yeah, yeah.

12 STEVE: You know, it's just been a scary  
13 experience for them and so --

14 JOHN: Who, who will the nurse be, do you  
15 know?

16 STEVE: It's going to either be Zilla  
17 (phonetic sp.) Henry or Netta. And I don't know what  
18 her last name is. I only know her by the first name.

19 JOHN: Okay. Okay.

20 STEVE: So even --

21 JOHN: Well, if it's Zilla --

22 STEVE: Yeah. She's already got an attorney  
23 and her husband (indiscernible) --

24 JOHN: Do you want to have her children come  
25 out with her?

1                   STEVE: They don't even know yet. I think a  
2 lot of them --

3                   JOHN: And we can handle it. If you want to  
4 have her children come out, if that would give her  
5 some more support, that's fine.

6                   STEVE: Okay, I'll go mention it to, to her  
7 then.

8                   JOHN: You know. It, it may be easier to,  
9 to have the children be supportive of her.

10                  STEVE: David's calling me. Just hang on  
11 one second, John.

12                  JOHN: Okay.

13                  STEVE: Maybe there's something else here  
14 that's happened.

15                  JOHN: Okay, go ahead. I'll hold on.

16                  [*gap*]

17                  STEVE: John?

18                  JOHN: Yes, sir.

19                  STEVE: I'm going to give you to David here.  
20 Just hang on. Because you know, we're talking with  
21 some of them right now and --

22                  JOHN: Go ahead. Go ahead.

23                  STEVE: Okay, hang on. Trying to get the  
24 phone here, got a long cord and -- okay. Okay, here  
25 he is.

1 JOHN: All right.  
2 [gap]  
3 DAVID: Say, John?  
4 JOHN: Hey, David.  
5 DAVID: Could you all, could you all send  
6 another bug in here, please?  
7 JOHN: (Laughing.)  
8 DAVID: I wish you could hear some of this.  
9 JOHN: I wish I could too, huh?  
10 DAVID: The things -- no, seriously.  
11 JOHN: What, what kind do you want?  
12 DAVID: I need one of those ones that you  
13 had before.  
14 JOHN: Just any old one?  
15 DAVID: Hey, wait a minute. We could put  
16 one of those things back together, huh, Steve?  
17 (Unidentified voices in background not discernible.)  
18 Okay. Just you know, you think you guys are  
19 negotiators. I mean, you know --  
20 JOHN: Hey.  
21 DAVID: -- you know, people are really --  
22 JOHN: You've got the Lord on your side.  
23 Remember that.  
24 DAVID: Yeah, I know. But remember,  
25 remember the disciples 2,000 years ago?



1 JOHN: Lord.

2 DAVID: Remember that?

3 JOHN: Yes.

4 DAVID: I mean they were really confirmed,  
5 they were really strong with Christ around, weren't  
6 they?

7 JOHN: Well --

8 DAVID: But when --

9 JOHN: -- be strong. Be strong.

10 DAVID: I know. Well, here's the thing now,  
11 John.

12 JOHN: Yeah.

13 DAVID: They're being strong, but like I  
14 say, they're, they're being shown the prophetic word  
15 again. That's all they've got now. Remember that.

16 JOHN: Well, I know they've got the fear of  
17 the unknown too, don't they?

18 DAVID: Well, you see the -- what's known is  
19 clear in front of their eyes according to the flesh.

20 JOHN: Well, I mean the fear of unknown, of  
21 coming out and --

22 DAVID: But no, no, no. That's not the  
23 thing. The fear of the --

24 JOHN: You don't think so?

25 DAVID: No. The fear of the unknown is

1 whether God's going to do what he says or not.

2 JOHN: Well, you know we're doing what we  
3 say.

4 DAVID: Yeah, I know. I know.

5 JOHN: And we're not, we're not --

6 DAVID: But I understand.

7 JOHN: -- playing games that way or anything  
8 else, you know.

9 DAVID: Understand. Like I say, the  
10 confirmation of the word of God is the final hope of  
11 mankind anyway. Okay, so, so anyway, go ahead and  
12 send the Bradley.

