

Improves ability to solve problems and make predictions



#### Children's Interest in Science-Earlier the Better


More likely to pursue science in college

 Children spend most of their time with parents and family


 Home experiences affect interest in science


#### Attitude Toward Science - Javier (2017)




Parent Perceptions of Family Science Event (n=9)
