Mr. Jack Wright moved to San Marcos in 1925 at the age of three, when his father began teaching in the English Department at Southwest Texas State Teacher's College. He quite literally grew up on the SWT campus, attending the campus elementary and junior high school (he then attended the city high school, which at the time was located off-campus). He continued his education by earning his teaching certificate, becoming one of the many people who gained the bulk of their education on "college hill."