13 JOHN: Okay.

14 DAVID: And --

15 JOHN: I mentioned, I mentioned to Steve,  
16 and I'll pass it by you for your thoughts on it. He  
17 said that one of the nurses will probably accompany  
18 Vicky and Rita out. And the --

19 DAVID: Well, Rita's --

20 JOHN: Excuse me.

21 DAVID: -- Rita's going to stay until the  
22 morning.

23 JOHN: Okay. All right.

24 DAVID: Okay?

25 JOHN: But he said one of the, one of the --

1 she just --

2 DAVID: Rita's always given me problems.

3 JOHN: She's just a little hesitant, huh?

4 DAVID: (Laughing.) Yeah. Wait until you  
5 meet her.

6 JOHN: Well, I've talked to her a couple of  
7 times.

8 DAVID: Yeah.

9 JOHN: And --

10 DAVID: She's from North Carolina. You know  
11 how those girls are out there, right?

12 JOHN: She's got tar between her --

13 DAVID: Yeah.

14 JOHN: -- toes, huh? Tarheel.

15 DAVID: Yeah.

16 JOHN: But he mentioned that, that Zilla may  
17 be one of the nurses coming out and if --

18 DAVID: Oh. It's --

19 JOHN: Okay.

20 DAVID: -- what's, what's your complete  
21 name? What's the complete one? Anetta Richards.

22 JOHN: Annette --

23 DAVID: Annetta --

24 JOHN: Uh-huh.

25 DAVID: -- Richards.

1 JOHN: Okay.

2 DAVID: What's your son's name? And write  
3 this down. Vivian --

4 JOHN: Um-hum.

5 DAVID: -- Wilson. Vivian Wilson. Huh?  
6 Yeah, it's a nephew. He's like your son though.

7 JOHN: Her, her nephew is Vivian --

8 DAVID: Vivian Williams. Wilson. Wilson.

9 JOHN: Okay.

10 DAVID: Wilson. And if you would, if you  
11 would, if you could contact him, he's in, he's in  
12 Canada.

13 JOHN: We may try to make some arrangements  
14 for her to contact him too --

15 DAVID: Okay.

16 JOHN: -- when she comes out.

17 DAVID: Okay. Well --

18 JOHN: We're, we're certainly not opposed to  
19 doing something like that.

20 DAVID: Well, that's what I told her and  
21 everything. And she definitely would like to talk to  
22 him.

23 JOHN: Okay. So she will be accompanying  
24 Vicky out then?

25 DAVID: Right.

1                   JOHN: Okay. Don't, don't --

2                   DAVID: We're, and we're --

3                   JOHN: -- have her come out until I call  
4 back in though. Because I'm going to call them and  
5 tell them to send the, the Bradley that's configured  
6 like an ambulance forward.

6                   DAVID: Right.

7                   JOHN: Okay.

8                   DAVID: Now remember, and Vicky like I say  
9 she, she needs her -- well, you know, she needs, she  
10 needs some, she needs some care and stuff.

11                   JOHN: Well, she's going to have a doctor  
12 look at her right away.

12                   DAVID: Okay.

13                   JOHN: When she comes out. Do you know  
14 specifically what problems she has?

15                   DAVID: Well, she's on --

16                   JOHN: I mean is she a diabetic or anything  
17 like --

18                   DAVID: She's on heart medication.

19                   JOHN: And she knows what type of  
20 medication.

21                   DAVID: Yeah. As a matter of fact, she'll  
22 bring it out with her.

23                   JOHN: Fine.

24

1                   DAVID: You know, just, they -- I'm sure  
2 they worked it out last night with the guys. Because  
3 you know, it disturbed a lot of people here last night  
4 with the guys, you know, hollering and screaming.

