Biographical/Historical note

Don Lucas is an alumnus of Southwest Texas State Teachers College; he graduated in May 1957 with a B.B.A. He and his wife, Carol, donated university publications and personal memorabilia related to his time as a student and as an alumnus.

Scope and Contents note

Memorabilia related to Don Lucas' time as a student includes newspaper clippings, homecoming ribbons, and receipts.

Especially notable are items related to Eleanor Roosevelt's 1957 lecture, which consist of a ticket to the event and an annotated lecture program.

A freshman beanie, identified by the words "Harris Hall," "Fish Don Lucas, Houston," and the letters "HH," is a notable artifact from the 1950s.
