Mettie Workman is an alumna of Southwest Texas State Normal College, who received her Primary Arts diploma in June 1920. Workman was from Evant, Texas, and she enrolled in the Sophomore Certificate program during the 1919-1920 school year. While a student, she was a member of Idyllic, H.E. Club, Country Life Club (secretary), and the Story Tellers League.