5                   JOHN: Yeah.

6                   DAVID: It sounded like, you know, another  
7 raid out there. But --

8                   JOHN: Yeah.

9                   DAVID: If they, if they want to, they can  
10 shine lights on these ladies and everything, you know,  
11 and --

12                   JOHN: I'm sure they will.

13                   DAVID: And --

14                   JOHN: And the place is probably pretty well  
15 lit up anyhow, huh?

16                   DAVID: Right.

17                   JOHN: Will they be carrying anything?

18                   DAVID: Just their Bibles --

19                   JOHN: Uh-huh.

20                   DAVID: -- and what else, what else you all  
21 going to be carrying?

22                   [*gap*]

23                   DAVID: Well, well now, well see, when they  
24 come, when they come back here, they'll, they'll sort  
25 everything out and stuff like that. So don't worry

1 about that kind of stuff, okay? You don't need, you  
2 don't need to take your suitcases or nothing. Just  
3 take your immediate clothes and everything that you  
4 got, you know, what you're wearing. And then we'll  
5 work that all out later, okay?

6 She wanted to know if she should take all  
7 her suitcases and all that and --

8 JOHN: Yeah. No.

9 DAVID: How old are you, Vicky? She's 59  
10 so.

11 JOHN: Okay. And do you know how old Anetta  
12 is?

13 DAVID: How old are you, Anetta? She's 63.

14 JOHN: Sixty-three. Okay. I will call you  
15 when the vehicle is in place up there, okay? Because  
16 we're telling them to go ahead --

17 DAVID: Now, now --

18 JOHN: -- and move it up. Oh, are they  
19 going to be carrying anything besides their Bibles?

20 DAVID: You going to have anything besides  
21 your Bibles? Maybe a sack or something with maybe a  
22 extra change -- what do you -- what do they need?  
23 They need a change of clothes or what?

24 JOHN: No. No, they don't.

25 DAVID: All right.

1 JOHN: As a matter of fact --

2 DAVID: Underwear?

3 JOHN: No. It's all provided for them.

4 DAVID: All right. Okay. Maybe your Bibles  
5 and what you're wearing.

6 JOHN: Yeah.

7 DAVID: Okie doke.

8 JOHN: Okay. I'll call you back --

9 DAVID: Remember, the Bradley needs to come  
10 right up near the front.

11 JOHN: Is it going to come -- I can tell you  
12 where it's going to come.

13 DAVID: All right.

14 JOHN: It's going to come up to the bend in  
15 the road where the light is outside where the -- right  
16 near where the bus was, okay?

17 DAVID: Okay.

18 JOHN: All right? And I'll call you when  
19 it's in place.

20 DAVID: All right.

21 JOHN: I appreciate what you're doing.

22 DAVID: Okay. We're still working -- we're  
23 getting this, we're getting this resolved now.

24 JOHN: Okay, and --

25 DAVID: Appreciate you --





1 STEVE: Yeah, they're getting ready now.  
2 It's --  
3 JOHN: Okay. The vehicle is up there.  
4 STEVE: It is. Okay --  
5 JOHN: And it's stationary right now waiting  
6 for them. I guess it's got a couple of lights on.  
7 STEVE: Okay. So they can just go right to  
8 the vehicle.  
9 JOHN: Yeah. She'll be --  
10 STEVE: Okay. It's there. One's putting  
11 on -- changing her dress. And they're, they're ready.  
12 JOHN: Okay.  
13 STEVE: Yeah, they'll just be --  
14 JOHN: The nurse will be able to handle her  
15 all right?  
16 STEVE: Vicky, Vicky walks slow. She's

20 JOHN: Okay.  
21 STEVE: -- walking very slow. And the nurse  
22 will --  
23 JOHN: But the nurse will be able to --  
24 STEVE: Yeah.  
25 JOHN: -- handle her all right?

1 STEVE: Right. Yeah, I think she can.  
2 JOHN: Well, we're --  
3 STEVE: I hope you know that --  
4 JOHN: -- we're patient.  
5 STEVE: Okay.  
6 JOHN: So --  
7 STEVE: It helps. It really helps.  
8 JOHN: Just take them -- tell they can go  
9 out anytime they want. The vehicle is out there  
10 waiting for them.  
11 STEVE: Okay.  
12 JOHN: And, and once they're safely in and,  
13 and back at our forward area there I'll give you a  
14 call and let you know that everything's all right.  
15 STEVE: Super. That would be great, John.

