Gauging Research Purpose

Logic of Rating

Common way of thinking, doing and making in PA

- MPA Program Accreditation
- University Accreditation
- Professional Certification
- Assessment of job candidate (rubric)
- Rating of Schools, School Districts Texas Education Agency
- Safety Regulations Adherence
- Evaluation of Program Processes (use of standards)
- Regulations with Standards generally
- Rating using best practices
- Auditing that uses standards





Research Purposes

1. Explanation
 2. Description
 3. Exploration

4.GAUGING





Gauging

- is a **normative** research purpose that uses a **logic of rating** and is often used in **assessment**
- is generally **applied research** that uses mixed methods
- is **problem oriented** and has limited external validity

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Democracy and Social Ethics Jane Addams

Democracy

She had an expansive view of democracy that included social justice. She linked social morality to a larger democratic spirit, one that implied "that diversified human experience and resultant sympathy are the foundations and guarantee of democracy" (Addams, 1902, p. 7). She moved beyond considering democracy's essentially political expression; rather, she also articulated and emphasized its social function (Addams, 1893, p. 14).

Way of life.

Includes a place-based problem orientation. It happens on the ground as we work to resolve problems.