5                   STEVE: You know -- yeah.

6                   JOHN: -- a lot of credibility here and --

7                   STEVE: Right. Right.

8                   JOHN: I know how hard you and, and David  
9 are working at this thing and just --

10                  STEVE: Oh, believe me --

11                  JOHN: -- keep up the good work.

12                  STEVE: I'm dry from all the talking. He's  
13 like I am.

14                  JOHN: You know. (Unidentified male voice  
15 in background not discernible.) We -- what me may be  
16 able to work out is -- what we're going to do with  
17 Victoria I'll tell you right now is we're going to  
18 take her to a hospital.

19                  STEVE: Okay.

20                  JOHN: Uh-huh. That's probably the best  
21 thing, don't you think so?

22                  STEVE: I don't know. Let me -- David knows  
23 more about it. He says that what they'll do is  
24 (indiscernible) and take her right to a hospital, or  
25 how bad is she? So they might do that.

1                   JOHN: What?

2                   DAVID: Well, tell them check her vital

3 signs --

4                   STEVE: I guess check her vital signs.

5                   DAVID: She wasn't eating any food.

6                   STEVE: She, she wasn't eating any food

7 so --                   DAVID: She wanted to die in here --

8                   JOHN: We're, we're going to get her a good,

9 good check-up.

10                   STEVE: Should I, should I say that? Okay.

11 David said, David said she wanted to die here and not

12 out there. And David --

13                   JOHN: Well --

14                   STEVE: -- you know, just tell her hey,

15 Vicky, you know --

16                   JOHN: We're going to get her a good

17 physical check-up.

18                   STEVE: He says that's not what our purpose

19 is, you know.

20                   JOHN: That's right. That's right.

21                   STEVE: So he had to tell her that.

22                   JOHN: Whenever they're ready to come out,

23 let them come out.

24                   STEVE: Okay.

25                   JOHN: And, and the vehicle is sitting over

1 | there --

2 |           STEVE: It will be pretty quick here.  
3 | Because you know, they left. They're already like in  
4 | their, in their rooms getting ready right now. So I  
5 | don't think it will be just too long here.

6 |           JOHN: Okay.

7 |           STEVE: Yeah. So yeah, I'll, I'll make sure  
8 | I'll be down there with them and --

9 |           JOHN: Okay.

10 |           STEVE: -- to the door and then make sure  
11 | they get out the door okay and everything.

12 |           JOHN: Okay. Give me, give me a jingle when  
13 | they go out the door, will you?

14 |           STEVE: Okay, I'll do that. I'll come right  
15 | back on the phone then.

16 |           JOHN: Thank you.

17 |           STEVE: Okay, I'll talk to you in a minute.

18 |           JOHN: All right.

19 |           STEVE: Okay, bye.

21 |           JOHN: Hello?

22 |           STEVE: John.

23 |           JOHN: Yeah.

24 |           STEVE: Man, that was quick. I didn't even  
25 | hear the phone ring.

1 JOHN: It rang here. It rang here.

2 STEVE: (Laughing.) Hey --

3 JOHN: They're on their way?

4 STEVE: Guess what? Guess what, John?

5 JOHN: What?

6 STEVE: They've decided not to come.

7 JOHN: Don't tell me that.

1 STEVE: And he's way over in London.

2 JOHN: Well, we already talked to Jack, the  
3 Sheriff?

4 STEVE: Yeah.

5 JOHN: And she's going to be able to contact  
6 him.

7 STEVE: Okay. And Anetta Richards, she's  
8 coming right out too.

9 JOHN: Okay.

10 STEVE: And you know, I want to get a good  
11 night's rest. Come the morning, you know, it's back  
12 to work.

13 JOHN: Yeah.

14 STEVE: Come the morning, it's back to work  
15 so --

16 JOHN: Well, do, do you see any that --

17 STEVE: David, he's going to be working  
18 right through the night himself.

19 JOHN: Good.

20 STEVE: So I, I need to get some rest. I've  
21 been missing out --

1                   STEVE: Okay.

2                   JOHN: What I want to do is call back and

3 You know, 2,000 years ago, Christ his word -- it's  
4 over. You got to keep your mind on the throne. On  
5 one, the last judgment. Times two, times three.  
6 Isaiah, Jeremiah, Ezekial (indiscernible). We got a
